
MUNICIPAL RESOLUTION NO. 2024-54

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING FOR A RECONSIDERATION IN THE DECISION OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF LEYTE IN RETURNING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2023-18 AND MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2023-19 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF JULITA, LEYTE FOR FURTHER STUDY REGARDING THE SOURCE OF FUND

WHEREAS, Municipal Ordinance No. 2023-18 of the Municipality of Julita, entitled "An Ordinance Institutionalizing the Grant of Cash Incentives to Individuals or Groups Who Excelled in Sports and Academic Competitions in the Municipality of Julita, Leyte, Appropriating Funds and Providing Guidelines Thereof" and Municipal Ordinance No. 2023-19 of the Municipality of Julita, entitled "An Ordinance Institutionalizing the Academic Excellence Awards of the Municipality of Julita, Leyte, Appropriating Funds and Providing Guidelines Thereof, and for Other Purposes" were indorsed to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte last August 18, 2023 for its appropriate review;

WHEREAS, on August 22, 2023, the said Municipal Ordinances were referred to the Provincial Legal Office for review;

WHEREAS, on August 24 2023, the Provincial Legal Office rendered its comments/opinions on the said Municipal Ordinances recommending a review on the source of fund stipulated in the ordinance and to ensure that it does not run contrary to the mandate of Section 335 Chapter 4 of the Local Government Code of 1991;



WHEREAS, on September 5, 2023, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan passed SP Resolution No. 2023-412 entitled "A Resolution Returning to the Sangguniang Bayan of origin Municipal Ordinance Nos. 2023-18 and 2023-19 of Julita, Leyte for Proper Correction";

WHEREAS, Section 335 Chapter 4 of the Local Government Code of 1991 states that "No public money or property shall be appropriated or applied for religious or private purposes.";

WHEREAS, the said Municipal Ordinances aims to promote programs that shall further inspire the constituents of the Municipality of Julita, especially the youth, to aspire for excellence in their craft, reach their dreams and become productive members of the society;

WHEREAS, the programs and activities shall be implemented by the Local Government Unit of Julita, Leyte;

WHEREAS, upon further research and consultation, similar ordinances exist and are being implemented by different municipalities, cities and provinces in the country;

WHEREAS, funding for such programs and activities are charged from the General Fund Annual Budget of the respective municipalities, cities and provinces;

WHEREAS, these enacted ordinances are imbued with public interest, so much that it shall be the basis of the general public to rely upon in performing their respective obligations or asserting their rights in a given territory;

WHEREFORE on motion of the *Hon. Mark Joy E. Macaso*, duly seconded by the *Hon. Nolie C. Caña* and the *Hon. Allan T. Novales*, be it;

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, TO REQUEST FOR A RECONSIDERATION IN THE DECISION OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF LEYTE IN RETURNING THE SAID ORDINANCES FOR PROPER CORRECTION.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished the *Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte and the Provincial Legal Office, Province of Leyte, Palo, Leyte* for its information, guidance and appropriate action.

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-412

A RESOLUTION RETURNING TO THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF ORIGIN MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NOS. 2023-18 AND 2023-19 OF JULITA, LEYTE FOR PROPER CORRECTION.

WHEREAS, submitted to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan are the following Ordinances from Julita, Leyte, to wit:

- 1. Municipal Ordinance No. 2023-18, entitled: "AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE GRANT OF CASH INCENTIVES TO INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS WHO EXCELLED IN SPORTS AND ACADEMIC COMPETITIONS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF JULITA, LEYTE, APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND PROVIDING GUIDELINES THEREOF";
- 2. Municipal Ordinance No. 2023-19, entitled: "AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AWARDS PROGRAM OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF JULITA, LEYTE, APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND PROVIDING GUIDELINES THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES":

WHEREAS, the Provincial Legal Office was requested to review and submit recommendation on the subject Ordinances pursuant to Section 481 (3) (vii) of R.A. 7160;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Legal Office rendered similar comments/opinions on both **Municipal Ordinance Nos. 2023-18** and **2023-19** to wit:

- 1. That Ordinance No. 2023-18 intends to grant "Cash Incentives" to individuals or groups who excelled in sports and academic competitions;
- 2. That pursuant to the 4th "whereas" of subject Ordinance as is, such legislative act shall further inspire the athletes to continue to improve in order to reach their dreams and aspirations to help uplift their families and the community and serve as a guide to success for others taking the same path;

- 3. That pursuant thereto, Section 8 (source of fund), of subject Ordinance, the budget shall be allocated in the Annual Budget, an indication that the fund to be used will be coming from the government coffers;
- 4. That the enactment of subject Ordinance is indeed laudable, as it will give inspiration to graduates as indicated in the 4th "whereas" of subject Ordinance;
- 5. That on the other hand, Section 335, chapter 4 of Local Government Code states;

"Section 335, Chapter 4 – No public money or property shall be appropriated or applied for religious or private purposes"

6. That in view thereof, the Provincial Legal office is of the opinion that a review be made on the subject of where the funds are to be sourced regarding Section 7 of the Ordinance to ensure that the same does not run contrary to the mandate of Section 335 Chapter 4 of the Code.

WHEREAS, on **Ordinance No. 2023-19**, the Provincial Legal Office opined to wit:

- That pursuant to the 4th "whereas" of subject Ordinance, the same intends to provide rewards and incentives to children and youth in order to inspire them towards a path of achieving academic excellence etc.;
- 2. That the Ordinance provides for the allocation of the fund to be used as cash incentives for these children and youth recognition of the Academic Excellence that they achieved;
- 3. That pursuant to Section 7 of the Ordinance, the budget shall be allocated in the Annual Budget of the LGU concerned, which means the same shall be taken from the LGU fund, a Government fund;
- That worthy of note is the provision of Section 335, Chapter 4
 of Code, quoted for reference;

"Section 335, Chapter 4 – No public money or property shall be appropriated or applied for religious or private purposes"

5. That in view thereof, the Provincial Legal office is of the opinion that a review be made on the subject of where the funds are to be sourced regarding Section 7 of the Ordinance to ensure that the same does not run contrary to the mandate of Section 335 Chapter 4 of the Code.

WHEREAS, the August Body, deemed it proper, to return said Ordinances for proper correction;

NOW, THEREFORE, on omnibus motion presented by Honorable Raissa J. Villasin, duly seconded by Honorable Ma. Corazon E. Remandaban, be it

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to RETURN TO THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF ORIGIN MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NOS. 2023-18 AND 2023-19 OF JULITA, LEYTE FOR PROPER CORRECTION.



"AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE GRANT OF CASH INCENTIVES TO INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS WHO EXCELLED IN SPORTS AND ACADEMIC COMPETITIONS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF JULITA, LEYTE, APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND PROVIDING GUIDELINES THEREOF.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

WHEREAS, further, Paragraph 19 of Section 2, Article 14, of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the State shall promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork, and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry;

WHEREAS, The Philippine Government has adopted a policy of giving incentives to athletes who are winners or medalists in legitimate international and local sports competitions pursuant to R.A. 9064 or the National Athletes. Coaches and Trainers Benefits and Incentives Act of 2001;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Julita, Leyte recognizes the pride and honor that winners of sports, skills and academic competitions bring to the Municipality that shall serve as an inspiration and a good role model to the citizens of this municipality, especially to the youth;

WHEREAS, such incentive program shall further inspire the athletes to continue to improve in order to reach their dreams and aspirations to help uplift their own families and the community and serve as a guide to success for others taking the same path;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of the *Hon. Mark Joy E. Macaso*, duly seconded by the *Hon. Aliana Marie R. Tubi and the Hon. Rosila L. Advincula;*


BE IT ENACTED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Julita, Leyte, in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. Title. This Municipal Ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Institutionalizing the Grant of Cash Incentives to Individuals or Groups Who Excelled in Sports and Academic Competitions in the Municipality of Julita, Appropriating Funds and Providing Guidelines Thereof"

SECTION 2. Declaration of Policy. It is hereby declared a policy of the Municipality of Julita, Leyte to grant financial incentives to deserving individuals for having given honor to this municipality in various legitimate competitions in the fields of sports and academics competitions. This program shall be known as the Julita Sports and Academic Competitions Awards Program.

SECTION 3. Definition of Terms.

 Sports Competitions - refer to various sports competitions in the local, national, international or worldwide levels and are duly organized,



GERMAN J. MACASO Municipal Vice Mayor accredited or sanctioned by government agencies for competitions conducted within the country. Participation in International and Worldwide competitions must have been permitted and/or authorized by the concerned national government agency

- b. Academic Competitions refer to the academic related competitions in the local, national, international or worldwide levels and are duly organized by national government agencies for competitions conducted within the country. Participation in International and Worldwide competitions must have been permitted and/or authorized by the concerned national government agency.
- c. Government agencies Local government agencies or units such as a Municipal Government, Provincial Government, etc. National government agencies such as the Department of Education, Philippine Olympic Committee, Philippine Sports Competition, Department of the Interior and Local Government, Commission on Higher Education, etc.
- d. International Competition a competition that is participated by other nations and are sanctioned by an international sanctioning body, example the International Olympic Committee. It can be held in other countries or can be hosted in the Philippines. These competitions include but are not limited to Summer Olympics (every 4 years), Winter Olympics (every 4 years, Asian Games (every 4 years), World Championship of respective sports, Asian Championship of respective sports, Southeast Asian (SEA) Games (every 2 years), ASEAN Championship of respective sports, Special Olympics
- e. National Competition a competition that is participated by individuals or teams from the different regions of the country such as but not limited to, Palarong Pambansa, Philippine National Youth Games (Batang Pinoy), National Open, National Games, Special Olympics
- f. Regional Competition a competition that is participated by individuals or teams from Region VIII such as but not limited to, Eastern Visayas Regional Athletics Association (EVRAA), Regional Schools Colleges and Universities Athletics Association (SCUAA)
- g. Provincial Competition a competition that is participated by individuals or teams from Leyte such as but not limited to Leyte Provincial Meet
- h. Area Competition a competition that is participated by individuals or teams from an area of Leyte in which a the Municipality is a part of such as but not limited to Area Meet
- i. Athlete/Contestant the individual who participated in the competition and has won the award
- j. Coach a person registered or authorized to train an athlete/contestant or a team of athletes/contestants before and during the competition.
- k. Individual Sport/Competition a type of competition that is participated by only one (1) participant as indicated in the rules of the competition
- Team Sport/Competition a type of competition that is participated by five
 or more participants as indicated in the rules of the competition

SECTION 4. Julita Sports and Academic Competition Excellence Awards Program Committee (JSACEAPC). The Julita Sports and Academic Competitions Excellence Awards Program Committee (JSACEAPC) is hereby created with the following composition and functions:


The Committee shall have the following functions and duties:

- 1. Formulate the necessary rules and regulations to implement the provisions of this Ordinance.
- 2. Evaluate and approve applicants and recipients of these awards.
- 3. Maintain a historical record of all the recipients of these awards as a permanent record of the Municipality of Julita.
- 4. Evaluate the effectiveness of Julita Sports and Academic Competitions Excellence Awards Program.
- 5. Shall convene at least twice a year or as often as maybe necessary, with the majority of the Board to constitute quorum, to (1) evaluate the effectiveness of the program; and (2) Evaluate and approve the applicants of these awards

SECTION 5. Qualification of Grantees. To qualify as a grantee, he/she must:

- 1. A bona-fide resident of the Municipality of Julita for as certified by the respective Punong Barangay, or a non-resident of the municipality representing a school or any other institution located within the municipality;
- 2. With good moral standing as certified by the respective Punong Barangay;
- 3. Has informed the JSACEAPC of the award within a period of one (1) year from the date of competition, otherwise, their incentives shall be deemed forfeited;
- 4. Submitted original and/or certified true copy of certification and appropriate documentations that he/she has participated and won first (1st), second (2nd) or third (3nd) place or gold, silver, or bronze medals accordingly in a duly accredited sports or academic competition at a particular level (international, national, regional, provincial, or area); and
- 5. Duly certified by the Awards Committee that the grantee has satisfactorily submitted and have passed the basic requirements set forth in this ordinance through an appropriate resolution of the Committee





EXPLANATORY NOTE



- 5. Shall convene at least twice a year or as often as maybe necessary, with the majority of the Board to constitute quorum, to (1) evaluate the effectiveness of the program; and (2) Evaluate and approve the applicants of these awards.

SECTION 4. Qualification of Grantees. To qualify as a grantee, he/she must:

- A bona-fide resident of the Municipality of Julita for at least one (1) year as certified by the respective Punong Barangay;
- 2. With good moral standing as certified by the respective Punong Barangay;
- Has informed the committee of the award within a period of one (1) year from the date of recognition, award or result of the examination, otherwise, their incentives shall be deemed forfeited;
- 4. Has presented the original and/or certified true copy of certification and appropriate documentations that he/she has achieved such recognition, award or result of examination; and
- 5. Duly certified by the Awards Committee that the grantee has satisfactorily submitted and have passed the basic requirements set forth in this ordinance through an appropriate resolution of the Committee.


