ORDINANCE **ALLOWING** THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF MATAG-OB, LEYTE TO ENTER INTO USUFRUCTUARY AGREEMENT WITH INTERESTED PARTIES.

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Matag-ob aims to promote the tourism industry of Matag-ob.

WHEREAS, in promoting tourism industry in Matag-ob, it would correspondingly increase economic activities in the locality.

WHEREAS, as an avenue for business opportunities to increase economic activities in the locality, the Local Government Unit of Matag-ob may enter into usufructuary agreement with any interested parties subject to limitations provided herein.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Matag-ob, Leyte in regular session assembled:

ARTICLE I General Provision

Section 1. Title- This ordinance shall be known as ORDINANCE ALLOWING THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF MATAG-OB TO ENTER INTO USUFRUCTUARY AGREEMENT WITH INTERESTED PARTIES."

Section 2. Declaration of Policies - It is the policy of the municipality of Matag-ob, Leyte to promote tourism thereby boosting economic activities.

Section 3. Purpose and Scope - It is the main purpose of this Ordinance to augment locality's economic development thru tourism.

Section 4. Definition of Terms - As used in this Ordinance, the following terms shall be understood, construed, and shall mean as follows:

- (a) Grantor refers to the Local Government Unit of Matag-ob, Leyte.
- (b) Grantee refers to any individual or entity granted usufructuary rights over the subject property.
- Usufructuary Agreement- an agreement which embodies the terms and conditions between the Grantor and Grantee wherein the Grantor gives the Grantee the right of usufruct over the Property while the Grantee uses the subject property for its own benefit and/or operation.
- (e) Patrimonial Property any property of the municipality not intended for government use or any property not entirely devoted to a government purpose.

Section 5. Limitations- The following shall refer to the terms and condition embodied in the usufructuary agreement.

- 1. The grant of usufructuary rights shall be for a period to be determined by the parties but not less than Twelve Years (12), starting from the date of execution of Usufructuary Agreement. Upon termination of the usufruct, the Grantee is given the priority to lease the site and/or premises.
- 2. The property subject of usufructuary agreement shall be located in an area that can boost economic activity and suitable for the promotion of local tourism.
- 3. The Grantee shall exercise its right to the exclusive use of the site for business activity related to TOURISM, specifically the operation of any establishment that can promote Matag-ob, Leyte as a tourist destination.
- 4. In relation thereto, the Grantee shall construct and maintain facilities, structures and improvements such as landscape but not limited to it, in accordance with local ordinance and/or national laws on environmental safety, maintenance and preservation.

- 5. While the usufruct and/or the beneficial use of the site is transferred to the Grantee, the ownership and title of site remains with and continues to be in the Grantor. Upon the termination of the usufruct, any improvements introduced on the thereon shall accrue to the Grantor.
- 6. The Grantee shall secure the corresponding permits prior to the operation of its business:
 - a) Business Permit
 - b) Building Permit
 - c) Occupancy Permit
 - d) Sanitary Permit
 - e) and other permits which the local government unit may require.
- 7. Utility bills and miscellaneous fees on the Property during the duration of the usufruct shall be borne by the Grantee.
- 8. The Grantee shall peaceably hold and enjoy the full use and possession of the Property for the duration of the usufruct
- 9. The duties and obligations of Grantee as usufructuary provided for in the relevant provisions of the New Civil Code of the Philippines are deemed part of the provisions of the Usufructuary Agreement.
- 10. The Grantor can terminate the usufruct should the Grantee violate any provision of the Usufructuary Agreement and fail to comply with its obligations.
- 11. The Usufructuary Agreement shall be binding between the parties, their respective assigns and successorsin-interest.
- 12. The parties and its successors in interest shall at all times exercise good faith in the performance of their obligations and the exercise of their rights under the Usufructuary Agreement.

Section 9. Separability Clause- If for any reason, any provision, section or part of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction or suspended or revoked, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remaining, sections or parts thereof, which shall remain or continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 10. Repealing Clause- All Ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations, or parts thereof, whose
