

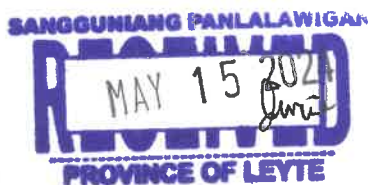

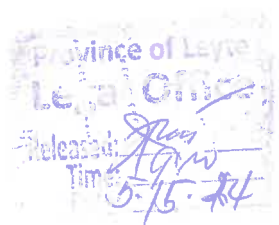

ORDINANCE NO. 24-01

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING CASH INCENTIVES TO VICTORIOUS INOPACAN
ATHLETES IN ANY SPORTS EVENTS WHETHER LOCAL AND/OR
INTERNATIONAL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR IMPLEMENTATION
THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, the Philippine Government has adopted a policy of giving incentives to athletes who are winners or medalists in legitimate international and local sports competitions pursuant to R.A. 9064 or the Sports Benefits and Incentives Act of 2001;

WHEREAS, winning athletes bring prestige not only to themselves or to their families but also to our beloved Municipality of Inopacan;

WHEREAS, the granting of cash incentives to the winning athletes is a way of motivating them to continually excel in sports and to inspire other potential athletes to

follow suit thereby sparing them from the bad influence of drugs and other criminal activities;

WHEREAS, in gratitude and recognition to the exemplary performance in sports, the Local Government Unit of Inopacan acknowledge them by providing cash incentives;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Alfie Jian B. Yamson, duly seconded by Honorable all the Members present, be it

RESOLVED as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to enact the following;

Section 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known as "Athletes Cash Incentives Ordinance of the Municipality of Inopacan";

Section 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS. As used in this ordinance, these terms shall have the following meaning:

2.1 Cash Incentives – refers to a monetary reward to inspire athletes to perform at their best and work towards personal or group athletics wide goal

2.2 Athlete – refers to a person who is proficient in sports and other forms of physical activities.

2.3 Local – refers to a Provincial, Regional and National Sports Event.

Section 3. QUALIFICATION OF GRANTEES. For the purpose of providing cash incentives, the following requirements and proceeding must be observed, to wit:

3.1 Athlete- Must be bonafide resident of the Municipality of Inopacan and must have duly represented the Municipality of Inopacan in participating in any sports competition;

3.2 He/She shall inform the Local Chief Executive and/or the Committee Chair on Youth and Sports Development in writing that she/he is an official representative of the schools or any sports competitions representing the Municipality of Inopacan duly signed by the coach and the school principal/school head.

3.3 A Certification from the Punong Barangay ascertaining the athlete's residency in that particular Barangay.

3.4 Athlete shall present to the Athlete Cash Incentives Committee the following, for verification, to wit:

3.4.3 PICTURES DURING THE GAME AND AWARDING

SECTION 4. ATHLETES CASH INCENTIVES. Athletes Cash Incentives to be granted are as follows:

4.1 Provincial Level

- 1st Place (Gold Medalist) - Php 1,500.00
- 2nd Place (Silver Medalist) - Php 1,000.00
- 3rd Place (Bronze Medalist) - Php 500.00

4.2 REGIONAL LEVEL

- 1ST PLACE (Gold Medalist) - Php 2,000.00
- 2ND PLACE (Silver Medalist) - Php 1,500.00
- 3RD PLACE (Bronze Medalist) - Php 1,000.00

4.3 NATIONAL LEVEL

- 1ST PLACE (Gold Medalist) - Php 3,000.00
- 2ND PLACE (Silver Medalist) - Php 2,500.00
- 3RD PLACE (Bronze Medalist) - Php 2,000.00

4.4 INTERNATIONAL LEVEL

- 1ST PLACE (Gold Medalist) - Php 5,000.00
- 2ND PLACE (Silver Medalist) - Php 4,000.00
- 3RD PLACE (Bronze Medalist) - Php 3,000.00

SECTION 5. CREATION OF ATHLETE CASH INCENTIVES COMMITTEE. The Athlete Cash Incentives Committee is hereby created, primarily to judiciously:

1. Verify athletes in the involvement of any sports activities, and;
2. Reward the winning athletes for their excellent performance in sports.

Cash Incentives Committee:

Chairman : Municipal Mayor

Vice Chair: SB member, Committee Chair on Youth & Sports

Members : Municipal Treasurer

SECTION 6. FUNDING REQUIREMENT. To carry out the provisions of this ordinance, initial fund in the amount of ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P100,000.00) shall be appropriated from the Youth and Sports Development under Municipal Mayor's Office.


SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 8. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, perspectives, executive order and/or rules and regulations inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and modified accordingly.


SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect after its approval.


