### COMMITTEE ON TOURISM, TRADE AND INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

Committee Report No. 06, S. 2024

This refers to the proposed provincial ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE LEVYING RENTAL FEES AND CHARGES FOR TOURISM FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT OWNED BY THE LEYTE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT".

During the committee meeting, clarifications and suggestions were made which are now provided for in the attached draft ordinance. The committee finds that the measure is timely and absolutely needed to be passed to raise funds to maintain, improve, and expand the Tourism Facilities and Equipment of the Leyte Provincial Government as mentioned in the proposed ordinance.

The committee also finds no provision in the said proposed measure that contravenes the Constitution and other existing laws and that the same is compliant to the general limitations of legislation, that:

- a. It does not contravene the Constitution;
- b. It is not unfair or oppressive;
- c. It is not partial or discriminatory;
- d. It does not prohibit trade;
- e. It is general and consistent with public policy; and
- f. It is not unreasonable.

In view thereof, this committee hereby recommends for the passage of the said ordinance and resolve that the same be scheduled for second reading, subject to the provisions of Sections 129<sup>2</sup> and 186<sup>3</sup> in relation to Sections 187<sup>4</sup> and 188<sup>5</sup> of Republic Act 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Section 129. Power to Create Sources of Revenue. — Each local government unit shall exercise its power to create its own sources of revenue and to levy taxes, fees, and charges subject to the provision herein, consistent with the basic policy of local autonomy. Such taxes, fees, and charges shall accrue exclusively to local government units.

Section 186. Power To Levy Other Taxes, Fees or Charges. - Local government units may exercise the power to levy taxes, fees or charges on any base or subject not otherwise specifically enumerated herein or taxed under the provisions of the National Internal Revenue Code, as amended, or other applicable laws. Provided, That the taxes, fees, or charges shall not be unjust, excessive, oppressive, confiscatory or contrary to declared national policy. Provided, further, That the ordinance levying such taxes, fees or charges shall not be enacted without any prior public hearing conducted for the purpose.

Section 187. Procedure for Approval and Effectivity of Tax ordinances and Revenue Measures, Mandatory Public Hearings. - The procedure for approval of local tax ordinances and revenue measures shall be in accordance with the provisions of this Code: Provided, That public hearings shall be conducted for the purpose prior to the enactment thereof: Provided, further, That any question on the constitutionality or legality of tax ordinances or revenue measures may be raised on appeal within thirty (30) days from the effectivity thereof to the Secretary of Justice who shall render a decision within sixty (60) days from the date of receipt of the appeal. Provided, however, That such appeal shall not have the effect of suspending the effectivity of the ordinance and the accrual and payment of the tax, fee, or charge levied therein: Provided, finally, That within thirty (30) days after receipt of the decision or the lapse of the sixty-day period without the Secretary of Justice acting upon the appeal, the aggrieved party may file appropriate proceedings with a court of competent jurisdiction.

Section 188. Publication of Tax ordinances and Revenue Measures. - Within ten (10) days after their approval, certified true copies of all provincial, city, and municipal tax ordinances or revenue shall be published in full for three (3) consecutive days in a newspaper of local circulation. Provided, however, That in provinces, cities and municipalities where there are no newspapers of local circulation, the same may be posted in at least two (2) conspicuous and publicly accessible places.

This committee certifies this proposed ordinance as URGENT.

WHEREAS. Section 129 of Republic Act 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 empowers Local Government Units (LGUs) like the Leyte Provincial Government to create its own sources of revenue, to wit:		
"Section 129. Power to Create Sources of Revenue. – Each local government unit shall exercise its power to create its own sources of revenue and to levy taxes, fees, and charges subject to the provision herein, consistent with the basic policy of local autonomy. Such taxes, fees, and charges shall accrue exclusively to local government units.";		
<b>WHEREAS</b> , the enactment of this Ordinance is very timely and absolutely needed to promote the tourism industry in the Province of Leyte;		
<b>WHEREAS</b> , it is vital to raise funds to maintain, improve, and expand the tourism facilities and equipment owned by the Leyte Provincial Government;		
NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Honorable, and duly seconded by Honorable, be it

## AN ORDINANCE LEVYING RENTAL FEES AND CHARGES FOR TOURISM FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT OWNED BY THE LEYTE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte, that:

**Section 1. Title.** This ordinance shall be known and cited as "An Ordinance Levying Rental Fee and Charges for the Tourism Facilities and Equipment Owned by the Leyte Provincial Government".

**Section 2. Scope.** The rental fees and charges imposed in this ordinance shall apply to those tourism facilities and equipment owned by the Leyte Provincial Government exclusively for tourism promotion.

Section 3. Definition. As used in this Ordinance:

- a. Equipment refers to the self-balancing scooters used for the Leyte Segway Tour.
- b. **Kiosks** refers to the 24 units 3m x 3m concrete Barbecue "BBQ" Kiosks located at the MacArthur Park Riverside.
- c. Power refers to the supply of electricity used to energize the tourism facilities.
- d. Stall refers to the 8 2x2m stalls located at the Leyte Pasalubong Center.
- e. **Tourism Facilities** refers to permanent structures owned by the Leyte Provincial Government like the Tourism Building and View Deck, Leyte Pasalubong Center, and the MacArthur Park Riverside Kiosks.

**Section 4. Fees and Charges.** The following schedule of fees and charges for the use of the Leyte Provincial Government Tourism Facilities and Equipment shall be imposed as follows:

a. Tourism Building and View Deck Exhibit Hall

Area: 126.4 sqm Capacity: 60 persons

Rental: Php 8,500.00 per 8hour event inclusive of electricity & water; additional

charge for lights & sound, and other appliances.

#### b. Tourism Building and View Deck Roof Deck Area

Area: 542.94 sqm

Rental: Php 14,500.00 per 8hour event inclusive of electricity, lights only;

additional charge for lights & sound, and other appliances.

#### c. MacArthur Park Riverside Kiosks

Area: 3x3 sqm

Rental: Php 2,000.00 per month excluding electricity & water; each kiosk will

be installed with electric and water submeters.

#### d. Leyte Pasalubong Center

Area: 2x2 sqm stalls

Rental: Php 2,000.00 per month.

#### e. Leyte Segway Tours at the Leyte Provincial Government Complex

Rental: Php 400.00 per 1 hour tour with tour guide.

**Section 5. Official Receipts and Permits.** Any use of the above Leyte Provincial Government Tourism Facilities and Equipment shall be covered by a Permit, which shall be issued by the Provincial Governor or his/her authorized representative. Any payment for the rental of said facilities shall be properly receipted by the Provincial Treasurer or his/her authorized representative.

**Section 6. Contract of Lease.** All tourism facilities rentals shall be covered by a lease contract. The terms and conditions of which shall be determined by the Office of the Provincial Governor subject to ratification of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan.

**Section 7. Tour Safety Agreement.** All Leyte Segway Tours shall be covered by a Tour Safety Agreement between the Leyte Tourism and Investment Promotion Center (LTIPC) and the client.

**Section 8. Exception.** The Fees and Charges shall not be imposed if subject facilities and equipment shall be used by the Leyte Provincial Government. Any other user, especially LGUs, accredited NGOs, Peoples' Organizations, and Civil Society Organizations maybe given a discount for exempted from payment of fees and charges at the discretion of the Provincial Governor.

Section 9. Reporting and Monitoring. The Leyte Tourism and Investment Promotion Center (LTIPC) shall lead and oversee the regular monitoring and evaluation of the implementation of this Ordinance. It may designate other relevant office/s or individuals to carry out monitoring, maintenance, and improvement activities in the various tourism facilities and equipment provided that all data gathered shall be submitted to and consolidated by the Leyte Tourism Investment and Promotion Center (LTIPC) for regular reporting to the Provincial Governor. These data shall also be used to decide on necessary actions, such as adjusting or modifying existing set of contracts or agreements, redesigning, or installing building improvements or repairs, and the frequency of such activities.

Section 10. Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR). The Provincial Governor may issue appropriate and relevant rules and regulations, as necessary for the proper implementation of any and all provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 11. Penal Provision. Violation of Section 4 of this Ordinance shall be ground for revocation of the permit or contract without prejudice to other remedies provided by law.

Section 12. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid and enforceable.

Section 13. Repealing Clause. Any provincial ordinance, resolution, rules and regulations, or parts thereof, in conflict with or inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby amended, modified, or repealed accordingly.

Section 14. Effectivity Clause. This Ordinance shall take effect after publication in the newspaper of general circulation in the Province of Leyte.
