 July 8, 2024

Respectfully returned to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte, through SP Secretary, the attached Ordinance No. 7 of the Sangguniang Bayan of Capoocan, Leyte.

**Issues/concerns for review/recommendation/legal opinion is/are as follows:**

- Ordinance No. 7 entitled: **An Ordinance Providing Guidelines on the Utilization of Emergency Transport Vehicles/Rescue Vehicles of the Local Government Unit of Capoocan, Leyte, Providing fees thereof and for other purposes.”**

**REVIEW/RECOMMENDATION/LEGAL OPINION:**

This office is of the opinion that the subject Ordinance is within the corporate powers of the local government unit particularly covered under Section 447 and Section 16 - General Welfare Clause of the Local Government Code of 1991.

However, perusal of the contents thereof, this office is likewise of the opinion that:

- 1) There is a need for the requesting sangguniang bayan to **organize** their guidelines for **emergency services** and **non-emergency services** in order to avoid confusion and further interpretation by the public taking into considerations the DOH Administrative Order No. 2010-0003, January 07, 2010 relative to the National Policy On Ambulance Use And Services and the applicable PDDRM Guidelines.
- 2) Although Section 447 (2) allows local government to generate and maximize the use of resources and revenues as well as (ii) approve ordinances prescribing rates for general and specific purpose the same shall be guided by the principal that it must not be unjust, excessive, oppressive, or confiscatory<sup>1</sup>. Thus, it is recommended that the LGU should attach its basis and references of said fees for review and consideration of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan.
- 3) Their Ordinance should stipulate in its “**whereas**” clauses the principle/purpose behind the imposition of fees and charges in order to specify its nature being regulatory or otherwise.<sup>2</sup> (i.e. if regulatory) “*that the fees collected shall be used to defray cost for repair and maintenance of the ambulances or rescue vehicles and for possible purchases of similar emergency vehicles in the future.*”

We hope to have assisted you with this request. Please note that the opinion rendered by this Office are based on facts available and may vary or change when additional facts and documents are presented or changed. This opinion is likewise without prejudice to the opinions rendered by higher and competent authorities and/or the courts.



**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of RA 7160 or otherwise known as “The Local Government Code of 1991” mandates every Local Government Unit to promote the general welfare of its residents, ensuring the health and safety of every inhabitant;

**WHEREAS**, Section 12 (c-16) of RA 10121 or otherwise known as “The Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010” mandated the establishment of LDRRM Office responsible to respond and manage the adverse effects of emergencies;

**WHEREAS**, The Local Government Unit of Capoocan, Leyte created the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office to perform the functions mandated by law in disaster risk reduction and management;

**WHEREAS**, one of the services offered by the Local Government Unit through its Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office is the Emergency Medical Services that involves Emergency and Non-emergency Transport of patients;

**WHEREAS**, as per record of the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO), due to the number of patients requesting for transport every day, the Local Government Unit of Capoocan cannot suffice the transportation expenses such as fuel among others for every transport conducted;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN, IN SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED, THAT:**

**SECTION 1. TITLE.** The Ordinance shall be known as **“GUIDELINES ON THE UTILIZATION OF EMERGENCY TRANSPORT VEHICLES/RESCUE VEHICLES AND AMBULANCE.”**

**SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY.** It is a declared policy of the Municipality of Capoocan to promote the general welfare by ensuring the health and safety of its constituents.

**SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS**

- A. **EMERGENCY-** unforeseen or sudden occurrence, especially danger, demanding immediate action.
- B. **EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES-** refers to rescue and emergency services that offers on-scene care to any trauma and medical incident. This will also apply for any patient that needs to be transported to any medical facilities for advance care.

- C. EMERGENCY TRANSPORT-refers to all emergency transport to other advanced medical facilities supported by a referral.
- D. EMERGENCY TRANSPORT VEHICLE-a vehicle use to transport emergency patient to any other medical facilities.
- E. NON-EMERGENCY TRANSPORT- refers to transport for dialysis session, consultation, laboratory test such as but not limited to CT scan, X-Ray, Blood and Urine Test, and Ultra Sound.
- F. AMBULANCE- a vehicle designed and equipped for transporting sick or injured patients to, from, and between places of treatment by land, water or air, affording safety and comfort to the patients and avoiding aggravation of illness and injury. This excludes rapid response vehicles, such as but not limited to, motorcycles, cars and other vehicles designed to transport patients but are not equipped to respond to medical emergencies based on the rules and regulations Governing the Licensure of Ambulances and Ambulance Service Providers issued by the DOH HFSRB.
- G. PATIENT TRANSPORT VEHICLES- refers to any form of vehicle, other than those classified as a licensed ambulance, designed and/or used to transport patients whose condition is of a non-life threatening nature.
- H. PWD – are those Persons With Disability (PWD) who are severely impaired.
- I. HEALTH FACILITY- refers to a building or physical structure that has amenities, equipment, and staffing for the delivery of clinical in-patients and outpatients services, emergency services, and other ancillary and support services such as, but not limited to, clinical laboratories, imaging facilities, and dialysis clinics. These include government or private hospital, primary care facilities, custodial care facilities, diagnostic/therapeutic facilities and other specialized outpatient facilities as classified in the DOH rules and regulation governing the new classifications of hospitals and other health facilities in the Philippines.
- J. HEALTH-RELATED ESTABLISHMENT- refers to any provincial, regional office or government agency that may necessitate the use of an ambulance for purposes of disaster response and management, calamities, and crises.

**SECTION 4. GUIDELINES**





- A. All Vehicles shall be available for all, either Capoocanon or Non-Capoocanon who are in need of emergency and non-emergency transport given utmost priority to the former.
- B. Requesting patient or any representative shall provide request from attending physician and present at the Capoocan DRRM Operations Center or Municipal Health Office their respective proof of residency and any documents that will support his/her request. However, in cases of unforeseen incidents such as vehicular incidents, marine and other aquatic emergencies, stabbing/hacking incidents, etc., may be transported first prior securing the said proof of residency.
- C. Bringing patients from the health facility to home is totally prohibited, unless, the attending physician required the use for the said purpose.
- D. Personnel-on-duty shall evaluate and assess the said document/s and will give advice whether fees are needed or not, and if there is available vehicle to be use.
- E. In cases where there is a scheduled non-emergency transport and suddenly there is a need for emergency transport, the emergency transport shall be prioritized.
- F. Non emergency transport shall be scheduled at least two days before except for those admitted patient that needs further laboratory test not available in the community hospital.
- G. Upon transport, all patient/s are monitored by the accompanying responder/s using Patient Care Report. PCR shall be signed by the patient or any representative.
- H. Utilization of any public official or employee as office service vehicle for recreation or for personal use and other purposes, inconsistent with its use for emergency and non-emergency cases is strictly prohibited.

**SECTION 5. FEES.** All shall be guided to the following fees schedule:



**A. EMERGENCY TRANSPORT**

No other amount shall be collected other than what is stipulated in this section.

- ❖ Fees of Senior Citizens, PWDs, 4Ps Beneficiaries and indigent Capoocanons who will avail of these services shall be charged to the funds from the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS), subject to the approval of the Office of the MSWDO.

**SECTION 6. TRAININGS.** The Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO) shall organize, facilitate, and/or conduct training/s for Emergency Transport Vehicle Management, while ambulance drivers from the Rural Health Unit (RHU) will be trained by the Department of Health (DOH).

**SECTION 7. ALLOCATION.** The Local Government Unit of Capoocan shall allocate to the MDRRMO at least **Php 800,000.00** annually for fuel consumption and **Php 1,000,000.00** annually for repairs and maintenance of emergency vehicles chargeable to annual/supplemental budget.


**SECTION 8. TRAVELLING EXPENSE AND ALLOWANCE.** All Transport Personnel including drivers and responders regardless of employment status shall be entitled for travelling expenses and allowances chargeable against their respective offices.

**SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.


**SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All ordinances, as well as pertinent rules and regulations thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

**SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and publication in any newspaper of local circulation and the posting thereof in bulletin boards at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two other conspicuous and publicly accessible places within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality.



37 Hon. Misagal: Ini nga emergency transport an pag biyahe hini han pasyente nga may ada  
38 referral tikang han Physician o Doctor.

39  
40 **D. EMERGENCY TRANSPORT VEHICLE-**a vehicle use to transport emergency patient to any  
41 other medical facilities.

42  
43 Hon. Misagal: An sarakyan ini, to transport han emergency patient para ngadto hiton iba nga  
44 mga durodilain na medical facilities or hospitals.

45  
46 **E. NON-EMERGENCY TRANSPORT-** refers to transport for dialysis session, consultation,  
47 laboratory test such as but not limited to CT scan, X-Ray, Blood and Urine Test, and Ultra  
48 Sound.

49  
50 Hon. Misagal: Or durodilain nga mga diagnostics examinations or test nga gin a-undergo hin  
51 patient nga pwede man ma-schedule, an diri ura-urada.

52  
53 **F. AMBULANCE-** a vehicle designed and equipped for transporting sick or injured patients to,  
54 from, and between places of treatment by land, water or air, affording safety and comfort to  
55 the patients and avoiding aggravation of illness and injury. This excludes rapid response  
56 vehicles, such as but not limited to, motorcycles, cars and other vehicles designed to  
57 transport patients but are not equipped to respond to medical emergencies based on the  
58 rules and regulations Governing the Licensure of Ambulances and Ambulance Service  
59 Providers issued by the DOH HFSRB.

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1 Hon. Misagal: This also excludes rapid response vehicles, it ambulance mag iba ngan han  
2 rapid response vehicle.

3  
4 *G. PATIENT TRANSPORT VEHICLES- refers to any form of vehicle, other than those*  
5 *classified as a licensed ambulance, designed and/or used to transport patients whose*  
6 *condition is of a non-life threatening nature.*

7  
8 Hon. Misagal: Amo ini an ha mga barangay, diba an mga barangay mayda kamo mga  
9 transports vehicles. Diri ini hya ambulance. Gagamit ini hya naton nga sarakyan para ma biyahe  
10 naton an pasyente nga may condition nga diri hiya tikamaratay na.

11  
12 *H. HEALTH FACILITY- refers to a building or physical structure that has amenities, equipment,*  
13 *and staffing for the delivery of clinical in-patients and outpatients services, emergency*  
14 *services, and other ancillary and support services such as, but not limited to, clinical*  
15 *laboratories, imaging facilities, and dialysis clinics. These include government or private*  
16 *hospital, primary care facilities, custodial care facilities, diagnostic/therapeutic facilities and*  
17 *other specialized outpatient facilities as classified in the DOH rules and regulation governing*  
18 *the new classifications of hospitals and other health facilities in the Philippines.*

19  
20 *I. HEALTH-RELATED ESTABLISHMENT- refers to any provincial, regional office or*  
21 *government agency that may necessitate the use of an ambulance for purposes of disaster*  
22 *response and management, calamities, and crises.*

23 Hon. Misagal: Pwede ini hya han Philhealth, PCSO, pwede ini hya DOH.

#### 24 SECTION 4. GUIDELINES

25  
26  
27 *A. All Vehicles shall be available for all, either Capoocanon or Non-Capoocanon who are in*  
28 *need of emergency and non-emergency transport given utmost priority to the former.*

29  
30 Hon. Misagal: Tanan kuno nga sarakyan available para ha tanan nga Capoocanon ngan diri  
31 Capoocanon. Kaklaruhon naton, Capoocanon ngan diri Capoocanon pwede makagamit hini na  
32 mga sarakyan, who are in need of emergency and non-emergency transport given utmost priority  
33 to the former. So pananglitan kun may ada nag pa schedule ano, masiring magamit kami kay  
34 mkadto kami hospital mapa dialysis or makadto hiton dialysis center tas tigda, may umabot nga  
35 emergency, kay diri man lagi sinasabot it emergency, so tatagaan naton hin priority an emergency,  
36 ayaw kita kasina, kay adin usa life threatening, kay bangen diri madara hiya ha hospital, diri hiya  
37 dayon matagan hin medical attention intalon mawawad-an hiya hit kinabuhi.

38  
39 *B. Requesting patient or any representative shall provide request from attending physician and*  
40 *present at the Capoocan DRRM Operations Center or Municipal Health Office their*  
41 *respective proof of residency and any documents that will support his/her request. However,*  
42 *in cases of unforeseen incidents such as vehicular incidents, marine and other aquatic*  
43 *emergencies, stabbing/hacking incidents, etc., may be transported first prior securing the*  
44 *said proof of residency.*

45  
46 Hon. Misagal: So, kun mayda gusto gumamit hini nga any ambulance or transport vehicle,  
47 kailangan anay niya umaro hin request tikang ha Physician, pwede iton aton MHO or di ngani iton  
48 iya Doctor. Tapos ini hiya igprepresentar ngadto han duduha nga departamento, amo ito an DRRM  
49 ngan MHO an aton RHU, tapos magdadara gihapon hiya han iya proof of residency, karugsinggon  
50 pwede ID nga nakabutang ngadto nga capoocanon hiya, kay para masabtan kun taga diin hiya,  
51 ngan iba pa na mga dokumento nga magsusuporta hito nga iya request. Pero, "Agi badaw  
52 emergency kapitana", may pero, cempre kun emergency malamang diri gad ito anay aaruan hini  
53 ngatanan tanan ano, to follow nala iton. Aatinderan anay ito nga unforeseen incident such as  
54 vehicular incidents, marine and aquatic emergencies, stabbing/hacking incidents, etc., maybe  
55 transported first prior securing the said proof of residency.

56  
57 *C. Bringing patients from the health facility to home is totally prohibited unless, the attending*  
58 *physician required the use for the said purpose.*



1 Hon. Misagal: Pananglitan, macheck out na didto hospital, diri ngayan kuno ito pwede, pero  
2 unless the attending Physician require the use for the said purpose, basta may-ada request or  
3 referral coming from the Doctor na dapat hiya gumamit hin patient transport vehicle or ambulance  
4 or in inga mga sarakyan nga identified hini nga mga ordinansa, pwede man hiya makagamit.  
5

6 *D. Personnel-on-duty shall evaluate and assess the said document/s and will give advice  
7 whether fees are needed or not, and if there is available vehicle to be use.*  
8

9 Hon. Misagal: Ig a-assess ito han in-charge, officer of the day didto, kun ini ba hiya taga  
10 capoocan or diri, tas kun okay ba gumamit or diri ngan kun may ada ba available nga sarakyan.  
11

12 *E. In cases where there is a scheduled non-emergency transport and suddenly there is a need  
13 for emergency transport, the emergency transport shall be prioritized.*  
14

15 *F. Non emergency transport shall be scheduled at least two days before except for those  
16 admitted patient that needs further laboratory test not available in the community hospital.*  
17

18 Hon. Misagal: Must be scheduled two days before han schedule niya nga pagkadto hito nga  
19 facility except for those admitted patient that needs further laboratory test, not available in the  
20 community hospital. Pananglitan ini nga pasyente, kailangan niya mag pa MRI, mag pa CT Scan  
21 nga diri available didi ha aton RHU, okay ito hiya bisan diri na magpa schedule at least two days.  
22

23 *G. Upon transport, all patient/s are monitored by the accompanying responder/s using Patient  
24 Care Report. PCR shall be signed by the patient or any representative.*  
25

26 *H. Utilization of any public official or employee as office service vehicle for recreation or for  
27 personal use and other purposes, inconsistent with its use for emergency and non-  
28 emergency cases is strictly prohibited.*  
29

30 Hon. Misagal: Diri hiya pwede gamiton pagkadto didto ha Lirang-lirang, ini na mga patient  
31 transport vehicle diri hiya pwede gamiton pagkadto ha mga recreational na mga facilities, pero  
32 depende liwat kun mayda seminar or mayda ginpapakuha or kun ito hiya nga recreational facility  
33 designated hiya labi na iton mga disasters, calamities, but case to case basis.  
34

35  
36 **SECTION 5. FEES.** All shall be guided to the following fees schedule:  
37

38 Hon. Misagal: Masiring kamo "kapitana kay kanan gobyerno man ito, kay ano man may  
39 bayad?" so, ito nga mga bayad that is also to regulate, kay kun diri kita magpapabayad cempre  
40 pareho hiton barangay limitado la an aton pondo, that is to regulate han paggamit. Diri ginsisiring  
41 nga gindidiri pag gamit, it's just that nga may mga regulasyon kita kay kun tanan lagi aton  
42 tangduan, January pala depleted na an aton resources labi na iton fuel consumption. When it  
43 comes also to maintenance, kay cempre pang gasolina la waray ipaarayad, badaw upos na iton  
44 goma, upos na an break pad, may mga kailangan kumpunihon iton aton sarakyan, hinumdumon  
45 naton ini nga sarakyan pag transport han pasyente para mabuhi. Diri dugngan an ira  
46 kadelikaduhan.

51 Hon. Misagal: Residents and non-residents han capoocan, as long as dinhi mahitabo an

53 an aton emergency transport vehicle to transport the said patient. So, free anywhere within the  
54 province, kay cempre kun hain it pinaka harani nga health facility. Kay diri ito hiya mapakadto ha  
55 southern leyte kay hirayo hinduro, so, within the province lang talaga siya

Hon. Misagal: Kun an requesting patient taga Capoocan, provided nga naghatag hiya hin proof of residency, kun an iya biyahe tikadto ha Biliran, that is 1,500.00. Kun pakadto Ormoc/Palo/Tacloban, 1,000.00 an bayad. Going back, non-emergency transport asya kailangan naton masabtan ano ito nga mga non-emergency transport. Amo iton mga mapa check-up, mapa dialysis, mapa urinalysis, CT scan, basta diri emergency. Next, Non-resient of Capoocan, masiring kamo kay ano matatabo hini nga may ada mga diri residente hin capoocan nga kailangan man nira ig-transport? Sugad hini an matatabo, according han manifestation, during han first reading ngan han committee meeting hini nga ordinansa, pananglitan may ada na disgrasay hin motor, signgon ta didi Culasian, ha may guisok, signgon ta taga Biliran hiya, maresponde an aton disaster team ngan an aton MHO. So, upon recommendation ni doktora, dri man ini hiya grabe, pwede na ini hiya umuli ha ira. Kun taga Biliran hiya, kun mapadulong hiya han ambulance nga waray man recommendation ni MHO nga dadad-on hiya ha hospital for further nga mga health care services, then, mayda niya fee nga 2,500.00, kay dadad-on hiya ngadto ha Biliran. So, kun dadad-on hiya ha Ormoc/Palo/Tacloban kay taga didto hiya, dinhi la hiya napangusan, baga natumba an iya motor, 2,000.00 an aaruon. PB Capaycapay: Ha fees ano, question kula, diba nasiring ka nga we have to regulate, kay ano an amount is baga huruhitaas man, since may ada man kita baga ig a-allocate nga fund, 800,000.00 to 1 million, I think ha akon, bisan an non-resident or resident han Capoocan pahub-an ta han fess kay bag ahitaas ito. Next, makadi ako didi hit section 4 han guidelines, pwede diri ta nala ig include didi an nasiring ha section 4, *A. All Vehicles shall be available for all, either Capoocanon or Non-Capoocanon who are in need of emergency and non-emergency transport given utmost priority to the former.* Kasi dapat kun non-emergency na ngani, siguro bangen case to case basis la ini, diri kay baga for example kun ig tatravel ta an non-emergency cases ngadto han mga town, tapos pepera la an aton available nga ordinance, so bagan diri hiya makaka serve han aton purpose kun kaya no may ada kita ambulance ha Municipyo, RHU, unless, siguro ini nga *Bringing patients from the health facility to home,* siguro pwede ini hiya case to case basis lugod. Pwede la hiya ig allow, kay ano, may ada iba nga patient nga diri talaga pwede ig sakay ha mga private vehicle, as a nurse by profession, kay ako base han akon observation, specially iton mga most operative cases, siguro pwede ito naton hiya ig consider. Next, is paragraph G. *Upon transport, all patient/s are monitored by the accompanying responder/s using Patient Care Report. PCR shall be signed by the patient or any representative.* Ini nga iyo kuan is hino an naupod ha part han RHU, hino an naupod nga well trained talaga pag CPR in cases na kikinahanglanon or whatever happens during the transport of patient?

Hon. Misagal: Number 1, you are telling us that this is about the regulation, so why ask for higher fees? With that, kapitan before kita mag came up hini nga fees, syempre nag consult han drivers who are knowledgeable kun pera iton gasolina. So, with that I would like Sir Rogel and Doktora to answer the said questions of Kapitan Capaycapay, with regards to the high fees imposed nga regulatory manla unta ini hiya kay ano hightaas hiya?

MDRRMO Sarigumba: Actually, tama po adto nga the fees are consulted han tarlan namon nga mga drivers. Now, the reason why nga kailangan hiya hin fees because na experience kasi

15 PB Capaycapay: While waiting, pwede mag response lat ako han kan Mr. Sarigumba.  
16 Regarding kasi han nagreregulate kita ngan nagconsult kamo ha mga drivers or ha gasolinahan, I  
17 think this not an income generation, yes I understand na an aton gintatagan hin fees, subject hini  
18 nga mga fees an mga non-emergency, but my point is kay ano sugad kahataas? Nga where in fact  
19 diri man hiya magiging income generation han aton Municipality, regarding ito nga amount kun  
20 pera it gasolina or krudo nga nagagamit. Since nag a-allocate kita hin fund, nakita ko didi from  
21 800,000.00 to 1 Million a year, although siring pman gutiay gadla ito hiya pero once ngani ighataas  
22 ta hinduro, for example masiring kita nga, yes upon han aton examination they are non-  
23 emergency, pero may ada man non-emergency nga diri talaga makasakay hiton public transport.  
24 So, an akon la point is kay ano nga diri ta mahamub-an bisan guti.

25  
26 MDRRMO Sarigumba: Ig clarify kula po an fund allocation nga imo ginsisiring, the allocation  
27 of fund waray po kita yana, waray po kita allocation han MOOE except han disaster fund, so the  
28 allocation here na 800,000.00 and 1 Million para han repair and maintenance for 5 vehicles nga  
29 gingagamit hin LGU including han floating assets. Now, magkakamay ada la allocation kun may  
30 ada liwat ini nga mga fees, because sir kailangan talaga hiya ig regulate, based han akon  
31 experience diri talaga pwede ini nga pabay-an ta nga sugad la an nagagasto naton ha kanan LGU  
32 fund ngadto han diri emergency cases. Kun an request naman to lower fees, I think it is up for  
33 another deliberation siguro. Thank you.

34  
35 Hon. Vallar: Good Afternoon. That is a very good question and clarification from our  
36 Honorable Captain from Barangay. Balud, but I would also like to know, what really, you're willing  
37 to suggest base on the fees. Base on your opinion, what amount are you willing to suggest that is  
38 applicable to the fees that we are going to extend for non-emergency purposes of constituents of  
39 Capoocan, leyte? So, what amount are you willing to suggest?

40  
41 PB Capaycapay: Thank you Hon. Vallar, regarding han mga resident for non-emergency  
42 cases why not for Biliran is ig 1,000.00 ta nala and then siguro Ormoc/Palo/Tacloban is 700, kay  
43 yes natitika increase it aton fuel, but then my point is, what if diri nira kaya, diri nira afford, dri man  
44 signgon nga nagkukuan hira, kay nagaaghat kita han to regulate, diri man ito ngatanan talaga is an  
45 iba nga makasakay la kun emergency, myda iba na mga patient nga bisan diri emergency. Ito na  
46 mga cases or dialysis cases dri man ito mga emergency cases but then, they need nga aada hira  
47 hit mas safest ngan convenient nga ira sasakyan.

48  
49 Hon. Vallar: Your suggestions has been noted and we will look into that in our deliberations,  
50 once we finalize the promulgations of ordinances. Thank you. We should decide the matter this  
51 time. Would there be a motion?

52  
53 MPDC Procia: Maupay nga kulop, nakita ko an karuyag signgon ni Kap En-En. That's a  
54 good point manggud kay badaw umabot it punto an usa nga buruligan, kablasanon intawon nga  
55 diri naton matra-transport otherwise huhulton ta daw anay nga maging emergency hiya, ada  
56 maburulong unta, huhulton ta nga maging emergency case hiya usa ig transport para free diba?  
57 So, this should not be the point. I suggest, actually nagkamay ada kami initial discussion with Mr.  
58 Rogel and Ma'am Dolor, kay igpupursue ta ha AICS, kay ones from the items from AICS is the

5 Hon. Misagal: Noted. Going back han suggestion, Kons Bong ikaw man an kumarawat han  
6 suggestion from 1,500 to 1, 000 and 1,000 to 700. Yana mayada ngadi coming from the Head of  
7 the department, hira man po iton hands-on, siring paman hira man iton maaram hiton day to day  
8 nga mga operations and transactions han ira opisina. Myda ngadi suggestion, kun mahitabo nga  
9 myda kablasanon or indigent nga mulupyo or Capoocanon pwede mandaw ig pursue han AICS.  
10 Ano iton AICS? Assistance of Individual in Crisis Situation, pwede ig pursue ha AICS. Kay ha AICS  
11 kasi may petty cash, medical related la dapat, with regards to hini nga aton yana gindi-discuss  
12 about transporting patients. Kun waray talaga nira iparasahe kay kailangan nira ig C-ray ngan CT  
13 Scan, they can go to DSWD, ma present hira hin indigency, ngan madaop hira ngadto han officer  
14 or personnel in-charge han AICS, ngan outright tatagaan hira hin monetary nga fund, the exact  
15 around 1,000, tapos ikakadto niya or ibabayad niya ngadto kay resesibuhan para maka avail hiya  
16 han patient transport vehicle. Going back, kun mapa schedule kita, pananglitan mapa dialysis, two

24 pasyente puros ito mga pobrehanon. Bisan 500 la nga makaabot la hira ha Tacloban dako-dako na  
25 ito. Pwede an mga pasyente makaaro hin Petty cash na tag 500 nga outright, pero waray pa kita  
26 makatitaw hit mga pasyente nga nakaaro, hopefully yana may ada na pasyente nga makakaaro.

27  
28 Hon. Vallar: So, an mahihitabo makuan ha AICS, Bangin ma-abuse naton iton aton AICS  
29 Fund, every time masiring nala kita nga indigent ini hiya, hinu mag identify, hinu mag classify? hino  
30 liwat an magreregulate hito nga AICS, kay bangen puro nala ngayan indigent, amo kasi iton aton  
31 problema ngada, no problem with emergencies.  
32

33 Hon Carolino: Kons an suggestion ni Captain Capaycapay, bangen an iya ginfe-feature diri  
34 Biliran la. Province of Biliran, so, kun aton pa ipapahamubo ngada 1,000.00, how about kun adto  
35 ito Caibiran, Bu-ol, nalibot, diri masadang an 1,000.00. Waray la niya mabutangi nga province of  
36 Biliran. Kun sumiring kita nga Biliran usa la an aton ginhuhunahuna only in Biliran Municipality,  
37 pero Province of Biliran amo ini nga 1,500.00. Diri gud mabug-at, halimbawa kun adto hiya ha  
38 Culaba, Bu-ol, Naval, Kawayan, kay Province of Biliran. Amo ito nga ini nga 1,500 okay na ini,  
39 waray la didi kabutangi nga Province of Biliran. Salamat.  
40

41 PB Capaycapay: Regarding kan Honorable Carolino, kasi it's not a matter of having nga  
42 may kita kita, may income. Diba siring ko kanina It's not about income generation, it's about  
43 helping or serving our community, so, it doesn't matter kun diri hiya makakasakay, siring paman  
44 kun ito talaga nga amount an aton ig cocollet, diba it is a matter of regulating la nga diri hiya dapat  
45 maabuso nga bisan hino nala magamit hini nga sarakyan, so, we are not after nga masiring, dapat  
46 sakti iton iya ginbabayad kay diri ini pasaherosan. We are serving the community, anyway this is  
47 the battle for the whole constituents, we are only here to regulate, or to impelement, so my point is  
48 diri kita dapat after kun pera iton gastos hito, kay an aton la kanina kay it is a matter of regulating,  
49 nga dri hiya ma abuse, that's my point. Thank you.

50  
51 Hon. Misagal: with regards ano, yes we are regulating, ito hiya ira ito fuel, kun mayda ka  
52 sarakyan, kay ako personally, para akon, dri masiring nga ou bakay ABC or Kapitan ka, mayda ka  
53 kwarta makakabayad ka hito. Yes okay, ada kita ngada but siring paman base on sympathy kay ha  
54 imo ito kanina tikang, hira iton maaram kay hira an aada dida. Sige daw hino man an may mga  
55 transport vehicles dinhi, labi na an Sto. Nino, hiya iton makakagsiring gud kay iya transport vehicle  
56 pati ngani munisipyo nagamit. An iya **agam-agam** ha akon, nakasiring gud adto hi kap Dodong ha  
57 akon one time bangen tungod han kawurok niya, "kap bangen nagsayop ada ako pag-aro hito nga  
58 transport vehicle from congressman, kay ano kap, kay pag kuan hin pasyente ceompre waray

10 uro-storyahan ini, pwede hiya humangyo, ini amon ini kuan kay kun maghangyo kamo okay la.  
11 May senior gihapon ini ngan hin PWD, amo nga aanhi kita, pwede ini hiya hamuboan.  
12

13 PB Capaycapay: Permission to speak, please. Point of clarification Hon. Misagal, you can't  
14 kun baga siring paman, kuanh an barangay, iba na municipality, they are outside of our topic.  
15 Actually, diri pwede naton ig compare an Barangay ha Municipality, yes, makuri bisan ha Balud to  
16 tell you frankly, iton aton rescue vehicle ginsiring ko ito before talaga nga diri ko ito igrereceive  
17 once diri nyo ginaayos, kay dako ito nga problema. Pero siring paman an aton yana  
18 ginurostoryahan ayaw na kita pag kadto yana ha Barangay kay it's a different story, diri kita
