

#### Gentlemen and Ladies:

Pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160), our preliminary review of the **General Fund Supplemental Budget No. 01 FY 2024** of the **Municipality of Inopacan**, **Leyte** duly enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan through **Appropriation Ordinance No. 24-01** with amendments under **Appropriation Ordinance No. 24-02** dated July 16, 2024 with a total appropriation in the amount of **P15,344,543.46** reveals compliance with the same law and its implementing Rules and Regulations.

It is therefore recommended for approval subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That the reversion of appropriations is duly authorized by the concerned officials and is backed up by cash collections and are made available to support the expenditures under Supplemental Budget No. 01;
- 2. That the provision of Productivity Enhancement Incentive (PEI) to qualified personnel shall be subject to Budget Circular No. 2017-4;
- 3. That the projects funded under 20% Development Fund (DF) shall strictly adhere to DBM-DOF-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1 dated November 4, 2020;
- 4. That the LGU created a position of Planning Officer IV, SG 22. Attention is hereby invited to Section 5 of the Civil Service Commission (CSC) Memorandum Circular (MC) No. 12, series of 2022 which provides that the creation and funding of optional positions may be allowed after the mandatory positions have been created.
  - In view thereof, the creation and funding of the said optional position (Planning Officer IV, SG 22) is hereby deferred until such time that the mandatory positions have been created. The appropriation is therefore, disallowed.
- 5. That the procurement of Equipment, Civil Works, and related services shall be made in accordance with the provisions of RA 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations;
- 6. That the purchase of lot shall conform with the provisions of RA 8974;
- 7. That funds are actually available to pay these proposed expenditures and shall be disbursed for the specific purpose(s) for which they have been appropriated pursuant to Sections 335 & 336 of RA 7160.

Compliance with CSC rules, DBM issuances, and accounting and auditing rules and regulations and all other existing laws shall be the responsibility of the implementing Local Government Unit.

WHEREAS, the reverted amount of Two Million Three Hundred Forty-Four Thousand Five Hundred Forty-Three Pesos and 46/100 Php 2,344,543.46 from the unused/unobligated 20% development fund - continuing appropriations thru Resolution No. 24-099, dated April 2, 2024, for Supplemental Budget No. 1 CY 2024 of the Municipality of Inopacan, Province of Leyte, could not suffice the funding requirement for Supplemental Budget No. 1; due to a deficit of Php 2,000,000.00;

WHEREAS, a new Appropriation Ordinance template has been introduced by the Leyte Provincial Budget Office:

For this purpose, "savings" refer to portions or balances of any programmed appropriation free from any obligation or encumbrance, still available after the satisfactory completion or avoidable discontinuance or abandonment of the work, activity or purpose for which the appropriation is authorized, or arising from unpaid compensation and related costs pertaining to vacant positions and leaves of absence without pay;

"Augmentation" implies the existence in the budget of an item, project, activity or purpose with an appropriation which, upon implementation or subsequent evaluation of needed resources, is determined to be deficient:

SECTION 5. Separability Clause. If, for any reason, any Section or provision of this Appropriation Ordinance is disallowed on the Budget Review or declared invalid by proper authorities, other Sections or provisions hereof that are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and in effect.

SECTION 6. Effectivity. The provisions of this Appropriation Ordinance shall take effect on April 2, 2024.

A RESOLUTION REVERTING TO THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCES/SURPLUS THE AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION PESOS (PHP 2,000,000.00) FROM THE UNUSED/UNOBLIGATED PERSONAL SERVICES CURRENT APPROPRIATIONS AS ADDENDUM TO APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 24-01 ENACTED ON THE 2<sup>ND</sup> DAY OF APRIL 2024 FOR SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 1 CY 2024 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF INOPACAN, PROVINCE OF LEYTE

WHEREAS, the amount of Two Million Three Hundred Forty-Four Thousand Five Hundred Forty-Three Pesos and 46/100 (Php 2,344,543.46) from the unused/unobligated 20% development fund — continuing appropriations is reverted thru Resolution No. 24-099, dated April 2, 2024; for Supplemental Budget No. 1 CY 2024 of the Municipality of Inopacan, Province of Leyte;

WHEREAS, per findings upon review by the Leyte Provincial Budget Office, the reverted amount of Php 2,344,543.46 could not suffice the funding requirement for Supplemental Budget No. 1; due to a deficit of Php 2,000,000.00;

WHEREAS, per the Statement of Funding Sources FY 2024 Supplemental Budget No. 1 (LBP Form No. 8), the reflected amount of Php 13,000,000.00 as the savings from the 2023 Unobligated Balances from PS and MOOE includes the amount of Php 2,000,000.00 which is part of the Special Education Fund (SEF), a fund which is not considered as savings under the general fund;

**WHEREAS**, transmitted to the August Body is the request for the reversion of funds from PS – 2024 Current Appropriations as addendum to Appropriation Ordinance No. 24-01, enacted on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of April 2024;

WHEREAS, the corrected Statement of Funding Sources to support the request for the addendum of the Supplemental Budget No. 1, CY 2024 was jointly certified by Mrs. Verhaert B. Nirza, Local Treasurer, and Mrs. Nancy Clyte A. Lagario, CPA, Municipal Accountant, on the availability of funds from 20% Development Fund Continuing Appropriations in the amount of Two Million Three Hundred Forty Four Thousand Five Hundred Forty Three Pesos and 46/100 (PHP 2,344,543.46) and Personal Services Current Appropriations in the total amount of Two Million Pesos (PHP 2,000,000.00); in addition to the savings from the 2023 Unobligated Balances from PS and MOOE, in the amount of Php 11,000,000.00;

WHEREAS, there is a need for a reversion from the Personal Services - Current Appropriations in the amount of Php 2,000,000.00 in addition to the reverted funds from the unused/unobligated 20% Development Fund Continuing Appropriations in the amount of Php 2,344,543.46, having a total amount of Php 4,344,543.46 to be made available for reappropriation to fund the Supplemental Budget No. 1;
