





7. **CREATION** OF THE MATAG-OB **EXCELLENCE INCENTIVE COMMITTEE.** The Matag-ob Excellence Incentive Committee (MEIC) is hereby created, which is primarily tasked to judiciously screen applicants based on the qualifications set forth in this Ordinance.

A. Composition. The Matag-ob Excellence Incentive Committee (MEIC) shall be composed of the following:

Chairman Co-chairman Members

: Municipal Mayor

: SB Chairman Cmte. on Education

: Mun. SK Federation President SB Chairman Cmte on Sports

: DepEd Personnel who are local

residents of Matag-ob (maximum of 5)

: Municipal Social Welfare and Development Officer (MSWDO)

: Municipal Local Government Operations Officer (MLGOO)

: Any LGU employee who is a local resident of Matag-ob, Leyte

B. All DepEd and LGU personnel to be included in the Committee's original composition shall be named through a Sangguniang Bayan Resolution or an Executive Order issued by the Municipal Mayor.


