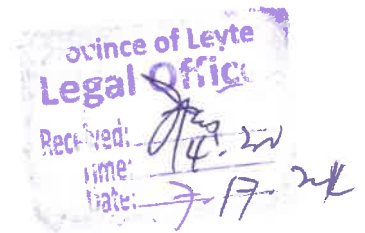

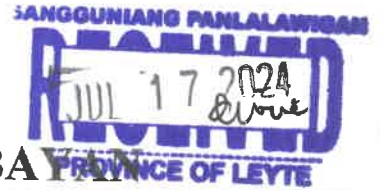

**PREFATORY STATEMENT**

**WHEREAS**, peddling activities, especially of aqua-marine and agricultural products, have become rampant in the municipality;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to regulate the above-mentioned activities as a preventive measure in the spread of diseases as well as to protect the legitimate vendors of the public market who pay regulatory fees and charges and as well as of their market stalls;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Sangguniang Bayan of Kananga, in its regular session duly assembled, hereby ordains the following:

**SECTION I – TITLE.** This ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Regulating the Peddling Activities Within the Territorial Jurisdiction of the Municipality of Kananga, Imposing Penalties to Violators Thereof and for Other Purposes”.

**SECTION II – SCOPE OF COVERAGE.** This ordinance shall cover all those who engage in peddling activities within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Kananga, Leyte.

**SECTION III – DEFINITION OF TERMS.** The following terms shall mean in this ordinance:

- a. Peddling - selling, whether on foot or aboard a vehicle, to the consuming public along the municipal streets or in any point of the municipality, aquatic resources and its by-products such as but not limited to fish (fresh, dried or salted) and agricultural products such as but not limited to fruits, vegetables and/or species, eggs and meat products.
- b. Aquatic Resources - includes fresh and marine water fish, all other aquatic flora and fauna and other living resources of aquatic environment.
- c. Nametag - a piece of plastic bearing the name, address and picture of the registered peddler written on it the is attached to that person's clothing or attached to something worn around his/her neck.
- d. Agricultural Products - are goods that come from plants, animals, and microorganisms. Also referred to as agricultural produce, agro products, and agro produce, these goods include crops, livestock, and dairy.



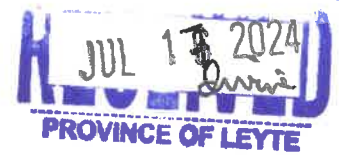

- e. Dry Goods - grocery items (such as tobacco, sugar, flour, and other coffee) that do not contain liquid. Textiles, ready-to-wear clothing, and notions as distinguished especially from hardware and groceries.
- f. Used Clothing - Second-hand fashion refers to clothes or accessories that have been previously owned by someone else. The term 'preloved' means the same thing, however, it also suggests that someone has loved the items before they are resold.

**SECTION IV – ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS:**

- I. Peddlers in all barangays are mandated to get a barangay clearance from the barangay where they reside, register at the Municipal Treasurer's Office and the Municipal Business Permits and Licensing Office, and pay the following annual fees and charges:
  - 1. Mayor's permit (variable - based on declared annual income and assessment of the Municipal Business Permits & Licensing Office pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Revenue Code)
  - 2. Medical Health Certificate Php 50.00
- II. A nametag bearing the name, address and picture of the peddler shall be issued to him/her free of charge as soon as he/she has complied with the requirements provided for in preceding paragraph of this ordinance. The nametag shall be issued by the Municipal Treasurer's Office of the LGU Kananga.
- III. Peddlers are required to wear the issued nametag during doing business within the municipality.
- IV. Unregistered peddlers, when apprehended are required to register at the Municipal Treasurer's Office, to get Municipal Health Certificate and pay the required fees and charges, on top of the penalty for violations incurred.
- V. The prices of goods (fish) being sold by said peddlers shall be in accordance with the SRP set forth by the Department of Agriculture (DA). Violation thereof shall be meted with appropriate fines and penalties.
- VI. Peddlers shall follow the regular schedule of renewal of licenses in the Municipality, otherwise they shall also be liable for penalties as provided by law.

**SECTION V – REGULATED ACTS.**

- 1. Only registered permittees shall be allowed to engage in peddling activities in all barangays of the Municipality of Kananga, except in Barangay Poblacion.
- 2. For fish peddling, any fish specie or variety is allowed, except those prohibited by law, rules or regulations, as long as they are fresh and fit for public consumption. Fish peddlers shall ensure the proper handling of the commodity, which, whenever necessary shall ensure its freshness by appropriate refrigeration or icing.
- 3. Peddling of agricultural products is allowed, except for meat products.

**SECTION VI – PENAL PROVISIONS.**

Any violations or infractions of the provisions of ordinance shall be meted with the following penalties:

- a. Imprisonment of one (1) day up to six (6) months or a fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php2,500.00) or both at the discretion of the court of competent jurisdiction.
- b. Peddlers caught violating the provisions of this ordinance shall have their goods confiscated and their weighing scales impounded at the Municipal Treasurer's Office. If the apprehended peddler can pay the fine/penalty immediately or within the day, the goods and the weighing scale shall be released to him/her. All unclaimed confiscated fish shall be auctioned to the public two hours after apprehension at Php 10.00 less than the prevailing market price. Proceeds shall accrue to the municipal coffers.

- c. Owners of impounded weighing scale found to have been calibrated and not tampered with, shall pay redemption fee of Php 50.00 per violation.
- d. Owners of uncalibrated weighing scales shall be fined Php 100.00 per violation.
- e. Owners of tampered weighing scales shall be fined Php 200.00 per violation.

**SECTION VII – OTHER PROVISIONS.**

1. The Business Permits and Licensing Office and the Office of the Municipal Treasurer shall maintain records, both physical and computer database, of all registered fish and agricultural products peddlers for ready reference.
2. Apprehended fish peddlers shall be brought to the PNP Office for record purposes, and then be turned over to the Municipal Treasurer or his deputy, including the confiscated goods for the payments for fines/penalties, the required fees and charges if unregistered, and the calibration of their weighing if un-calibrated, and/or scale tampered with, and proper disposition of the confiscated fish.
3. Barangays officials are mandated to monitor peddlers operating within their barangays and report any violators of the provisions of this ordinance to their proper authorities.
4. The barangays shall submit to the municipality a list of all peddlers who do business within their barangay.

**SECTION VIII. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** – If any section or part of this Ordinance is held unconstitutional or invalid, the other sections or provisions not otherwise affected shall remain in full force or effect.

**SECTION IX. REPEALING CLAUSE.** – All other ordinances, orders, issuances, rules, and regulations, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.


**SECTION X. EFFECTIVITY.** – This Ordinance shall take effect 15 days after its publication or after due compliance with all the requirements provided under Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

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



**MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING HELD BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN ON APRIL 25, 2024  
AT THE ABC HALL BUILDING, KANANGA, LEYTE FOR THE MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE  
NO. 23L.24-050, SERIES OF 2024**

1. Ordinance No. 23L.24-050– An Ordinance regulating the peddling activities within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Kananga, Leyte, imposing penalties hereof and for some other purposes”.

**(Attendance hereto attached)**

The Public Hearing was conducted by the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan spearheaded by the Office of the Vice Mayor thru Facebook Page and Posting in the public places. The Public Hearing was attended by the Punong Barangay and Peddlers from different barangays, BPLO Mrs. Wenzeliza Seromines it was open at 9:09 in the morning with an opening prayer led by SB Secretary Atty. Allan R. Castro, and the Singing of National Anthem conducted thru Sound System. The SB Secretary Atty. Allan R. Castro acted as the master of the ceremony. Before the introductory message of Atty. Castro he give the floor to the Municipal Vice Mayor Honorable Miguel Jorge P. Tan for his Welcome Address.

Atty. Castro said that this ordinance is intended to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the Municipality of Kananga residents and businesses by licensing transient vendors, controlling of operation of such vendors, and by limiting the number allowed to operate within the Municipality. This ordinance allowed peddlers to vending under the municipal rules and regulations provided in this ordinance. After his introductory Atty. Allan Castro give the floor to Hon. Richie C. Cruz the proponent of the said ordinance.

Hon. Cruz(Proponent of the above-mentioned ordinance) said that under this ordinance only registered permittees shall be allowed to engaged in peddling activities in all barangays of the Municipality of Kananga, except Barangay Poblacion where the Market operation is located. He asked the attendees to understand the provision of ordinance so that it will also be discussed in your barangay area. After he introduced the ordinance as the proponent he give the floor to the SB Secretary.

Atty. Castro said that this is only draft ordinance, the Sanggunian is open for any suggestion or recommendation.

Mr. Delima(Fish Vendor) he said that there are lot fish vendors also came from different municipalities, and sad to say they have more “suki” compare to them.

Hon. Cruz asked Mr. Delima if he has a permit as fish vendor or peddler.

Mr. Delima answered that he has no permit as of this time as peddler.

Hon. Cruz said that every peddler need licenses and permit to legally operate. He added and informed that as a local food distributors we must serve a fresh goods to our customer.

Hon. Aseo (SB Member) said that under this ordinance any person, peddlers coming from other municipality can do business her in Kananga provided that she/he must first obtain a municipality license.

Mr. Sison asked if the peddler coming from Carigara, need to obtain a permit from Carigara.

Hon. Cruz answered that only need a Kananga permit.

Mr. Sison complained regarding market prices. He suggested that there must be price control of fish in market.

Hon. Cruz said that regarding price control it is the responsible of DTI.

Mr. Galano (Secretary of Brgy. Poblacion) asked why peddler is not allowed in Barangay Poblacion.

Hon. Cruz answered that Market is located in Barangay Poblacion. The income of businesses and licensed vendors in the market could be affected.

Hon. Decio (Punong Barangay of Brgy. Libertad) said that as resident from the upland barangay, this ordinance is great help for them since the effects of fare increase and the prices is less compare in the market. She said as Barangay Official we can assist for permit inspection. She added that during pandemic, products or goods like chicken, bread, fruits and vegetable is offer and delivered in their area thru peddlers.

Hon. Cruz said that once the peddler obtain permits the barangay also can generate income.

Mrs. Wenzeliza(Business and Licensing Officer) said that aside of permits there should be a valid ID of the applicant to be presented during peddling hour.

Hon. Bonifacio Balbero(Punong Barangay of Brgy. Natubgan) said that his observation if this ordinance adopted by the Municipal Council the implementation of Talipapa Market will be affected. He said that only dry commodities are being sold in their Talipapa Market because of the presence of many peddlers mostly selling fish.

Hon. Cruz said that there are barangays have already implemented Talipapa Market because of the pandemic. He said that this ordinance for review of the Municipal Council and we will discuss that observation of Hon. Balbero during the review of the ordinance.


Mrs. Wenzeliza suggested that the Talipapa Market can also be occupied by the Peddlers so that the fees will be added to the Barangay.

Hon. Victoriano L. Globa (SB Member) suggested to increase the amount of peddler's permit to minimize the number of peddlers so that it may not cause problem in the future.

Mrs. Wenzeliza said that this ordinance regulating of peddlers can affect the operations of transportation and market. For the first permit application is less than P1,000.00, the second permit is more less compare the first permit because they are not going to pay the occupancy and police clearance. She added that she was concern the statement of Hon. Globa and for that reason she asked the Municipal Council to further review the ordinance prior the adoption.

The closing and final message was rendered by Hon. Miguel Jorge P. Tan-Municipal Vice Mayor and public hearing formally ended at 10:25 AM.



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
