AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE DISPENSING, SELLING, AND RESELLING OF PHARMACEUTICAL PRODUCTS IN SARI-SARI STORES AND OTHER SIMILAR RETAIL OUTLETS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TOLOSA, LEYTE

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 15 of the 1987 Constitution mandates the State to protect and promote the right to health of the people and instil health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, Section 30 of Republic Act. No 10918, otherwise known as the Philippine Pharmacy Act prohibits the compounding, dispensing, selling, or reselling of pharmaceutical products through retail drug outlets not licensed by the Food and Drugs Administration (FDA);

WHEREAS, Republic Act. No 8203, otherwise known as the Special Law on Counterfeit Drugs, prohibits by person from manufacturing, selling, offering for sale, donating, distributing, trafficking, brokering, exporting, importing, or processing counterfeit drugs;

WHEREAS, the FDA, through its Advisory No. 2020-13481 has issued a public health warning against the purchase and use of several counterfeit drug products that proliferated in the market, including commonly known medicines such as Phenylephrine HCI/ Chlorphenamine Maleate/ Paracetamol (Neozep® Forte), Loperamide (Diatabs®), Ibuprofen/ Paracetamol (Alaxan® FR), Carbocisteine (Solmux®), and others;

WHEREAS, The proliferation of counterfeit pharmaceutical products and the sale of medicines by sari-sari stores, without authorization from the FDA, are a potential cause of serious harm to the health and safety of the general public;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Tolosa, Leyte session duly assembled that:

Section 1. Title - This Ordinance shall be known "An Ordinance Regulating the Dispensing, Selling and Reselling of Pharmaceutical Products in Sari-Sari Stores and Other Similar Retail Outlets in the Municipality of Tolosa, Leyte".

### Section 2. Objectives – This Ordinance aims to:

- Regulate the dispensing, selling and reselling of pharmaceutical products in sari-sari stores and other similar retail outlets in the municipality of Tolosa, Leyte, as it poses health risk to the public;
- To safeguard the health of the people and to protect them from counterfeit drugs:
- Avoid potentially fatal side effects resulting from irresponsible use of counterfeit drugs and other similar products not registered or licensed by the Food and Drugs Administration.

section 3. Definition of Terms - As used in this Ordinance the following terms shall mean:

- Botika ng Barangay refers to a drug outlet managed by a legitimate community organization (CO)/non-government organization (NGO) and/or the Local Government Unit (LGU), with a trained operator and a supervising pharmacist.
- Counterfeit pharmaceutical products refer to pharmaceutical products which do not contain the amount as claimed; with wrong ingredients; without active ingredients; or with insufficient quantity of active ingredients, which result in the reduction of the products that are deliberately and fraudulently mislabeled with respect to identify and/or source or with fake packaging, and can apply to both branded and generic products.
- Household remedies refer to any preparation containing pharmaceutical substances of common or ordinary use to relieve common physical ailments and which may be dispensed without medical prescription in original packages, bottles or containers, of which the nomenclature has been approved by the FDA.
- Over-the-counter (OTC) medicines refer to medicines used for symptomatic relief of minor ailments and which may be dispensed without a prescription.
- Pharmaceutical products refer to drugs, medicines, biologicals, pharmaceutical and biopharmaceutical products/specialties, veterinary products, veterinary biologics, and veterinary medicinal products.
- Pharmacist refers to a health professional who has been registered and issued a valid Certificate of Registration (COR) and Professional Identification Card (PIC) by the PRC and the Professional Regulatory Board of Pharmacy.
- Pharmacist-only OTC medicines refer to over-the-counter medicines classified by appropriate government agencies to be obtained only from a licensed pharmacist. with mandatory pharmacist's advice on their selection and proper use.
- h. Prescription medicines refer to medicines which can only be dispensed by a pharmacist to a patient, upon the presentation of valid prescription from a physician, dentist, or veterinarian and for which a pharmacist's advice is necessary.
- Sari-sari stores refer to retailing stores selling a general line of merchandise, classified as micro-enterprises.

### Section 4. Prohibited Acts

- 1. Pursuant to Section 30 of RA 10918, no pharmaceutical product of whatever nature and kind, shall be compounded, dispensed, sold or resold, or otherwise be made available to the consuming public, except through a retail drug outlet duly licensed by the FDA;
- 2. The manufacture, sale, or offering for sale, donation, distribution, trafficking, brokering, exportation, or importation or possession of counterfeit drugs as defined in Section 3 hereof not otherwise covered by Republic Act No. 3720, as amended. The presence of availability of such counterfeit drugs within the premises of any entity,

engaged in the sale, manufacture or distribution of drugs and/or pharmaceutical products or in a private residence, or in public or private vehicle, or in the premises not covered by a valid license to operate from the Bureau are likewise prohibited pursuant to Section 4 of RA 8203;

- Sari-sari stores and other similar retail outlets and micro-enterprises are prohibited from dispensing, selling, or reselling prescription and pharmacist-only OTC medicines, as defined and classified by the FDA, as these medicines may only be dispensed by or obtained from a licensed pharmacist and with said licensed pharmacist's advice, pursuant to RA 10918;
- The possession, dispensing, selling, or reselling of counterfeit pharmaceutical products are prohibited and shall be governed by the provisions of RA 8203.

Section 5. Requirements for the Opening and Operation of a Retail Pharmaceutical Outlet or Establishment - Stores such as convenience stores, cooperative-run stores, and other small and medium enterprises which intend to sell household remedies and OTC drugs (which are not pharmacist-only) are first required to apply as a retail outlet for non-prescription drugs (RONPD), pursuant to FDA Circular No. 2014-028, and secure the following:

- A license to operate (LTO) from the FDA;
- b. The employment of the supervision and oversight of a duly registered and licensed pharmacist, pursuant to Section 31 (b) of RA 10918; and

Other requirements imposed by the FDA on its LTO applicants.

Section 6. Responsibility of the LGU - The LGU shall have the following responsibilities pertinent to this ordinance:

- The LGU shall ensure the integration of guidelines in the existing business permit and licensing system and requirement;
- The Municipal Health Office and Barangay Health Stations in coordination with the LGU shall ensure the operation of their respective pharmacies wherein nonprescription drugs are made available.
- The LGU shall also establish an enabling mechanism designed to assist owners of sarisari stores and other retail stores in securing proper authorization from FDA to dispense sell, and resell pharmaceutical products.

Section 7. Penalties - Any person found to have committed violation any of the following acts shall be penalized as follows:

First offense – a fine of ₱1,000.00 or warning

Second offense – a fine of ₱1,500.00 or imprisonment of not more than three (3) months or both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

Third offense – a fine of ₱2,500.00 or imprisonment of not more than six (6) months or both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

If the Violation is committed by a group, organization or entity, may it be a corporation, ' partnership or single proprietorship, the Head, President or General Manager or Owner, or person acting on behalf of such responsible officers shall be held liable for the violation.

In addition to the foregoing penalties, revocation of the business permit or license of stores determined by the LGU, the FDA, or the PNP to be dispensing, selling, or reselling of pharmaceutical products without proper authorization upon the commission of the third offense.

Section 8. Enforcement - The Local Chief Executive or his duly authorized representative in coordination with the Punong Barangays, the Philippine National Police (PNP) and the Food and Drugs Administration (FDA) shall be primarily responsible for the enforcement of this Ordinance which shall include the crackdown of counterfeit drugs and the illegal distribution of pharmaceutical products.

Section 9. Information, Education and Campaign - It shall be the obligation of the Local Government Unit of Tolosa to conduct massive information, education, and communication efforts

### **RESOLUTION NO. 04-71-2024**

RESOLUTION APPROVING ORDINANCE NO. 04, SERIES OF 2024. RE: AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE DISPENSING, SELLING, AND RESELLING OF PHARMACEUTICAL PRODUCTS IN SARI-SARI STORES AND OTHER SIMILAR RETAIL OUTLETS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TOLOSA, LEYTE

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 15 of the 1987 Constitution mandates the State to protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, Section 30 of Republic Act. No 10918, otherwise known as the Philippine Pharmacy Act prohibits the compounding, dispensing, selling, or reselling of pharmaceutical products through retail drug outlets not licensed by the Food and Drugs Administration (FDA);

WHEREAS, Republic Act. No 8203, otherwise known as the Special Law on Counterfeit Drugs, prohibits by person from manufacturing, selling, offering for sale, donating, distributing, trafficking, brokering, exporting, importing, or processing counterfeit drugs;

WHEREAS, the FDA, through its Advisory No. 2020-13481 has issued a public health warning against the purchase and use of several counterfeit drug products that proliferated in the market, including commonly known medicines such as Phenylephrine HCI/ Chlorphenamine Maleate/ Paracetamol (Neozep® Forte), Loperamide (Diatabs®), Ibuprofen/ Paracetamol (Alaxan® FR), Carbocisteine (Solmux®), and others;

WHEREAS, The proliferation of counterfeit pharmaceutical products and the sale of medicines by sari-sari stores, without authorization from the FDA, are a potential cause of serious harm to the health and safety of the general public;

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 15 of the 1987 Constitution mandates the State to protect and promote the right to health of the people and instil health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, the FDA, through its Advisory No. 2020-13481 has issued a public health warning against the purchase and use of several counterfeit drug products that proliferated in the market, including commonly known medicines such as Phenylephrine HCI/ Chlorphenamine Maleate/ Paracetamol (Neozep® Forte), Loperamide (Diatabs®), Ibuprofen/ Paracetamol (Alaxan® FR), Carbocisteine (Solmux®), and others;

WHEREAS, The proliferation of counterfeit pharmaceutical products and the sale of medicines by sari-sari stores, without authorization from the FDA, are a potential cause of serious harm to the health and safety of the general public;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Tolosa, Leyte session duly assembled that:

Section 1. Title - This Ordinance shall be known "An Ordinance Regulating the Dispensing, Selling and Reselling of Pharmaceutical Products in Sari-Sari Stores and Other Similar Retail Outlets in the Municipality of Tolosa, Leyte".

Section 2. Objectives – This Ordinance aims to:

- a. Regulate the dispensing, selling and reselling of pharmaceutical products in sari-sari stores and other similar retail outlets in the municipality of Tolosa, Leyte, as it poses health risk to the public;
- To safeguard the health of the people and to protect them from counterfeit drugs;
- c. Avoid potentially fatal side effects resulting from irresponsible use of counterfeit drugs and other similar products not registered or licensed by the Food and Drugs Administration.

Section 3. Definition of Terms - As used in this Ordinance the following terms shall mean:

- Botika ng Barangay refers to a drug outlet managed by a legitimate community organization (CO)/non-government organization (NGO) and/or the Local Government Unit (LGU), with a trained operator and a supervising pharmacist.
- b. Counterfeit pharmaceutical products refer to pharmaceutical products which do not contain the amount as claimed; with wrong ingredients; without active ingredients; or with insufficient quantity of active ingredients, which result in the reduction of the products that are deliberately and fraudulently mislabeled with respect to identify and/or source or with fake packaging, and can apply to both branded and generic products.
- c. Household remedies refer to any preparation containing pharmaceutical substances of common or ordinary use to relieve common physical ailments and which may be dispensed without medical prescription in original packages, bottles or containers, of which the nomenclature has been approved by the FDA.
- d. Over-the-counter (OTC) medicines refer to medicines used for symptomatic relief of minor ailments and which may be dispensed without a prescription.
- Pharmaceutical products refer to drugs, medicines, biologicals, pharmaceutical and biopharmaceutical products/specialties, veterinary products, veterinary biologics, and veterinary medicinal products.

Pharmacist - refers to a health professional who has been registered and issued a valid Certificate of Registration (COR) and Professional Identification Card (PIC) by the PRC and the Professional Regulatory Board of Pharmacy.

- Pharmacist-only OTC medicines refer to over-the-counter medicines classified by appropriate government agencies to be obtained only from a licensed pharmacist, with mandatory pharmacist's advice on their selection and proper use.
- Prescription medicines refer to medicines which can only be dispensed by a pharmacist to a patient, upon the presentation of valid prescription from a physician, dentist, or veterinarian and for which a pharmacist's advice is necessary.
- Sari-sari stores refer to retailing stores selling a general line of merchandise, classified as micro-enterprises.

### Section 4. Prohibited Acts

- Pursuant to Section 30 of RA 10918, no pharmaceutical product of whatever nature and kind, shall be compounded, dispensed, sold or resold, or otherwise be made available to the consuming public, except through a retail drug outlet duly licensed by the FDA;
- The manufacture, sale, or offering for sale, donation, distribution, trafficking, brokering, exportation, or importation or possession of counterfeit drugs as defined in Section 3 hereof not otherwise covered by Republic Act No. 3720, as amended. The presence of availability of such counterfeit drugs within the premises of any entity, engaged in the sale, manufacture or distribution of drugs and/or pharmaceutical products or in a private residence, or in public or private vehicle, or in the premises not covered by a valid license to operate from the Bureau are likewise prohibited pursuant to Section 4 of RA 8203:
- 3. Sari-sari stores and other similar retail outlets and micro-enterprises are prohibited from dispensing, selling, or reselling prescription and pharmacist-only OTC medicines, as defined and classified by the FDA, as these medicines may only be dispensed by or obtained from a licensed pharmacist and with said licensed pharmacist's advice, pursuant to RA 10918;
- The possession, dispensing, selling, or reselling of counterfeit pharmaceutical products are prohibited and shall be governed by the provisions of RA 8203.

Section 5. Requirements for the Opening and Operation of a Retail Pharmaceutical Outlet or Establishment - Stores such as convenience stores, cooperative-run stores, and other small and medium enterprises which intend to sell household remedies and OTC drugs (which are not pharmacist-only) are first required to apply as a retail outlet for non-prescription drugs (RONPD), pursuant to FDA Circular No. 2014-028, and secure the following:

- A license to operate (LTO) from the FDA;
- The employment of the supervision and oversight of a duly registered and licensed pharmacist, pursuant to Section 31 (b) of RA 10918; and Other requirements imposed by the FDA on its LTO applicants.

Section 6. Responsibility of the LGU - The LGU shall have the following responsibilities pertinent to this ordinance:

- The LGU shall ensure the integration of guidelines in the existing business permit and licensing system and requirement;
- b. The Municipal Health Office and Barangay Health Stations in coordination with the LGU shall ensure the operation of their respective pharmacies wherein nonprescription drugs are made available.
- The LGU shall also establish an enabling mechanism designed to assist owners of sarisari stores and other retail stores in securing proper authorization from FDA to dispense sell, and resell pharmaceutical products.
