Gentlemen and Ladies:

Pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160), our preliminary review of the **General Fund Supplemental Budget No. 3 CY 2024** of the **Municipality of Isabel, Leyte** duly enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan through **Appropriation Ordinance No. 03, Series of 2024** with a total appropriation in the amount of **P28,000,000.00**, reveals compliance with the same law and its implementing Rules and Regulations.

Compliance with DBM issuances, accounting and auditing rules and regulations and all other existing laws shall be the responsibility of the implementing Local Government Unit.



AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 03 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ISABEL, LEYTE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024 INVOLVING AN AMOUNT OF TWENTY EIGHT MILLION DEGOS 28,000,000.00) FROM THE DEVELOPMENT BANK OF THE PHILIPPINES (DBP) LOAN PROCEEDS OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ISABEL AND APPROPRIATING THE SAME FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A THERMAL DECOMPOSITION MACHINE FOR THE LGU'S MATERIAL RECOVERY FACILITY

WHEREAS, presented for consideration before this august body is the proposed Supplemental Budget No. 03 of the Local Government Unit of Isabel, Leyte, for CY 2024;

WHEREAS, the same covers additional appropriations for the purchase and installation of a Thermal Decomposition Machine for the LGU's Material recovery Facility.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED by the 19thSangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Isabel, Province of Leyte, in the 85th Regular Session assembled AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 02 OF THE MUNICIPALITYOF ISABEL, LEYTE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024 INVOLVING AN AMOUNT OF TWENTY EIGHT MILLION PESOS (PhP 28,000,000.00) FROM THE DEVELOPMENT BANK OF THE PHILIPPINES (DBP) LOAN PROCEEDS OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ISABEL AND APPROPRIATING THE SAME FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A THERMAL DECOMPOSITION MACHINE FOR THE LGU'S MATERIAL RECOVERY FACILITY.

SECTION 1. The Supplemental Budget No. 03 of the Municipality of Isabel, Leyte for Fiscal Year 2024 in the total amount of Twenty Eight Million Pesos (PhP 28,000,000.00) covering the additional appropriation for the purchase of a Thermal Decomposition Machine for the LGU's Material recovery Facility.

SECTION 2.Sources of Funds. The sources of funds for the Supplemental Budget No.03 for CY 2024 in the total amount of TWENTY EIGHT MILLION PESOS (PhP 28,000,000.00):

SECTION 4.Separability Clause. If, for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, other sections or provisions thereof which are not affected thereby shall constitute to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 5.Effectivity. The provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.


We are glad to inform that LGU — Isabel's loan application to finance the Procurement of Thermal Decomposition Equipment for the LGU's Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) in the amount of **PESOS: TWENTY-EIGHT MILLION (Php28,000,000.00)** was approved by the Bank's approving authorities.

Relow are the details, to wit:

Total Loan	TWENTY - EIGHT MILLION (Php 28,000,000.00) or 100% of the winning bid price
Amount	whichever is lower
Tenor.	Ten (10) years inclusive of one (1) year grace period, payable in one hundred eight (108) equal monthly amortizations on principal to commence at the end of the 13th month from date of initial drawdown.
Interest .	Fixed for one (1) year based on existing market rate at the time of drawdown p.a., payable monthly, subject to a floor rate of 7.50% p.a., commencing at the end of the 1st month from date of initial drawdown. Interest shall be reviewed annually based on the relevant benchmark rate plus applicable credit spread subject to a floor rate equivalent to the existing rate. GRT for the account of the LGU.
Availability	Within one (1) year from date of Notice of Approval.
Credit Related	1. Commitment Fee – waived
Fees	2. Front-End Fee – waived
	3. Extension Fee – waived
	4. Default Charge - 24% p.a.
	5. Prepayment penalty - 3% of the amount to be prepaid.
	6. Service Charge for Insurance Advances - 2% on advanced premium
	7. GRT and other applicable fees/taxes for the account of the LGU.

I. Pre-release requirements:

- 1. Seal of Good Financial Housekeeping issued by DILG
- 2. Certificate of Borrowing Capacity & Net Debt Service Ceiling issued by DOF-BLGF.
- 3. Favorable Monetary Board Opinion
- 4. Authority to debit in favor of DBP to auto-debit LGU's account to ensure payment of both principal, interest and other fees as they become due.
- 5. Letter on the waiver of confidentiality of investments and bank deposits.
- 6. Validated Ordinance by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan (SP) expressly authorizing the following:
 - a. The Municipal Mayor to negotiate and enter into a contract of loan applied for and to assign or otherwise enter into a collateral agreement to secure the payment of the loan applied for;
 - b. Waiver on the confidentiality of investment and bank deposits, whether in peso or foreign currency:
 - c. Ratifying the approved terms and conditions of DBP lending entered into by the Municipal Mayor which shall contain a provision that such ratification includes any and all subsequent requests by the LGU which makes the loan a statutory obligation of the LGU, including the following:
 - i. The LGU to execute the Loan Agreement, Promissory Notes, and other documents relating thereto, and specifically stating that the obligations of the LGU thereunder, as well as the terms and conditions thereof, shall be valid and binding on the LGU and shall not be subject to recall by the SB for the whole term of the loan, regardless of any change in its composition;
 - ii. The continuing assignment of the applicable portion of the LGU's NTA and local revenues with control agreement in favor of DBP until the loan is fully paid. This shall be registered pursuant to R.A. 11057 (PPSA) once the system is fully operational.
 - iii. The DBP to automatically debit on due date from the LGU's CASA deposit account with DBP to an amount equivalent to the maturing loan amortization until the loan is fully paid;
 - iv. The inclusion of appropriation for debt-servicing in the LGU's annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Code until the loan is fully paid.









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- v. The undertaking that the LGU will not incur additional obligation/indebtedness without DBP's prior consent.
- 7. Certification to be issued by the Municipal Treasurer or Municipal Budget Officer noted by the Municipal Mayor stating that:
 - a. All loans of the LGU have been entered into its book of accounts;
 - b. The principal and interest payments for all existing loans of the LGU have been made and that said loans are all in current status;
 - c. The projects to be financed are included in the LGU's approved local development plan and annual investment plan;
 - d. The expenditures for the proposed projects' equity payments, cost overruns and other incidental expenses are included and appropriated for in the LGU's budget;
 - e. The source of repayment for the proposed loan with DBP is available and not restricted, and that all related obligations including principal, interest and Gross Receipts Tax payments are duly appropriated for and full provision has been made by the LGU;
 - f. The annual amortization of existing loans or indebtedness are being paid regularly in accordance with the approved amortization schedule and that the total amortizations for all credits inclusive of the DBP loan shall not exceed 20% of the LGU's total annual regular income
- 8. Perfection of loan and security documents
- Compliance to RA 9184 and submission of complete bid documents (Minutes of Bidding, Notice of Award, Notice to Proceed and Contract)
- N(0) 10. ECC/CNC, whichever is applicable

- 11. Payment of Documentary Stamp Tax and applicable fees.
- 12. Certificate and Notice of Borrowing
- 13. Execution of Promissory Note/s and Disclosure Statement/s
- 14. Undertaking for the borrower to register the Security Agreement/s pursuant to RA No. 11057 under the Personal Property Security Registry (PPSR) once the system has become fully operational.
- 15. Appropriate insurance cover with official receipt or proof of payment
- 16. Certificate of Registration for Treatment, Storage and Disposal (TSD) Facility from DENR
- 17. Certificate of Conformity (COC) issued by the DENR-EMB
- 18. Appointment/Designation of Pollution Control Officer (PCO)
- 19. Proposed 10-year Solid Waste Management Plan
- 20. Loan release/s shall be credited to the deposit account of the LGU with DBP

II. Release Conditions - One-time Release Allowed, subject to the following:

- 1. Proof of delivery of machineries and equipment
- 2. Certificate of Delivery and Acceptance which also states that the equipment are in good condition and have been satisfactorily tested and commissioned
- 3. List of Accredited Local Technician for Equipment
- 4. Certification that Training was conducted with list/attendance of participants
- 5. Certification from Equipment Supplier on the Availability of Spare Parts in the Philippines
- 6. Payment of applicable fees and tax/es
- 7. Any cost overruns shall be for the account of the borrower
- 8. Loan release/s shall be credited to the deposit account of the LGU with DBP Maasin Br.

III. Post-release conditions:

- 1. Submission of Post Borrowing Report (PBR) to BSP 30 days after the final disbursement of the loan proceeds, copy furnished DBP.
- 2. Submission of the following 60 days from project completion for Procurement of Machineries and Equipment:
 - a. Official Receipt from the supplier.
 - b. Pollution Control Officer Accreditation Certificate
- Submission of Approved 10-year Solid Waste Management Plan within one year from date of full release.
- 4. Project Performance Monitoring Report
