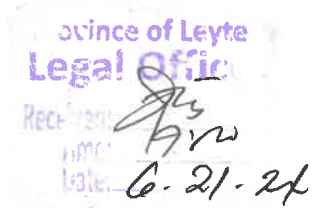

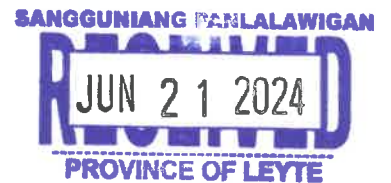

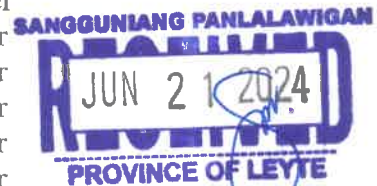

AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE QUARTERLY INSPECTION AND CALIBRATION OF DISPENSING PUMP METERS AT ALL GASOLINE RETAIL OUTLETS WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF MUNICIPALITY OF CARIGARA, IMPOSING FEES FOR THE CALIBRATION AND SEALING OF DISPENSING PUMPS, PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS AND PROHIBITING UNDERDELIVERY AND/OR SHORT SELLING OF GAS, AND ILLEGAL TRADING OF GASOLINE RETAIL OUTLETS

WHEREAS, RA 8479, otherwise known as the "Downstream Oil Industry Deregulation Act of 1998", mandates the Department of Energy (DOE) to promote the entry of new industry participants, promote fair trade practices, monitor marketing processes and quality of Liquid Petroleum Products, and stop the operation of business involved in the sale of Liquid Petroleum Products not complying with the national standards of quality;

**WHEREAS**, Batas Pambansa Blg. 33, as amended by PD No. 1865, and the Implementing Rules and Regulations therefore, define and penalize certain prohibited acts inimical to the public interests and national security, including illegal trading of petroleum and/or petroleum products, hoarding, adulteration, and underdelivery or short selling;

**WHEREAS**, DOE Department Circular Nos. 2003-11-010 and 2013-09-0021, as amended by DC No. 2017-11-011, establish the minimum requirements for operation of Retail Outlets and prescribe the rules and regulations governing the Business of Retailing Liquid Fuels;

**WHEREAS**, the retailing of Liquid Fuels is subject to pertinent permits and licenses issued by government authorities, including the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) and the local government units (LGUs);

**WHEREAS**, under Section 20, DOE DC No. 003-11-010, issued on November 14, 2003, the DOE recognizes and respects the rights of the LGU to refuse issuing the necessary business permits and/ or impose fines and/ or penalties in case of violations specified hereto, and may recommend to the concerned LGU the suspension, revocation or termination of the business permit of persons violating the aforesaid DOE DC;

**WHEREFORE**, premises considered and pursuant to Section 447 (a)(2)(xv) of R.A No. 7160, otherwise known as the “Local Government Code of 1991”, which empowered the Sangguniang Bayan to regulate the inspection, weighing and measuring of articles of commerce”, the Sangguniang Bayan of Carigara do hereby pass and enact the ordinance as follows:

**SECTION 1. TITLE** – This Ordinance shall be also known as, “Inspection and Calibration of Dispensing Pump at all Retail Outlet”.

**SECTION 2. COVERAGE** – This Ordinance shall apply to all persons, natural or juridical, engaged or intending to engage in the business of retailing liquid fuels in the Municipality of Carigara.

**SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS** - For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following terms shall be defined:

- a. **LIQUID FUELS (LF)** – shall refer to gasoline, diesel, and kerosene;

- b. **ADULTERATED** – refers to an impure gasoline due to addition of a foreign substance or inferior ingredient, or the presence of water or other inferior ingredients co-mingled with gasoline debasing its quality;
- c. **CALIBRATION**- shall herein refer to the act, method or process of: a) testing the accuracy of a dispensing pump meter used in delivering gasoline or other liquid fuels; or b) measuring the actual quantity of liquid fuels dispensed within the tolerable minimum quantity as determined under the Department of Energy (DOE) Rules and Circular;
- d. **DISPENSING** – shall refer to the act of transferring Liquid Fuels from the dispensing pump directly to vehicles’ fuel tank and/or in appropriate container/s provided by the Retail Outlet;
- e. **DISPENSING PUMP** – shall refer to an equipment used to deliver or dispense liquid fuels and which is installed in a forecourt/curb area within the Retail Outlet which is composed of a dispensing nozzle and volumetric meter;
- f. **DELIVERY/SELL**- refers to the act of knowingly passing, giving or transferring possession of liquid fuels by the retail outlet to the end user whether for money or any consideration;
- g. **DOST-ITDI**- shall refer to the Department of Science and Technology-Industrial Technology Development Institute;
- h. **OIMB**- shall refer to the Oil Industry Management Bureau;
- i. **PNS**- shall refer to the Philippine National Standard;
- j. **NML** - shall refer to the National Metrology Laboratory of DOST-ITDI;
- k. **TEST MEASURE** – shall refer to a calibration bucket that is used to measure the quantity of Liquid Fuel;
- l. **RETAIL OUTLET**- shall refer to a gasoline station, facility or business establishment, which sells/ or dispenses liquid fuels such as gasoline directly to the

individual end user/s;

- m. **RETAILING** – shall refer to the act of selling/ or dispensing Liquid Fuels to individual end user/s; and
- n. **Municipal Treasurer’s Office (MTO) and/or its representative** – is the authorized calibrating entity or the proper authority referred in this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4. STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS.** – All Retail Outlet/s engaged or intend to engage in retailing Liquid Fuels shall comply/or observe the following:

- a. The Retailing of Liquid Fuels shall be conducted in duly approved premises with an initial minimum lot area of 100 square meters and where vehicles being serviced shall at all times be inside the duly approved business premises;
- b. Dispensing pump shall be fixed and permanent;
- c. Dispensing pumps shall be properly calibrated and sealed by authorized calibrating entity;
- d. Product deliveries and retailing of Liquid Fuels shall be conducted only within the premises of the Retail Outlet;
- e. All Liquid Fuels shall be stored in Underground Storage Tank (UGT);
- f. Retail Outlet/s shall sell and dispense Liquid Fuels to customers/ or end users regardless of quantity and amount, directly to their vehicles’ fuel tank or in appropriate container/s. The use of appropriate container which shall be provided by Liquid Fuels Retail Outlet may be allowed, provided that it is used for emergency (such as transporting the Liquid Fuels to their place of use/consumption) but not for storage and commercial purposes;
- g. Retail Outlet/s should ensure that Liquid Fuels shall not be discharged into any street, highway, drainage canal or ditch, storm drain or flood control channel, lake or tidal waterway, or directly into the ground;
- h. All Retail Outlets should have a forecourt and maintain/install facilities such as Office/Cashier’s Booth, canopy, boundary wall, master switch that will disconnect the electric power to all dispensing pumps in case of emergency and a clean restroom with toiletries and running water; and
- i. All Retail Outlets shall post safety and informational signages and levels in strategic and appropriate locations within their business premises.

**SECTION 5. CONSUMER SAFETY AND SIGNAGES.** – The following signages shall be posted or displayed by the owner and/ or operator of Retail Outlet in strategic and appropriate locations within their respective business premises for information of the consumers and service station personnel:


- a. Price Display Board with updated prices for each Liquid Fuels;
- b. Price Display Board with updated prices in the dispensing pump/s;
- c. Product quality label;
- d. Do not use cellular phone while filling;
- e. No smoking;
- f. Switch-off engine while filling;
- g. No straddling (motorbike/tricycle); and
- h. Other safety signs as may be required by the DOE, LGU, and other government agencies

**SECTION 6. CALIBRATION AND SEALING OF DISPENSING PUMPS BY PROPER AUTHORITY** – The Municipal Treasurer or his/her representative is the authorized calibrating entity and proper authority who shall calibrate and affix the seal, and on the other hand, break the seal of all dispensing pumps used in Retail Outlets to dispense Liquid Fuels sold to the public quarterly/ or every three (3) months pursuant to Section 23, Rule VI of DOE DC No. 2017-11-0011. Immediate calibration shall also be conducted in case the dispensing pump is found underdelivering.


In the absence or incapacity of the Municipal Treasurer or his/her duly authorized representative, the National Metrology Laboratory (NML) of the Industrial Technology Development Institute (ITDI), Department of Science and Technology (DOST) or, in its absence, the oil company or a third-party contractor.

In case the calibration be made by the oil company or a third-party contractor, it shall first secure a certification from Municipal Treasurer or NML ITDI DOST that the latter are unavailable or incapable of doing the calibration.



**PUMP** – The Municipal Treasurer or his duly authorized representative shall impose and collect the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php250.00) as payment for the following:

- Calibration & Sealing – Php100/nozzle
- Sticker – Php150/nozzle

**SECTION 8. FINES/SANCTIONS AGAINST PROHIBITED ACTS** – The Retail Outlet Official and/ or Retail Outlet that commits the prohibited act shall be imposed of the following penalties:

Treasurer as Vice Chairperson, and four (4) Others as members: the Municipal Administrator, SB Member-Chairperson Committee on Police, Fire, Public Safety, Peace & Order and Human Rights Protection, the BPLO and the Chief of Police of the Carigara Municipal Police Station.

The Board shall assume the following powers/functions: 1) Conduct hearing/s on administrative case filed against any person/s or Retail Outlet committing the prohibited act/s enumerated under this Ordinance; 2) Renders decision on administrative case within fifteen (15) days from the date of filing thereof; 3) Impose fine against the owner or operator of Retail Outlet; 4) Order the suspension or revocation of business permit and/ or closure of business establishment; and 5) Recommend to the proper government agencies to file criminal charges.

The Board shall formulate its own rules and regulations governing the case filed before them. It shall also institute and/ or commence administrative proceeding upon receipt of a verified complaint.

**SECTION 10. NO CONTEST PROVISION** – Any person, individual or entity cited or apprehended for violation of this Ordinance and does not wish to contest the violation and is willing to comply the necessary requirements and pay voluntarily the minimum fine imposed upon him/her prior to the filling of formal charges with the proper government agencies shall be allowed to pay the said fine with the Municipal Treasurer’s Office (MTO) within seventy-two (72) hours from the issuance of notice of violation.

**SECTION 11. APPLICABILITY CLAUSE** – DOE issuance and circulars as well as other existing laws, insofar as they are not inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be applied supplementary.

**SECTION 12. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE** – If any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the provisions that are not affected thereby shall continue to be in force and effect.

**SECTION 13. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE**- This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days from the date a copy hereof is posted in a bulletin board at the entrance of the Municipal Hall Building of Carigara, Leyte and in at least two (2) conspicuous places in the municipality.
