• Ordinance No. 2024-193 entitled: "An Ordinance Amending Section 13 & 26 of Municipal Ordinance No. 130, Series of 2022, Otherwise Known as A Revised Fishery Ordinance of Carigara, Leyte.

REVIEW/RECOMMENDATION/LEGAL OPINION:

This office is of the opinion that the subject Ordinance is in accordance to its power under section 447(a)(1)(vi)¹ of the Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A 7160) and in relation to the mandate of R.A 10654 an act to prevent, deter and eliminate illegal, unreported and unregulated fishing, amending Republic Act No. 8550, otherwise known as "The Philippine Fisheries Code of 1998" and for Other Purposes.

Likewise as settled in the case of Costantino v. Desierto 288 SCRA 654, it is within the power of the Local Council to repeal or amend its prior acts either expressly, or by the passage of an essentially inconsistent resolution. Hence, recommending the declaration of its validity.



SECTION 2. Section 26 of Municipal Ordinance No. 130 is hereby amended as per Civil Service Commission Qualification Standards (Revised 1997). To read as follows;

"Section 26. THE CARIGARA FISHERY LAW ENFORCEMENT TEAM/ BANTAY DAGAT. The Carigara Fishery Law Enforcement Team o Bantay Dagat shall be composed of the officers and members of the MFARMCS, LGU Deputized by Municipal Mayor, Philippine National Police and with the assistance of the Philippine Coast Guard, Philippine Maritime Police and BFAR.

The Carigara Fishery Law Enforcement Team (CFLET) shall conduct daily monitoring in the Marine Reserve Area and apprehend illegal fishing activities and intruders. Aside from surveillance and apprehension operations, the CFLET shall issue auxiliary invoice, entrance fee ticket and also assist licensed fishermen whose legal nets are entangled underneath the water and if necessary, assist water search and rescue. CFLET/Bantay Dagat shall issue Citation Ticket to illegal fishers. Original copy of such notice shall be issued to the fishers while the duplicate shall be submitted to the Municipal Treasurer who receives the penalty fee."

SECTION 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reasons, a part or provisions of this Ordinance which shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provision hereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, rules and regulations or parts not consistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY. This ordinance shall take force and effect upon approval.

Toilets, piggeries and pigsties with sewer or canals leading to rivers, creeks or the sea is prohibited.

Violation of any of the above prohibition shall be penalized a fine of Php 2,500.00 and/or imprisonment of not more than 6 months upon discretion of the court.

Section 11. DECLARATION OF CLEAN-UP DAYS OF CREEK/RIVER BANKS AND COASTAL SHORES. Through a Sangguniang Bayan Resolution, every 30th day of April and 5th day of June shall be declared as creeks/river banks and coastal shores Clean-Up days. Every BLGU shall mobilize citizenry to actively participate in this clean-up operation in their respective territorial jurisdictions. All high school and college students and their respective teachers including the elementary teachers are enjoined to actively participate in the clean-up drives. These activities shall be coordinated by the Office of the Local Chief Executive with the school supervisors and principals of the DepEd.

Section 12. PEOPLES PARTICIPATION IN WASTE MANAGEMENT. The MLGU in coordination with the different people's organization, the Solid Waste Management Board and institutions concerned shall conduct continuous education on proper management of solid and liquid wastes.

Section 13. MARINE RESERVE AREA (MRA). To enable the fish population in the Municipal Waters of Carigara, Leyte to reproduce and provide replenishment to its stock, a Marine Reserve Area is hereby established within the territorial waters of the Municipality of Carigara with the following geographic coordinates. Barugohay Norte Fish Sanctuary Lattitude:11°20′17″ N to Longitude: 124°41′49″ E with the total area of 10 hectares and Jugaban Fish Sanctuary Latitude: 11°19′18″ N to Longitude: 124°41′26″ E with the total area of seven (7) hectares.

A 200-meters buffer zone is hereby established around the marine reserve area perimeter where the operation of passive fishing gears such as hook and line set gill nets shall be allowed.

For the protection and sound management of the area it shall therefore be unlawful for any person as defined in this ordinance to undertake fishery activities within the designated and/or specified fish sanctuary (core area).



CHAPTER V

FISHERY LICENCES AND PERMITS

Section 14. PERSON ELIGIBLE FOR FISHING PRIVILEGES. The Carigara Municipal Fisherfolks and their organizations shall be given preferential option in the grant of fishing privileges. Provided that duly registered fisherfolk organizations/cooperatives shall have preference in the grant of fishery rights by the Sangguniang Bayan pursuant to Section 149 of the Local Government Code 1991.

It shall be unlawful for any person not qualified under this Ordinance to engage personally or through other person to collect/gather and culture fish and other fishery/aquatic products in waters within the jurisdiction of this municipality.

All registered fisherfolk shall always carry with him/her fishing license whenever actually engaged in fishing activities.

Section 15. FISHERY LICENSE AND PERMIT. All individuals, associations, cooperatives, partnerships, firms and corporations that are located and operating in the municipality shall be issued Fishery License upon payment of the prescribed fees, provided however, that all

Section 25. Auxiliary invoice. No person, as defined in this ordinance, shall transport fish and other fishery products derived from the Municipal of Carigara, Leyte without first securing an auxiliary invoice or permit to transport from the Municipal Management and Licensing Unit of the Municipal Agriculturist Office and paying the corresponding fees prescribed for the purpose.

All fish other fishery /aquatic products landed in this municipality shall be subjected to regulatory inspection and must have an auxiliary invoice to be issued by the Municipal Fishery Licensing Unit prior to the transport from the point of origin to their point of destination in the Philippines and or export purpose upon payment of fee at the rates prescribed in Section 22 hereof.

CHAPTER VI

THE CFLET, MFARMC, BFARMC & BANTAY ILOG

Section 26. THE CARIGARA FISHERY LAW ENFORCEMENT TEAM/BANTAY DAGAT. The Carigara Fishery Law Enforcement Team (CFLET) or Bantay Dagat shall be composed of the officers and members of the MFARMC, LGU Personnel Deputized by the Municipal Mayor, Philippine National Police (PNP) and with the assistance Philippine Coast Guard (PCG), Philippine Maritime Police and BFAR.

Thru this Ordinance, the Bantay Dagat or the Carigara Fishery Law Enforcement Team (CFLET) shall apprehend illegal fishers as a result of its own surveillance and/or report from the BFARMC. Aside from its surveillance and apprehension operations, the CFLET shall issue auxiliary invoice, entrance fee ticket and also assist licensed fishermen whose legal fishnets were entangled underneath the waters and if necessary, assist water search and rescue. CFLET/Bantay Dagat shall issue Citation Ticket to an illegal fisher. Original copy of such notice shall be issued to the fisher while the duplicate shall be submitted to the Municipal Treasurer who receives the penalty fee.

Section 27. COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL FISHERIES AND AQUATIC RESOURCE MANAGEMENT COUNCIL (MFARMC). Pursuant to Section 69 of the Philippine Fisheries Code of 1998 (RA10654), the MFARMC shall be established in this municipality. The Local Government Unit (LGU) shall provide assistance to the MFARMC.
