#### **MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2024-03**

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPREHENSIVE HYDRATION AND HEALTH PROMOTION POLICY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PALO, LEYTE.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Palo, Leyte, recognizes the paramount importance of promoting healthy habits and preventing diseases among school-aged children, including the increasing risk of kidney diseases and illnesses;

WHEREAS, adequate hydration is essential for maintaining optimal physical health and cognitive function, particularly in the developing minds and bodies of young students;

WHEREAS, it is imperative to establish comprehensive guidelines ensuring that students have access to clean water, consume an adequate amount of water, and are educated on the prevention of diseases related to hydration and sanitation;

WHEREAS, promoting hydration and preventing diseases such as kidney disease, dengue fever, and waterborne illnesses among school-aged children can significantly contribute to their well-being and academic performance;

WHEREAS, parents and teachers should develop the "I have a role in health" mentality;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan, of Palo, Leyte, in session duly assembled:

**SECTION 1. TITLE.** 

This ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Establishing a Comprehensive Hydration and Health Promotion Policy in the Municipality of Palo, Leyte."

For the purposes of this ordinance, the following definitions shall apply:

- 1. Chronic Renal Diseases Long-term conditions affecting the kidneys, including chronic kidney disease and related complications.
- 2. Dengue Prevention Strategies aimed at preventing the transmission and spread of dengue fever, a mosquito-borne viral infection.
- 3. Hydration The process of providing and consuming an adequate amount of water to maintain proper bodily function and health.
- 4. Prevention of Kidney Disease Measures taken to reduce the risk of kidney diseases such as chronic kidney disease among the population.
- 5. Public & Private Schools Educational institutions within the Municipality of Palo, Leyte, providing education to students typically from kindergarten through fifth or sixth grade.
- 6. School-Aged Children Individuals within the age range eligible for enrollment in elementary schools as defined by the educational authorities of Palo, Leyte.
- 7. Students refers kindergarten, elementary learners, junior high and senior high school students.
- 8. Water Bottle Container designed for holding potable water, typically made of plastic, metal, or glass, and equipped with a lid or cap for sealing, which may be made of recyclable or non-recyclable material.
- 9. Waterborne Diseases Illnesses caused by the ingestion of contaminated water, including but not limited to diarrhea, cholera, and typhoid fever.

#### SECTION 3. COMPREHENSIVE HYDRATION AND HEALTH PROMOTION POLICY.

- 1. All Kindergarten, Elementary, Junior High, and Senior High schools within the Municipality of Palo, Leyte, are encouraged to implement a comprehensive hydration and health promotion policy aimed at promoting hydration and preventing diseases among school-aged children.
- 2. The policy shall include, but not be limited to, the following components:
  - a. Encouraging Water Bottle Use Students are encouraged to bring their own water bottles to school each day. It can be any water bottle or container depending on its availability.
  - b. Designated Water Consumption, Nature and Body Movement Break Times - Students are encouraged to consume water from their water bottles at designated times during the school day, specifically at 10:00 AM and 3:00 PM. Simultaneous drinking at 10:00 AM and 3:00 PM should be observed only within 3-5 minutes and shall continue whatever tasks they are expected to. Aside from the above, the students/children will also be encouraged to observe Call of Nature and Body Movement Break.
  - c. Appointment of Bell Ringer Schools are encouraged to appoint someone who will be in charge of ringing or sounding the bell at 10:00 AM and 3:00 PM to signal the designated water consumption

#### **SECTION 4. IMPLEMENTATION GUIDELINES.**

Kindergarten, Elementary, Junior High, and Senior High schools shall develop and implement procedures to encourage compliance with the comprehensive hydration and health promotion policy, including but not limited to:

- a. Providing clear and consistent communication to kindergarten, learners, students, parents/guardians, teachers, and staff regarding the benefits of hydration and the importance of the policy.
- b. Educating kindergarten, learners, and students about the importance of hydration, the benefits of regularly consuming water, and the risks associated with dehydration and waterborne illnesses.
- c. Encouraging parents/guardians to provide their children with durable and reusable water bottles that are labeled with the student's name for identification.
- d. Ensuring that water dispensers or fountains are available and easily accessible to kindergarten, learners, and students during designated water consumption times.
- e. Monitoring compliance with the policy and addressing any concerns or issues promptly.

#### **SECTION 5. EDUCATION AND AWARENESS.**

- Schools shall incorporate education about hydration, sanitation, and disease prevention into their curriculum, including lessons on the importance of drinking clean water, preventing waterborne illnesses, and maintaining kidney and physical health.
- 2. Schools shall also organize awareness campaigns and activities aimed at promoting the habit of bringing water bottles and drinking water regularly among students, parents/guardians, teachers, and staff.

#### SECTION 6. ENFORCEMENT.

- 1. The Municipal Health Office shall oversee the implementation of this local policy, providing essential support to students in the municipality. Additionally, the Municipal Sanitation Inspector shall ensure the quality and safety of water sources used for refills in schools through series of regular evaluation, prioritizing the health and well-being of kindergarten, elementary, junior high and senior high school students and teachers and staff.
- 2. Non-compliance with the comprehensive hydration and health promotion policy may result in corrective action, including but not limited to providing guidance and support to schools, and issuing recommendations, as determined by the Municipal Health Board.

#### **SECTION 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE**

If any provision of this ordinance is held invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision herein.
