REVIEW/RECOMMENDATION/LEGAL OPINION:

This office is of the opinion that the Subject Ordinance is in accordance to its power under Section 16¹ – the General Welfare Clause of the Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A 7160), pursuant to *Memorandum Circular No. 24 “Launching the Bagong Pilipinas Campaign as the Administration’s Brand of Governance and Leadership”, and Memorandum Circular No. 52 which is “Prescribing the Recital of the Bagong Pilipinas Hymn and Pledge during Flag Ceremonies”*. Hence, recommending for the declaration of its validity.

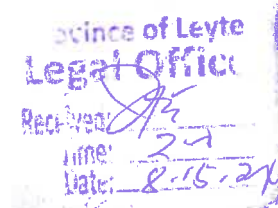

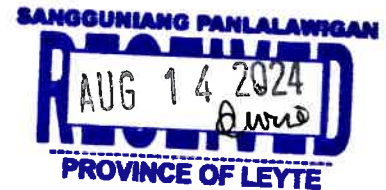

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BAGONG PILIPINAS LOGO, BAGONG PILIPINAS HYMN AND BAGONG PILIPINAS PLEDGE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BURAUEN, LEYTE

SPONSOR: HON. FE S. RENOMERON

WHEREAS, the Office of the President issued Memorandum Circular No. 24 which is *“Launching the Bagong Pilipinas Campaign as the Administration’s Brand of Governance and Leadership”*; and Memorandum Circular No. 52 which is *“Prescribing the Recital of the Bagong Pilipinas Hymn and Pledge during Flag Ceremonies”*;

WHEREAS, *Bagong Pilipinas* is the overarching theme of the Administration’s brand of governance and leadership, which calls for a deep and fundamental transformations in all sectors of society and government, and fosters the State’s commitment towards the attainment of comprehensive policy reforms and full economic recovery;

WHEREAS, *Bagong Pilipinas* is characterized by a principled, accountable and dependable government reinforced by unified institutions of society, whose common objective is to realize the goals and aspirations of every Filipino;

WHEREAS, MC No. 24 and MC No. 52 encourage National Government Agencies (NGAs) and instrumentalities, Government-Owned and/or Controlled (GOCCs), State Universities and Colleges (SUCs), other educational institutions, and LGUs to integrate the recital of the *Bagong Pilipinas* Hymn and Pledge in the conduct of weekly flag ceremonies, subject to existing laws, rules and regulations. Furthermore, all are directed to adopt the *Bagong Pilipinas* logo and incorporate the same in letterheads, websites, official social media accounts, and other documents and instruments pertaining to flagship programs of the government;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Burauen, Leyte, in regular session assembled, that:

SECTION 1 – Title. This ordinance shall be known as, “THE INTEGRATION OF *BAGONG PILIPINAS* LOGO, HYMN, AND PLEDGE IN ALL OFFICIAL GOVERNMENT FUNCTIONS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BURAUEN, LEYTE”

SECTION 2 – Scope and Application. This ordinance shall be observed in all government offices, public and private educational institutions, barangays, and places where official government function is being held in the Municipality of Burauen, Leyte.

SECTION 3 – Adoption of Bagong Pilipinas Logo. All government agencies, including the Municipal Government of Burauen, barangays, educational institutions, and other public entities, shall adopt and incorporate the *Bagong Pilipinas* logo in their official letterheads, websites, official social media accounts, and other documents and instruments pertaining to flagship programs of the government, as directed by the Office of the President and this ordinance. The *Bagong Pilipinas* logo is as follows:





SECTION 4 – Recital of Bagong Pilipinas Hymn and Pledge. All government agencies, including the Municipal Government of Burauen, barangays, educational institutions, and other public entities, shall adopt and integrate the recital of *Bagong Pilipinas* Hymn and Pledge into their flag ceremonies, as directed by the Office of the President and this ordinance. The *Bagong Pilipinas* Hymn and Pledge shall be recited in the following manner:

SECTION 5 – Compliance and Implementation.

- a. Government agencies, including the Municipal Government of Burauen, barangays, educational institutions, and other public entities shall ensure full compliance with this ordinance.
- b. The Municipal Mayor shall oversee the implementation of this ordinance and may issue guidelines and directives as necessary to ensure effective compliance.
- c. Non-compliance with this ordinance shall be subject to appropriate sanctions as provided by existing laws and regulations.

SECTION 6 – Repealing Clause. All ordinances, resolutions, executive orders and all other issuances inconsistent herewith are deemed to be repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7 – Separability Clause. If any of the provisions of this ordinance is declared invalid and unconstitutional, other parts or provisions hereof shall continue to be in full force and effect.


SECTION 8 – Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


