¹ Section 16-General Welfare Clause- Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied there from, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare xxx.

² (3) Issue licenses for the operation of fishing vessels of three (3) tons or less for which purpose the sangguniang bayan shall promulgate rules and regulations regarding the issuances of such licenses to qualified applicants under existing laws.

³ Section 447. Powers, Duties, Functions and Compensation. -

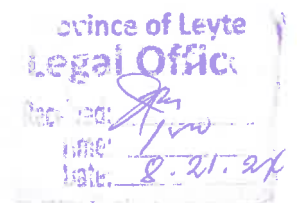

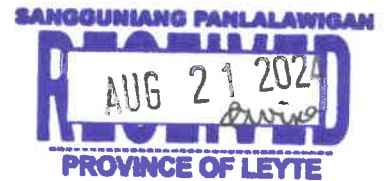

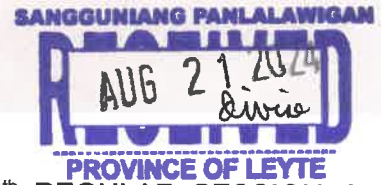

SECTION 1. Title. This ordinance shall be known as "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THE GUIDELINES FOR THE REGISTRATION OF FISHING VESSELS THREE (3) GROSS TONNAGE AND BELOW IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TABANGO, PROVINCE OF LEYTE."

SECTION 2. Scope. The ordinance shall apply to all fishing vessels with three (3) gross tonnage and below owned or operated by the resident of this Municipality or its principal office of the operator is located herein.

SECTION 3. Definition of Terms. As used in this Ordinance, the following terms are defined as follows:

- a. Registration – an act/process of enlisting a fishing vessel three (3) gross tons and below to establish its identity and ownership by assigning it a permanent number (recorded in the municipal registry of municipal fishing vessels)
- b. Admeasurement – means the measure of the volumetric capacity of the fishing vessel to determine its gross tonnage.
- c. Gross Tonnage – the product of vessel tonnage length, tonnage depth, and tonnage breadth modified by a factor of 0.70 divided by 2.83
- d. License/Permit to fish – the privilege to fish in its municipal waters granted to registered fisherfolk by the LGU
- e. Fishing vessel – any watercraft used for fishing or in support of fishing operations in municipal waters weighing three (3) gross tons and below
- f. Net Tonnage – the GT modified by a factor of 0.32
- g. Registered Breadth – the transverse distance taken at the widest part of the hull, excluding rub rails from the outboard side of the skin on the other side of the hull
- h. Registered depth – the vertical distance taken at or near midship from a line drawn horizontally through the gunwale of the skin of the sides of the hull (excluding the rail) to the outboard face of the bottom skin of the hull, excluding the keel Registered Length the horizontal distance between the







outboard side of the foremost part of the stem and the outboard side of the aftermost part of the stem, excluding fittings and attachments.

- i. Tonnage Length – The length measured at the centerline of the fishing vessel from the point forward where the line of the tonnage deck intersects the line of the inboard faces at the stem to the point aft where the line of the tonnage deck intersects the inboard face of the stem
- j. Tonnage Depth – measured at the centerline from a point below the line of the tonnage deck. The measurement is taken at a right angle to the vessel centerline of the vessel down to the inboard of the bottom skin of the hull
- k. Tonnage Breadth – measured at the mid-part from the gunwale inside of the skin of the hull to the inside of the skin on the other side of the hull
- l. Motorized fishing vessel – a fishing vessel propelled by mechanical means
- m. MARINA – Maritime Industry Authority
- n. PCG – Philippine Coast Guard
- o. BFAR – Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources
- p. Homeport – refers to the LGU where the fishing vessel is registered

SECTION 4. Registration of fishing Boats. No fishing boat three (3) gross tons or below, shall be allowed to be licensed or be issued with a fishing boat license without first registering the said fishing boat to the municipality or allowing transient fisherfolk with an appropriate fishing permit to operate within the jurisdiction of the municipality to fish using an unregistered fishing boat. Likewise, no vessel of any size or build shall be allowed to operate or be used for any purposes within the jurisdiction of the municipality without first registering the said vessel with to appropriate government agency.

SECTION 5. Application. Application for registration shall be submitted and processed in the Municipal Agricultural Office. Application for Municipal Fishing Vessel Registration shall be in proper form and shall be filed under oath.

SECTION 6. Eligibility to Apply for Vessel Registration. Only Filipino citizens, single proprietorships, partnerships and/or corporations, duly registered or accredited fisherfolk associations, or cooperatives are eligible to apply for registration.

SECTION 7. Requirements. An applicant for fishing vessel registration shall submit the following requirements for evaluation by the Municipal Agricultural Office;

1. Duly accomplished registration form
2. Barangay clearance
3. Community Tax Certificate
4. PNP-Maritime Group clearance
5. Payment of registration fee

SECTION 8. Issuance of Certificate of Number. After all the documentary requirements are fully complied with and upon payment of the prescribed registration fee, the municipality shall issue the applicant a Certificate of Number. The certificate of number shall indicate the official serial

number of the boat and its official name and shall serve as proof of ownership of the boat.

SECTION 9. Deletion and Cancellation of Fishing Vessel Registration. The fishing vessel registration shall be deleted or canceled under the following circumstances:

- a. Loss or decay of fishing vessel;
- b. Transfer of municipal area of operation of the fishing vessel; and,
- c. Such other lawful causes.

Under the foregoing circumstances, the owner/operator of the subject vessel shall immediately inform the municipality.

SECTION 10. Renewal of Vessel's Registration. Registration of fishing vessels registered to this municipality is subject to renewal every year. Application for registration shall be submitted and processed in the Municipal Agriculture Office (MAO) not later than the last working of February every year. Application for renewal of vessel's registration shall present MAO the copy of the Certificate of Number of the vessel for assessment prior to the payment of the appropriate renewal fee. Failure to renew the vessel's registration on the prescribed deadline shall subject the owner/operator of the said vessel to pay a penalty of 25% of the renewal fee.

SECTION 11. Registration Fees. The following are the registration fees based on different categories of the fishing vessel:


1. Fees for Initial Registration/Issuance of New CN/Re-issuance of CN:
 - a. Motorized vessel ₱200.00
 - b. non-motorized vessel 100.00
2. Renewal of Registration:
 - a. Motorized vessel 100.00
 - b. non-motorized vessel 50.00

SECTION 12. Penalty. Any person caught operating an unregistered fishing vessel within the jurisdiction of the municipality in violation of this ordinance shall be fined:


- First Offense – ₱500.00
- Second Offense - ₱1,000.00
- Third and succeeding offense - ₱2,500.00

SECTION 13. Implementation. The Philippine National Police (PNP), Maritime Command (MARICOM), Philippine Coast Guard (PCG), Fishery Law Enforcers/deputized fish wardens, and all other law enforcement agents authorized by existing laws to enforce fishery law, rules, and other regulations are hereby empowered to enforce this ordinance.



SECTION 15. Separability Clause. If for any reason, any part of this ordinance is held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 16. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after posting in conspicuous places within the Municipality.

GUIDELINES FOR THE REGISTRATION OF FISHING VESSELS THREE (3) GROSS TONNAGE AND BELOW IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TABANGO, PROVINCE OF LEYTE.

- **Section 2. Scope.** The ordinance shall apply to all fishing vessels three (3) gross tonnage and below owned or operated by the resident of this Municipality or its principal office of the operator is located herein.
- **Section 3. Definition of Terms.** As used in this Ordinance, the following terms are defined as follows.
 - Naa mn mo copy dli lang ni nako basahon wala ba mo ikadugang or usbon? Wala.
- **Section 4. Registration of Fishing Boats.** No Fishing boat three (3) gross tons or below, shall be allowed to be licensed or be issued with a fishing boat license without first registering the said fishing boat to the municipality or allowing transient fisherfolk with an appropriate fishing permit to operate within the jurisdiction of the municipality to fish using an unregistered fishing boat. Likewise, no vessel of any size or build shall be allowed to operate or be used for any purposes within jurisdiction of the municipality without first registering the said vessel with to appropriate government agency.
- **Section 5. Application.** Application for registration shall be submitted and processed in the municipality Agricultural office . Application for the Municipal Fishing Vessel Registration shall be in proper form and shall be filled under oath.
- **Section 6. Eligibility to Apply for Vessel Registration.** Only Filipino Citizens, single proprietorship, partnerships and / or corporations, duly registered or accredited fisherfolk associations, or cooperatives are eligible to apply for registration.
- **Section 7. Requirements.** An applicant for fishing vessel registration shall submit the following requirements for evaluation by the Municipal Agricultural Office;
 - 1. Duly accomplished registration form
 - 2. Barangay Clearance
 - 3. Community Tax Certificate
 - 4. PNP- Maritime Group clearance or local PNP (if the former is not available)
 - 5. Payment of registration fee
- **Section 8. Issuance of Certificate of Number.** After all, the documentary requirements are fully complied with and upon payment of the prescribed registration fee, the municipality shall issue to the applicant a certificate of number. The certificate of number shall indicate the official serial number of the boat and its official name and shall serve as proof of ownership[of the boat.

- **Section 9. Deletion and Cancellation of Fishing Vessel Registration.** The fishing vessel registration shall be deleted or cancelled under the following circumstances:
 - A. Loss od decay of fishing vessel;
 - B. Transfer of municipal area of operation of the fishing vessel; and
 - C. Such other lawful causes.

Under the foregoing circumstances, the owner/operator of the subject vessel shall immediately inform the municipality.

 - 1. Fees for Initial Registration/Issuance of New CN/Re-issuance CN

 - A. Motorized vessel 300
 - B. Non-motorized vessel 150

- **Section 12. Penalty.** Any person caught operating an unregistered fishing vessel with in the jurisdiction of the municipality in violation of this ordinance shall be fined not more that Php 2,500.00.

- **Section 15. Separability Clause.** If for any reason, any part of this ordinance is held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

- **Section 16. Effectivity.** This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after posting in conspicuous places within the Municipality.


