

 Ordinance No. 11, S-2024 entitled: "An Ordinance Establishing the Framework for the Transfer of Operation, Development, Management and Maintenance of the Port of Baybay City from Philippine Ports Authority to LGU- Baybay City, Creating its Office and Plantilla Positions and Appropriating Funds Therefore and for Other Purposes.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE FRAMEWORK FOR TRANSFER OF OPERATION, DEVELOPMENT, MANAGEMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PORT OF BAYBAY CITY FROM PHILIPPINE PORTS AUTHORITY TO LGU-BAYBAY CITY, CREATING ITS OFFICE POSITIONS AND **APPROPRIATING** AND PLANTILLA **FUNDS** THEREFORE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act (RA) No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides "Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom x  $\dot{x}$   $\dot{x}$  and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare."

WHEREAS, Section 17 of Republic Act 7160 also provides "(a) Local government units shall endeavor to be self-reliant and shall continue exercising the powers and discharging the duties and functions currently vested upon them  $x \times x$  Local government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provision of the basic services and facilities enumerated herein such as  $x \times x$  (a) (4) (i) Adequate communication and transportation facilities,"

WHEREAS, one of the powers of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of a component city as stated in Section 458 (a.), (5) (iii) of the Local Government Code and Section 11, par. (a), (5), (iii) of RA 9389 (Charter of the City of Baybay) are as follows "Authorize the establishment, maintenance and operation by the city government of wharves, and other structures intended to accelerate productivity related to marine and seashore or offshore activities,"

WHEREAS, on several occasions the Philippine Ports Authority (PPA) and the LGU-Baybay City have discussed the transfer of

management, operation, development, and maintenance of the Port of Baybay City from PPA to LGU-Baybay and had in fact agreed in principle the terms and conditions of the transfer;

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2024, the Philippine Ports Authority (PPA) Governing Board issued Resolution No. 3302 granting the request of the City Government of Baybay to manage, operate, develop and maintain the port of Baybay City;

WHEREAS, in the month of August 2024, the Philippine Ports Authority conducted a month training to selected personnel from LGU-Baybay on the various functions of the port in transition to LGU-Baybay's operation, management, development, and maintenance of the port;

WHEREAS, the yearly budgetary requirements for personal services, maintenance and other operating expenditures and capital outlay of the "Port of Baybay City" under the management, operation and maintenance of LGU-Baybay shall be sourced from its share in the national wealth (formerly IRA) and other income from LGU-Baybay subject to Section 76 of R.A. 7160.

WHEREAS, Sec. 76 of R.A. 7160 provides that "Every LGU shall design and implement its own organizational structure and staffing pattern taking into consideration its service requirements and financial capability, subject to the minimum standards and guidelines prescribed by the Civil Service Commission".

WHEREAS, LGU-Baybay has already allocated the amount of P3M from its Second Supplemental Budget for the year 2024 passed and approved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod on September 5, 2024 for its operation in the remaining months of the fiscal year 2024;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED, BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD, IN SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. **CREATION AND OFFICIAL NAME** -The port of Baybay shall be officially named for purposes of this Ordinance the "**Port of Baybay City**".

There is hereby created the Office of the Port of Baybay City officially named the **Baybay City Port Office (BCPO)** under the control, operation, maintenance and management of the Local Government Unit of Baybay City.


SECTION 2. **INITIAL APPROPRIATIONS** –The sum of **THREE MILLION PESOS (P3,000,000.00)** is hereby appropriated for the continuous operation, management and maintenance of Port of Baybay City for the remaining months of the year 2024;

SECTION 3. STAFFING PATTERN AND ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE -In order that the aforesaid Port of Baybay City may effectively discharge its powers and functions and provide adequate delivery of port services as mandated by this Ordinance, the

The duties and responsibilities of the aforesaid employees are those defined in the policy guidelines of the PPA.

SECTION 4. ADOPTION OF POLICY GUIDELINES - The LGUadopts the policy guidelines of the Philippine Authority as embodied in the existing Port Rules and Regulations incorporated in the Administrative Orders and other issuances by PPA and the Memorandum of Agreement which the Philippine Ports and LGU-Baybay City may hereinafter enter However, LGU-Baybay may, upon assumption and from time to time formulate its own policies, rules, regulations, and guidelines to effectively and efficiently manage the port and increase its financial capability subject to the approval of the PPA and in accordance with existing laws.

#### SECTION 5. TRANSITORY PROVISIONS

- a. All existing fees and charges collected by the Philippine Ports Authority from the passengers, shipping lines and stevedoring and all other entities transacting business with PPA shall be collected by LGU-Baybay in the same amount unless it is increased or decreased thru city ordinance and ratified or approved by PPA;
- b. LGU-Baybay shall use its official receipt in all its collections until such time that "cash tickets" are procured from the provincial government;
- c. LGU-Baybay shall honor the existing contract of PPA and LIPSI, the stevedoring operating at the Port of Baybay City until December 31, 2024;
- d. This Ordinance is enforceable only upon the execution and sianina of the Memorandum of Agreement Philippine Ports Authority and LGU-Baybay City, transferring the operation, management, and maintenance of the Port of Baybay City from PPA to LGU-Baybay;
- e. The publication of this Ordinance and submission to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review shall be made only

after the Memorandum of Agreement is concluded by the PPA and LGU-Baybay;

SECTION 6. **SEPARABILITY CLAUSE-** If for any reasons, any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining parts thereof not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. **REPEALING CLAUSE-** All Ordinances, Resolutions, Executive Orders, Memoranda and Administrative Regulations or part thereof issued by LGU-Baybay which are in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are thereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. **EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE**- This Ordinance shall take effect upon due compliance with all the requirements as provided for under R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.












SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD BULLETIN BOARD
