186	I would like to open the floor for corrections from the Body if they have regarding the
187	Provincial Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Reconstituting Expanding the Provincial Health
188	Board and the Creation and Strengthening of Its Support Unit, and for other purposes." Like
189	what I mentioned during the first reading that it is in the Local Government Code of 1991 that
190	there should be an established Local Health Board in the Province, City and Municipality
191	following the composition and performing the functions provided by law.
192	Is there any question from the floor?
193	HON. TRINIDAD G. APOSTOL: 2 <sup>ND</sup> DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER
194	Mr. Chair, I have a question. Can I be recognized?
195	HON. MICHAEL L. CARI: TEMP. PRESIDING OFFICER/5 <sup>TH</sup> DIST. BOARD MEMBER
196	Yes, Honorable Apostol, you are recognized.
197	HON. TRINIDAD G. APOSTOL: 2 <sup>ND</sup> DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER
198	I have some questions here regarding the function of the Provincial Health Board. For
199	number 1, it says here "Propose to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, following the standard

and criteria set by the DOH, annual budgetary allocation for the operation and maintenance

- of health facilities and services with the province". Now, for my knowledge and for clarification, I would like to ask the Chairman how much is the allocation for the health services in the Province of Leyte as per the Annual Budget because this is an additional budget that you are asking.

- This is not, actually, an additional budget. This is already part of the Annual Budget of
  the Provincial Health Office given that the Local Health Board is needed as the Advisory
  Committee as far as the functioning of the Universal Health Care is concerned. It is not an
  additional funding but it is already a part of the funding in the Provincial Health Board.

- But Honorable Villasin, what I am asking is how much is the allocation for health services coming from the Province of Leyte.

- At the moment, I don't have that but let me check as far as the Annual Budget is concerned.

  my knowledge, because I'm very curious, what is this Special Health Fund? Is this coming
  from the National? Or coming from the Province?

## 230 HON, RAISSA J. VILLASIN: 2<sup>ND</sup> DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

Mr. Chair, this is actually coming from the National. It is Special Health Fund coming from PHILHEALTH. However, at this particular point, the guidelines are not yet clear as far as the usage and the downloading of the Special Health Fund is concerned. That will be part of the function of the Provincial Health Board to make sure Special Health Fund will be utilized as far as the health services of the province is concerned. That is also one of the reason why the Provincial Health Board is necessary so that they will be the ones to determine how the Special Health Fund will be totally utilized. But as of this moment, the Special Health Fund will be coming from the National Government. However, the guidelines is still being threshed-out by the PHILHEALTH, DOH, and all other Local Government Units. Although, from the last session, a resolution has been granted to give authority to Governor Jericho Icot Petilla and also to our treasurer in order for them to open a Special Health Fund with a specific bank.

- the guidelines are not yet clear as far as the usage and the downloading of the Special
- Health Fund is concerned. And the function of the Local Health Board is based on Section
- 102 (b) of the Local Government Code of 1991.

- 274 participation of the different LGU's. Our province is included because Governor Jericho Icot
- 275 Petilla wants to make sure that we totally understand how the allocation of the Special Health
- Fund will be utilized as far the different LGU is concerned. There are still no guidelines as far
- the Special Health Fund is concerned as of this moment.

- Mr. Chairman, I think we should know exactly how much is the Special Health fund
- 280 allocated for the Province of Leyte.

- 286 May I share something with regards to the concern of the Honorable Apostol. I heard
- in one of the meetings with the good Governor with the PHILHEALTH that the PHILHEALTH

is planning to download all the PHILHEALTH reimbursement to the LGU's. So kun meada mga hospitals na requesting for reimbursement, it is now the LGU who will pay the Hospitals instead of PHILHEALTH directly. It is the long term plan of the PHILHEALTH. That is maybe one reason why there is a Special Health Fund being created by the Local Government Unit. Kay yana kun meada kita PHILHEALTH refund, PHILHEALTH it na release but in the future, kun ma iron out na ini na rules and guidelines, it is now the LGU an mabayad han PHILHEALTH reimbursment to the different hospitals and the funding will depend of course to the population of a certain LGU. For the Province of Leyte, kay duru dako man kita, we might get a bigger share of funds coming from the PHILHEALTH. So that is the idea, Mr. Chair.

Mr. Chair, in additon, amo iton gin threthresed out yana kay diri pa sure iton DOH and PHILHEALTH if they're going to download it upfront or by case or by population. So amo pa iton it diri klaro. That's the reason why that there's still no clear guidelines as of the moment. An that's the reason why since the funds will be downloaded to the LGUs, the Provincial Health Board will be the one to look into the usage and proper reimbursement and distribution and utilization of the Special Health Fund.

HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

The Vice President of PHILHEALTH and the Undersecretary of DOH was here during the meeting for the Universal Health Care Law. What was discussed was that the usual practice was that in our hospitals, claims for PHILHEALTH are received, processed and reimbursed it with PHILHEALTH National. But under the Universal Health Care Law, PHILHEALTH will advance projected claims on the different provinces. That the idea. During the discussion, Governor Jericho Icot Petilla was questioning with a population of 100 million plus Filipinos, if all will claim, for instance with a medical bill of Two Thousand, it is way beyond the budget of PHILHEALTH and DOH, combined together. So that's the question now, can everybody claim or only the indigents? That's one of those being threshed out. The money advanced for claims against PHILHEALTH will be downloaded already proportionate to the population and usual claims against PHILHEALTH. And also there is another fund also for Hospital Enhancement Fund. Now, if I may Mr. Chair, I have a question to the proponent. Mr. Chair, the Ordinance says "An Ordinance expanding the composition of the Provincial Health Board." The Provincial Health Board is created pursuant to RA 7160 or the Local Government Code. May we know in what sense the composition of the Board has been expanded under this proposed ordinance?

## HON. RAISSA J. VILLASIN: 2<sup>ND</sup> DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

In this proposed ordinance, it is in the inclusion of the member as an additional member of the Provincial Health Board is the representative or the President of the League of the Municipalities of the Philippines. In our case, it is the President of LMP Leyte Chapter which is Mayor Remedios "Matin" Petilla. That is basically the addition to it. Also, the representative from Ad Hoc Committee and from Indigenous Cultural Communities. It's just a small expansion because the previous composition did not include representatives from the different cities and municipalities within the province.

Mr. Chair, will you please allow the representative from the Provincial Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit of the Provincial Health Office to make the presentation, Ms. Kimberly Pearl Alvero? Kay daghang na dengue na, so we're just checking kung how prevalent dengue is already, Mr. Chair. Kay kung more than 80% na calamity naman, di ba?

MS. KIMBERLY PEARL ALVERO: PHO, DISEASE SURVEILLANCE OFFICER

Good Morning Honorable Board Members. I am Kimberly Pearl Alvero, Disease Surveillance Officer from the Provincial Health Office.

(PRESENTATION on DENGUE UPDATE OF THE PROVINCE OF LEYTE)

HON, VINCENT L. RAMA: 4<sup>TH</sup> DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

771 Mr. Presiding Officer, if I may?

HON, CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5<sup>TH</sup> DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

The Honorable Rama, Mr. Chair.

774 HON, MICHAEL L. CARI: TEMP, PRESIDING OFFICER/5TH DIST, BOARD MEMBER

The Honorable Rama is recognized.

HON. VINCENT L. RAMA: 4TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

On the part of this dengue situation, what I have noticed in the three (3) hospitals that we have, the Ormoc District Hospital and the three (3) private hospitals in Ormoc, the situation is like this: when a parent feels like their child has dengue they automatically take them to the hospital. And from what I know, when you mentioned anti body, 'di ba, i, from what I learned is that it would take seven-two (72) hours in order for a person to be determined if they have dengue after test. What's happening now is parents take them to the hospital or people suspicious of having dengue, they go straight to the hospital. That is why, all the hospitals especially the Ormoc District Hospital are overwhelmed because of that. I was wondering if we have a program on teaching them how to go about it. It's understood that you are paranoid already. But what's happening in the hospital as recorded, most of them di pala dengue. Pupunta kasi, they think its dengue and then supposedly the hospital would want to receive them after it's really officially dengue. It's not that really bad dengue, but first ano pa lang. But what's happening now, they go straight to the hospital that's why

most of the hospitals overwhelmed in Ormoc. As a matter of fact, this week is still full right
now of cases supposedly they're three (3) days after, but they're there na. So, what's
happening is they're three days before and they extend another five days. All rooms are
already occupied.

My question is, I know it's not easy, but is there a program wherein we can teach the community, if you encounter fever, how could you convince him that not to assume that it's dengue automatically?

That's layman's question, kasi hindi tayo doctor.

MR. NARCISO RAGRAG: PHO, DENGUE COORDINATOR

Actually, for those patients who have fever, joint pains, muscle pains, or skin rashes but without warning signs, they can be treated at Rural Health Unit (RHU) level. But for those patients with warning signs, like abdominal pains, mucosal bleedings, they should be referred to hospitals.

HON. VINCENT L. RAMA: 4<sup>TH</sup> DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

E, kasi paranoid na lahat, e. Deretso na lahat sa hospital so na overwhelmed ang hospital. Tapos na.

Yes, I have a question. With the cases now, we have 2,741 cases as recorded from January to August 17, 2024, may I ask you people, what is your office doing now with the outbreak of this dengue? Are you educating our people in the barangay for any prevention that should be given to their families? *Kailangan ang prevention nito*, e. What we need is prevention, fumigation. You have to coordinate with the LGUs to fumigate all the areas susceptible for the said mosquitoes-dengue carrier. So, what is now the work of your office with this outbreak of dengue, with 2,000 plus cases from January to August 17?

MR. NARCISO RAGRAG: PHO, DENGUE COORDINATOR

819	Yes, ma'am. Right now, we have an ongoing health education to all barangays
820	through the Rural Health Unit. Actually, we are inviting some municipalities to attend their
821	ABC Meeting. We have schedule. Tomorrow, we are attending the ABC Meeting at Isabel,
822	then September 3 in Carigara and we are waiting for other municipalities for their schedule.
823	And we are also inviting the Barangay Health Workers (BHW).
824	We can control dengue if there's a community effort. We cannot eliminate the dengue
825	cases if there's no cooperation of the community. If only the barangay officials will work.
826	HON. TRINIDAD G. APOSTOL: 2 <sup>ND</sup> DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER
827	Yes. You have to coordinate with the barangay officials like for example, in the case of
828	Hilongos, they have the most numbers of dengue cases. So, at least, you have to coordinate

with the Local Government officials to educate our people to prevent this dengue mosquitoes

to prosper. Lalo na etong mga stagnant water, doon nag aano 'yung mga dengue

mosquitoes. What is important is to educate our people for the prevention of this dengue.

May we know dengue thrives from the mosquitoes, 'no, mga vectors from stagnant water, 'di ba? Malaria is the same, 'no? What's the difference between malaria and dengue?

MR. NARCISO RAGRAG: PHO, DENGUE COORDINATOR

Yes, they are vectors. The vector of the dengue is aedis egypti, while the malaria is the anophylus mosquito.

HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

Okay. So, do we have presence of malaria in Leyte or Region 8? Wala 'no?

MR. NARCISO RAGRAG: PHO, DENGUE COORDINATOR

Wala. But we have the vector. Usually, our malaria cases are imported.

858	Yes, the Honorable Gimenez.

860	I'd like just to ask Kananga has declared an outbreak, so what is the threshold that we
861	are looking at in order to declare a provincial-wide outbreak?
862	MS. KIMBERLY PEARL A. ALVERO: PHO, DISEASE SURVEILLANCE OFFICER
863	So, we got the threshold from the weekly average cases compared to the past five
864	years cases, po.
865	HON. MA. MARTINA L. GIMENEZ: PROVL LIGA NG MGA BARANGAY PRESIDENT
866	So, where are we as far as the provincial number is concerned?
867	MS. KIMBERLY PEARL A. ALVERO: PHO, DISEASE SURVEILLANCE OFFICER
868	If we compare our as you can see in the graph, Honorable Gimenez, we are above
869	of the epidemic threshold especially from weeks 28 to 33 which you got 100 to 300 hundred
870	cases per week.
871	HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER
872	Can we go to the next page? Yes, that's the picture, 'no. That's clearly an epidemic.
873	It's red.
874	May we know from the presentors if you are recommending that we declare a state of
875	calamity or a state of epidemic?

877	HON	WILSON	S. UY:	1ST	DISTRICT	<b>BOARD</b>	MEMBER

Mr. Chair, before you answer the question of Honorable Loreto, mayda la ako paki ana. My understanding is before any declaration of state of calamity dapat mayda three or four Local Government Units in the Province of Leyte na mag declare before the province can ... amo ba eto or just a number of cases?

## MS. KIMBERLY PEARL A. ALVERO: PHO, DISEASE SURVEILLANCE OFFICER

There are no actually guidelines on how many percent of municipalities that will declare for us to declare. But as for the Department of Health, if there are two to four municipalities to declare, we can declare for an outbreak. But we can also see the other municipalities before pa we declare because there are municipalities that don't have cases. So, as per our Provincial Health Officer, he wants to have a granular outbreak or specific maybe per district or inter local health zone outbreak before the declaration of the whole province outbreak.

- 899 In Baybay?
- 900 MS, KIMBERLY PEARL A. ALVERO: PHO, DISEASE SURVEILLANCE OFFICER
- In Baybay, no. We have one (1) in Hilongos, one (1) in Merida and one (1) in Isabel.
- 902 HON, CARMEN L. CARI: PCL FEDERATION PRESIDENT
- So, it's only three (3). Do you have any fogging operation in this western part of
  Leyte? Because we noticed that in that map most of the dengue cases are located in the
  western part, Baybay down to Ormoc.

906	What do you think is the reason that most of the cases are in the western part, while
907	Leyte have the same atmosphere?
908	MR. NARCISO RAGRAG: PHO, DENGUE COORDINATOR
909	It's because of Cebu City. It is the transport area, the gateway going to Leyte. There
910	are many cases in Cebu.
911	HON. MA. MARTINA L. GIMENEZ: EX-OFFICIO MEMBER, LIGA NG MGA BARANGAY PRESIDENT
912	Mr. Chair, if I may?
913	HON. MICHAEL L. CARI: TEMP. PRESIDING OFFICER/5TH DIST BOARD MEMBER
914	Yes, Honorable Gimenez, go ahead.
915	HON. MA. MARTINA L. GIMENEZ: EX-OFFICIO MEMBER, LIGA NG MGA BARANGAY PRESIDENT
916	You mentioned a while ago that you've been talking with the ABC's in all the towns or
917	how many towns have you gone to? Because what I know is just last week, they were
918	ordered by DILG to conduct a Barangay Weekly Clean Up Drive. Now, this particular week,
919	we were asked to do the search and destroy. Are you also in contact with DILG because that
920	was the instruction from the DILG for this week's Clean Up Drive? That was my number 1
921	question. Number 2, the mentioned fogging a while ago, what I know based on experience,
922	fogging does not work. You fog here and they will just transfer to another place. And then
923	number 3, if it is really an emergency case, maybe we can have a meeting with all the
924	Municipal Liga Presidents to help in handling this. I think the key people that should spear
925	head in the town should be the Mayors. So that's it. Thank you.
926	MS. KIMBERLY PEARL A. ALVERO: PHO, DISEASE SURVEILLANCE OFFICER
927	As for DILG, we already coordinated with them to include in their Kalinisan Program or
928	the Clean Up Drive to focus on the Search and Destroy.
929	MR. NARCISO RAGRAG: PHO, DENGUE COORDINATOR
930	As for the fogging, it was started last June.
931	HON. MA. MARTINA L. GIMENEZ: EX-OFFICIO MEMBER, LIGA NG MGA BARANGAY PRESIDENT
932	What I'm saying is although I agree with the fogging, it is a temporary solution to the
933	problem because even Dr. Flores used to tell us before na pag nag fogging ka, it just
934	transfers

#### ADAM ALBESA: PHO, SANITATION OFFICER

Actually Ma'am, it is on the method on how the fogging is conducted because some of the method is just horizontal. They just follow the trend. Actually, the dynamics of these mosquitoes is that they try to transfer. If the method is spherical, all the mosquitoes there will be destroyed especially if we are following the down-wind and the up-wind method. It is when the fogging is blown toward the houses where in the Aegis Egyptis is destroyed. Actually, this is not dangerous because the chemical that are being used is systemic. Actually, there are many explanation but based on my experience of 26 years in service for fogging operation, never have I been told that it is not effective. We come to know that it is really effective.

It is the very best that we could do because we are only 3 units. In PHO we only have 13 coordinators and the 3 of us is in the Control. Actually we are trying the best that we could with all our available resources.

Yes, Honorable Rama, you were raising your hand?

May I ask, what is the advantage of declaring a State of Calamity on Dengue? Would it give us more funds from Manila? What are the advantages?

965	If we will declare State of Calamity, I believe we are given 20% of 5% of the budget of
966	the Province. That is what we know. Actually we are trying to recommend to the
967	Municipalities to declare an outbreak and the Sangguniang Bayan to declare a State of
968	Calamity but for the Province of Leyte, we are trying to look into the eyes of our boss, Dr.
969	Flores. Sabi nya granular kasi hindi naman ubos lahat based on the picture. But we would
970	like to recommend that the whole Western Portion of Leyte should declare a State of
971	Calamity. Kasi ito na ang problema naming ngayun kasi malayo kami from Palo and we are
972	going there daily.

974	Mr. Chair, I have a question.
975	HON. MICHAEL L. CARI: TEMP. PRESIDING OFFICER/5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER
976	Go ahead, Honorable Floor Leader.
977	HON, CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER
978	For clarification, those screens you mentioned have chemicals, right? So when
979	mosquitoes lands on them, they die. Are you implementing this in schools?
980	ADAM ALBESA: PHO, SANITATION OFFICER
981	We are trying to give them to schools but our school nurses have not yet withdrawn
982	the supply from the Provincial Health Office.
983	HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5 <sup>TH</sup> DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER
984	How many of these screens rolls do you have at hand?
985	ADAM ALBESA: PHO, SANITATION OFFICER
986	We have about 700.
987	HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER
988	So how long is it effective?
989	ADAM ALBESA: PHO, SANITATION OFFICER
990	Only for 6 months. You just have to remove it, wash it and they impregnate it again.
991	HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

Is it safe for children in case they touch it?

993	ADAM ALBESA: PHO, SANITATION OFFICER
994	Yes, it is very safe. It is systemic and only bad for flies and mosquitoes.

1000	Here at the map, Baybay City is fully at Red. What are you doing regarding this
1001	problem? Are you helping Baybay City by any way?

1003	Yes, Very much Ma'am. We were there just last July 30, 2024. While we were
1004	conducting the Zero Defecation Program, we were also conducting the Control Operation sa

1008	I would like to ask for clarification. It is true that Dengue Mosquitoes are low flying? I
1009	heard about that.

1011	Yes. Actually you will never find Dengue Mosquitoes that could level a Banana Tree.
1012	HON. TRINIDAD G. APOSTOL: 2 <sup>ND</sup> DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER
1013	Mr. Chair, can I be recognized?
