

CITY ORDINANCE NO. 12, S-2024 34th Regular Session



AN ORDINANCE, EXPRESSLY REPEALING BAYBAY CITY ORDINANCE NO. 5, SERIES OF 2019, PROHIBITING, DISALLOWING MOTORCYCLE DRIVERS AND BACKRIDERS, THE USE & WEARING OF HELMETS, BONNETS AND MASKS TO COVER AND HIDE THE FACE AND IDENTITIES..."

> Introduced by Hon. Dominic Junie F. Murillo and the SP Committee of Peace & Order and Public Safety

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 5, Series of 2019, Section 1, which the use and wearing of helmets within the Proper/Poblacion was enacted to address the sudden surge of criminalities perpetrated by "helmet-wearing" motorcycle riding-in-tandem" personalities committed within the poblacion proper of the city of Baybay;

WHEREAS, the evil sought to be avoided in City Ordinance No. 5, Series of 2019, is already contained or lessened with the increase number of police personnel assigned in the city of Baybay coupled with the installations of multiple CCTV cameras in all strategic areas in the entire poblacion including all exit roads and alleys, hence the need to repel said ordinance.

WHEREAS, a significant number of accidents involving head injuries in the City of Baybay were duly reported and recorded due to the not wearing of a prescribed helmet and is imperative upon the local government unit through the Local Sangguniang Panlungsod to adopt measures to effectively and efficiently carry out primary duties to its citizenry;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10054, which was signed into law on March 23, 2010, entitled, "AN ACT MANDATING ALL motorcycle drivers TO WEAR STANDARD PROTECTIVE MOTORCYCLE HELMETS WHILE DRIVING AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREFOR":

WHEREAS, the said RA 10054 aims to safeguard the general public, particularly the operators or drivers of motorcycles and their passengers, from the head injuries that are life threatening accidents;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE 6TH SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF BAYBAY CITY, IN ITS 34TH REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED THAT;

Section 1. Title - AN ORDINANCE, EXPRESSLY REPEALING BAYBAY CITY ORDINANCE 2019, NO. 5, SERIES OF DISALLOWING MOTORCYCLE DRIVERS AND BACKRIDERS, THE USE

Section 2. Scope and Application - This ordinance shall apply to all motorcycle drivers, including drivers and passengers within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Baybay.

Section 3. Purpose - It is the intent of this ordinance give as reflected in the title to give.

Section 4. Separability Clause — If any provision, section or part of this ordinance is declared invalid, or suspended or revoked by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect the remaining provisions, sections or parts thereof, and shall remain valid and subsisting.

Section 5. Repealing Clause — All ordinances, local rules and regulations or part thereof in conflict with, or inconsistent with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 6. Effectivity — This Ordinance shall take effect upon due compliance with all the requirements as provided for under R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

### **ORDINANCE NO. 05, S. 2019**

"AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING, DISALLOWING AND BANNING THE USE AND WEARING OF HELMETS, BONNETS AND MASKS TO COVER AND HIDE THE FACE AND IDENTITIES OF PERSONS, MOTORCYCLE DRIVERS AND BACKRIDERS AND IMPOSING PENALTIES IN VIOLATION THEREOF."

(Sponsored by Honorable Atty. Ernesto M. Butawan)

#### PREFATORY STATEMENT

WHEREAS, one of the alarming issues affecting our City very recently are the incidents involving unknown assailants or motorcycle driving assailants, wherein the perpetrators were and used helmets, bonnets and masks to cover their identities in order to escape arrest from Police Authorities and authorized law enforcers and evade prosecution;

WHEREAS, the residents of the entire City of Baybay now greatly feared for their safety and security due to the continuous and uncontrolled assaults, threats and shooting incidents perpetuated by mask/bonnet-wearing assailants, motorcycle drivers and back riders, thereby significantly affecting the peace and order situation of this City;

WHEREAS, there were some cases related to physical assault by mask/bonnet-wearing assailants and drive-by shooting incidents which have remained unsolved due to lack of witnesses to identify the perpetrators and most likely, due to the tinted helmets, bonnets and masks worn by these criminals during the incident;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code empowers the Local Government Unit to draft and formulate measures, ways and means to ensure the well-being of the community, thus, the common interest shall be primordially attended;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Atty. Ernesto M. Butawan, and duly seconded by Honorable Edgardo R. Ompoy, Honorable Vicente Victor G. Veloso and Honorable Filemon F. Avila,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Baybay in session, on May 6, 2019, thus this ordinance, entitled;

"AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING, DISALLOWING AND BANNING THE USE AND WEARING OF HELMETS, BONNETS AND MASKS TO COVER AND HIDE THE FACE AND IDENTITIES OF PERSONS, MOTORCYCLE DRIVERS AND BACKRIDERS AND IMPOSING PENALTIES IN VIOLATION THEREOF."

Section 1. Prohibition Within the City Proper/Poblacion.

All motorcycle drivers and back riders are prohibited, disallowed and banned to wear helmets, bonnets and masks when driving within the city proper/poblacion of the City of Baybay.

Section 2. Medical Condition.

Drivers and back riders wearing and using masks and bonnets to prevent inhaling dusts because of medical condition must present a medical record/documents to justify their intention.

**Section 3.** Driving Outside City Proper/Poblacion.

When driving outside city proper/población the driver or his back-rider must immediately remove his/her helmet, bonnets or mask once the motorcycle is in complete stop whether the engine is still on or off;

places except in their respective nomes or private places, as a consequence hereor, the authorized law enforcers shall require the person to remove their mask, helmet or bonnet and present valid identification card for their identity to avoid apprehension and prosecution under this ordinance;

### Section 5. Checkpoints.

All motorcycle drivers and back riders must take off their helmets, bonnets or masks upon order of the law enforcements agencies manning the checkpoints.

- Section 6. Violation of any provision/s of this Ordinance shall suffer the following fines and penalties:
  - a. For motorcycle driver citation ticket plus fine of P500.00 and imprisonment of 15 days;
  - b. For non-driver and back rider violators an imprisonment of 15 days;
- **Section 7.** All traffic enforcers of the city and all Barangay Tanods in their respective barangays and the members of the Philippine National Police (PNP) and Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) shall enforce this Ordinance;

### Section 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared separable and if any provision shall be held invalid, or unconstitutional, the remaining portions hereof are not affected and shall remain valid and effective.

### Section 9. REPEALING CLAUSE.

All ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

### Section 10. EFFECTIVITY.

This Ordinance shall take effect 15 days after its publication and after due compliance with all the requirements provided for under R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.


