**RESOLVED** as it is **HEREBY RESOLVED**, to enact this ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND INSTITUTIONALIZING A DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE, MANDATING THE CONDUCT OF AUTHORIZED DRUG TESTING ANNUALLY IN ALL OFFICES OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF VILLABA, LEYTE INCLUDING THE OFFICES OF ITS THIRTY-FIVE (35) BARANGAY AS WELL AS PROVIDING SANCTIONS FOR VIOLATION AND FUNDS THEREOF.

#### **ARTICLE I**

## **General Principles and Policies**

**Section 1.** Short Title — This ordinance shall be known as "A Drug-Free Workplace Ordinance in the Local Government Unit of Villaba, Leyte."

**Section 2.** <u>Declaration of Policy</u> - The local government unit of Villaba recognizes the threat posed by drug abuse in the community and its ill effects in the workplace including among others inefficiency, decrease in productivity, increase accidents, absenteeism, lapses in the performance of assigned task, Criminality and the like and thereby declares the policy of the local government to absolutely prohibit the use of dangerous drugs in and outside the Workplaces by all its officials and employee's including workplaces on its thirty-five (35) barangays.

**Section 3.** Coverage. — This ordinance is geared towards ensuring and maintaining a safe, secure and healthy workplace free from the use of dangerous drugs and free from other related activities as prescribed by R.A 9156.

This ordinance shall be applicable to all public officials, elected or appointed, Regular, Casual, Job Order employees and other government employees regardless of his/her employment status including barangay officials and its personnel and shall cover all stages of employment.

Section 4. Definition of Terms - As used in this Ordinance the following terms shall be defined as follows:

- a. Workplace a Place where work is usually performed. For this purpose, it shall mean a11 the Offices of the local government und of Villaba including its thirtyfive (35) barangays.
- b. Unlawful Acts refer to any of the unlawful acts penalized under Article II of Republic Act 9165.
- c. Public Officials and Employees any Person holding any public office in the local government unit of Villaba, by virtue of an appointed, Or election.
- d. Contract of Service/job Order refers to employment covered by a contract Pertaining to lump sum work or services such as janitorial, Security, Or Consultancy Services where no employer-employee relationship exists; Piece of work or intermittent job of short duration not exceeding six (6) months on a daily basis; all of which are not covered by Civil Service law, rules and regulations, but covered by Commission on Audit rules; and the public officials or employees involved do not enjoy the benefits received by government employee's including, but not limited to, personal economic relief allowance, Cost of living allowance, and representation and travel allowance.
- e. Authorized Drug Testing the testing done by drug testing laboratories accredited by the Department of Health (DOH). It shall employ, among other, two (2) testing methods, the screen test, which will determine the positive result as well as the type of the drug used, and the confirmatory test, which will confirm a positive Screening test.
- f. Confirmatory Test an analytical test using a device, tool or equipment with a different chemical or physical principle that is more specific which will validate and confirm the result of the screening test.
- g. Dangerous Drugs include those listed in the Schedules annexed to the 1961 Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the 1 972 Protocol, and in the Schedules annexed to the 1 971 Single Convention on Psychotropic Substances as enumerated in the attached annex which is an integral part of Republic Act No. 91 65 or the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002, as amended.
- h. Drug Dependency Examination refers to the examination conducted by a Physician accredited by the DOH to evaluate the extent of drug use of a person and to determine whether he/she is a drug dependent or not, which includes history taking, intake interview, determination of criteria for drug dependency, mental and Physical status, and the detection of dangerous drugs in body specimens through laboratory procedures.

- i. **Mandatory Drug Testing** Compulsory Submission of a public officer or Prospective employee to drug testing as mandated by the Act or by the drug-free workplace program of the local government unit.
- j. Random Drug Testing drug testing where the selection process results in equal Probability that any employee from a group of employees' will be tested, and without any priors notice of the date and venue.
- k. Screening Test a rapid drug test performed to establish potential or presumptive Positive result. It refers to the immunoassay test to eliminate a "negative" specimen, i.e. one without the presence of dangerous drugs, Presumptive positive specimen that requires Confirmatory test.
- 1. Substance Use Disorder term used in Diagnostic Manual 5 which combines Categories of substance use, abuse and dependence into a single disorder measured on a Continuum form from mild to severe. Each specific substance is addressed as a separate disorder (e.g. alcohol use disorder, Shabu use disorder) and are diagnosed based on the same overarching eleven (11) behavioral criteria. Clinicians can also add "in early remission." in sustained remission," on maintenance therapy," and "in controlled environment" in describing their diagnosis which could either be the following:
  - 1. Mild SUD a minimum of two (2) to three (3) criteria has been met. Similar to experimental and occasional users.
  - 2. Moderate SUD four (4) or five (5) criteria met which would be similar to regular and habitual users; and
  - 3. Severe SUD if six (6) or more symptoms/criteria have been met which is about equivalent to an abuser and substance dependent individual.
  - m. Center any of the treatment and rehabilitation centers which undertake treatment, aftercare and follow-up treatment of drug dependents. it includes institutions, agencies and the like whose purposes are: the development of skills, arts and technical know-how, Counselling and/or inculcating civil, Social and moral values to drug dependent patients, with the aim of weaning them away from dangerous drugs and keeping them drugfree, adapted to their families and peers and re-adjusted into the community as law aiding, useful and productive citizens.
  - n. **Rehabilitation** a dynamic process including aftercare and fo1low-up treatment directed toward the physical, emotional/psychological, Vocational, Social and Spiritual change of a drug dependent to enable him/her to live without dangerous drugs, enjoy the fullest life compatible with his capabilities and potentials and render him/her able to become a law abiding and productive member of the Community.

- O. **Employee Assistance Program** a Program that aids the public Officials and employees' who have drug related or alcohol related issues and Problems that may affect work performance. It shall be jointly implemented by the local government unit, the officials and employees' and employees' union.
- P. "For Cause", or "Probable Cause" Drug Test drug testing required when there is a "probable cause" or "reasonable ground" to believe that a person is using Or is under the influence of dangerous drugs.
- q. **Act refers to R.A. 9165 -** otherwise known as "The Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of2002".
- r. National Agency refers to a unit of the National Government.

#### **ARTICLE III**

# Responsibility of the Official and Employees of the Local Government Unit of Villaba Including its thirty-five (35) Barangays

**Section 5.** Responsibilities - The following shall be the responsibilities of public officers pursuant to this Ordinance:

- a. Any public official or employee must never possess and/or use dangerous drugs and other substances of abuse;
- b. Any public official or employee must not directly or indirectly sell, give, provide or administer any dangerous drugs and/or other substance of abuse to his/her co-officials or employees or others and/or to commit or abet/aid in the commission of any unlawful acts penalized under R. A. 9165;
- C. The officials and employees must faithfully abide by this Ordinance as a condition for continued employment;
- d. officials and employees must voluntarily seek treatment and rehabilitation if they have problems related to dangerous drugs;
  - e. To advocate against drug abuse;
  - f. To help maintain a drug-free workplace.

#### **ARTICLE IV**

# **Guidelines in the Conduct of Authorized Drug Test**

**Section 6.** <u>Guidelines in the Conduct of Random Drug Testing.</u> – The following guidelines outline the purposes of the random drug testing program:

a. there shall be an annual mandatory random drug testing for all government officials either appointed or elected officials regardless of employment status.

- <sup>a</sup> b the random drug testing shall be implemented as a collaborative undertaking of the local government to include the barangay, its officials and employees.
  - b. Random drug testing shall be implemented primarily for a drug-free workplace.
- c. The drug testing program shall guarantee and respect the personal privacy and dignity of the officials and employees.
- Section 7. <u>Testing for "Probable Cause" or "Reasonable Ground"</u> In addition to the annual mandatory drug testing, those employees and officials who are found to have the following signs and symptoms shall be subjected to undergo special drug testing:
  - a. Attendance —frequent unauthorized absences, repeated tardiness, truancy from the job.
- b. Personal Appearance slurred speech, bloodshot eyes, drastic change in appearance, etc.
- c. Mental Factor hot-headedness, irritability, increased difficulty in handling assignments, etc.
- d. General Performance missed deadlines, low productivity, increased wastage, public complaints, frequent accidents, carelessness, etc.
- e. Peer Relation isolation, frequent quarrels with officemates, heavy borrowing, frequent mood swings, etc.

### **ARTICLE V**

#### **Sanctions**

**Section 8.** <u>Violations of Officials and Employees</u> - Any officer or employee found to have violated this Ordinance may suffer any or a combination of the following sanctions.

- a. An appointive public officer/employee who refuses, without valid reason, to Submit himself/herself to authorized drug testing or is found positive for drug use after the Conduct of a confirmatory test in an authorized drug testing activity and who refuses to undergo the recommended treatment and rehabilitation as provided in this Ordinance shall be charged with the administrative offense of grave misconduct.
- b. Any elective public officer who refuses, Without and valid reason, to Submit himself/herself to authorized drug testing or if found positive for drug use after the Conduct of a confirmatory test in an authorized drug testing activity shall undergo medical intervention or rehabilitation as recommended by the Municipal Health Officer. However, those who refuses to undergo the recommended treatment and rehabilitation as provided in this Ordinance shall be subject to disciplinary action for misconduct in office pursuant to Section 60 of the Local Government Code and Article 124 (3) of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Local Government Code.

- C. Any public officer found to have tampered the test result of a drug test, interfered with the conduct of the drug test or in the release of drug test results, or violated rules of confidentiality of records shall be charged with the administrative offense of grave misconduct without prejudice to the filling of a case for violation of Section, Article II of the Act,
- d. Officials or employees who for the second time have been detected to be using dangerous drugs after completion of his/her treatment and/or rehabilitation program or while undergoing treatment and/or rehabilitation shall be administratively Charged of the offense of grave misconduct without prejudice of the filing of Criminal charges as provided in the Act.
  - e. Officials or employees who are found arrested/apprehended or charge in court for Commission of any of the unlawful acts provided for under Article II of

Republic Act 9 165 shall be administratively charged of the offense of grave misconduct and without prejudice to further criminal prosecution.

## Section 9. Accreditation of Drug Testing Center.

- Only those drug testing center that are accredited and licensed by the Department of Health shall be allowed to conduct the mandatory drug testing.
- b. The official drug testing results from the accredited drug testing center shall only be considered for purposes of filing for administrative sanctions before to their respective grievance committee.

#### **ARTICLE VI**

#### Miscellaneous Provisions

**Section 10.** Funding. – The Cost of the drug testing for the Municipal and Barangay officials and employees shall be funded by the Local Government Unit of Villaba and shall form part of the annual budgetary appropriation. Likewise, the cost of Drug Testing of the officials and employees from other national agencies who are working in this municipality shall be shouldered by each respective offices.

**Section 11.** <u>Separability Clause</u>. – If any part of this Ordinance is declared not valid, unconstitutional or unlawful, such declaration shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections or parts thereof, which shall remain or continue to be in full force and effect.

**Section 12.** Repealing Clause. – All previous ordinances and provisions inconsistent with this Ordinance shall be deemed repealed or modified accordingly.

# Minutes of the Public Hearing of the Committee on Law Enforcement and Order

The public hearing, called by Hon. Niel Albert B. Inopiquez, author of the proposed ordinance, commenced at 10:00 AM after the invitees were present in the Sangguniang Bayan Session Hall, Administrative Building, New Municipal Compound. Attendees included Hon. Niel Albert Inopiquez, Hon. Roque M. Compra, Chairman of the Committee; Hon. Mark Esmas, LNB President; some members and officers of the LNB; HRMO; Mr. Teddy Vapor; and Municipal Health Officer Dr. Oliver Razo.

Hon. Inopiquez greeted everyone and explained that the purpose of the public hearing was to discuss the passage of the ordinance: "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND INSTITUTIONALIZING A DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE, MANDATING THE CONDUCT OF AUTHORIZED DRUG TESTING ANNUALLY IN ALL OFFICES OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF VILLABA, LEYTE, INCLUDING THE OFFICES OF ITS THIRTY-FIVE (35) BARANGAYS, AS WELL AS PROVIDING SANCTIONS FOR VIOLATORS AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS THEREOF." He presented the proposed ordinance and opened the floor for comments, suggestions, and inclusions to improve the ordinance.

Dr. Oliver Razo emphasized that if an individual is found positive for drug use, they should undergo medical intervention or rehabilitation as recommended by the Municipal Health Officer. Those who refuse the recommended treatment and rehabilitation shall be subject to disciplinary action. Mr. Teddy Vapor suggested that any appointive public officer or employee who refuses, without valid reason, to submit to authorized drug testing, or who is found positive for drug use after a confirmatory test and refuses the recommended treatment and rehabilitation as provided in this Ordinance, shall be charged with the administrative offense of grave misconduct. He also stated that the cost of drug testing for municipal and barangay officials and employees should be funded by the Local Government Unit of Villaba and form part of the annual budgetary appropriation. The cost of drug testing for officials and employees from other national agencies working in the municipality should be shouldered by their respective offices.

With no further concerns raised, the hearing adjourned at 2:45 PM.

# **COMMITTEE REPORT**

SUBJECT: AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND INSTITUTIONALIZING A DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE, MANDATING THE CONDUCT OF AUTHORIZED DRUG TESTING ANNUALLY IN ALL OFFICES OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF VILLABA, LEYTE INCLUDING THE OFFICES OF ITS THIRTY-FIVE (35) BARANGAY AS WELL AS PROVIDING SANCTIONS FOR VIOLATORS AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS THEREOF

#### FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Municipal Health Officer recommended that if an individual is found positive for drug use, they should undergo medical intervention or rehabilitation. Those who refuse the recommended treatment and rehabilitation shall be subject to disciplinary action. Any public officer or employee who refuses without valid reason, to submit authorized drug testing, or who is found positive for drug use after a confirmatory test and refuses the recommended treatment and rehabilitation as provided in this ordinance, shall be charged with the administrative offense of grave misconduct.
