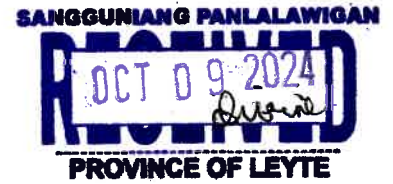

**JUSTIFICATION FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE MODIFIED
SALARY SCHEDULE IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE
FIRST TRANCHE OF THE ADJUSTED SALARY SCHEME
FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENT PERSONNEL**

We recognize that the primary objective behind the issuance of Executive Order No. 64 is to advance social justice, specifically ensuring the equitable distribution of benefits and compensation among government employees.

We also acknowledge the concern of the authors of LBC No. 160, dated August 12, 2024, in providing Local Government Units (LGUs) the opportunity to align their compensation with that of Civilian Government Personnel by permitting the full adoption of the Salary Schedule outlined in Section 3 of Executive Order No. 64.

For clarity, we respectfully quote Section 5.1 and its subsections 5.1.1, 5.1.2, and 5.1.3 of LBC No. 160 as follows:

5.1 The new salary rates shall be in accordance with the First Tranche Monthly Salary Schedule for Local Government Personnel, as presented in *Annexes A-1 to A-8*.

The Sanggunian may adopt any of the following options:

5.1.1 Fully adopt the Salary Schedule in Section 3 of EO No. 64 (Annex A-1 of this Circular), notwithstanding the ceilings provided under Section 4 thereof, subject to compliance with the PS limitation and budgetary authorization requirements of RA No. 7160;

5.1.2 Follow the percentage of the Salary Schedule corresponding to the LGU's current income classification;

5.1.3 If funds are insufficient to implement fully the salary schedule for the LGU level and income class, or for purposes of complying with the PS limitation, the Sanggunian may formulate a modified salary schedule with lower rates but at a uniform percentage of the rates in the applicable salary schedule in *Annexes A-1 to A-8* across all positions.

It is explicitly stated in Section 5.1 that the salary rates for LGU personnel shall follow the First Tranche Salary Schedule, as outlined in Annexes A-1 to A-8.

Section 5.1.1 permits LGUs to fully adopt the Salary Schedule in Section 3 of Executive Order No. 64 (Annex A-1), subject to specific conditions, particularly Personnel Services (PS) limitations.

This demonstrates the intent of the framers of LBC No. 160 to provide LGUs the opportunity to align their compensation with that of the national government, provided they adhere to PS limitations.

Moreover, the framers showed considerable flexibility by further allowing LGUs to increase their compensation notwithstanding the built-in PS limitations, by granting the Sanggunian the authority to adopt a Modified Salary Schedule for compliance with these limitations.

Sec. 5.1.3 states that if funds are insufficient to implement fully the salary schedule for the LGU level and income class, or for purposes of complying with the PS limitation, the Sanggunian may formulate a modified salary schedule with lower rates but at a uniform percentage of the rates in the applicable salary schedule in Annexes A-1 to A-8 across all positions.

Allow us to rephrase Sec. 5.1.3 for a clearer interpretation, hence...

"The Sanggunian may establish a Modified Salary Schedule with reduced rates, applying a uniform percentage adjustment to the rates in the applicable Salary Schedule found in Annexes A-1 to A-8 across all positions, under the following circumstances:

- 1. If available funds are insufficient to fully implement the salary schedule for the LGU level and income class.*
- 2. For the purpose of complying with Personnel Services (PS) limitations."*

We can now confidently conclude that the two instances where the Sanggunian may formulate a Modified Salary Schedule are outlined in Nos. 1 and 2.

Given that our LGU, a 5th class municipality, is financially capable of fully adopting the Salary Schedule in Section 3 of EO 64, but would exceed the Personnel Services (PS) Cap if we fully implement the First Tranche Updated Salary Schedule in Section 3 of EO 64, our LGU, through the Sanggunian Bayan, exercised the authority granted under Section 5 of LBC No. 160, specifically Section 5.1.3, by enacting Municipal Ordinance No. 2024-08, dated September 02, 2024, an Ordinance Adopting a Modified Salary Schedule by Adopting a Seventy-Five Percent (75%) of the Authorized Salary Schedule for National Government Agencies (NGAs) as Prescribed in Section 3 and Authorized in Section 4 of Executive Order No. 64, Dated August 02, 2024 Entitled, "Updating the Salary Schedule for Civilian

Government Personnel and Authorizing the Grant of an Additional Allowance and for Other Purposes” Intended for Non-Public Health Workers and Further Adopts the Salary Rates Authorized for Personnel of Special Cities/ First Class Provinces and Cities (Annex A-1 LBS 160 Dated August 12, 2024) for Public Health Workers (PHW) of the Rural Health Unit of this Local Government Unit.

This justifies our decision to adopt the Modified Salary Schedule.

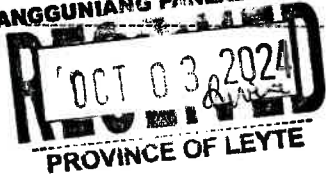

Respectfully returned to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte, through SP Secretary, the attached Ordinance No. 2024-08 of the Sangguniang Bayan of Julita, Leyte.

Issues/concerns for review/recommendation/legal opinion is/are as follows:

- Ordinance No. 2024-08 entitled: **“An Ordinance Adopting a Modified Salary Schedule by Adopting a Seventy-Five Percent (75%) of the Authorized Salary Schedule for National Government Agencies (NGA’s) as Prescribed in Section 3 and Authorized in Section 4 Executive Order No. 64, dated August 2, 2024.**

REVIEW/RECOMMENDATION/LEGAL OPINION:

This office is of the opinion that the subject Ordinance is generally in accordance to its power under Section 447(1)(viii)¹ of the Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A 7160) as authorized by Section 3 and 4 of Executive Order No. 64². However, as provided under LBC No. 160 dated August 12, 2024, Section 5, 5.1.1, Annex A-1 only applies to full adoption of salary schedule to wit;

“Fully adopt the Salary Schedule in Section 3 of EO No. 64 (Annex A-1 of this Circular), notwithstanding the ceilings provided under Section 4 thereof, subject to compliance with the PS limitation and budgetary authorization requirements of RA No. 7160; Hence, recommending for the declaration of its validity”.

Since the LGU intends to adopt 75% of the Authorized Salary Schedule for National Government Agencies (NGA’s), the same shall be considered

under Section 5.1.3¹, and the applicable salary schedule in Annex A-2 to A-8 shall be adopted. Hence, returning to the SP for further review.

This opinion is likewise without prejudice to the opinions rendered by higher and competent authorities and/or the courts.

WHEREAS, Section 4 of Executive Order No. 64 set forth the updated Salary Schedule for Civilian Government Personnel that may also be granted to personnel of Local Government Units (LGU's) subject to these following conditions: **(a) Authorization** from their respective *sanggunian* as provided under Sections 447 (a), 448 (a), and 468(a) of RA No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991, as amended and **(b) Compliance** with the Personnel Services (PS) limitation in the LGU budget under Sections 325 and 331 of RA No. 7160;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Julita, Leyte decides to formulate a modified salary schedule by adopting a seventy-five percent (75%) of the authorized Salary Schedule for National Government Agencies (NGA's) prescribed in Section 3 as authorized in Section 4 of Executive Order No. 64;

BE IT ENACTED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Julita, Leyte, in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. Title. This Municipal Ordinance shall be known as **AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A MODIFIED SALARY SCHEDULE BY ADOPTING A SEVENTY-FIVE PERCENT (75%) OF THE AUTHORIZED SALARY SCHEDULE FOR NATIONAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES (NGA'S) AS PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 3 AND AUTHORIZED IN SECTION 4 OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 64, DATED AUGUST 2, 2024 ENTITLED, "UPDATING THE SALARY SCHEDULE FOR CIVILIAN GOVERNMENT PERSONNEL AND AUTHORIZING THE GRANT OF AN ADDITIONAL ALLOWANCE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES" INTENDED FOR NON-PUBLIC HEALTH WORKERS AND FURTHER ADOPTS THE SALARY RATES AUTHORIZED FOR PERSONNEL OF SPECIAL CITIES/FIRST CLASS PROVINCES AND CITIES (ANNEX A-1 LBC 160 DATED AUGUST 12, 2024) FOR PUBLIC HEALTH WORKERS (PHW) OF THE RURAL HEALTH UNIT OF THIS LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT.**

SECTION 2. Modified Salary Schedule. SECTION 3. For **Public Health Workers (PHW's)** of the Local Government Unit of Julita, Leyte the Annex A-1 of LBC 160 dated August 12, 2024 shall be followed.

SECTION 4. Funding. The amount that will be allocated for the salary increase shall be charge against the funds of the Local Government Unit of Julita, Leyte in accordance with the pertinent provisions of Executive Order No. 64 and Republic Act No. 7160.

SECTION 8. Separability Clause. If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 9. Repealing Clause. All ordinances, rules and regulations, or parts thereof, in conflict with or inconsistent to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 10. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after its approval.
