This refers to the Comprehensive Land Use Plan and Zoning Ordinance of the municipality of Jaro, Leyte, which were the subjects of Resolution No. 2024-01 of the Provincial Land Use Committee (PLUC), after the same was endorsed by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan to the latter for review.
