REVIEW/RECOMMENDATION/LEGAL OPINION:

This office is of the opinion that the subject Ordinance is generally in accordance to its power under Section 447(a)¹ of the Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A 7160) in relation to RA 8293² and RA 10667³ and in compliance with DILG memorandum circular No. 2020-124⁴. Hence, we recommend for the declaration of its validity.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 09, SERIES OF 2024 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO CURTAIL THE SALE, MENTAL, TRANSFER, DISTRIBUTION, MANUFACTURE AND/OR PRODUCTION OF PIRATED, COUNTERFEIT OR FAKE GOODS, ARTICLES OR SERVICES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

NOW, WHEREFORE, ON MOTION OF Hon. Nenfa C. Oyao, Chairman Committee on Business, Trade, Industry, Consumer Protection, Labor and Employment, duly seconded by Hon. Felipe H. Perez, Jr. and Hon. Stephanie M. Miralles, BE 17;

BE IT RESOLVED TO ENACT;

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 09 Series of 2024

"AN ORDINANCE TO CURTAIL THE SALE, RENTAL, TRANSFER, DISTRIBUTION, MANUFACTURE AND/OR PRODUCTION OF PIRATED, COUNTERFEIT OR FAKE GOODS, ARTICLES OR SERVICES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Introduced by: Hon. Introduced by: Hon. Nenfa C. Qyao, Hon. Felipe H. Perez, Jr. and Hon. Stephanie M. Miralles

WHEREAS, the Municipality Government of Merida adhered to the policy of the National Government to curb the proliferation and introduction into commerce of pirated, counterfeit or fake goods, articles or services, and the commission of other acts that violate intellectual property rights as protected by law:

WHEREAS, piracy and counterfeiting of intellectual property rights not only cause economic prejudice and demoralization among legitimate businessmen and establishments which offer products and cervices dependent on intellectual property protection; but also undermine the Municipality's strategy for growth and development and result in unrealized revenues and taxes;

WHEREAS, the state policy to enhance the enforcement of intellectual property rights requires the determined and active support of the local government at its grassroots level;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan in Session duly assembled that:

All business licenses and permits issued by the Municipal Government shall carry the SECTION 1. express condition that the licensee shall not engage in the sale, rental, transfer, distribution, m**an**ufacture and/or production of pirated, counterfelt or fake goods, articles or services nor shall permit other persons to commit said acts within the licensee's business establishment or premises.

For this purpose, any stall, table or equivalent contraptions, containing pirated, counterfeit or fake goods and articles, and services within Two (2) meters from the door, window or any opening leading to the licensee's establis**hment s**hall be deemed includ**ed** in the term "premises".

SECTION 2. Any breach or violation of the condition as set forth in the preceding section shall be a ground for the revocation or suspension of the business permit or license for a period of not more that Ten (10) days for the first violation; Thirty (30) days for the second violation; and cause the cancellation thereof for the third and subsequent violations.

The pirated, counterfeit or fake goods and articles, of any person engaged in any business or trade, with or without any license or permit shall be taken into preventive custody and disposed of in accordance with law.

SECTION 4. In the cases covered under Section 2 and 3, the respondent may, within Twenty-four (24) hours from notice of an order to suspend or cancel the business license or permit or to take custody or pirated, counterfeit or fake goods, articles or services, move to reconsider said order/s. The Municipal Mayor shall decide said motion within Fifteen (15) days from receipt.

The notice of suspension or cancellation of the business license or permit shall be issued by the Municipal Mayor after an inspection of the business establishment concerned is conducted. The inspection may be on the occasion of a seneral inspection regularly conducted by the Municipality, or for such purpose only upon receipt of a complaint or information that the licensee is engaged in the sale, rental, transfer, distribution, manufacture and/or production of pirated, counterfeit or fake goods, articles and services.

The Municipality may seek the assistance or coordination of the Philippine National Police (PNP), the National Bureau of Investigation (NBI), the Videogram Regulatory Board (VRB), and other law enforcement agencies in conducting the inspection.

SECTION 5. OFFENSES. The penalty of a fine or Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php2,500.00) or an imprisonment for a period not exceeding Six (6) months, or both, in the discretion of the court, shall be imposed upon:

- 5.1 Any person who, having been issued a business license or permit, shall commit a breach of the condition thereof imposed by Section 1 of this Ordinance;
- 5.2. Any person who, without any business license or permit, shall engage in the sale, rental, transfer, distribution, manufacture and/or production of pirated, counterfeit or fake goods, articles or services;
- 5.3. Any person who shall violate the order of the Municipal Mayor suspending or cancelling a license or permit or taking the subject good into custody;
- SECTION 6. The prosecution for commission of any of the foregoing offenses shall not constitute a bar for the prosecution of offenses under the Intellectual Property Code and other related laws.
- SECTION 7. PERSONS LIABLE. Should the offense be committed by a juridical person, the stockholder, chairperson, president, officer, director, trustee, partner or manager who committed or caused the commission of such of one, shall be liable.
- SECTION 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision or part hereof is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the ordinance or part thereof not otherwise affected shall remain valid and subsisting.
- SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE. All Ordinances and Resolution inconsistent herewith are hereby deemed repealed or accordingly modified.

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval and after Fifteen (15) days from posting in a least Three (3) conspicuous places within the Municipality and publication in a newspaper of general or local circulation.
