

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Municipality of Babatngon, Leyte in session assembled:

SECTION 1. Title - This ordinance shall be known as the "PALENG QR PH PROGRAM IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BABATNGON, LEYTE."

SECTION 2. Definition of Terms.

- DIGITAL PAYMENT refers to a monetary payment transaction between two (2) parties through digital payment instrument in which both the payer and the payee use an electronic channel.
- b) ELECTRONIC FUND TRANSFER (EFT) refers to transfer of funds between two (2) transaction accounts in the same or in different financial institutions supervised by the BSP, which are initiated and received using electronic devices and channels to transmit payment transactions.
- c) TRANSACTION ACCOUNT -- refers to a bank or e-money account held with a BSP-regulated Financial Service Provider (FSP) that can be used to store, send, and receive funds.
- d) QUICK RESPONSE CODE (QR Code) is a two-dimensional image-based bar code capable of holding large amounts of information. QR codes store information using patterns of black dots and white spaces, arranged in a square grid. It can be read by a smartphone camera that is equipped with a barcode reader.
- e) QR Ph is the national QR Code standard that allows a quick, low-cost, and safe method to pay, transfer to and receive funds from other ban and e-money accounts in the Philippines.
- CLIENT or USER refers to a person who availed of the QR Ph ready Transaction Account.
- CUSTOMER refers to a person who buys products, commodities, goods or other food products in public markets.
- FINANCIAL SERVICE PROVIDER (FSP) refers to financial institutions that provide banking, loans, money transfers, and financial options to customers.

SECTION 3. Coverage – All vendors in public markets, community shops, sari-sari store owners, tricycle and tricab operators and drivers, and other local merchants except for ambulant and street vendors, shall require to open a QR Ph-ready Transaction Account which shall be used for the payment of commodities, goods or other food products and fare, respectively. They shall also display conspicuously the QR Codes in their stores and vehicles for the convenience of customers.

SECTION 4. Assistance - The Local Government Unit of Babatngon (LGU-Babatngon), through the Business Permit and Licensing Office and in coordination with the Financial Service Providers (FSPs), shall provide necessary assistance to vendors, sari-sari store owners, tricycle and tricab operators and drivers, other local merchants, and their clients in opening a QR Ph-ready Transaction Account.

The assistance may include the issuance of relevant documents such as LGU-Babatngon Certification which shall free of charge, to support the know-Your-Customer (KYC) requirements of FSP and the holding of Paleng-QR Ph" "account opening day (s)".

<u>SECTION 5. Strategic Location of FSPs</u> - All participating FSPs shall set up booths in strategic locations where they shall assist target users or clients in account opening and provide QR Code printouts that can be readily displayed in their terminals, stores, and vehicles.

<u>SECTION 6. Participation of FSPs</u> – All participating FSPs which are QR Ph-ready shall be invited by the LGU-Babatngon to participate in the Paleng-OR Ph Program and support the onboarding target users or clients to a Transaction account and adoption of Digital Payments in public markets aand local transportation.

SECTION 7. Duties of FSPs - All participating FSPs shall perform the following:

- a) Provide personnel, customer assistance booths and other appropriae resources including QR Code printouts which are deemed reasonable to ensure the successful conduct of LGU-Babatngon Paleng-QR Ph account opening day (s);
- b) Provide target users or clients with appropriate materials on opening a Transaction Account using the QR Code payments and other digital financial services;
- c) Provide resource speakers and contents, as requested, for the LGU-Babatngon financial literacy program;
- d) Assign competent contact person to the LGU-Babatngon for efficient and timely coordination on the program implementation; and
- e) Provide special offers for accounts opened under the Paleng-QR Ph program such as free microinsurance coverage for a certain period (e.g., three months); t-shirts and other wearables; and special user rebates for a limited period.

SECTION 8. Identification of Users or Clients. Prior to the opening of QR-Ph ready Transaction Account, all target users or clients must show for the purpose of identification at least one government-issued identification card (ID card) to the FSPs personnel.

<u>SECTION 9. LGU-Babatngon Certification</u> - The LGU-Babatngon shall issue Certification to the participating FSPs in support of the Know-Your-Customer (KYC) of their requirements.

<u>SECTION 10. – Information, Education and Communication Campaign (IECC)</u> - The LGU-Babatngon shall develop its IECC and provide banners, standees, and other Paleng-QR Ph markers in public markets, terminals, tricycles and tricabs in order to promote and sustain the objective of the Paleng-QR Ph Program.

<u>SECTION 11. – Free Internet Connectivity</u> - The LGU-Babatngon shall facilitate the free internet access in public areas, public and community markets, and terminals to ensure ease and convenience of account opening and using QR Code digital payment by users and clients.

<u>SECTION 12. – Prohibited Acts</u> - The following are the prohibited acts:

- Refusal of vendors, sari-sari store owners, tricycle operators and drivers, and other local merchants to adopt and open a QR Ph-ready Transaction Account; and
- Failure of vendors, sari-sari store owners, tricycle operators and drivers, and other local merchants to provide QR
 Code printouts their stores, terminals and vehicles.

SECTION 13. Penalties - The following penalties shall be imposed for violation of this ordinannce.

- a) First Offense shall pay the penalty of PhP 1,000.00 and order the owner to comply with the provision of the ordinance, existing laws, rules and regulation within thirty (30) days from receipt of order.
- b) Second Offense shall pay the penalty of PhP 2,000.00 and notify to cease operations until the owner to comply with the provisions of the Ordinance, existing laws, rules and regulation within the thrity (30) days from receipt of order.
- c) Third Offense shall pay the penalty of PhP 2,500.00 and impose a Closure Order to the establishment.

SECTION 14. Separability Clause - If any provision or section of this Ordinance or the application of such provision or section to any person or circumstances is declared invalid, the remainder of the ordinance or the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected by such declaration.
