EXPLANATORY NOTE

Section 16 of the Local Government Code of the Republic Act No. 7160, under the General Welfare Clause, provides that every local government unit shall ensure and support the maintenance of peace and order within their respective territorial jurisdiction. This means that any initiatives and endeavors in promoting peace and order in the community by the municipal government shall be prioritized and be given utmost support.

Executive Order No. 297, S. 2000, was issued on October 4, 2000, in order to regulate the Unauthorized Manufacture, Sale, Distribution and Use of PNP Uniforms, Insignias and other Accoutrements. Likewise, the Executive Order imposes penalties, such as, among others: immediate closure of establishment, cancelation of the business license or permit; condemnation, seizure and forfeiture of unauthorized items, and imposition of reasonable fines and penalties for violators of the said Order, which could be adopted by the Local Government Unit of Jaro, Leyte.

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Article 179 "Illegal Use of Uniforms and Insignias" of Republic Act 3815 of the Revised Penal Code of the Philippines penalizes any person who shall publicly & improperly make use of insignias, uniforms to an office not held by such person or to a class of persons of which he is not a member. It does not include, however, the illegal manufacture, sale or distribution of the same.

On the other hand, Republic Act No. 493 was also enacted prohibiting among others the wearing, use, manufacture and sale of insignias, decorations and medals, badges, patches and identification cards prescribed by the AFP or Constabulary. But this law does not apply to the Philippine National Police. There is no existing law that regulates the manufacture, sale, distribution and use of uniforms, insignias and other accoutrements of the PNP.


The unauthorized manufacture, sale, distribution and use of PNP uniforms, insignias and other accoutrements requires strict of concern, for it is a symbolic PNP identifiers, that instead of providing a comforting sense of security to the constituents it is used by some lawless elements in the commission of crimes within the municipality.

Considering that it is not far-fetched that a number of business establishments may engage in the manufacture, sale and distribution of PNP uniform, insignias, and other accoutrement's, in the municipality, for being a lucrative business, there is a need to enact a corresponding municipal ordinance in order to mitigate, or even eradicate the proliferation of the unauthorized use of PNP uniforms and to prevent illegal activities that may be committed by lawless personalities within the jurisdiction of Jaro, Leyte.






**ORDINANCE NO. 30
SERIES OF 2024**



AN ORDINANCE MANDATING ALL BUSINESS OPERATING WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF JARO, LEYTE ENGAGED IN THE MANUFACTURING, SELLING OR DISTRIBUTION OF PNP UNIFORMS, INSIGNIAS AND OTHER ACCOUTREMENTS TO SECURE PNP CERTIFICATE OF CONFORMITY AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Jaro, Leyte, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE OF ORDINANCE – This Ordinance shall be known as: **"The PNP Certificate of Conformity Ordinance"**

SECTION 2. SCOPE AND APPLICATION – All businesses operating within the territorial jurisdiction of Jaro, Leyte, whether in physical, online or in digital platform, engaged in the manufacture, sale and distribution of Philippine National Police uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrements. It includes enterprises dealing with raw materials for the production of aforementioned items.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS – for the purposes of implementation of this Ordinance, the following definitions shall be binding and controlling:

- A. PNP Uniforms, Insignias and Accoutrements** – these are authorized clothing, garment, distinguishing marked, emblem, merchandise, or decorations worn by bonafide members and officially acknowledged by the Philippine National Police.

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- B. **PNP Certificate of Conformity (COC)** – a certification issued by the Local Police Office through the Directorate for Research and Development (DRD) which signifies authority to manufacture, sell, or distribute PNP uniforms, insignias and accoutrements.
- C. **Distributor** - an authorized agent of a supplier or manufacturer to supply or deliver PNP uniforms, insignias and accoutrements wherein the latter has a valid PNP Certificate of Conformity.
- D. **Manufacture** – act of producing or trading of fit-to-use, ready-to-wear, or ready-to-use PNP uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrements.

SECTION 4. REQUIREMENT FOR PNP CERTIFICATE OF CONFORMITY – all businesses engaged and dealing with PNP uniforms, insignias and other accoutrements must secure a PNP Certificate of Conformity which shall be a mandatory requirement in the processing of a local business permit.

SECTION 5. COORDINATION WITH THE PNP – for effective implementation of this ordinance, the Local Police Office in coordination with Jaro BPLO shall ensure that all establishment engaged in the manufacturing, selling, or distribution of PNP uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrements applying for a business permit shall be first evaluated by the local PNP Office.

The PNP shall also submit to the BPLO a list of registered establishments who failed to secure the PNP Certificate of conformity.

SECTION 6. AUTHORITY TO INSPECT ESTABLISHMENT - The BPLO in coordination with the Local Police shall periodically conduct a joint inspection of business establishment, verifying and requiring the presentation of their respective PNP Certificate of Conformity.

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SECTION 7. IMPLEMENTING OFFICES – The Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO) is the primary office mandated to formulate the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) and to execute the provisions of this ordinance with the assistance of the Local-PNP Office.

SECTION 8. PENALTIES – Failure to secure a PNP Certificate of Conformity or present the same during inspection shall warrant the issuance of appropriate notice of violation. Upon findings that the establishment continuously violates pertinent provision of this ordinance, the BPLO may either order the suspension of the business operation, revocation of the business permit, or closure of the business establishment, depending on the gravity of the violation committed.

In case of violation found during the inspections for failure to present PNP Certificate of Conformity to engage in manufacturing, selling and/or distribution of PNP uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrements, the items found therein shall be seized or confiscated subject to proper disposal, without prejudice to the revocation of business permit and the filing of appropriate administrative, civil or criminal action.

Any violator/s of the provisions of this ordinance shall be imposed with a penalty of fine not exceeding Php 2,500.00 but not less than Php 2,000, or imprisonment of not more than three (3) months, or both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.


SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If for any reason, any section of the ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other sections which are not affected there by shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE - All ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed accordingly.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE – This ordinance shall take effect Fifteen (15) days after a copy hereof is posted in at least three (3) conspicuous places in the municipality in accordance with the provision of R.A. 7160






The Chair opines and asks from the floor for any other further inquiries, and hearing none, request Hon. Pormida to offer the final motion, seconded en masse.







Hon. Salgado took the floor and then moves for the approval of Ordinance No. 30, Series of 2024, which was duly seconded en mase by all SB members present

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And then after, the Chair declared that Ordinance No. 30, Series of 2024, has been formally been moved, carried and approved en masse by the August Body, under the third-and-final-reading.

Hon. Salgado took the floor and then move the above proposal, seconded by Hon. Altres, Hon. Aure, Hon. Tañala and Hon. Familiar, and then the Chair declared for the plenary discussion, and give the floor to Hon. Salgado.

Hon. Salgado opines that in the previous 89th Regular Session the proposed resolution has been tabled under the referral of proposed measures, upon the letter request of the JARO-PNP dated July 2, 2024, duly signed by Reymond U. Quinagutan, Police Major/Officer In-Charge.

Hon. Salgado continue that the proposed resolution has been referred to the committee level for review of Executive Order No. 70, S. 2018, which mandates for the institutionalization of an inclusive and sustainable peace and for the creation of the NTF-ELCAC, and formulation of a National Peace Framework. A committee meeting has been conducted on July 11, 2024, and the minutes of the said committee meeting has been deliberated upon and adopted during the 91st Sb Regular Session held on July 22, 2024, and if there are no more further inquiries from the Body on the above proposed resolution, it is already subject for its final approval.

The Chair asks from the floor for further discussion on the proposed resolution and hearing none request Hon. Salgado to offer the final motion.

Hon. Salgado took the floor, and move for the approval of the proposed resolution and it was duly seconded en masse.

And then after, the Chair declared that Item No. 07, under the business for the day has been moved, carried and approved en masse by the August Body.

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OTHER MATTERS:

1. Hon. Pormida informed the Body that in the Budget Hearing last August 15-17, 2024, discussed by the MBO-Mr. Juancho C. Bonayon, are Executive Order No. 64, S. 2024, dated August 2, 2024 and the DBM-LBC No. 160, dated August 12, 2024, which is for Implementation of the 1st Tranche of the Modified Salary Schedule for Local Government Personnel pursuant to E.O. No. 64, S. 2024.

Hon. Pormida further informed the Body that the Local Finance Committee (LFC) member with the SB Chairman Committee on Finance, Budget and Appropriations will conduct a Special Executive Meeting to discuss the matter on the possibilities to implement Executive Order No. 64, S. 2024.

2. Hon. Pormida likewise informed the Body that discuss also in the Budget Hearing was the cash assistance of the SB, utilizing the SB members annual funds of Php 220,000.00. According to Hon. Pormida the Body has to decide how much will be transferred to the MSWDO, to be utilized exclusively for the cash assistance of the SB for the year 2025.

The Chair opines and asks for the opinion/s of the SB members on the propositions presented by Hon. Pormida for there is a need for the SB members to decide on the amount to be transferred to the MSWDO.

Hon. Pormida speaks out that on his part he is suggesting an amount of Php 150,000.00 for each SB members, totaling to Php 1,500,000.00 pesos, which amount will be transferred from the SB to the MSWD, this will be intended for the SB's cash assistance (ex. medical, burial assistance).

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The Chair asks from Hon. Pormida, on the remaining Php 70,000.00 for every SB member.

Hon. Pormida that the remaining amount of Php 70,000.00 will be utilized by the SB members for expenses incurred on supplies and materials, travel and food during the SB members committee meetings.

Hon. Aure inquire pertaining to cash solicitations, if it is changeable to the SB funds which is in custody of the MSWDO.

Hon. Pormida reply that solicitations to the SB members could not be charge to the funds at the MSWDO for its is disallowed by COA, also Hon. Pormida informed the Body that discussed was on the procedure to Fastrack the release of the SB cash assistance, and it was decided thru cash payroll of a group of ten (10) donees at a maximum amount of Php 3,000.00.

Hon. Emnas speaks out that on the event that group of ten (10) donees could not be reach, it follows that the release of cash assistance still would be delayed.

Hon. Pormida reply that the group of ten (10) cash assistance will be a consolidation of an assistance from the executive Office and the Legislative Office, hence there will be no problem to reach the group of ten (10) persons in the payroll.

Hon. Que opines and clarifies that educational assistance will no longer be processed, and the endorsement of the SB cash assistance will still come from the SB members.

Hon. Pormida reply that educational assistance could no longer be given by the SB, and as usual procedure the MSWDO will not process cash assistance not until there is endorsement from the SB/or SB members.

The Chair opines and inquire as to the amount of cash assistance for the Vice-Mayor's Office.

Hon. Pormida reply that the SB cash assistance of Php 1,500,000.00 is taken from the Sangguniang Bayan's Office, the Vice-Mayor will still decide how much would be transferred to the MSWDO taken from the Vice-Mayor's Fund, which will be additional to the SB Funds.

Hon. Altres inquire from Hon. Pormida the categories/items which are included under the medical assistance.

Hon. Pormida reply that under the medical assistance will includes:

- a. Hospitalization
- b. Medicines
- c. Equipment's/for donee

Hon. Que speaks out that pertaining to the medicines, on his view it is not necessarily to give the maximum amount of Php 3,000.00, only what is necessary.

Hon. Pormida, solicitations for medicines will depend on the M.D. prescriptions, and the MSWDO evaluation, the SB members could endorse the amount for medicine assistance, which will be based the MSWDO evaluation, in-charge to process the cash assistance.

3. At this point in time the Chair announced to the Body the presence of the newly assigned Fire Marshall of the JARO-BFP, and acknowledge the visitors, and give the floor to introduce themselves and purpose of their courtesy call to the SB.

The visitors took the floor and introduced themselves as SFO4 Alex Colaba, from Jaro, Leyte, he was previously assigned at Kananga, Leyte, and has transferred to JARO-BFP last August 8, 2024, as the replacement of the former Fire Marshall, and FO3 Geremy Homeres, likewise introduced himself as member of the JARO-BFP contingents.

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Hon. Pormida advised the new BFP Fire Marshall to feel free to communicate with the Sangguniang Bayan on his proposals of activities for the JARO-BFP to improved/upgrade the services of the JARO-BFP, and assures SFO4 Colaba that the SB will favorably assist him.

4. Hon. Pormida informed the Body that there are two (2) regulatory ordinances submitted to the SB for review from Brgy, Tuba and Brgy. Villa Paz.

He further suggests to conduct the committee meeting on August 19, 2024 at 10:00 A.M. which all the committee member concur thereto, further he is requesting Mr. Joel Cornista-SB/LSS to contact the concerned barangay officials on the schedule of the committee meeting.

5. Hon. Pormida suggest to the Body to conduct a special session on August 22, 2024, right after the committee meeting of the committee on finance, budget and appropriations to review the Appropriation Ordinance N0. 01, Series of 2024, of Php 41,500,000.00 pesos.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Section 16 of the Local Government Code of the Republic Act No. 7160, also known as the General Welfare Clause Act provides that every local government unit shall ensure and support the maintenance of peace and order within their respective territorial jurisdiction. This means that initiatives and any endeavors in promoting peace and order in the community is one of the importance of the municipal government; hence, it should be supported if not prioritized.

Executive Order No. 297, S. 2000, entitled: Regulating the Manufacture, Sale, and Distribution and use of PNP Uniforms, Insignias and other Accoutrements was signed on October 4, 2000, in order to control the unauthorized manufacture, sale and distribution of PNP uniforms, insignias and other accoutrements. The Executive Order imposes penalties, such as, among others: immediate closure of establishment, cancelation of the business license or permit; condemnation, seizure and forfeiture of unauthorized items; and, imposition of reasonable fines for violators of the said order, all of which could be adopted by the local government unit.

Article 179 "Illegal Use of Uniforms and Insignias" of Republic Act 3815 of the Revised Penal Code of the Philippines penalizes any person who shall publicly & improperly make use of insignias, uniforms to an office not held by such person or to a class of persons of which he is not a member. It does not include, however, the illegal manufacture, sale or distribution of the same.

On the other hand, Republic Act No. 493 was also enacted prohibiting among others the wearing, use, manufacture and sale of insignias, decorations and medals, badges, patches and identification cards prescribed by the AFP or Constabulary. But this law does not apply to the Philippine National Police. There is no existing law that regulates the manufacture, sale, distribution and use of uniforms, insignias and other accoutrements of the PNP.

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The unauthorized manufacture, sale, distribution and use of PNP uniforms, insignias and other accoutrements requires strict of concern, for it is a symbolic PNP identifiers, that instead of providing a comforting sense of security to the constituents it may be used by lawless elements in the commission of crimes within the municipality.

Considering that it is not far-fetched that a number of business establishments may engage in the manufacture, sale and distribution of PNP uniform, insignias, and other accoutrement's, in the municipality, for being a lucrative business, there is a need to enact a corresponding municipal ordinance in order to mitigate, or even eradicate the proliferation of the unauthorized use of PNP uniforms and to prevent illegal activities that may be committed by lawless personalities within the jurisdiction of Jaro, Leyte.

ORDINANCE NO. 30
SERIES OF 2024

AN ORDINANCE MANDATING ALL BUSINESS OPERATING WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF JARO, LEYTE ENGAGED IN THE MANUFACTURING, SELLING OR DISTRIBUTION OF PNP UNIFORMS, INSIGNIAS AND OTHER ACCOUTREMENTS TO SECURE PNP CERTIFICATE OF CONFORMITY AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Jaro, Leyte, that:

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SECTION 1. TITLE OF ORDINANCE – This Ordinance shall be known as:
"The PNP Certificate of Conformity Ordinance"

SECTION 2. SCOPE AND APPLICATION – All businesses operating within the territorial jurisdiction of Jaro, Leyte, whether in physical, online or in digital platform, engaged in the manufacture, sale and distribution of Philippine National Police uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrements. It includes enterprises dealing with raw materials for the production of aforementioned items.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS – for the purposes of implementation of this Ordinance, the following definitions shall be binding and controlling:

- A. PNP Uniforms, Insignias and Accoutrements** – these are authorized clothing, garment, distinguishing marked, emblem, merchandise, or decorations worn by bonafide members and officially acknowledged by the Philippine National Police.
- B. PNP Certificate of Conformity (COC)** – a certification issued by the Local Police Office through the Directorate for Research and Development (DRD) which signifies authority to manufacture, sell, or distribute PNP uniforms, insignias and accoutrements.
- C. Distributor** - an authorized agent of a supplier or manufacture to supply or deliver PNP uniforms, insignias and accoutrements wherein the latter has a valid PNP Certificate of Conformity.
- D. Manufacture** – act of producing or trading of fit-to-use, ready-to-wear, or ready-to-use PNP uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrements.

SECTION 4. REQUIREMENT FOR PNP CERTIFICATE OF CONFORMITY – all businesses engaged and dealing with PNP uniforms, insignias and other accoutrements must secure a PNP Certificate of Conformity which shall be a mandatory requirement in the processing of a local business permit.

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SECTION 5. COORDINATION WITH THE PNP – for effective implementation of this ordinance, the Local Police Office in coordination with Jaro BPLO shall ensure that all establishment engaged in the manufacturing, selling, or distribution of PNP uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrements applying for a business permit shall be first evaluated by the local PNP Office.

The PNP shall also submit to the BPLO a list of registered establishments who failed to secure the PNP Certificate of conformity.

SECTION 6. AUTHORITY TO INSPECT ESTABLISHMENT - The BPLO in coordination with the Local Police shall periodically conduct a joint inspection of business establishment, verifying and requiring the presentation of its respective PNP Certificate of Conformity.

SECTION 7. IMPLEMENTING OFFICES – The Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO) is the primary office mandated to formulate the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) and to execute the provisions of this ordinance with the assistance of the Local-PNP Office.

SECTION 8. PENALTIES – Failure to secure a PNP Certificate of Conformity or present the same during inspection shall warrant the issuance of appropriate notice of violation. Upon findings that the establishment continuously violates pertinent provision of this ordinance the BPLO, may either order the suspension of the business operation, revocation of the business permit, or closure of the business establishment, depending on the gravity of the violation committed.

In case of violation found during the inspections for failure to present PNP Certificate of Conformity to engage in manufacturing, selling and/or distribution of PNP uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrements, the items found therein shall be seized or confiscated subject to proper disposal, without prejudice to the revocation of business permit and the filing of appropriate administrative, civil or criminal action.

Any violator/s of the provisions of this ordinance shall be imposed with a penalty of fine not exceeding Php 2,500.00 but not less than Php 2,000.00, or imprisonment of not more than three (3) months, or both fine and penalties at the discretion of the court.

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SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If for any reason, any section of the ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other sections which are not affected there by shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE - All ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed accordingly.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE – This ordinance shall take effect Fifteen (15) days after a copy hereof is posted in at least three (3) conspicuous places in the municipality in accordance with the provision of R.A. 7160



MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING CONDUCTED LAST AUGUST 2, 2024 REGARDING AN ORDINANCE MANDATING ALL BUSINESS OPERATING WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF JARO, LEYTE ENGAGED IN THE MANUFACTURING, SELLING OR DISTRIBUTION OF PNP UNIFORMS, INSIGNIAS AND OTHER ACCOUTREMENTS TO SECURE PNP CERTIFICATE OF CONFORMITY AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

The public hearing started at 11:29 in the morning of August 2, 2024 spearheaded by HON. ALEXANDER N. SALGADO, Chairman of the Committee on Peace and Order, Public Safety and Transportation.

The Chairman of the Committee acknowledged the presence of all Barangay Captains in the Municipality of Jaro as well as the resource persons who attended the public hearing despite of their busy schedules.

HON. ALEXANDER N. SALGADO imparted a brief background and discussed on the following prevailing laws as introductory points of the ordinance:

- Section 16 of the Local Government Code (RA 7160) – known as the General Welfare Act wherein the Local Government Units should support and ensure the safety and Order in their respective area of jurisdiction.
- Executive Order No. 297 was implemented to control and manage the authorized manufacturer, seller, and distributor of PNP uniforms, insignias and other accoutrements.
- In addition, Executive Order No. 297 also imposes penalties for violators such as immediate closure of establishment, cancellation of business permit; condemnation, seizure and forfeiture of unauthorized items; and imposition of reasonable fines for violators.

HON. ALEXANDER N. SALGADO informed the attendees that all business engaged in dealing with PNP uniforms, insignias and other accoutrements must secure PNP certificate of Conformity and must coordinate to the Local PNP, to Business Permit and Licensing Department (BPLD), and to the Department of Public Order and Safety DPOS.

He added that failure to secure a PNP Certificate of Conformity during inspection shall warrant the issuance of appropriate notice of violation. For continuing violation of this provision, the BPLO may either order to suspend business operation, revocation of business permit or closure of the business establishment depending on the nature of the violation committed. That in case of violation found during the aforementioned inspections for failure to present competent proof of authority to deal with PNP uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrements, the items found therein shall be confiscated subject to proper disposal, without prejudice to the revocation of business permit and filing of appropriate administrative case.

HON. ALEXANDER N. SALGADO proposed that any violator of the aforementioned provisions shall be imposed a fine of not exceeding 3,000 pesos but not less than 1,000 pesos or imprisonment of three (3) days depending on the discretion of the court.

During the open forum, HON. PEDRO B. TAÑALA JR. recommended to the body that every costumer who will purchase PNP uniforms, insignias and other accoutrements must be required to present their Identification Card for identity check.

The chairman agreed to the suggestion of HON. PEDRO B. TAÑALA JR.

There being no more matters discussed by the body, the Committee Chairman wrap-up the gist of the proceedings and thanked for their indulgence and cooperation in making the Public Hearing successful. The public hearing was adjourned at 11:53 in the morning.


