**A RESOLUTION ENACTING ON THIRD AND FINAL READING, PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 2024-14, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING KATUWANG SA DIWA AT GAWA PARA SA MASAGANANG ANI AT MATAAS NA KITA (KADIWA) NG PANGULO WITH APPROPRIATION THEREOF."**

**WHEREAS**, Memorandum Circular No. 2024-003 of the Department of The Interior and Local Government calls for the participation of Local Government Units in the KADIWA ng Pangulo (KNP);

**WHEREAS**, KADIWA aims to provide a direct and effective farm-to-consumer food supply chain, support enterprise development, promote local products rooted in local culture, community resource, creativity, connection, and competitive advantage;

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**WHEREAS**, the Province of Leyte adheres to the policy to promote a just and fair environment for trade and other economic activities, and to provide effective mechanisms or measures to promote the well-being of its citizens, their livelihood, and the economy;

**WHEREAS**, the implementation of the KADIWA ng Pangulo is a new indicator for the evaluation of Seal of Good Local Governance (SGLG);

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of Honorable \_\_\_\_\_, and duly seconded by Honorable \_\_\_\_\_, be it

**AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING KATUWANG SA DIWA AT GAWA PARA SA MASAGANANG ANI AT MATAAS NA KITA (KADIWA) NG PANGULO WITH APPROPRIATION THEREOF**

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte in session assembled:

**SECTION 1. PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

KADIWA ng Pangulo is a joint, collaborative program of the Department of Agriculture (DA), Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), and the Province of Leyte that will empower local communities, provide farm-to-consumer supply chain, promote networking and market linkages, and support local products. It also encourages the participation and support of non-government organizations, business sectors, and cooperatives.

**SECTION 2. SCOPE**

The KADIWA ng Pangulo will be implemented within the Province of Leyte:

- 2.1 Philippine Coconut Authority grounds, Government Center, Palo, Leyte every 15<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> of the month or its nearest working day should it fall in a weekend;
- 2.2 Provincial Government Complex grounds, West Bypass Road, Barangay Guindapunan, Palo, Leyte every Wednesday.

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159 **SECTION 3. OBJECTIVES**

160  
161 3.1 To ensure food security, delivery of nutritious food and access to  
162 affordable goods and commodities.

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164 3.2 Support farmers to sell agri-produce, to facilitate product regional  
165 exchange of OTOP (One Town, One Product) products, and to provide  
166 opportunity for local micro-entrepreneurs to market their products.

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168 3.3 To provide market opportunities to MSMEs (Micro, Small, and Medium  
169 Enterprises) through local product promotion and eliminating as may layers,  
170 allowing producers to earn bigger income from directly selling their  
171 products instead of using trader-intermediaries.

172  
173 3.4 To encourage consumer spending, thereby jumpstarting and reviving  
174 local economies.

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176 **SECTION 4. COMPOSITION.**

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178 There is hereby created the KADIWA EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE headed by the  
179 Governor of Leyte as Chairman.

180  
181 The Regional Executive Director of the Department of Agriculture shall be  
182 the Vice-Chairman and the following will be the members:

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- 185 • Provincial Director of the Department of Trade and Industry
  - 186 • Provincial Director of the Department of Labor and Employment
  - 187 • Regional Director of the Department of Social Welfare and  
Development
  - 188 • Provincial Director of the Department of the Interior and Local  
189 Government
  - 190 • Sangguniang Panlalawigan (SP) Member Chairman in Agriculture

192 A KADIWA LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE shall likewise be created with the Vice  
193 Governor as Presiding Officer and the Sangguniang Panlalawigan Member  
194 chairing the Agriculture Committee as Vice Chairman.

195  
196 The SP Members of the Agriculture Committee and the Provincial Liga ng  
197 mga Barangay President shall be the members.

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199 A KADIWA MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE shall likewise be created composed  
200 of the Provincial Agriculturist as Chairman, and the KADIWA ng Pangulo Focal  
201 Person and the Representatives of participating farmers, fisherfolk, MSMEs as  
202 members.

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209 **SECTION 5. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

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5.1 EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE. The executive committee shall oversee the overall implementation of the KNP and provide policy direction and support in achieving the objectives of the program.

5.2 LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE. The committee shall formulate ordinances, resolutions, and/or any legislative measures supporting the implementation of KNP.

5.3 MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE.

5.3.1 The committee shall coordinate with the partner agencies, participating farmers, fisherfolk, and MSMEs and oversee the operation of KNP.

5.3.2 This committee shall provide technical assistance through training, seminars, coaching and mentoring to the KNP locators.

5.3.2 This committee in coordination with the Executive Committee shall ensure that the products of the local farmers and fishers should be transported from the farm to the KNP venue.

5.3.3 The Province of Leyte through the Office of the Provincial Agriculture shall have the following responsibilities in the implementation of the KNP:

242 An initial amount of Fifty Thousand Pesos is hereby allocated for the  
 243 implementation of this ordinance. In the succeeding years, appropriations for the  
 244 KADIWA ng Pangulo shall be included in the Annual Budget for the Office of the  
 245 Provincial Agriculturist or OPA.

246 **SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE**

247 If for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this ordinance shall be  
 248 held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not  
 249 affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

250 **SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY**

251 This ordinance shall take effect after the requirement of posting prescribed  
 252 in RA 7160 is complied with.

375 the formulation of Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) thereof."

377 and PhilHealth Circular No. 2024-0013, the Provincial Legal Office has recommended  
378 that the same be declared valid. In view thereof, Mr. Chair, I'd like to move that we
