This office is of the opinion that the subject Ordinance is generally in accordance with its power under Section 43 of R.A. No. 6975¹ in relation to Section 447(a)² of the Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A 7160). Hence, we recommend for the declaration of its validity.

This opinion is likewise without prejudice to the opinions rendered by higher and competent authorities and/or the courts.

Section 43. People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB). – (a) Creation and Functions. – Within thirty (30) days from the issuance of the implementing rules and regulations by the Commission, there shall be created by the sangguniang panlungsod/bayan in every city and municipality such number of People's Law Enforcement Boards (PLEBs) as may be necessary: Provided, That there shall be at least one (1) PLEB for every municipality and for each of the legislative districts in a city. The PLEB shall have jurisdiction to hear and decide citizen's complaints or cases filed before it against erring officers and members of the PNP. There shall be at least one (1) PLEB for every five hundred (500) city or municipal police personnel.

² (a) The sangguniang bayan, as the legislative body of the municipality, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the municipality as provided for under Section 22 of this Code

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 05, S.2024

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE OPERATIONAL GUIDELINES ON THE PEOPLE'S LAW ENFORCEMENT BOARD (PLEB) OF VILLABA, LEYTE, DEFINING ITS FUNCTIONS RECREATING OF THE COMPOSITION AND MEMBERSHIP, FOR ITS ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF

Authored by: Hon. Roque M. Compra Chairman, Committee on Peace and Order, and Public Safety

Preparatory Statement:

WHEREAS, Section 43, of Republic Act No. 6975 or the Department of Interior and Local Government Act of 1990 as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, mandates the creation of a People's Law Enforcement Board in every municipality to conduct hearing and adjudication of Citizen's complaints against uniformed members of the Philippine National Police (PNP) for offences committed in their area of jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, the People's Law Enforcement Board of the Municipality has been created and subsequently reorganized to update its membership;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 2017-154 dated November 16, 2017 of the Department of Interior and Local Government titled "Operational Guidelines on the Implementation of the People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB) Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion by the Hon. Roque M. Compra, duly seconded en masse, be it

ORDAINED, as the Sangguniang Bayan in regular session assembled hereby ordained, that:

SECTION 1. Short Title. – This Ordinance shall be known as the "People's Law Enforcement Board Ordinance of the Municipality of Villaba, Leyte"

SECTION 2. Composition and Membership. – There is hereby created a People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB) to be composed of the following:

- a) One Member of the Sangguniang Bayan chosen by his/her Sangunnian;
- b) One Liga ng mga Barangay Representative or the Punong Barangay;
- c) Three other Members who are removable only for cause to be chosen by the Municipal Peace and Order Council from among the respected members of the community known for their probity and integrity, one (1)

of whom must be a woman and another member of the Bar, or in the absence thereof, a college graduate, or the District Supervisor of the DepEd or the principal of the Central Elementary School in the Locality;

SECTION 3. Creation. – People's Law Enforcement Board which shall have jurisdiction to hear and adjudicate all citizen's complaints formally filed with, or referred to it, against any uniformed member of the Philippine National Police (PNP), and if warranted, impose the corresponding penalty.

SECTION 4. Definition of Terms. – As used in this Ordinance, the following terms shall be understood to mean as follows:

- a) Citizen's Complaint a formal charge initiated by a natural or juridical person or his/its duly authorized representative or guardian on account of an injury, damage or disturbance sustained as a result of an irregular or illegal act or omission of a member of the Philippine National Police.
- b) Complaint a written and sworn statement regarding a wrong, grievance or injury sustained by a person committed by the PNP member, within territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of the Villaba, Leyte.
- c) Complainant one who initiates a complaint against a uniformed member of the Philippine National Police (PNP), either as complaining witness or as a concerned government agency or office.
- d) Decision a written disposition of a case personally and directly prepared and signed by the members of the PLEB stating clearly the findings of facts the law applicable thereto. It shall also include a finding of exoneration or culpability of the respondent with the corresponding penalty in case of the latter.
- e) Jurisdiction the authority vested by law to hear and decide a case.
- f) PLEB it is the central receiving entity for any citizen's complaint against the officers and members of the PNP and shall have the jurisdiction to hear and decide cases filed before it.
- g) Quorum it refers to the number necessary to do business, which in this case, is the presence of the majority of the PLEB members.
- h) Respondent Officer any uniformed member of the Philippine National Police.
- i) Regional Appellate Board an appellate body organized to decide appeals on decisions of the PLEB, where the penalty imposed is demotion or forced resignation or dismissal from the service.

SECTION 5. Rules of Procedure:

(1.) The PLEB, by a majority vote of all its members and its Chairman shall determine whether or not the respondent Officer or member of the Philippine National Police (PNP), is guilty of the charge upon which the complaint is based.

- (2.) Each Case shall be decided within Sixty (60) days from the time the case has been filed with the People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB).
- (3.) The procedures in the PLEB shall summary in nature, conducted in accordance with due process, but without strict regard to technical rules of evidence.
- (4.) Cases before the PLEB shall be governed by the Philippine National Police, PNP Memorandum Circular No. 2002-010, otherwise known as the 2002 PLEB Revised Rules of Procedure without prejudice to any subsequent issuances as thereafter may be promulgated.

SECTION 6. Decision of the PLEB. – The Decision of the PLEB shall be final and executory. Any Appeal on the said decision may be raised to the Regional Appellate Board within Ten (10) days from receipt of a copy of the decision. The Regional Appellate Board shall decide the appeal within Sixty (60) days from receipt of the complete records of the case. Failure of the Regional Appellate Board to act on the appeal within said period shall render the decision final and executory without prejudice, however, to the filing of an appeal by either party with the Secretary.

SECTION 7. Term of Office. – The term of office of the members of the PLEB shall be for the period of Three (3) years from assumption of office. Such member shall hold office until his successor shall have been chosen and qualified.

SECTION 8. Duties, Functions and Responsibilities. – The duties, functions and responsibilities of the members of the PLEB shall pursuant to the provisions of the Republic Act No. 6975 and Republic Act No. 8551 as supplemented by the NAPOLCOM Memorandum Circular No. 2016-002 and DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2017-157, among others.

SECTION 9. Compensation. – Pursuant to Section 70 of Republic Act No. 8551, membership in the PLEB is a civic duty and members shall be paid per diems as may be determined by the Sanggunian based on the availability of funds, The Local Government Unit (LGU) of Villaba, shall include in its annual budget in an item and the corresponding appropriation for the maintenance and operation of the PLEB, under the office of the Municipal Mayor.

SECTION 10. Policy and Guidelines. – Implementation of the nationwide simultaneous Trainings for the capacity enhancement of People's Law Enforcement Boards.

- a) The main objective of the training is to equip the participants with knowledge and skills on roles and functions of the PLEB, and on the PLEB Rules of Procedure.
- b) Providing capacity development activities, such as orientations, seminars, or trainings, to capacitate DILG and NAPOLCOM personnel and local government units, specifically PLEB members in the performance of their duties and responsibilities.

SECTION 11. Separability Clause. – In case any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 12. Repealing Clause. – All Ordinances, Resolutions, Local Executive Orders, Rules and Regulations, or any part thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby deemed repealed, modified, or amended accordingly.

SECTION 13. Effectivity. – This Ordinance shall be take effect immediately upon its approval.

This Ordinance was approved by the Sangguniang Bayan in its Regular Session on September 30, 2024.

Hon. Compra, started by greeting everyone present. He explained that the purpose of the public hearing of the Ordinance the Operational guidelines on the People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB).

Mr. Manuel I. Rubillos, the Municipal Budget Officer emphasized that under the existing rules and regulations on the grant of per diem to local regulatory bodies, like the PLEB, as stated in Local Budget Circular No.73, dated January 10, 2001. The PLEB Member shall be paid honorarium per meetings/sessions in a month, as prescribed by SECTION 9. Compensation of this Ordinance, but not to exceed Ph.4,000 a month.

PMAJ Edwin D. Tolibas, explained the NAPOLCOM Memorandum Circular No. 2016-002, that revises the rules of procedure before the administrative disciplinary authorities, and Internal Affairs Service (IAS), of the Philippine National Police. It establishes the scope, nature, and definitions relating to administrative cases to be filed against Police Officer.

Mr. Teddy Vapor, the Municipal Administrator/HRMO raised his concerned that PLEB Member shall have mandatory trainings to capacitate DILG, and NAPOLCOM personnel and local government units, specially PLEB Members in the performance of their functions, duties and responsibilities. His knowledge of allocation of funds, shall be include in the next annual budget hearing in an item and the corresponding appropriation for the maintenance and operation of the PLEB, which is under the office of the Municipal Mayor.

Hon. Casas, raised his concerned, that he asked to the author of this Ordinance to provide a copy of the NAPOLCOM Memorandum Circular No. 2016-002, and among others.

With no further arguments from the invite persons, Hon. Compra, moved for the adjournment of the meeting. The Public hearing adjourned at 11:20 AM.
