**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The Municipality of Santa Fe has now an objective and the Ordinance to primarily promote the development, conservation, and sustainable management of public parks and green open spaces to enhance the municipal's livability, environmental quality, and overall well-being of the residents, integrate urban green spaces into planning processes to ensure their proper allocation, design, accessibility and maintenance promote an eco-friendly and pollution free municipality for the residents and tourists and support rural well-being by providing spaces for rest, relaxation and exercise and by keeping temperatures down to help combat climate change.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Sangguniang Bayan of Santa Fe, Leyte in a session duly assembled that;

**SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.** This ordinance shall be known as the "Urban Green Spaces Ordinance"

**SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY.** It is hereby declared the policy of the state to develop green spaces in all public and private institution to all barangays of the Municipality to promote balance and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature, improve ambient air quality, enhance the health and quality of life of the people, and cultivate a sense of community identity and camaraderie.

**SECTION 3. SCOPE.** This Ordinance shall cover public and private institutions or establishments in all barangays of the Municipality of Santa Fe, Leyte.

**SECTION 4. DECLARATION OF GREEN SPACES.** Every barangay shall establish, develop and maintain public green spaces, including but not limited to permanent forest, tree parks, or watersheds with an aggregate size equivalent to at least twenty percent (20%), and for the private institution of at least five percent (5%) for

vegetation of its entire area within one (1) year from approval of this Ordinance. Provided, that the forest, park, or watershed may be in one or more places within the Local Government Unit's respective jurisdiction; Provided, that, for purposes of this Ordinance, public green spaces shall refer to an open area of grass, trees, or other vegetation set apart for leisure recreational, or aesthetic purposes for the public.

**SECTION 5. Establishment and Maintenance of Public/Green Open Spaces.**

- a. The Municipality of Santa Fe shall establish and maintain public parks and green open spaces in accordance with existing laws, regulations, and guidelines set forth by the national government especially the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, and other government agencies;
- b. The designated public parks/green open spaces shall be preserved and protected from any form of encroachment, destruction, illegal activities that may compromise the ecological integrity or public accessibility;
- c. In developing the said spaces, the municipality is encouraged to utilize native and indigenous flora and fauna species; and,
- d. The municipality shall provide necessary resources, personnel, and equipment to ensure the effective maintenance, up keeping and improvement of the public park and green open spaces.

**SECTION 6. CREATION OF THE GREEN SPACES DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE.**

A green spaces development committee, hereinafter referred to as the "committee" is hereby created with the Local Chief Executive (LCE) as chairman. Municipal Environment and Natural Resources office (MENRO), Municipal Engineering Office (MEO), Department of Education (DepEd), Municipal Local Government Operation Officer (MLGOO) and Tourism Office as member. The committee shall initiate, coordinate and monitor all the activities of green green spaces development. The committee shall tap any, and/or all government agencies, corporations and instrumentalities, non-government organizations, people's organizations and the barangay as local committees to provide resources and assistance in the implementation of this Ordinance. The committee shall have the power to promulgate pertinent rules and regulations as may be necessary to fully implement the objectives and purposes of this Ordinance within a period not exceeding the following powers and functions;

**A. The Municipal Engineering Office shall:**

- i. provides the necessary technical data with respect to the classification location, condition, and length of all existing vacant public lots in the Barangays; and,
- ii. Provides the necessary tools, equipment, and manpower to effect the development of green spaces.

**B. The Municipal Local Government Operation Officer (MLGOO) shall:**

- i. mobilizes all LGUs to ensure prompt and effective implementation of this Ordinance in every barangay; and
- ii. Effect the apprehension and prosecution of all persons violating the provisions of this Ordinance.

**SECTIONS 9. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS.** The MEO, in consultation with The MLGOO, MENRO, and Tourism Office shall formulate the implementing Rules and regulations of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 10. APPROPRIATIONS.** The fund needed for the implementation of this Ordinance shall be taken at least 0.5% of the National Tax Allocation Share under the 20% Development Fund of the Municipality, or as the need arises. Provided, that funds for this purpose shall also be included the following year And every year thereafter for its maintenance.

**SECTION 11. INFORMATION AND EDUCATION.** The Public Information Office under the Municipal Mayor and the Public Information Officer of the Sangguniang Bayan of Santa Fe shall ensure the widest information and education to inform the residents of all barangays of the municipality about the provisions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 12. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If for any reason, any provision of this Ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional or invalid, the other sections or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and Effect.

**SECTION 13. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All laws, decrees, orders, rules and regulations or parts thereof which are inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 14. EFFECTIVITY.** This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its posting and publication.

**ENACTED** this **09<sup>th</sup>** day of **September 2024** during the **33<sup>rd</sup> Regular Session** of the Sangguniang Bayan at the **Sangguniang Bayan Session Hall, Santa Fe, Leyte.**

34 i. Identifies, assess and manage the hazards, vulnerabilities and risks that may occur in public parks  
35 and green spaces.


36 ***F. Municipal Planing Development Coordinator (MPDC) shall;***

37 i. Provide principles of open space planning, key considerations, open space gap analysis and develop  
38 strategic priorities and actions.

39 ***G. Agriculture's Office shall;***

40 i. Develop urban agriculture, green space policies need to redefine green spaces.

41 **SECTION 7. PROHIBITED ACTS.(read.....)** No person shall engage in any of the following  
42 activities within the public parks and green open spaces.



- 1 a. Unauthorized construction, alteration, or demolition of structures, including fences, walls, or any
- 2 form of enclosure.
- 3 b. Dumping. Littering, or improper disposal of waste materials.
- 4 c. Destruction, removal, cutting or vandalism of vegetation, trees, or any natural features;
- 5 d. Unauthorized hunting, trapping, or disturbance of wildlife found therein;
- 6 e. Operation of motorized vehicles in the said areas, unless specifically authorized;
- 7 f. Setting fires or burning materials, except in designated areas and with proper permits; and
- 8 g. Engaging in any other activities that pose the threat to public safety, disturb the peace, or violate
- 9 other ordinances, existing laws and regulations.

10 **SECTION 8. PERSON LIABLE AND PENALTIES.(read.....)** Any person who destroys or

11 damage structures, and/or litter in the public green spaces shall be punished with a fine of 500 pesos

12 (P500.00) for the first offense, one thousand pesos (P1,000.00) for the second offense and two

13 thousand pesos (P2,000.00) for the third and final offense.

14 **SECTIONS 9. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS.(read.....)** The MEO, in

15 consultation with the MLGOO, MENRO, and Tourism Office shall formulate the implementing Rules

16 and regulations of this Ordinance.
