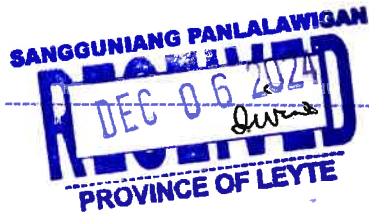




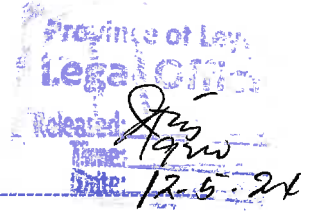

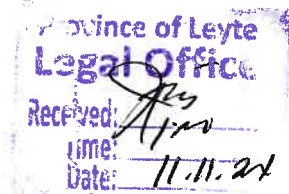

**MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 24-15
 SERIES OF 2024**

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING KATUWANG SA DIWA AT GAWA SA MASAGANANG ANI AT MATAAS NA KITA (KADIWA) NG PANGULO (KNP) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BURAUEN, LEYTE AND WITH INTEGRATION OF THE ONE-CROP-ONE BARANGAY PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Katuwang sa Diwa at Gawa para sa Masaganang Ani at Mataas na Kita (KADIWA) was launched and spearheaded by the Department of Agriculture (DA) in 2019, in collaboration with farmers and enterprises registered in the *Sagip Saka* Registry System for Basic Sectors Agriculture (RSBSA) which seeks to empower the community by providing a direct and effective farm-to-consumer food supply chain. The implementation of this program is reiterated by the President Ferdinand R. Marcos, Jr. during his State of the Nation Address (SONA) citing “The KNP system enabled the public to buy goods at cheaper rates and the farmers to sell their crops without having to worry about transportation cost.”;

WHEREAS, the KADIWA ng Pangulo program is a government initiative aimed at providing affordable and accessible food and agricultural products directly to consumers by bridging the gap between producers and consumers. This program seeks to enhance food security, support local farmers, and stimulate the local economy. The Municipality of Burauen, Leyte, recognizing the importance of these objectives, proposes the establishment of the KADIWA ng Pangulo program within its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, the program will ensure a steady supply of affordable and nutritious food to residents. It will reduce dependency on external sources by promoting local produce. By providing a direct market for their products, local farmers will benefit from fairer prices and reduced transportation costs. The program will encourage sustainable farming practices and increase farmers' incomes. The initiative will generate employment opportunities within the municipality. It will promote entrepreneurship to people's organizations and cooperatives and the growth of small and medium enterprises (SMEs) related to agriculture and food processing. Residents will have access to fresh and affordable food products. The program will foster healthier eating habits and improve overall community health.

WHEREAS, the HAPAG (Halina't Magtanim ng Prutas At Gulay) sa Barangay Project is an initiative of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) in the Philippines aimed at promoting urban agriculture and enhancing food security at the community level. The project encourages local government units (LGUs), particularly barangays (villages), to engage in the cultivation of fruits and vegetables to ensure a steady supply of nutritious food for their constituents. The Municipality of Burauen recognizes the importance of agricultural development and the need to support local farmers through innovative programs. The One-Crop-One-Barangay Program aims to promote agricultural specialization, improve crop yields, and ensure sustainable farming practices in each barangay. The KADIWA ng Pangulo initiative is designed to provide

market access to local farmers, enabling them to sell their produce directly to consumers and improving their income;

WHEREAS, integrating the One-Crop-One-Barangay Program into the KADIWA ng Pangulo initiative will strengthen the local agricultural economy and benefit both producers and consumers;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Burauen, Leyte, in regular session assembled, that:

SECTION 1 – Title. This ordinance shall be known as, “**Burauen KADIWA ng Pangulo (KNP) Ordinance**”.

SECTION 2 – Declaration of Policy. It is hereby declared the policy of the Municipality of Burauen to:

- 2.1. Enhance food security by providing affordable and accessible food products to residents.
- 2.2. Support local farmers by providing direct market access and fair prices for their produce.
- 2.3. Stimulate the local economy by promoting local agricultural products and creating employment opportunities.

SECTION 3 – Objectives. This Ordinance is intended to support the implementation of KADIWA ng Pangulo (KNP) in the Municipality of Burauen, Leyte with the integration of One-Crop-One-Barangay Program, with DA, DTI, DOLE and DILG with the aim of achieving the following Objectives:


- 3.1. Establish and operationalize the KADIWA ng Pangulo center within Burauen, Leyte;
- 3.2. To promote agricultural specialization in each barangay;
- 3.3. To enhance the productivity and sustainability of local farming practices;
- 3.4. Create a reliable and efficient supply chain connecting local farmers and consumers;
- 3.5. To increase participation of local farmers and enterprises as well as consumers to KNP;
- 3.6. Implement training programs for farmers on sustainable farming practices and business management;
- 3.7. Encourage community participation and support for the program; and
- 3.8. Monitor and evaluate the impact of the program on local food security, economy, and farmers' livelihoods.

SECTION 4 – Definition of Terms. For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following terms shall be defined as follows:

- 4.1. *KADIWA ng Pangulo* - A government initiative aimed at providing affordable and accessible food and agricultural products directly to consumers.
- 4.2. *One-Crop-One-Barangay (OC-OB)* - is a community-driven agricultural initiative aimed at enhancing local agricultural productivity and economic stability by encouraging each barangay (village) to specialize in the cultivation of a single, strategically chosen crop.
- 4.3. *Farmers' Cooperative* - An association of farmers united to achieve common economic interests and mutual aid in the production and marketing of agricultural products.
- 4.4. *Sustainable Farming Practices* - Agricultural methods that maintain the productivity and usefulness of the land over time, promoting environmental, economic, and social sustainability.

SECTION 5 – Policy Content and Guidelines.

- 5.1. KNP shall run every third Monday of every month;
- 5.2. KNP shall have 1 market area with 9 product clusters as to the One-Crop-One-Barangay Program with drop-off points for transport of produce with “Bagsakan Day” on a Friday of the month at Trading Post;
- 5.3. Agricultural produce such as rice, vegetables, and fruits of farmers for the various Barangays;
- 5.4. Processed goods both food and non-food produce by MSMEs;
- 5.5. *Mercado* stalls (Ready-to-eat-food) for micro-enterprise of the LGU;
- 5.6. The venue of the KNP may be in a closed or an open space area provided there are available tents, tables and chairs. It should be well – ventilated and with areas that can accommodate stalls for selling products, area for eating and parking;
- 5.7. No registration fee shall be collected from participating farmer/MSME merchants nor visiting consumers.



SECTION 6 – Establishment of KADIWA ng Pangulo Center.

- 6.1. The Municipality of Burauen shall establish KADIWA ng Pangulo center in strategic location within its jurisdiction to serve as a marketplace for local farmers and consumers;
- 6.2. The Municipal Agriculture Office, in coordination with the Municipal Planning and Development Office, shall identify and develop suitable location for the center;
- 6.3. The center shall be equipped with necessary facilities for storage, display, and sale of agricultural products.

SECTION 7 – Management and Operations.

7.1. A local committee, to be known as the KADIWA ng Pangulo Management Committee, shall be formed to oversee the implementation and operations of the program.


- o The committee shall be composed of representatives from the Municipal Agriculture Office, Municipal Planning and Development Office, MLGOO, DTI MSMEs, farmers’ organization/ cooperatives, and other relevant stakeholders.



7.2. The committee shall set guidelines for the procurement, pricing, and sale of products in the centers.

7.3. Partnerships with the Barangay Council with One-Crop-One-Barangay Program, local farmers, peoples’ organization/ cooperatives, and relevant stakeholders shall be established to ensure a steady supply of products to the KNP center.

SECTION 8 – Roles and Responsibilities. KADIWA ng Pangulo (KNP) is a joint program and collaborative arrangement among concerned government agencies of national government and local government units. It also encourages full participation and support of non-government organizations, business sectors and cooperatives. The MLGU shall have the following responsibilities in the implementation of KNP as follows:

SECTION 9 – Financial Support and Incentives

- 9.1. The Municipality shall allocate funds for the initial setup of One-Crop-One-Barangay Program and operational costs of the KADIWA ng Pangulo center.
- 9.2. Incentives such as tax breaks and subsidies shall be provided to participating farmers and businesses to encourage their active involvement in the program.

SECTION 10 – Training and Capacity Building.

- 10.1. The Municipal Agriculture Office, in collaboration with relevant agencies and organizations, shall organize regular training sessions for farmers on best practices in agriculture, marketing, and business management.
- 10.2. Workshops and seminars shall also be conducted for community members to raise awareness about the benefits of the program and encourage their participation.

SECTION 11 – Monitoring and Evaluation.

- 11.1. A monitoring and evaluation framework shall be developed to track the progress and impact of the program.
- 11.2. Regular assessments shall be conducted, and strategies shall be adjusted as needed to ensure the program's effectiveness and sustainability.

SECTION 12 – Repealing Clause. All ordinances, resolutions, executive orders and all other issuances inconsistent herewith are deemed to be repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 13 – Separability Clause. If any of the provisions of this ordinance is declared invalid and unconstitutional, other parts or provisions hereof shall continue to be in full force and effect.


SECTION 14 – Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
