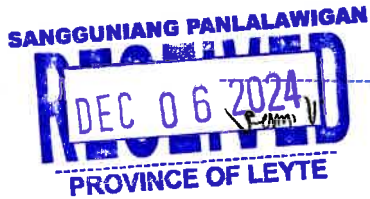

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Electric Vehicle For Hire (EV) or E-Trike began plying the streets of Poblacion Isabel, Leyte in 2015 upon the passage of Municipal Ordinance No. 16-15-009 : An Ordinance for the Franchise and Regulation of Electric Vehicles-For-Hire in the Municipality of Isabel, Leyte, to Levy fees and Charges for the Operation Thereof, and for Other Purposes. This was amended in 2021 through Municipal Ordinance No. 18-21-002 where it increased the allowed number of E-trike units from 150 to a maximum of 200 units. The Sangguniang Bayan recently received a petition letter from a number of E-trike operators and drivers requesting the increase of the number of E-Trike Units allowed as well as an increase of the schedule of fares. Fourteen years hence on since the passage of Municipal Ordinance 16-15-009, the Sangguniang Bayan deemed it necessary to revisit and update the E-Trike Ordinances to answer and meet the changes and needs of the current time, hence this measure.

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 19-24-003

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 16-15-009, AND MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 18-21-002. OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE ORDINANCES REGULATING THE ELECTRIC VEHICLE FOR HIRE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the 19th Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Isabel, Leyte.

SECTION 1. Amendments – The following provisions of Municipal Ordinance No. 16-15-009 are hereby amended and to read as follows:

SECTION 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS – AS USED IN THIS Ordinance, the terms:

d. Poblacion – Refers to the five (5) urban barangays of the Municipality of Isabel, Leyte specifically Barangays Sto. Niño, Marvel, and the three (3) Relocation Barangays of Sto. Rosario, San Roque, and Sta. Cruz.

SECTION 5. ISSUANCE OF Electric Vehicle Operator Permit – Terms and Conditions therefore:

a. The total number of EVOP issuance for the entire municipality shall be up to a maximum of Four Hundred Thirty (430) units only.

d. In relation to the preceding paragraph, any application for EVOP must be supported with the following documents:

j. Senior Citizens & PWD	P 5.00
k. Children below 2 yrs old	Free

SECTION 7. OPERATING CONDITIONS:

f. Drivers of EV-for-Hire must secure an LGU-issued official EV-for-Hire Driver's ID which shall be worn at all time while driving the EV unit. A copy of a valid LTO issued Driver's License or An Accomplishment Certificate of Driver's Proficiency Training signed by the Isabel Police (PNP) Traffic Personnel and/or the Chairperson SB Committee, is a requirement in applying for the EV-for-Hire Driver's ID.

g. An EV-for-hire unit shall have two rows of passenger seats with a seating capacity of two (2) passengers each row located at the back of the driver either facing each other or both facing forward. Each EV-for-hire unit shall have a maximum of four (4) duly seated passengers only. Sitting of passenger beside the driver is strictly prohibited.

k. Drivers of EV-for-Hire must maintain proper hygiene and shall wear the prescribed uniform by their association and with shoes. Wearing of a hood or any face covering is strictly prohibited for identification purposes.

l. An EV-for-Hire unit shall have a service lifespan of five (5) years, subject to annual inspection for road worthiness during the renewal of the issuance of the EVOP.

m. All Electric Tricycle (e-trike) units shall carry a trash bin inside for the passengers use.

SECTION 2. REPEALING CLAUSE -All other ordinances or any parts thereof which are inconsistent herewith are deemed repeated or modified accordingly.

SECTION 3. SEPARIBILITY CLAUSE - If, for any other reasons, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, the rest of the provisions hereof which are not affected thereby, shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and after ten (10) days from date a copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the Municipal Hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places within the Municipality.

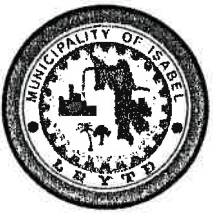

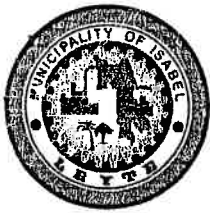

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The growing number of electric vehicles-for-hire plying the major thoroughfares in the Poblacion of Isabel has raised concerns over traffic safety. The recent turn-out of events indicates a parallel growth in the rate of road accidents which, most often than not, involve this type of vehicle. There is a common perception that the problem could be the result of the lack of strict regulations in the operation of electric vehicles in the municipality.

Hence, the following measure...

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 16-15-009
 (Series of 2015)

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE FRANCHISE AND REGULATION OF ELECTRIC VEHICLES-FOR-HIRE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ISABEL, LEYTE, TO LEVY FEES AND CHARGES FOR THE OPERATION THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED, by the 16th Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Isabel, Province of Leyte, in session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE – This Ordinance shall be entitled “ELECTRIC VEHICLES – FOR – HIRE FRANCHISE AND REGULATION ORDINANCE OF ISABEL, LEYTE, 2015”

SECTION 2. PURPOSE – The main purpose of this Ordinance is to establish franchising and regulatory system which will contain the total number of electric vehicles-for-hire in the municipality and to have control in the limit of such vehicles that are allowed to operate within the poblacion of the municipality.

SECTION 3. SCOPE OF APPLICATION – The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to all electric vehicles-for-hire operating or operated within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality of Isabel, Leyte.

- a. ELECTRIC VEHICLE-FOR-HIRE – shall refer to any three or more-wheeled vehicle run by electric motor, instead of an internal combustion engine (ICE) fed by gasoline or diesel, which gets energy from rechargeable batteries, operated to render transport services to the general public for a fee. For brevity, it can also be termed as “EV-FOR-HIRE” where “E” stands for Electric, and “V” for Vehicle.
- b. ELECTRIC VEHICLE-FOR-HIRE OPERATION PERMIT (OR EVOP) – shall refer to a document granting franchise or license to operate which is issued by the LGU of Isabel to a person, natural or juridical, allowing him/it to operate EV-for-hire over zones/routes specified herein.
- c. ZONE / ROUTE – shall refer to a contiguous area or block, say a subdivision, or a barangay, or a route where an EV-for-hire may operate without fixed origin or destination but within the poblacion of the municipality only.

SECTION 5. ISSUANCE OF EVOP – Terms and Conditions therefor:

- a. The total number of EVOP issuances for the entire municipality shall be up to a maximum of One Hundred Fifty (150) units only
- b. Only Filipino citizens, and partnerships or corporations with sixty (60%) Filipino equity, are qualified to be operators of EV-for-hire. However, no EVOP shall be granted unless the applicant is in possession of units with valid registration papers from the Land Transportation Office (LTO).
- c. The grantee of an EVOP must carry a common carrier’s insurance sufficient to answer for any liability it may incur to passengers and third parties in case of accidents.
- d. In relation to the preceding paragraph, any application for an EVOP must be supported with the following documents:
 - 1. Proof of citizenship or proof of 60% Filipino equity in the case of partnership/corporation;
 - 2. Valid registration papers of the unit from the LTO; and
 - 3. Common carrier’s insurance policy.
- e. The above-mentioned documents shall be inspected by the Chairman of the Committee on Transportation and Communication or, in the absence thereof, the Chairman of the Committee on Trade and Industry, together with any police officer assigned to the traffic section of the local PNP unit, to verify their authenticity and validity. If found authentic and valid, a certification to that effect shall be issued by the committee chairman concerned.
- f. Before an EV-for-hire can operate, there must be an inspection to be made on the unit by the persons above-mentioned in order to determine its suitability for transport services and, in like manner, a certification shall be issued concerning thereto.
- g. After all the requirements have been complied with, the EVOP shall then be issued duly signed by the Chairman of the Committee on Transportation.

SECTION 6. SCHEDULE OF FARES – a) The following shall be the rate of fares for EVs-for-hire from any point to any destination within the poblacion of the municipality:

a. Regular Fare	-	-	-	-	P 5.00
b. (With Senior Citizen’s I.D) Senior Citizen	-	-	-	-	4.00
c. Person with disability (PWD)	-	-	-	-	4.00
d. Student or Pupil (With School I.D)	-	-	-	-	4.00
e. Children, two (2) yrs. Old & below	-	-	-	-	Free of Charge

- b) The Schedule of fares shall be posted prominently on the conspicuous part of the EV-for-hire unit.

SECTION 7. OPERATING CONDITIONS - (a) No operator shall be allowed to operate more than two (2) units of EV-for-hire in the municipality.

(b) Each EV-for-hire unit shall be assigned and bear an identification number issued by the LGU, aside from its LTO license plate number, if available.

(c) For safety reasons, the operation of EV-for-hire shall be confined only within the poblacion and specifically up to the Isabel National High School (INHS) in the East and up to Isabel National Comprehensive School (INCS) in the West.

(d) An operator wishing to stop service completely, or to suspend service for more than one (1) month, should report in writing such service stoppage to the Sangguniang Bayan which originally granted the EVOP prior thereto.

(e) The EVOP shall be valid for one (1) year, renewable this January 2016 and every January each year thereafter. Change of ownership of a unit or transfer of EVOP shall be construed as an amendment to an EVOP and shall require appropriate approval of the Sangguniang Bayan through the Chairman of the Committee on Transportation.

(f) Drivers of EV-for-hire must hold Driver's License issued by the Land Transportation Office (LTO) and must have Driver's ID issued by the LGU and shall always follow traffic rules and regulations.

(g) A Passenger-type EV-for-hire, with corresponding "6-Passenger Capacity" marking on its side, shall be allowed to carry Six (6) duly-seated passengers only, while a Cargo-type EV-for-hire, with corresponding "8-Passenger Capacity" marking on its side, shall be allowed to carry Eight (8) passengers only.

(h) An EV-for-hire shall be allowed to operate like a taxi service, i.e., service rendered upon demand and without a fixed route but within the poblacion.

(i) EV-for-hire units should have a uniform color which is ORANGE throughout its entire body.

(j) During night time operation, EV-for-hire units should always switch "on" their head lights, for safety reason.

SECTION 8. FEES and CHARGES - (a) The following fees and charges shall be imposed by the Local Treasury Office:

SECTION 10. PENAL PROVISIONS / PENALTIES – (a) The following penalties shall be imposed for violations of this Ordinance

1. For late filing – 25% of the Filing fee if the unit is not operating. If it is operating, it will be fined PhP 1,000.00 and the unit shall be impounded. From the anniversary date of the EVOP, the operator is given a 60-day grace period within which to make a renewal of the same, beyond of which warrants its cancellation.
2. For driving without licence duly issued by the LTO – PhP 500.00 fine
3. For charging fares more than those prescribed under the Ordinance – PhP 500.00 fine
4. For overloading – PhP 200.00 fine
5. For operating more than two (2) units – PhP 2,500.00 fine plus cancellation of the EVOP
6. For operating unit without an identification number – PhP 500.00 fine
7. For failure to post the schedule of fares on a conspicuous part of the unit – PhP 200.00 fine
8. For operating a unit in violation of sec. 7 (c) of the Ordinance – PhP 500.00 fine plus suspension of EVOP for three (3) months.
9. For change of ownership of unit or transfer of EVOP without appropriate approval of the SB Committee on Transportation Chairman. – cancellation of EVOP
10. For non-observance of "switched-on headlight during night time" – PhP1,000.00
11. For non-compliance of side mirrors installed at left and right frontal sides of the EV-for-hire unit – PhP200.00
12. For non-compliance of reflectorized stickers *stuck on conspicuous spot/s of the unit – PhP200.00.
13. For non-observance of One-Orange color policy -- PhP1,000.00
14. Driving without proper driving attire and shoes – PhP 200.00

(b) Violation of item no. 2 to item no. 7, except item no. 5, for the third time or more shall warrant the suspension of the EVOP for three (3) months. Violation made for the 6th time shall warrant the indefinite cancellation of the EVOP.

(c) Violation of Section 7 (c) of this Ordinance for the third time shall warrant the indefinite cancellation of the EVOP.

(d) Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be meted the above-mentioned fines, whichever is applicable, or an imprisonment of Five (5) days, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 11. REPEALING CLAUSE – All other Ordinances or any parts thereof which are inconsistent herewith are deemed repealed or modified accordingly

SECTION 12. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provisions of this Code shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 13. EFFECTIVITY– This Ordinance shall take effect after the lapse of ten (10) days from the date a copy hereof is posted in a bulletin board at the lobby of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) conspicuous places of the local unit.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

For several years already, it has been noticed that the number of electric vehicles-for-hire in the municipality whose franchises have been renewed annually has dwindled considerably. The reason to it is that, among other things, there is a requisite for registration or renewal application prescribed in the local ordinance pertinent to this type of vehicles which the operators find very impossible to comply with.

As a matter of fact, almost all of the units now operating in the local streets are colorum or illegal public transports.

As a solution thereto, hence this measure.

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 18-21-002

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 16-15-009, AN ORDINANCE FOR THE FRANCHISE AND REGULATION OF ELECTRIC VEHICLES-FOR-HIRE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ISABEL, LEYTE, TO LEVY FEES AND CHARGES FOR THE OPERATION THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the 18th Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Isabel, Leyte.

SECTION 1. Amendments – The following provisions of Municipal Ordinance No. 16-15-009 are hereby amended and to read as follows:

SECTION 5. ISSUANCE OF Electric Vehicle Operator Permit – Terms and Conditions therefore:

- a. The total number of EVOP issuance for the entire municipality shall be up to a maximum of Two Hundred (200) units only.
- b. Only Filipino Citizens, and partnerships, or corporations with sixty percent (60%) Filipino equity, are qualified to be operators of EV-for-hire. Furthermore, residents in Isabel are to be prioritized as operators/ owners of the same.
- d. In relation to the preceding paragraph, any application for EVOP must be supported with the following documents:

1. Proof of citizenship or proof of 60% Filipino equity in the case of Partnership/corporation;
2. Common carrier's insurance policy.

SECTION 7. OPERATING CONDITIONS – (a) Each EV-for-hire unit shall be assigned with, or bear, an identification number issued by the LGU.

(b) For safety reasons, the operation of EV-for-hire shall be confined only within the poblacion or it may be allowed to operate beyond thereof but specifically up to the Isabel National High School (INHS) campus in the East and up to the Isabel National Comprehensive School (INCS) campus in the West only.

(c) An operator wishing to stop service completely, or to suspend service for more than one (1) month, shall report in writing such service stoppage to the registration or renewal section of the Municipal Treasury Office.

(d) Prior to the issuance and/or renewal of the Electric Vehicle Operator Permit or EVOP, it should be inspected by authorized LGU employee that its chassis, body and engine are in good condition. LTO registration will no longer be required on the corresponding EV-for-hire units prior to the issuance/renewal of the EVOP.

(e) The EVOP shall be valid for one (1) year and renewable every month of January of every year thereafter, starting from January 1 up to March 31. Change of ownership of a unit or the transfer of EVOP shall be construed as an amendment to an EVOP and shall require the approval of the Sangguniang Bayan thru the Chairperson of the Committee on Transportation.

(f) Drivers of EV-for-hire must possess a Drivers license issued by the Land Transportation Office (LTO) and likewise secure a Driver's ID from the LGU and shall follow traffic rules and regulations always.

(g) A passenger-type EV-for-hire, with a corresponding "6-passenger capacity" marking on its side, shall be allowed to carry a maximum of six (6) duly seated passengers only, while a cargo-type WEV-for-hire, with corresponding "8- passenger capacity" marking on its side, shall be allowed to carry a maximum of eight (8) duly seated passengers only.

(h) An EV-for-hire shall be allowed to operate like a taxi service, i.e. service rendered upon demand and without a fixed route but within the poblacion area only or beyond but up to the INHS campus in the East and the INCS campus in the West.

(i) Every EV-for-hire unit shall have a uniform color, which is ORANGE, painted throughout its entire body.

(i) During night time, EV-for-hire units shall always switch "ON" their headlights.

SECTION 2. REPEALING CLAUSE -All other ordinances or any parts thereof which are inconsistent herewith are deemed repeated or modified accordingly.

SECTION 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If, for any other reasons, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, the rest of the provisions hereof which are not affected thereby, shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and after ten (10) days from date a copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the Municipal Hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places within the Municipality.





