NOTICE OF HEARING

Applicant, ST. JUDE THADDEUS INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY, INC., a 100% Filipino domestic corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of Philippine Laws, registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission (S.E.C.), and a grantee of a congressional franchise under R.A. No. 11583, requests for the issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC) to install, operate and maintain an FM RADIO BROADCASTING STATION IN MAASIN CITY, LEYTE.

Applicant, further requests for the issuance of a Provisional Authority (PA) pending final determination of the application.

In view thereof, this will be heard by this Commission on NOVEMBER 28, 2024, (THURSDAY) at eleven thirty in the morning (11:30A.M.) at the Legal Branch, 3rd Floor, NTC Building, National Telecommunications Commission, BIR Road, East Triangle, Diliman, Quezon City, via zoom hearing, wherein applicant shall present its compliance with the Commission's jurisdictional requirements, as well as its evidences, if warranted.

In lieu of face to face hearing, a virtual hearing shall be conducted. A link to join the virtual hearing will be sent to your e-mail address on the same day of hearing at least 15 minutes before the scheduled time. In connection to this, you are hereby ordered to send your e-mail address through legal@ntc.gov.ph and secretariat@ntc.gov.ph

However, should the hearing date be declared a holiday or non-working day due to force majeure, the said hearing shall be held on the NEXT regular working day.

At least fifteen (15) days before the date of hearing, applicant shall have published the Notice of Hearing in one (1) newspaper of general circulation and have served copies of the Notice of Hearing and the application including all annexes attached therewith to all affected parties by registered mail or through personal delivery, as furnished by the Commission.

Any party opposed to the granting of the application is hereby directed to appear at the scheduled hearing and must file its verified opposition, on or before the date of hearing, furnishing the applicant with a copy of the same. Failure on the part of any affected party to file its opposition on time and to appear at the scheduled hearing shall be construed as a waiver of its right to be heard and the Commission shall proceed to hear and decide the application on its merit.
