# MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 24-Series of 2024

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PROHIBITIONS ON THE USE OF SCHOOL GROUNDS AT THE BURAUEN COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOR SAFETY AND SECURITY PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the safety and security of students, faculty, and staff, at the Burauen Community College "BCC" is of paramount importance to the community;

WHEREAS, the Burauen Community College is owned and operated by the Local Government Unit, dedicated to maintaining a safe and conducive learning environment;

WHEREAS, unauthorized access to school grounds and buildings poses significant risks to the safety and well-being of the college community;

WHEREAS, establishing clear limitations on the use and rental of school grounds is essential to protect the integrity of the educational environment;

WHEREAS, the Burauen Community College has a responsibility to ensure that all activities conducted on its premises are in alignment with its mission and values;

WHEREAS, previous incidents have highlighted the need for stringent regulations regarding access to school grounds to prevent potential disturbances and hazards;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Burauen in regular session assembled THAT:

#### **Section 1. TITLE**

This Ordinance shall be known as the "Ordinance Limiting Use of BCC School Grounds".


#### Section 2. PURPOSE

This ordinance establishes limitations on the use and rental of school grounds at the Burauen Community College to protect the welfare of all individuals on campus and to mitigate risks associated with unauthorized access.

## **Section 3: DEFINITIONS**

- a. School Grounds: Refers to all outdoor areas, fields, facilities, buildings, and property owned or operated by the Burauen Community College, including the interiors of all buildings, parking lots, sports fields, gardens, classrooms, and administrative spaces.
- Community College who are enrolled and in good standing with the institution, as well as authorized representatives of the Local Government Unit who are engaged in official duties.
- Use: Refers to any activity conducted on school grounds, including but not limited to educational programs and classes, recreational activities and sports events, meetings,

workshops, conferences, student organization events, social gatherings, and any other organized activities.

## Section 4: LIMITATIONS ON USE AND RENTAL

- a. Access to school grounds and buildings is strictly limited to authorized users. Unauthorized access and use are not permitted under any circumstances.
- b. Unauthorized individuals or groups, including but not limited to former students, community members, or visitors, are strictly prohibited from accessing, using, or renting the school grounds or buildings at any time. This restriction aims to prevent potential safety hazards and ensure a secure educational environment.
- c. School grounds and facilities shall not be rented out to any individuals or groups under any circumstances. This prohibition is in place to maintain the safety and integrity of the educational environment.

### Section 5: LEGAL RESPONSIBILITY

- a. **Liability for Accidents:** The Burauen Community College or Local Government Unit shall not be liable for any accidents, injuries, or damages incurred by unauthorized individuals on school grounds, as such individuals are in violation of this ordinance.
- b. Waiver of Responsibility: By entering the school grounds, all unauthorized individuals acknowledge that they are trespassing and waive any rights to claim damages or seek compensation from the Burauen Community College or the Local Government Unit for any injuries or damages sustained while on the premises without permission.
- c. Reporting and Documentation: Authorized users are encouraged to report any suspiciously activity or unauthorized presence on campus to the College security personnel immediately. The Burauen Community College will maintain a record of such reports to ensure the safety and security of all authorized users and to document incidents that may impact liability.
- d. Compliance with Policies: All individuals and groups utilizing the school grounds must adhere to established policies and procedures. Failure to comply may result in removal from the premises and potential legal consequences.

#### **Section 6: ENFORCEMENT**

- a. College security personnel, in coordination with local law enforcement, are authorized to enforce this ordinance rigorously.
- b. Any unauthorized individual found on school grounds or in buildings will be subject to immediate removal and may face legal consequences, including but not limited to trespassing charges.
- Authorized users are expected to cooperate with enforcement personnel and may be held accountable for facilitating unauthorized access.

#### **Section 7. EFFECTIVITY**

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval by the Sangguniang Bayan of Burauen.
