#### MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 03 Series of 2024

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL TREASURER TO DEPUTIZE ALL BARANGAY TREASURERS WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF MATALOM, LEYTE IN THE COLLECTION OF COMMUNITY TAX.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 164 (b) of the Local Government Code of 1991, the Municipal Treasurer may deputize all Barangay Treasurers in the collection of Community Tax in their respective jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, the efficient collection of community taxes is vital for the development and maintenance of essential services within the municipality;

WHEREAS, the barangays as a Local Government Unit and as partners for progress of the Municipality of Matalom, Leyte need be given more powers, authority, responsibilities and resources for them to attain their fullest development;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED as it is hereby ORDAINED, in a session duly assembled, that:

**SECTION 1.** Deputation of Barangay Treasurers.

- 1. The Municipal Treasurer is hereby authorized to deputize all Barangay Treasurers for the issuance of community tax certificates within the barangay's jurisdiction;
- 2. Deputized Barangay Treasurers shall adhere to the guidelines and procedures established by the Municipal Treasurer for the collection of community taxes.

SECTION 2. Responsibilities of Deputized Barangay Treasurers.

- 1. Deputized Barangay Treasurers shall collect community taxes from residents within their respective barangays in accordance with the provisions of relevant laws and ordinances:
- 2. Deputized Barangay Treasurers shall remit all collected taxes to the Municipal Treasurer within the specified timelines and in the manner prescribed by municipal regulations;
- 3. Deputized Barangay Treasurers shall maintain accurate records of tax collections and transactions, providing regular reports to the Municipal Treasurer upon request.

SECTION 3. Sharing of Collections. All collections of Community Tax through the deputized barangay treasurer shall be divided into:

- 1. 50% shall be accrued to the general fund of the Municipality;
- 2. 50% shall be accrued to the Barangay where the tax is collected.

The sharing is pursuant to Section 164 (c) of the Local Government Code of 1991.

**SECTION 4. Cooperation and Assistance.** 

- 1. The Municipal Treasurer shall provide necessary training and support to deputized Barangay Treasurers to ensure effective tax collection.;
- 2. The Municipal Treasurer and deputized Barangay Treasurers shall cooperate closely to address any issues or concerns related to community tax collection promptly.

SECTION 5. IMPLEMENTATION. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and publication.

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and in effect.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval and after ten (10) days of posting of the same at three (3) conspicuous places in the Municipality.
