RESOLUTION NO. 2024-550

A RESOLUTION ENACTING ON THIRD AND FINAL READING, PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 2024-14, ENTITLED: AN ORDINANCE OPERATIONALIZING HEALTHY LEARNING INSTITUTIONS IN THE PROVINCE OF LEYTE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines declares that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, the Universal Health Care Act (Republic Act No. 11223) embodies the principle of an integrated and comprehensive approach to ensure that all Filipinos are health literate, provided with healthy living conditions, and protected from hazards and risks that could affect their health, whereby directing local government units to issue and implement effective health promotion policies and programs that promote health literacy and healthy lifestyle among their constituents. Furthermore, under Section 30, schools under the supervision of the Department of Education (DepEd) are designated as healthy settings;

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization (WHO) recognizes that health should be holistic, and that schools are regarded as a key setting for promoting the health, wellbeing, and development of children and adolescents;

WHEREAS, the Department of Health's Health Promotion Framework Strategy (HPFS) takes a life-course approach, and prioritizes health promotion among the youth; Furthermore, it identifies 7 priority areas for health promotion, specifically diet & physical activity, environmental health, immunization, substance use, mental health, sexual and reproductive health, violence & injury prevention;

WHEREAS, the Department of Education (DepEd), likewise recognizes the importance of health to education and aims to provide all learners and DepEd personnel with a sustainable holistic school

155 health and nutrition program towards healthier behaviors and better learning outcomes through its
156 OK sa DepEd program (DepEd Order No. 028, s. 2018);
157

158 **WHEREAS**, the Joint Department of Health – Department of Social Welfare and Development –
159 Department of Education – Commission on Higher Education – Legal Education Board – Technical
160 Education and Skills Development Authority – and Department of the Interior and Local Government
161 Administrative Order No. 2022-0001 enjoins local governments to support learning institutions in
162 implementing policies, programs, and efforts for health education and promotion;
163

164 **WHEREAS**, the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160) accords every local
165 government unit power and authority to promote general welfare within its territorial jurisdiction,
166 including the promotion of health and safety of its constituents;
167

168 **WHEREAS**, the Province of Leyte acknowledges the need for a strongly-supported, well-
169 coordinated, multi-sectoral approach to transform schools to become healthy learning institutions;
170

171 **WHEREAS**, this ordinance shall provide guidance and outlines roles and responsibilities of the
172 local government to operationalize Healthy Learning Institutions program in the Province of Leyte;
173

174 **NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of Honorable Raissa J. Villasin, and duly seconded by Atty. Ronnan
175 Christian M. REposar, and Honorable MJ Luiny D. Lumen, be it

181 **ORDINANCE OPERATIONALIZING THE HEALTHY LEARNING INSTITUTIONS IN THE PROVINCE OF LEYTE AND**

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189 **Section 1. Short Title.** This Ordinance shall be known as "The Healthy Learning Institutions
190 Ordinance of the Province of Leyte."
191

192 **Section 2. Declaration of Principles and Policies.** It is the policy of the Province of Leyte to
193 uphold the right to health and education of its constituents and instill health consciousness among
194 them. The Province of Leyte further recognizes that health promotion in learning institutions maximizes
195 the positive impact of education in learners' development. Towards this end, the Province of Leyte
196 shall adopt a settings-based approach that ensures an avenue for population-based health
197 interventions, age-appropriate health education, and implementation of health-promoting policies in
198 learning institutions.
199

200 **Section 3. Objectives.** This Ordinance seeks to:
201

- 202 a. Outline guiding principles for the realization of healthy learning institutions as
203 envisioned in the UHC Act;
- 204 b. Provide a framework for development and prioritization of healthy learning institution
205 programs and/or standards in accordance with existing laws;
- 206 c. Promote a settings-based approach for health promotion focusing on learning
207 institutions;
- 208 d. Provide support to learning institutions to meet the relevant standards for healthy
209 learning institutions; and
- 210 e. Establish a referral system for efficient delivery of healthcare and services to learners.
211

212 **Section 4. Scope.** Healthy learning institutions interventions shall cover all public and private
213 learning institutions as defined herein, within the jurisdiction of the Province of Leyte.
214

215 **Section 5. Governing Laws.** This Ordinance hereby adopts the following relevant and enforceable
216 national laws, rules, and other regulations, governing healthy learning institutions, such as but not
217 limited to:
218

- 219 a. Republic Act No. 11223. An Act Instituting Universal Health Care for All Filipinos,
 220 Prescribing Reforms in the Health Care System, and Appropriating Funds Therefor;
 221 b. Republic Act No. 10627. An Act Requiring All Elementary and Secondary Schools to
 222 Adopt Policies to Prevent and Address the Acts of Bullying in their Institutions;
 223 c. Republic Act No. 11036. An Act Establishing a National Mental Health Policy for the
 224 Purpose of Enhancing the Delivery of Integrated Mental Health Services, Promoting
 225 and Protecting the Rights of Persons Utilizing Psychiatric, Neurologic and Psychosocial
 226 Health Services, Appropriating Funds Therefor, and for Other Purposes;
 227 d. Republic Act No. 11313. Safe Spaces Act;
 228 e. Republic Act No. 9710. Magna Carta of Women;
 229 f. Republic Act No. 11053. An Act Prohibiting Hazing and Regulating Other Forms of
 230 Initiation Rites of Fraternities, Sororities, and Other Organizations, and Providing
 231 Penalties for Violations Thereof;
 232 g. Republic Act No. 11900. Vaporized Nicotine and Non-Nicotine Products Regulation
 233 Act;
 234 h. DOH-DSWD-DepEd-CHED-LEB-TESDA-DILG Joint Administrative Order No. 2022-0001.
 235 Guidelines on Healthy Settings Framework in Learning Institutions;
 236 i. Department of Health Administrative Order No. 2013-0013. National Policy and
 237 Strategic Framework on Adolescent Health and Development;
 238 j. Department of Education (DepEd) Order No. 40, s. 2012. DepEd Child Protection
 239 Policy;
 240 k. DepEd Memorandum No. 2015-0238. Guidelines in the Implementation of School-
 241 based Immunization;
 242 l. Executive Order No. 326, s. 1941. Regulating the Operation of Bars;
 243 m. Executive Order No. 26, s. 2017. Providing for the Establishment Smoke-Free
 244 Environments in Public and Enclosed Spaces;
 245 n. Executive Order No. 106, s. 2020. Prohibiting the Manufacture, Distribution, Marketing,
 246 and Sale of Unregistered and/or Adulterated Electronic Nicotine/Non-Nicotine Delivery
 247 Systems Heated Tobacco Products, and Other Novel Tobacco Products, Amending
 248 Executive Order No. 26 (s. 2017) and for Other Purposes.
 249

250 **Section 6. Definition of Terms.** The following terms shall be construed as follows:

- 251
- 252 a. **Health** – refers to a state of complete physical, mental and social well-being and not
 253 merely the absence of disease or infirmity (World Health Organization, 1948).
 254
- 255 b. **Health Promotion Framework Strategy (HPFS)** – refers to the Department of Health's 10-year
 256 national roadmap on health promotion, which shall be the basis of implementation of
 257 health promotion in the country, nationwide and locally.
 258
- 259 c. **Healthy Learning Institutions** – refer to learning institutions that foster health and well-being
 260 of learners and personnel. These are learning institutions that have met the standards
 261 jointly established by DOH and the education NGA (DSWD, DILG, DepEd, CHED, TESDA,
 262 LEB) to be recognized or awarded as such.
 263
- 264 d. **Learning Institutions** – refer to the institutions below that provide education to Filipino
 265 students and are encompassed by this policy:
 266
- 267 d.1. **Child Development Centers** – refer to early learning centers, public or private,
 268 that offer early education and/or child care programs for children zero (0) to
 269 four (4) years old, who are taught by Child Development Teacher(s)/Worker(s).
 270
- 271 d.2. **Community Learning Centers** – refer to physical spaces to house learning
 272 resources and facilities of a learning program for out-of-school children in
 273 special cases and adults. These are venues for face-to-face learning activities
 274 and other learning opportunities for community development and
 275 improvement of the people's quality of life.
 276
- 277 d.3. **Basic Education Institutions** – refer to institutions that provide basic education
 278 or education that is intended to meet basic learning needs which provide the
 279 foundation on which subsequent learning can be based, including institutions
 280 that provide kindergarten, elementary and/or secondary education, as well as
 281 alternative learning systems for out-of-school learners and those with special
 needs.

- 282 d.4. **Higher Education Institutions (HEI)** – refer to educational institutions, private or
 283 public, offering CHED-recognized higher education programs.
 284
 285 d.5. **Technical Vocational Institutions** – refer to institutions, whether public or private,
 286 offering Technical Vocational Education and Training registered program(s).
 287 These shall include TESDA Technology Institutions, Private Technical Vocational
 288 Institutes, HEIs, State Universities and Colleges, Local Colleges and Universities,
 289 Training Centers, and enterprises.
 290 d.6. **Legal Education Institutions (LEIs)** – refer to institutions, whether public or
 291 private, offering Legal Education Board (LEB)-registered law programs.
 292

293 **Section 7. General Guidelines for the Operationalization of Healthy Learning Institutions in the**
 294 **Province of Leyte:**
 295

- 296 a. The Provincial DSWD, DepEd, CHED LEB, TESDA, DOH, and DILG shall ensure the
 297 implementation and enforcement of established guidelines and standards for healthy
 298 learning institutions. They will provide necessary support to educational institutions to
 299 achieve these objectives and establish a recognition or compliance system for institutions
 300 to be designated as healthy learning institutions, in accordance with existing laws.
 301
 302 b. The policies, activities, and implementation of the healthy learning institutions framework
 303 shall align with the six pillars of the WHO Health Promoting Schools Framework: 1) Healthy
 304 School Policies, 2) Physical School Environment, 3) Social School Environment, 4) Health
 305 Skills and Education, 5) Links with Parents and Communities, and 6) Access to Health
 306 Services.
 307
 308 c. The goals of the healthy learning institutions framework shall be guided by the key priority
 309 areas of the Health Promoting Framework for Schools (HPFS): 1) Diet and Physical Activity,
 310 2) Environmental Health, 3) Immunization, 4) Substance Use, 5) Mental Health, 6) Sexual
 311 and Reproductive Health, and 7) Violence and Injury Prevention. Additionally, the
 312 overarching goal of promoting health literacy and awareness of health rights shall be
 313 integrated into the curriculum, programs, and activities of the learning institutions.
 314
 315 d. The Provincial DOH, DSWD, DepEd, CHED, LEB, TESDA and DILG shall ensure the promotion
 316 and protection of the health of students, faculty, and staff, with particular attention to
 317 individuals with disabilities, senior citizens, pregnant and lactating women, members of
 318 indigenous groups, indigents, rebel returnees, and members of the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual,
 319 Transgender, Queer or Questioning (LGBTQ+) community, as well as other vulnerable
 320 populations.
 321

322 **Section 8. Provincial School Board.** The Provincial School Board shall lead the planning, needs
 323 assessment and targeting, resource allocation, and monitoring of learning institutions in the LGU. In this
 324 capacity, the Board shall undertake the following:
 325

- 326 a. Review the capacities of learning institutions in its area and identify needs to
 327 operationalize and meet the standards for Healthy Learning Institutions;
 328 b. Determine, in accordance with the criteria set by the concerned national government
 329 agency in education, the annual budgetary needs to be able to support the
 330 operationalization of HLI in schools with priority given to public schools for equity
 331 considerations;
 332 c. Authorize the provincial treasurer to disburse funds from the local government's annual
 333 National Tax Allocation (NTA) or the Special Education Fund, as appropriate, to
 334 support Healthy Learning Institutions programs and activities pursuant to the budget
 335 prepared and in accordance with existing rules and regulations;
 336 d. Serve as an advisory committee to the Sanggunian concerned on educational
 337 matters such as, but not limited to, the necessity for and the uses of local
 338 appropriations for health and educational purposes;
 339 e. Monitor and evaluate with the Health Promotion Committee the implementation of HLI
 340 in the Province of Leyte, and submit an annual report to DOH and concerned national
 341 government agency in education, detailing the progress and impact of HLI;
 342 f. Provide Province-level recognition and awards for schools that consistently meet or
 343 surpass standards for Healthy Learning Institutions; and
 344 g. Coordinate with national-level government agencies for national recognition of the
 345 aforementioned schools.

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Section 9. Provincial Health Board. The local health board shall:

- a. In coordination with the Local School Board, oversee the implementation and evaluation of healthy learning institutions in the province;
- b. Propose to the Sanggunian the annual budgetary allocations for the operationalization of HLI;
- c. Provide assistance to learning institutions in ensuring that appropriate medical assistance of the Province of Leyte is accessible through the Information and Service Delivery Network (ISDN); and
- d. Ensure measures to ban the sale of, and prevent access to, tobacco products, alcohol and illicit drugs in schools and in the immediate vicinity.

Section 10. Provincial Health Promotion Unit. The Health Promotion Unit shall:

- a. Guide the development and planning of HLI in the Province of Leyte which may include, but not limited to the conduct of capacity building, advocacy activities;
- b. Recommend ordinances that strengthen and broaden existing health promotion policies, programs, and activities in learning institutions;
- c. Monitor and evaluate the implementation of HLI in the Province of Leyte, together with the local school board; and
- d. Closely coordinate with the Department of Education, Schools Division Office for the planning, implementation, monitoring & evaluation of HLI, including the establishment or strengthening Information and Service Delivery Networks to ensure appropriate medical assistance are available to learners through schools systems

Section 11. Reporting and Monitoring. The Province of Leyte, through the Local School Board, shall regularly monitor the implementation of HLI, and other indicators related to components of this Ordinance. Feedback from the schools shall be incorporated into the monitoring process. Monitoring data shall be consolidated by the local school board and reported on a regular basis by the Province of Leyte to DOH and the national government agencies in education.

Section 12. Appropriations. The funding and other resources necessary to implement the provisions of this Ordinance and implement other related programs may be sourced from the Gender and Development (GAD) fund, provided requirements for use of these funds are satisfied; Department of Health Centers for Health Development (DOH-CHD) subsidies for related programs, projects, and activities; and/or funding support or grants from other external development partners or non-government organizations (NGOs).

Section 13. Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR). The Province of Leyte may issue appropriate and relevant rules and regulations, as necessary for the proper implementation of any and all provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 14. Separability Clause. If for any reason, any section of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other sections which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force or in effect.

Section 15. Repealing Clause. All other orders and issuances, or parts thereof, inconsistent herewith are repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

Section 16. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its full publication in a newspaper of general circulation in Leyte, as required by the local government code.
