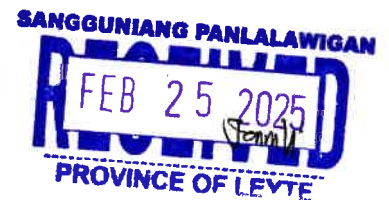


WHEREAS, this Plan is a necessary document that a local government unit has to devise setting the strategies therein in order to attain the development of the youth as partners in nation-building.


