

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE HALINA'T MAGTANIM NG PRUTAS AT GULAY (HAPAG) SA BARANGAY PROJECT IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TOLOSA, LEYTE

WHEREAS, the economy of the country depends heavily on the agricultural sector, thus challenges encountered, especially by farmers, have negative effects on the food security in the sountry;

WHEREAS, given its geographic location, the Philippines experienced numerous threats to food security brought about by strings of natural calamities that have rendered farm produce unusable or increased food prices due to food shortage;

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has further worsened the country's food insecurity, disrupting the availability and access to fresh and nutritious foods at affordable prices. When people are severely food insecure, they most likely experience hunger;

WHEREAS, to address the problem of hunger and food insecurity in the community, the National Government enacted several laws and implemented various initiatives and strategies to ensure sustainable and resilient production and food availability in the community;

WHEREAS, the project HAPAG aims to increase barangays' capacity for sustainable agriculture activities by strengthening the barangay community garden, which would encourage homes and communities to grow fresh fruits and vegetables;

WHEREAS, in support of the thrust of the current administration and cognizant of the role of barangays as essential partners of the national government in contributing to addressing hunger and ensuring food security in the barangay, the national government, through the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) introduced the Halina't Magtanim ng Prutas at Gulay

BE IT ENACTED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Tolosa in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the "HAPAG Ordinance" of the Municipality of Tolosa, Leyte.

SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS. The following terms as used in this Ordinance shall mean as follows:

- Aeroponics an integration of aquaculture (fish-farming) with hydroponics. Creates symbolic relationships between the plants and the fish. It uses the nutrient-rich waste from fish tanks to "fertigate" hydroponics production beds, and hydroponic bed cleans water for fish habitats.
- b) Aquaponics refers to a bio-system that incorporates recirculated aquaculture (fish farming) with hydroponic vegetable and herbs production to create a symbolic relationship between the plants and the fish.
- Barangay Community Garden refers to a piece of land or several patches of land operated and cultivated by the barangay for the purpose of planting and growing fruits and vegetables and fruit-bearing trees.
- Container Gardening refers to micro model farming where a family unit or household is producing fruits and vegetables in containers for personal consumption.
- Fruit Bearing Tree Planting refers to the planting of fruit-bearing trees for food production purposes such as papaya, bananas, mango, avocado, jackfruit, guyabano, coconut, guava, lemon, mulberry, etc.
- Hydroponics method of growing food using mineral nutrient solutions in water without soil (soilless-based)
- Square Foot Gardening is a simple method of creating small, orderly, and highly productive kitchen gardens.
- Vertical Gardening refers to a special kind of urban gardening suitable for small spaces, particularly for decorating the walls and roofs in various styles. It is an alternative method for gardening by expanding the scope of growing plants in a vertical space.

SECTION 3. DECLARATIONN OF POLICY. It is hereby declared a policy of the Municipality of Tolpsa to enjoin all barangays in establishing their respective Barangay Community Gardens as part of the Halina't Magtanim ng Prutas at Gulay (HAPAG) project of the municipality.

SECTION 4. ESTABLISHMENT OF BARANGAY COMMUNITY GARDEN. Pursuant to the declared policy in this ordinance, all barangays shall establish their Barangay Community Gardens in accordance with the following guidelines:

- a) The community garden shall be established in an available site to be determined by the Sangguniang Barangay. It shall have at least a minimum of two hundred (200) square meters of land or its equivalent in several patches of land.
- b) In establishing the community garden, the barangay shall identify which vegetable plants (e.g. leafy vegetables, fruit bearing plants, etc.) herbal plants, root crops (e.g. sweet potato, cassava, garlic, onion, etc.) they wish to grow.
- Barangays with suitable spaces are hereby encouraged to plant bamboos (kawayan)
- Barangays that do not have vacant areas, shall implement alternative gardening such as container gardening, hydroponics, aquaponics, and aeroponics.

e) Barangays are encouraged to coordinate and request from the LGU for any vacant property owned by the local government or private individuals who own a certain vacant/idle lot that can be used to establish the barangay community garden.

The barangay shall encourage their residents to set up their family vegetable garden and/or plant fruit bearing trees in any available open spaces.

SECTION 5. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE LGU.

- Ensure the formulation, revision or updating of the local nutrition plan of action, to include and support the establishment of and maintenance of community gardens (this include both the barangay and household garden).
- Implement, monitor, and evaluate the local nutrition plan which includes, but are not limited to the provision of technical assistance and maintenance to barangays to promote basic agriculture through natural farming to serve as food baskets or main source of vegetables to sustain the dietary needs of the community as well as households, provision of agricultural services and facilities to the barangays.
- Include in the comprehensive development plan, as well as in the local development and annual investment programs, applicable programs and activities to promote nutrition such as the establishment and maintenance of barangay community gardens, to ensure adequate funding for nutrition impact.
- Ensure the organization, reorganization, and strengthening of the Municipal Nutrition Committee with the local chief executive as chairperson through the enactment of a local ordinance or issuance of an Executive Order to that effect.
- e) The Local Chief Executive, through an appropriate Order, shall designate a Municipal Nutrition Action Officer, preferably on a full-time basis with the corresponding staff support to coordinate nutrition action and implement one or more components of the local nutrition action plan, as may be needed.
- Provide technical and financial assistance to barangays, particularly in the implementation of agriculture activities and provision of agricultural support services.
- Provide agricultural support services and facilities to the barangays such as, but not limited to, vegetable seed farms, fruit-tree and other kinds of seedling nurseries, improvement and development of local distribution channels, preferable through cooperatives; interbarangay irrigation system, prevention and control of plant pests and diseases; assistance in the organizations of cooperatives, among others.
 - Promote vegetable production and consumption of crops existing naturally in the area.

Encourage the residents in the barangay to set up their family vegetable garden and/or plan fruit-bearing trees in available open spaces.

The Local Chief Executive shall issue an Executive Order designating an inspection and j) monitoring team for the establishment of community gardens in the barangays.

SECTION 6. FUNDING. The Municipal Government of Tolosa shall appropriate the funds necessary for the efficient and effective implementation of this Ordinance, particularly programs, projects and activities that support the establishment, functionality, and sustainability of Barangay Community Gardens.

SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any part, section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other parts thereof, not affected thereby shall remain in full force and affect.

SECTION 8. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, executive orders, resolutions and other local issuances or parts thereof, inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby amended, modified or repealed accordingly.

CALL TO ORDER - The Presiding Chair, Hon. Menardo M. Mate, called the session to order at exactly 9:30 AM.

NATIONAL ANTHEM/INVOCATION - The session commenced with a computer-generated National Anthem followed by an invocation and the singing of the Tolosa Hymn, promoting unity and reverence.

ROLL CALL - The acting secretary conducted the roll call, confirming the attendance of members of the Sangguniang Bayan. Present were Hon. Menardo M. Mate, Hon. Felicito D Beltran III, Hon. Manny R. Martinez, RN, MPRM., DPA., Hon. Edilberto V. Zabala, Jr., Hon. Manuel B. Balledo, Hon. Felipe V, Canonigo III, Hon. Virman Jessie O. Pundavela, Hon. Ireneo Rolando A. Lumbre, Hon. Rolly A. Cinco, Hon. Melanie Feliza M. Vivero and Hon. Catherine R. Benjamin. With a quorum established, the presiding chair Hon. Menardo M. Mate declared the session officially commenced.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS SESSION - The minutes of the previous session were read by the acting secretary. No corrections were made, and Hon. Manny R. Martinez, RN, MPRM., DPA., moved for their approval. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously.

After suspending the rules, Hon. Manny R. Martinez, RN, MPRM., DPA., called for an inquiry from Hon. Ireneo Rolando A. Lumbre regarding the status of the Patubig project implementation in Barangay Malbog. Hon. Ireneo Rolando A. Lumbre sought clarity on the project's progress, while Hon. Manuel B. Balledo questioned whether it had been approved by the Local Government Unit (LGU). Engineer Wilfredo Cañas clarified that the project had not gone through the LGU and noted that the Barangay Chairman is responsible for accepting such projects. Hon. Melanie Felisa M. Vivero the clarified as the ABC President the mechanism of Barangay projects to provide clarity.

Hon. Ireneo Rolando A. Lumbre expressed his intent to clarify the issue at the Barangay level, and Engineer Canas committed to further investigating the matter. Hon. Manuel B. Balledo inquired whether the LGU had the authority to question projects at the Barangay level, to which Engineer Canas responded that the LGU could only question building projects, with other initiatives handled directly by the Barangay Council.

Hon. Menardo M. Mate asked for updates regarding the implementation of signages and street lights to facilitate the celebration of All Souls Day within the Municipality of Tolosa, Leyte.

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE HALINA'T MAGTANIM NG PRUTAS AT GULAY (HAPAG) SA BARANGAY PRPJECT IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TOLOSA, LEYTE

WHEREAS, the economy of the country depends heavily on the agricultural sector, thus challenges encountered, especially by farmers, have negative effects on the food security in the country;

WHEREAS, given its geographic location, the Philippines experienced numerous threats to food security brought about by strings of natural calamities that have rendered farm produce unusable or increased food prices due to food shortage;

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has further worsened the country's food insecurity, disrupting the availability and access to fresh and nutritious foods at affordable prices. When people are severely food insecure, they most likely experience hunger;

WHEREAS, to address the problem of hunger and food insecurity in the community, the National Government enacted several laws and implemented various initiatives and strategies to ensure sustainable and resilient production and food availability in the community;

WHEREAS, the project HAPAG aims to increase barangays' capacity for sustainable agriculture activities by strengthening the barangay community garden, which would encourage homes and communities to grow fresh fruits and vegetables;

WHEREAS, in support of the thrust of the current administration and cognizant of the role of barangays as essential partners of the national government in contributing to addressing hunger and ensuring food security in the barangay, the national government, through the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) introduced the Halina't Magtanim ng Prutas at Gulay (HAPAG) sa Barangay Project and thus enjoins the LGUs thru their component barangays to adopt and institutionalize the same in their programs;

BE IT ENACTED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Tolosa in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the "HAPAG Ordinance" of the Municipality of Tolosa, Leyte.

SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS. The following terms as used in this Ordinance shall mean as follows:

- Aeroponics an integration of aquaculture (fish-farming) with hydroponics. Creates symbolic relationships between the plants and the fish. It uses the nutrient-rich waste from fish tanks to "fertigate" hydroponics production beds, and hydroponic bed cleans water for fish habitats.
- b) Aquaponics refers to a bio-system that incorporates recirculated aquaculture (fish farming) with hydroponic vegetable and herbs production to create a symbolic relationship between the plants and the fish.
- Barangay Community Garden refers to a piece of land or several patches of land operated and cultivated by the barangay for the purpose of planting and growing fruits and vegetables and fruit-bearing trees.
- Container Gardening refers to micro model farming where a family unit or household is producing fruits and vegetables in containers for personal consumption.
- Fruit Bearing Tree Planting refers to the planting of fruit-bearing trees for food production purposes such as papaya, bananas, mango, avocado, jackfruit, guyabano, coconut, guava, lèmon, mulberry, etc.

- Square Foot Gardening is a simple method of creating small, orderly, and highly productive kitchen gardens.
- h) Vertical Gardening refers to a special kind of urban gardening suitable for small spaces, particularly for decorating the walls and roofs in various styles. It is an alternative method for gardening by expanding the scope of growing plants in a vertical space.

SECTION 3. DECLARATIONN OF POLICY. It is hereby declared a policy of the Municipality of Tolosa to enjoin all barangays in establishing their respective Barangay Community Gardens as part of the Halina't Magtanim ng Prutas at Gulay (HAPAG) project of the municipality.

SECTION 4. ESTABLISHMENT OF BARANGAY COMMUNITY GARDEN. Pursuant to the declared policy in this ordinance, all barangays shall establish their Barangay Community Gardens accordance with the following guidelines:

- The community garden shall be established in an available site to be determined by the Sangguniang Barangay. It shall have at least a minimum of two hundred (200) square meters of land or its equivalent in several patches of land.
- In establishing the community garden, the barangay shall identify which vegetable plants (e.g. leafy vegetables, fruit bearing plants, etc.) herbal plants, root crops (e.g. sweet potato, cassava, garlic, onion, etc.) they wish to grow.
- Barangays with suitable spaces are hereby encouraged to plant bamboos (kawayan)
- Barangays that do not have vacant areas, shall implement alternative gardening such as container gardening, hydroponics, aquaponics, and aeroponics.
- e) Barangays are encouraged to coordinate and request from the LGU for any vacant property owned by the local government or private individuals who own a certain vacant/idle lot that can be used to establish the barangay community garden.
- f) The barangay shall encourage their residents to set up their family vegetable garden (and/or plant fruit bearing trees in any available open spaces.

SECTION 5. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE LGU.

- Ensure the formulation, revision or updating of the local nutrition plan of action, to include and support the establishment of and maintenance of community gardens (this includes both the barangay and household garden).
- Implement, monitor, and evaluate the local nutrition plan which includes, but are not limited to the provision of technical assistance and maintenance to barangays to promote basic agriculture through natural farming to serve as food baskets or main source of vegetables to sustain the dietary needs of the community as well as households, provision of agricultural services and facilities to the barangays.
- Include in the comprehensive development plan, as well as in the local development and annual investment programs, applicable programs and activities to promote nutrition such as the establishment and maintenance of barangay community gardens, to ensure adequate funding for nutrition impact.
- d) Ensure the organization, reorganization, and strengthening of the Municipal Nutrition Committee with the local chief executive as chairperson through the enactment of a local ordinance or issuance of an Executive Order to that effect.
- e) The Local Chief Executive, through an appropriate Order, shall designate a Municipal Nutrition Action Officer, preferably on a full-time basis with the corresponding staff support to coordinate nutrition action and implement one or more components of the local nutrition action plan, as may be needed.

Provide technical and financial assistance to barangays, particularly in the implementation of agriculture activities and provision of agricultural support services.

- Provide agricultural support services and facilities to the barangays such as, but not limited to, vegetable seed farms, fruit-tree and other kinds of seedling nurseries, improvement and development of local distribution channels, preferable through cooperatives; interbarangay irrigation system, prevention and control of plant pests and diseases; assistance in the organizations of cooperatives, among others.

SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any part, section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other parts thereof, not affected thereby shall remain in full force and affect.

SECTION 8. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, executive orders, resolutions and other local issuances or parts thereof, inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby amended, modified or repealed accordingly.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval and compliance with the mandatory posting of three (3) consecutive weeks prescribed under R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 and in official social media platforms of the LGU.

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160) mandates local government units (LGUs) to provide essential public services, including healthcare, for the general welfare of their constituents;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Tolosa, Leyte, has prioritized health as part of its flagship "Healthiest Tolosa," aiming to ensure that healthcare services, especially for preventive and promotive care, are accessible and visible to all residents and visitors;

WHEREAS, the establishment of a Municipal Health Desk in the Municipal Hall will contribute to the "Healthiest Tolosa" program by providing daily health assistance and patient navigation to employees and clients, supporting a proactive approach to health promotion and disease prevention;

WHEREAS, this initiative supports the WHO-SDH Healthy Workplace Journey of the ocal Government Unit by creating a safe and health-conscious environment for employees and visitors, fostering a culture of wellness within the workplace;

WHEREAS, the creation of a Municipal Health Desk will enhance the delivery of basic health services, serve as a navigation point for health concerns, and support the health-related needs of the public and LGU employees during office hours;

WHEREAS, the desk will play a pivotal role in raising health awareness, providing education on healthy lifestyles, and encouraging the community to participate in health initiatives, thereby promoting a healthier and more informed citizenry;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Tolosa, Leyte, in session duly assembled:

SECTION 1. TITLE

Immediate Health Assistance: Provide immediate health assistance to employees and clients of the Local Government Unit who seek preventive and promotive health services within the premises of the Municipal Hall.

Basic First Aid Services: Offer basic first aid services in coordination with the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO) in case of minor medical emergencies, ensuring that prompt care is available for injuries or health concerns that arise during working hours.

Patient Navigation: Serve as a navigation point for employees and clients needing further medical care or specialized health services, guiding them through the local healthcare system and available resources.

Health Education: Provide health-related information and guidance, including details on local healthcare programs, facilities, schedules for medical services such as consultations, vaccinations, and health outreach programs, and conduct health education sessions on topics such as nutrition, exercise, and preventive care.

Health Promotion Activities: Coordinate with the Municipal Health Office to implement health promotion activities, such as health fairs, screenings, and workshops, to foster community engagement in health and wellness initiatives.

Monitoring and Reporting: Track the health-related needs and concerns raised by employees and clients, ensuring timely response and appropriate navigation. The data collected will be used to inform future health initiatives and improve service delivery.

SECTION 4. PERSONNEL ASSIGNMENT

The Municipal Health Desk shall be led by the Municipal Health Office and the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO). The offices shall assign, on a scheduled basis, at least 1-2 health personnel for visibility and accessibility. These personnel will be responsible for:

- Providing services such as blood pressure (BP) monitoring, health education, and addressing other health-related concerns of employees and clients.
- Conducting routine health assessments to identify common health issues within the workforce and the community.
 - Reporting any health emergencies or concerns to the appropriate authorities for immediate action.

Additionally, the Municipal Health Officer shall appoint 1 health professional to serve as the Health Desk Focal, overseeing the overall operation of the health desk and supervising the effective implementation of its services. The Health Desk Focal may or may not be regularly physically present but will ensure proper oversight and support for daily duties of the health personnel and act as a focal point for their concerns and communications regarding health desk operations.

SECTION 5. FUNDING

The funding required for the establishment, maintenance, and staffing of the Municipal Health Desk shall be included in the annual budget allocation of the Municipal Health Office. Additional funding may be sought through partnerships with health organizations and community programs.

SECTION 6. IMPLEMENTATION

The Local Chief Executive, through the Municipal Health Office, shall ensure the proper implementation of this Ordinance. This includes:

- Regular training and capacity-building sessions for the health personnel assigned to the desk to keep them updated on best practices in health service delivery.
- Developing promotional materials to raise awareness about the Municipal Health Desk and its services among employees and clients.

SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

If any part or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF TOLOSA, LEYTE:

SECTION 1. TITLE.

This ordinance shall be known as the "Ordinance Authorizing the Disbursement of 70% of the PhilHealth Capitation for Health-Related Activities Under Section 5 of the PhilHealth Capitation Ordinance."

SECTION 2. PURPOSE.

This ordinance aims to facilitate the utilization of 70% of the PhilHealth Capitation to support various health-related activities and initiatives in the Municipality of Tolosa. These initiatives are designed to enhance community health and well-being, particularly through:

- Promoting e-Konsulta services for accessible healthcare.
- Organizing bloodletting activities to ensure a safe and sufficient blood supply.
- Addressing social determinants of health through targeted programs and community 3. engagement.

SECTION 3. AUTHORITY TO DISBURSE FUNDS.

The Municipality of Tolosa is hereby authorized to allocate funds, specifically 70% of the PhilHealth Capitation, for the following activities:

- 1. e-Konsulta Initiatives: This includes funding for the promotion and implementation of telehealth services, outreach programs, and health education campaigns to improve access to healthcare.
- 2. Blood Letting Activities: Funds will be allocated to organize and implement regular blood donation drives in collaboration with recognized organizations, ensuring safe and adequate blood supply for the community.
- 3. Social Determinants of Health Initiatives: Funding will be directed toward programs that address social determinants of health, including but not limited to health education, community engagement, nutrition programs, and access to preventive healthcare services.
- Other Health Programs that Support e-Konsulta

SECTION 4. CONDITIONS OF DISBURSEMENT.

The disbursement of funds shall be subject to the following conditions:

- Availability of Funds: The amount disbursed will depend on the actual availability of funds from the PhilHealth Capitation.
- Compliance with COA Guidelines: All disbursements must adhere to the guidelines and regulations set forth by the Commission on Audit (COA) to ensure transparency, accountability, and proper utilization of public funds.
- Prior Approval by the Local Chief Executive: Any disbursement must receive prior approval from the Local Chief Executive, who shall endorse the specific health-related activities and initiatives to be funded.

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

If any provision of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval and publication in a newspaper of general circulation




