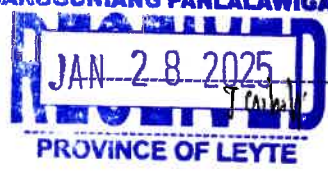

**REVIEW/RECOMMENDATION/LEGAL OPINION:**

This office is of the opinion that the subject Ordinance is generally in accordance with its power under Section 447(a)(1)<sup>1</sup> of the Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A. 7160) in consonance with RA 7610<sup>2</sup>. Hence, we recommend for the declaration of its validity.

<sup>1</sup> Section 447. Powers, Duties, Functions and Compensation. -

(a) The sangguniang bayan, as the legislative body of the municipality, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the municipality as provided for under Section 22 of this Code, and shall:

(1) Approve ordinances and pass resolutions necessary for an efficient and effective municipal government, and in this connection shall:

**AN ORDINANCE STRENGTHENING THE BARANGAY COUNCIL FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN IN 77 BARANGAYS IN BURAUEN, LEYTE, AND PROVIDING INCENTIVES THROUGH THE INSTITUTIONALIZATION OF THE MOST CHILD-FRIENDLY BARANGAY AWARDS**

**WHEREAS**, the Philippines is a signatory in the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child, the Declaration of the Rights of the Child and the Geneva Declaration of the Rights of the Child;

**WHEREAS**, it is the declared policy of the State and the Municipality of Burauen to protect the rights and welfare of children;

**WHEREAS**, children, as the future leaders and caretakers of our society, deserve essential protection and support to help them fully embrace their roles within the community;

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Government of Burauen will boost the performance of BCPCs in the municipality by encouraging them to exert their best efforts in doing their tasks through giving them additional incentives;

**WHEREAS**, advancing the efficacy and responsiveness of all BCPCs, by giving them ample means of motivation to excel further in performing their duties and responsibilities, will propel the city towards inclusive, robust and comprehensive socio-economic development;

**BE IT ORDAINED**, therefore, by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Burauen that:

**Section 1. TITLE.** – For brevity, this ordinance shall be known as the “Most Child-Friendly Barangay Awards Ordinance”.

**Section 2. PURPOSE.** – This ordinance is promulgated in order to:

- a. Protect and promote the rights and welfare of children;
- b. Enhance the efficiency, competence, and responsiveness of barangay governments in Burauen, Leyte; and
- c. Establish a sustainable mechanism that will continually drive the barangays to implement innovative programs effectively and sustainably for protecting and promoting children.

**Section 3. COVERAGE.** – This Article shall cover all barangay governments of Burauen, Leyte and shall focus on the effectiveness and innovativeness of their respective programs on the protection and promotion of children rights and welfare.

**Section 4. THE MOST CHILD-FRIENDLY BARANGAY AWARD.** – The Most Child-Friendly Barangay Award is hereby established to be conferred to barangays of Burauen, Leyte, which have met the criteria and conditions prescribed in this Article, as confirmed, and validated by the Awards Committee comprised herein.

**Section 5. CRITERIA.** – The Most Child-Friendly Barangay Award shall be conferred to outstanding barangays which have gained the highest points in the following criteria:

**Section 6. COMPOSITION OF THE MOST CHILD-FRIENDLY AWARDS COMMITTEE.** – The Most Child Friendly Awards Committee is hereby constituted and shall be composed of the following offices:

- Chairperson: Municipal Local Government Operations Officer
- Co-Chairperson: Municipal Social Welfare and Development Officer
- Members: SB Member, Chair – Committee on Child Protection and Education
- Municipal Health Officer
- Municipal Civil Registrar
- Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator
- Senior Tourism Officer
- Municipal Nutrition Action Coordinator
- Burauen East District Representative
- Burauen North District Representative
- Burauen South District Representative
- 4Ps Municipal Link
- CSO Representative from Faith-Based Organization

**Section 7. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF THE MOST CHILD-FRIENDLY BARANGAY AWARDS COMMITTEE.** – In order to efficiently and effectively implement the Most Child-Friendly Barangay Award, the Committee composed in the preceding section shall:

- a. Craft and implement guidelines on the efficient implementation of the Most Child Friendly Barangay Award;
- b. Review and suggest amendments, if necessary, in the criteria provided in this Article,
- c. Search, validate, review, evaluate and select the Most Child-Friendly Barangay Awardees following the established guidelines, rules and criteria of the awards, and
- d. Submit to the Municipal Mayor on or before October 31 of every year the list of the Child-Friendly Barangay Awardees.

**Section 8. THE SECRETARIAT.** – The Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office shall provide the secretariat functions of the Most Child-Friendly Barangay Awards Committee.

**Section 9. FUNCTIONS OF THE SECRETARIAT.** – The secretariat shall have the following functions and duties:

- a. Serve as repository of all documents, memorabilia, pictures, and other related information on the Most Child-Friendly Barangay Awards;
- b. Provide the Most Child-Friendly Barangay Awards committee with the various forms, guidelines, and criteria of the awards;



- c. Assist in the search of the Most Child-Friendly Barangay Awardees; and
- d. Plan and conduct a Most Child-Friendly Barangay Awards Presentation in NOVEMBER of every year during the LIGA Night.

**Section 10. SELECTION AND EVALUATION PERIOD.** – The selection and evaluation period shall cover the months from September of the preceding year to August of the current year. The evaluation and assessment shall be conducted in the month of September of the current year.

**Section 11. AWARDING AND PRESENTATION OF THE MOST CHILD-FRIENDLY BARANGAY AWARDEES.** – The awarding and presentation of the Most Child-Friendly Barangay Awardees shall be in November of every year. The event shall be one of the highlights of the celebration of the Children's Month.

**Section 12. THE AWARDS.** – Recipients of the Most Child-Friendly Barangay Awards shall be given the following prizes:

- a. 1<sup>st</sup> Place: One hundred thousand (P100,000.00) worth of projects and a plaque of recognition
- b. 2<sup>nd</sup> Place: Sixty-five thousand (P65,000.00) worth of projects and a plaque of recognition
- c. 3<sup>rd</sup> Place: Fifty thousand (P50,000.00) worth of projects and a plaque of recognition
- d. 4<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> Place: Five thousand pesos (P5,000.00) with certificate and token

Provided that the participant with the highest total score will be awarded 1st place, the one with the second highest score will receive 2nd place, and the participant with the third highest score will secure 3rd place. Additionally, barangays ranked 4th to 10th place must have a rating of not less than 60% to 70 % to qualify for the consolation prize worth five thousand pesos (P5,000.00) with a certificate and token award. These placements will be determined based on the final computed total scores for each entry.

**Section 12-A. PROCEDURE IN CASE OF A TIE.** – In the event of a tie between two or more barangays, the following procedure shall be implemented:

1. *Secondary Evaluation:* A thorough secondary evaluation of the tied barangays will be conducted, focusing on:
  - o The long-term sustainability and impact of their child-friendly programs, policies, and ordinances (10%).
  - o The level of community involvement in child-related activities (10%).
  - o Innovation and creativity in addressing child welfare issues (10%).
2. *Panel Deliberation:* The selection committee will convene for final deliberation to assess additional factors, including:
  - o Consistency in the implementation of child-friendly policies (10%).
  - o Any special initiatives that exceed basic criteria (10%).
3. *Community Feedback:* The committee may gather feedback from the community, including parents, teachers, and children, to evaluate the effectiveness of the barangay's efforts (10%).
4. *Final Decision:* If a tie persists after the secondary evaluation, the committee will cast a final vote. In the event of a deadlock, the Chairperson of the selection committee shall have the deciding vote.

**Section 13. UTILIZATION OF CASH AWARD.** – The cash prize awarded under this Article shall be utilized solely on projects directly addressing child welfare, protection, and development. Eligible uses include, but are not limited to:

1. Purchase of reading materials
2. Purchase of TV and sound system
3. Installation of internet connection and initial subscription
4. Purchase of Desktop for reading center
5. Improvement of ECCD centers
6. Support to Brigada Eskwela Program
7. Improvement or Rehabilitation of Barangay Health Station

8. Development of playground and sport facilities.
9. Celebration of Children's Month and Nutrition Month
10. Purchase of ECCD supplies

The barangay is obliged to implement and liquidate the project intended for the use of cash prize within a period of 6 months of the check's issuance. Failure to liquidate the cash prize will be a ground for disqualification from participating in future searches for the Most Child-Friendly Barangay.

**Section 14. FUNDING.** – The Local Government Unit of Burauen shall allocate an annual budget to ensure the successful and efficient implementation of the Most Child-Friendly Barangay Awards. This budget shall be included in the Municipal Council for the Protection of Children (MCPC) and shall amount to at least one percent of the municipality's total National Tax Allocation (NTA) under the Special Purpose Appropriation for the current year.

**Section 15. REVIEW.** – At least once every year, an evaluation of the performance and accomplishments of the AD Hoc Body shall be conducted to assess its effectiveness and functionality. This assessment will consider the overall effectiveness, efficiency, and sustainability of the Ad Hoc Body, providing valuable insights for informed decision-making regarding the establishment of a permanent organizational structure or the implementation of alternative measures.

**Section 16. SEPARABILITY.** – If any part or provision of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid, the remaining parts or provisions shall continue to be in full force and effect.


**Section 17. EFFECTIVITY.** – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval by the Sangguniang Bayan of Burauen.
