b.1.b All other costs relative to running a Local Qualifier Tournament until Finals, including but not limited to the items mentioned in b.1.a.

b.2 Rules and Regulations:

The Program Partner must follow all the NBTC League rules and guidelines, including, but not limited to, eligibility and sanctions. The Program Director shall provide a copy of said rules.

b.3 Collaterals/Bannering:

The Program Partner will allow NBTC to display sponsors' collaterals on the ground in the playing venue during the Local Qualifying Tournament.

Merchandising using NBTC patents and trademarks is strictly prohibited.

b.4 Approval:

The program Partner will seek the approval of the Program Director with regards to getting a local sponsor(s) and implementation of the tournament, including but not limited to the tournament format, schedule of games, and playing venues

b.5 Independent:

Program Partner's contracts with sponsors and other suppliers are independent of this Agreement. The Program Director cannot be held liable for actions of the Program Partner entered into without the written consent of the Program Director.

4. RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE NBTC PROGRAM DIRECTOR (SECOND PARTY)

a. Rights of the Program Director

- a.1 To grant exclusive rights to run the Local Qualifying Tournament in designated areas to qualified individuals/associations/corporations/units
 - a.2 To impose necessary penalties and fines to erring parties when warranted
 - a.3 To enforce the tournament rules and guidelines in the Local Qualifying

a.4 To do all acts necessary to preserve the integrity of the NBTC Grassroots program.

b. Responsibilities of the Program Director

- b.1 The Program Director will provide the following:

- 5. This Memorandum of Agreement constitutes the complete Agreement between the PARTIES and supersedes all previous agreements or representations, whether written or oral, concerning the subject matter described herein.
- 6. The terms of this Memorandum of Agreement may not be amended or modified, nor may any provision be waived except in writing and mutually agreed upon by the Parties hereto this Agreement. This Agreement is to the benefit of the PARTIES and their successors and assigns.
- 7. That if any provision of this Agreement is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions of this Agreement will remain in full force and effect;
- 8. This Memorandum of Agreement shall be effective between the PARTIES on the date of signing by the parties.
- 9. This Agreement shall be for the duration of the **NBTC 2024-25 Season 15** from the date of signing unless otherwise terminated by any party. The party seeking the termination must inform the other party at least 20 days prior to the actual termination. Said notice must be in writing duly received by the other party


