RESOLUTION EXPRESSING OPPOSITION TO HOUSE BILL NO. 11077

WHEREAS, the proposed House Bill No. 11077 seeks to divide the province of Leyte into two separate provinces, namely: Western Leyte and Eastern Leyte;

WHEREAS, the division of Leyte province into two separate entities would have detrimental effects on the unity and development of the province as a whole;

WHEREAS, the division of Leyte province would result in the fragmentation of resources, services and infrastructure, leading to inefficiencies and duplication of offorts:

WHEREAS, the division of Leyte province would also lead to the displacement of government employees and the disruption of public services, causing inconvenience and hardship to the residents of the province;

WHEREAS, the division of Leyte province would weaken the political and economic power of the province, making it more vulnerable to external influences and exploitation:

WHEREAS, the division of Leyte province would also create unnecessary administrative and bureaucratic burdens, leading to increased costs and inefficiencies in governance:

WHEREAS, the division of Leyte province would further exacerbate existing social and economic disparities between the two proposed provinces, leading to increased Inequality and social unrest;


WHEREAS, the division of Leyte province would also undermine the historical and cultural heritage of the province, erading the sense of identity and belonging of its residents:

WHEREAS, the division of Leylo province would not address the underlying issues and challenges facing the province, such as poverty, unemployment, and lack of basic services;

WHEREAS, the division of Leyto province would only serve the interest of a few individuals and groups, at the expense of the welfare and well-being of the majority of the population;


