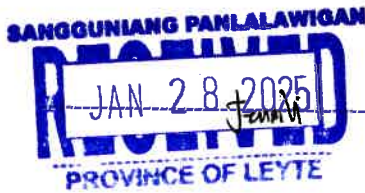
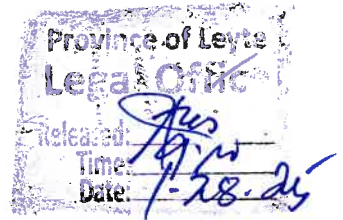

2nd INDORSEMENT

January 9, 2025

Respectfully returned to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte, through SP Secretary, the attached Municipal Ordinance No. 198 of the Sangguniang Bayan of Matag-ob, Leyte.

Issues/concerns for review/recommendation/legal opinion is/are as follows:

- Municipal Ordinance No. 198 entitled: **“An Ordinance Establishing Regular Clean-Up Drive of All Barangays in the Municipality of Matag-Ob Leyte to Prevent Immediate Flooding and Combat Dengue Outbreak.”**

REVIEW/RECOMMENDATION/LEGAL OPINION:

This office is of the opinion that the subject Ordinance is generally in accordance with its power under Sections 447(a)(1)¹ and (5)(xiii)² of the Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A. 7160). However, we note and recommend the deletion of the DILG Unnumbered Advisory in the Whereas Clauses of the Ordinance as such is directed at LGUs surrounding the Manila Bay area; thus, inapplicable to the subject municipality. Considering the foregoing, further review of said ordinance is recommended.

We hope to have assisted you with this request. Please note that the opinion rendered by this Office are based on the facts available and may vary or change when additional facts and documents are presented or changed. This opinion is likewise without prejudice to the opinions rendered by higher and competent authorities and/or the courts.

¹Section 447. Powers, Duties, Functions and Compensation. -

(a) The sangguniang bayan, as the legislative body of the municipality, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the municipality as provided for under Section 22 of this Code, and shall:
(1) Approve ordinances and pass resolutions necessary for an efficient and effective municipal government, and in this connection shall:

² (xiii) Provide for an efficient and effective system of solid waste and garbage collection disposal and prohibit littering and the placing or throwing of garbage, refuse and other filth and wastes;

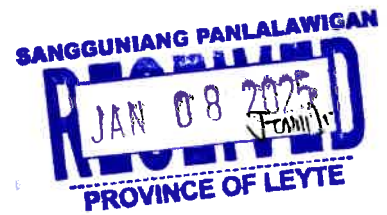

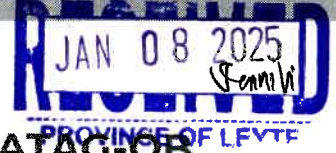

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 198

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING REGULAR CLEAN-UP DRIVE OF ALL BARANGAYS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MATAG-OB LEYTE TO PREVENT IMMEDIATE FLOODING AND COMBAT DENGUE OUTBREAK.

WHEREAS, Article II Section 16 of the 1987 Philippines Constitution provides that the State shall protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 or other known as the "Local Government Code of 1991" mandates all Local Government Units (LGUs) to ensure and support the promotion of health and safety and enhancement of the right of the people to a balance ecology in the promotion of general welfare;

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Republic Act No. 9003 or otherwise known as the "Philippine Clean Air Act of 1999" states that the state shall promote and protect the global environment to attain sustainable development while recognizing the primary responsibility of LGUs to deal with environmental problems and that the state recognizes that the responsibility of cleaning the habitat and environment is primarily area-based. It further stipulates that the state recognizes that a clean and healthy environment is for the good of all and should, therefore, be the concern of all;

WHEREAS, Section 2 Republic Act No. 9003 or otherwise known as the "Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000" declares that the state shall adopt a systematic, comprehensive and ecological solid waste management program which shall ensure the protection of the public health and environment, encourage greater private sector participation in solid waste management, and institutionalize public participation in the development and implementation of national and local integrated, comprehensive, and ecological waste management programs, among others;

WHEREAS, through DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2024-001, the KALINISAN (Kalinga at Inisyatiba Para aa Malinis na Bayan) sa Bagong Pilipinas Program was launched last January 6, 2024 that aims to consolidate all efforts of the government to maintain and provide a healthy and safe environment for all by capacitating LGUs and enabling community participation anchored on the tradition of “bayanihan”;

WHEREAS, DILG Unnumbered Advisory dated January 25, 2024 entitled “Submission of Compliance Reports to the Weekly Clean-up Drive of the Barangays enjoin all Barangays to enact an ordinance or any appropriate issuance declaring one day of the week as their Barangay Clean-up Day;

NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVE, as it is hereby RESOLVED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Matag-ob, Leyte during its regular session duly assembled that;

Section 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as an “Ordinance ESTABLISHING REGULAR CLEAN-UP DRIVE OF ALL BARANGAYS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MATAG-OB LEYTE TO PREVENT IMMEDIATE FLOODING AND COMBAT DENGUE OUTBREAK.”

Section 2. Declaration of Policy. It shall be the policy of The Municipality of Matag-ob, Leyte local development while simultaneously protecting and preserving the environment. The Municipality of Matag-ob, Leyte likewise recognizes the vital role the community plays in ensuring the safety of its residents by establishing a safe and healthy ecology.

Section 3. Clean-up. A clean-up drive shall be conducted every week in all Barangays. The following activities can be undertaken but not limited to:

- a. Dredging of clogged canals, esteros, and other waterways;
- b. Pruning thick bushes or tree branches;
- c. Draining of receptacles containing stagnant waters;
- d. Dismantling all possible breeding places of mosquitoes;
- e. Community gardening/tree planting; and
- f. Information drive on solid waste management, dengue prevention, and community gardening
- g. Dredging of clogged rivers, creeks, and all waterways

Section 4. Schedule. The component barangays of the Municipality of Matag-ob, Leyte shall choose their convenient schedule within the week to conduct their weekly clean-up drive.

Section 5. Photo Documentation and Posting in Social Media. The Barangay Secretary shall document and upload the photo documentation to



include attendance sheet as proof of attendance of the clean-up activities to the official social media/ page/s of the Barangay.

Section 6. Reporting. There shall be a weekly reporting of the clean-up drive to the Municipal Local Government Operations Officer (MLGOO) by the Barangay Secretary with the following information indicated therein:

- a. Number of Participants
- b. Number of Barangay officials who participated in the clean-up;
- c. Volume of waste collected (in kilograms);
- d. Number of clean-up sites; and
- e. Link to social media posting of the weekly clean-up.

Section 7. Community Participations. The Barangay shall ensure to encourage the participation of community members, private sectors, civil society organizations, particularly youth and student organizations during the weekly clean up activity.

Section 8. Repealing Clause. All Ordinances, Executive Orders and Rules and Regulations inconsistent or in conflict with any provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


Section 9. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions not otherwise affected shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 10. Amendments Clause. This ordinance maybe Amended or modifieds necessary through the appropriate legislative process.

Section 10. Effectivity Clause. This ordinance will take effect immediately upon approval.
