

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING LAYMANIZED MULTI-HAZARDS EARLY WARNING SYSTEM (EWS) AND ITS PRESCRIBED PROTOCOL AND GUIDELINES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BABATNGON, LEYTE.

Introduced by: HON. FEDERICO P. ELIZAGA, JR. Sangguniang Bayan Member

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Babatngon, Leyte in session assembled:

**SECTION 1. LAYMANIZED FLOOD AND RAIN-INDUCED LANDSLIDE EWS.** There shall be a laymanized multi-hazards EWS in the municipality and shall be installed in different areas in area of responsibility (AOR).

SECTION 2. MULTI-HAZARDS EARLY WARNING SYSTEM. The following shall be the multi-hazards early warning systems.

#### 2.1 WEATHER STATION

- 2.1.1 The weather station shall be installed in the premises of the municipal hall close to the operations center for effective monitoring system.
- 2.1.2 The daily temperature and rainfall shall be collected and recorded and reported to 25 BDRRMCs thru group chats or SMS and shall be posted in fb account; *mdrrmo babatngon*.
- 2.1.3 In case of Yellow rainfall warning, all BDRRMCs shall be warned and advised to conduct "bandilyo" to inform every resident to monitor and set ready for pre-emptive evacuation.
  - 2.1.4 Records of daily rainfall shall be consolidated for database.
- 2.1.5 The weather station monitoring system shall be EWS for flood and rain-induced landslide and dry season/El Nino
- 2.1.6. Advisories shall be based on PAGASA Color-coded Rainfall Advisories and Classification as shown below:



2.2 EWS for FLOOD. This shall be the flood EWS and shall be installed in areas with rivers:



2.2.1 The signage shall be installed in rivers banks but visible to the community.

2.2.2 The MDRRM Office shall conduct IEC to all BLGUs/BDRRMCs and BDRRMCs shall also convene their respective residents for IEC activity on this FLOOD EWS.

2.2.3 The following are alert levels and community's action:

2.2.3.1 ALERT LEVEL 1 WARNING ADVISORY: Rivers are 60% full. All residents in the area shall closely monitor the weather updates and ready all necessary things in case evacuation is declared. The BDRRMC shall be responsible in monitoring the water level in rivers within their AOR using the FLOOD EWS and take actions based on the Early Warning System.

2.2.3.2 ALERT LEVEL 2 /ALERT ADVISORY: Rivers are 80% full. The BDRRMCs shall

implement pre-emptive evacuation to families living close to the high risk areas to flooding.

2.2.3.3 ALERT LEVEL 3 CRITICAL: Rivers are 100% full. The MDRRMC and BDRRMCs of 25 BLGUs shall ensure that all affected residents are safely housed in safe evacuation area. There shall be no RESCUE EVACUATION, thus, all responders shall be in safe areas.

2.2.3.4 ALERT LEVEL 4. Declaration of safety to return home. The MDRRMC through the BDRRMCs shall be one to have the say it is safe to return home for the evacuees. Affected population can leave the evacuation area if the authorities released an adivisory and termination of evacuation.

2.3 OUTDOOR WARNING SIGNAGES. There shall be warning signages in all high risk areas to flooding, landslide and storm surge within the AOR.. The outdoor warning signages for flooding, landslide and storm surge to be installed shall be in accordance with the standard specifications of MGB (DILG MC 2016-113). The signages shall be placed strategically in hazardous areas.

2.4 MULTI-HAZARD MAP. The MDRRMC through the lead of the Offices of the Municipal Engineer, MPDC and MDRRMO shall ensure that Multi-Hazard maps shall be installed in different strategic location to promote community's awareness. The Punong Barangay of every BLGU in the municipality, as the Chairperson of BDRRMC, shall ensure that barangay multi-hazard map are placed strategically within their respective AOR. The maps shall be in 1:50,000 and shall be printed in 4feetxfeet size of tarpaulin, framed and posted. The source of the multi-hazard map shall be Mines and Geosciences Bureau (MGB). The MEO, MPDC and MDRRMO shall be the responsible Offices to request multi-hazard map of Babatngon, Leyte to ensure that updated hazard maps are in place.

2.5 FLOOD GAUGE. Flood gauge shall be placed in all roads highly susceptible to flooding and rivers within the Municipality . Road side flood gauge can be a permanent structure found in the area and painted with yellow, orange and red that will indicate the flood height. The flood gauge within rivers shall be concrete post and will be placed in strategic area in the river and will be painted (yellow, orange, red) also to emphasize the risk category.

2.5.1 The flood gauge will be painted with the following color-coding and classifications:

2.5.1 a. YELLOW shows 1 to 2 feet water level in the road

2.5.1 b. ORANGE shows 3 to 4 feet water level in the road

2.5.1 c. RED show 5feet and above water level in the road



2.5.2 DISSEMINATION OF WARNING. The MDRRMC and BDRRMCs will monitor the EWS installed in roads and rivers and disseminate all DRRM stakeholders and public for its safety. Monitoring result shall be transmitted through social media (mdrrm babatngon fb account) fb group chats, Uswag Babatngon fb, SMS, and among others. Advisory will be issued to all concern for disaster preparedness to include LEADRRMOs, PDRRMO and among others for general public information.

SECTION 3. MONITORING OF MULTI-HAZARD EWS. The MEO and MDRRMO shall conduct regular monitoring on the condition of all EWS installed within the AOR. The monitoring activity shall be done every month of July of the year. The team shall immediately implement action in the case of damage EWS for its repair or replacement.

SECTION 4. Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Committees (BDRRMCs). All BDRRMCs of 25 barangay Local Government are mandated to implement the following:

Establish Multi-Hazard Early Warning System in respective area of responsibility (AOR)

2. Formulate policy support for the protection of various Early Warning System against human vandalism and any other destruction.

SECTION 5. FUNDING. LDRRM Fund shall be the fund source of this projects and allocation for Early Warning system annually shall be considered.

SECTION 6. PENALTY. Any person doing vandalism, destruction or any activities that may cause damage to the established early warning system within the area of responsility of Babatngon, Leyte shall be penalized as follows:

First Offense Second Offense - A fine of One Thousand Pesos (P 1,000.00)

- A fine of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P 1,500.00) **Third Offense** 

- A fine of not more than Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P 2,500.00) or an imprisonment of not more than six (6) months or both upon discretion of the court.
