



#### **MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 02** Series of 2025

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING REPUBLIC ACT 11361 OR THE "ANTI-OBSTRUCTION **OF POWER LINES** ACT" AND **FURTHER** STRENGTHENING ITS IMPLEMENTATION IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TOLOSA, LEYTE

#### Authored and Sponsored by: HON. MELANIE FELISA M. VIVERO

Section 1. Purpose. To ensure the uninterrupted conveyance of electricity from DORELCO power substations to the end-users – the member-consumer owner and protect the integrity and reliability of the Electric Cooperative's distribution systems by keeping the land beneath, the air spaces surrounding and the area traversed by power lines clear of dangerous obstructions.

Section 2. Coverage. This Ordinance shall cover all power lines and other related facilities for the conveyance of electricity throughout the Municipality of Tolosa, Leyte.

Section 3. Definition of Terms. - For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following terms are defined as follows;

- a.) "Act" refers to Republic Act No. 11361, otherwise known as the "Anti-Obstruction of Power Lines Act".
- b.) "Associated facilities" refers to any or all of the equipment and other fixtures that are attached or connected with, and are integral to a power line, such as, but not limited to poles, guys, crossarms, insulators, and conductors.

- c.) "Conveyance of electricity" refers to the delivery of electricity from the DORELCO Power Substation to the premises of the end user through power lines.
- d.) "Distribution lines" refer to the portion of the distribution system pertaining to the lines or wires.
- e.) "Distribution system" refers to the system of wires and associated facilities belonging to DORELCO extending between the delivery points from the EC power substation and the connection to the premises of the end user.
- f.) "Electric Cooperative" or "EC" refers to DORELCO, a duly organized and registered Electric Cooperative pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 269, as amended, otherwise known as the "National Electrification Administration Decree", holding the franchise to distribute electricity to thirteen (13) municipalities in Leyte, including Tolosa.
- g.) "End user" refers to any person or entity requiring the supply and delivery of electricity for its own use.
- h.) "Hazardous activities" refer to planting of plants and trees, burning of waste and other materials, excavation, quarrying, construction, and other activities of the same nature and character and regardless of purpose intended, which are performed partially/wholly inside the powerline corridor which threaten or endanger the continuous and uninterrupted conveyance of electricity.
- i.) "Hazardous improvements" refer to plants, trees, structures, buildings and buildings of whatever kind, whether temporary or permanent in character, and regardless of purpose for which they are intended, which are located, partially or wholly inside the Power Line Corridor which threaten or endanger the continuous and uninterrupted conveyance of electricity.
- j.) "Owner or Operator of Power Lines" or "Power Line Owner/Operator" of "PLO" refers to DORELCO having the ownership and/or responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the distribution power lines.
- k.) "Power lines" refer to transmission lines, sub-transmission lines, distribution lines, and other connection assets including the poles and towers used to support the lines, and other related facilities constructed or erected used for the purpose of conveyance of electricity.
- 1.) "Power line obstruction" refers to any hazardous activity or hazardous improvement and other similar circumstances that threaten or endanger the continuous and uninterrupted conveyance of electricity.
- "Tall growing plants" refer to plants, vines and other plant species, which grow or have the potential to grow more than three (3) meters in height from the ground.
- n.) "Power Line Corridor (PLC)" refers to and is constituted as the land beneath, the air spaces surrounding, and the area traversed by power lines, which shall be kept clear and free from any power line obstructions, dangerous structures, hazardous activities and improvements and other similar circumstances in accordance with the provisions of the Act.

Section 4. Prevention and Removal of Power Line Obstruction on Public Property. - In cases where the power line corridor is wholly or partially located within public property, DORELCO shall have the right to enter the said property to prevent and remove any power line obstruction, and perform the following acts:

- (a) To conduct maintenance and inspection activities within the power line corridor.
- (b) To conduct repair or restoration activities within the power line corridor.

- (c) To conduct trimming, pruning, cutting, or clearing activities for tall growing plants within the power line corridor without the need of securing prior clearance or permit from the Local Government Unit of Tolosa.
- (d) To remove, dismantle, or demolish hazardous improvements in accordance with the National Building Code of the Philippines: Provided, that such acts may be carried out without prior clearances or permit from but with due notice to the Local Government Unit of Tolosa.
- (e) To stop, prevent, or prohibit the conduct of hazardous activities; and
- (f) Perform other analogous acts or activities, which will cause the prevention and removal of any power line obstruction.
- (g) Any damages that may be incurred during the cause of operation shall be the sole responsibility of DORELCO, which shall be liable for any and all resulting costs, repairs, or claims arising therefrom.

Section 5. Prevention and Removal of Power Line Obstruction on Private Property. - DORELCO shall have the primary duty and responsibility to remove power line obstructions. In cases where the power line corridor is wholly or partially located within a private property, the property owner shall coordinate and assist DORELCO by acilitating the necessary access in order to perform the acts enumerated in Section 4.

The property owner shall have the primary duty and responsibility to prevent power line obstructions and to inform DORELCO of their existence. In the performance of these acts, the property owner shall be entitled to necessary assistance such as, but not limited to education, information, technical and manpower support from DORELCO.

In the event that the property owner fails to perform any duty and responsibility under the preceding paragraphs, the owner or operator of the power lines shall have the right to access the power line corridor in order to undertake the acts enumerated under Section 4: Provided, however, that the NOTICE TO THE PROPERTY OWNER shall no longer be required to avert an imminent danger posed by a power line obstruction.

Any damages that may be incurred during the cause of operation shall be the sole responsibility of DORELCO

Section 6. Assistance from the Barangay. — In the performance of this acts under Sections 4 and 5, DORELCO shall coordinate and be assisted by the Barangay concerned where the clearing or removal of line obstructions are being conducted.

The Barangay is mandated to provide assistance by way of providing manpower to augment the clearing crew/personnel of DORELCO.

The Barangay is mandated to keep its residents updated and notified of the clearing schedules as provided by DORELCO.

Section 7. Disposal of Waste and Debris. - Waste and debris which resulted from the removal of obstructions and other activities under this Ordinance shall be disposed of by the Barangay where the clearing or removal of line obstructions are conducted in accordance with the relevant barangay and municipal ordinances.

Section 8. The DORELCO shall assist in the disposal of debris beyond the Barangay's capacity, such as large branches and other oversized waste, in compliance with environmental laws and municipal regulations

Section 9. Separability Clause. - Any portion or provision of this Ordinance, which may be declared unconstitutional or invalid shall not have the effect of nullifying other portions or provisions hereof.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11361, also known as the "Anti-Obstruction of Power Lines Act," was enacted to ensure the continuous and uninterrupted supply of electricity by prohibiting he construction, planting, and installation of structures or obstructions along power line corridors;

WHEREAS, the law mandates Local Government Units to assist in its implementation by formulating ordinances or measures to prevent any form of power line obstruction within their

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Tolosa recognizes the importance of safeguarding power lines to avoid disruptions in electricity supply, ensuring public safety, and supporting economic activities dependent on stable electricity;

WHEREAS, adopting and enforcing the provisions of R.A. 11361 at the local level will further enhance the Municipality's capacity to address violations, prevent hazards, and ensure compliance with national standards;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Melanie Felisa M. Vivero, duly seconded unanimously, the Sangguniang Bayan recognizes the necessity of enacting an ordinance to adopt R.A. 11361 and strengthen its local implementation, be it;

Section 1. Purpose. To ensure the uninterrupted conveyance of electricity from ORELCO power substations to the end-users - the member-consumer owner and protect the htegrity and reliability of the Electric Cooperative's distribution systems by keeping the land

Section 2. Coverage. This Ordinance shall cover all power lines and other related facilities for the conveyance of electricity throughout the Municipality of Tolosa, Leyte.

Section 3. Definition of Terms. - For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following terms e defined as follows;

- a.) "Act" refers to Republic Act No. 11361, otherwise known as the "Anti-Obstruction of
- b.) "Associated facilities" refers to any or all of the equipment and other fixtures that are attached or connected with, and are integral to a power line, such as, but not limited to poles, guys, crossarms, insulators, and conductors.
- c.) "Conveyance of electricity" refers to the delivery of electricity from the DORELCO Power Substation to the premises of the end user through power lines.
- d.) "Distribution lines" refer to the portion of the distribution system pertaining to the lines
- e.) "Distribution system" refers to the system of wires and associated facilities belonging to DORELCO extending between the delivery points from the EC power substation and the connection to the premises of the end user.
- f.) "Electric Cooperative" or "EC" refers to DORELCO, a duly organized and registered Electric Cooperative pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 269, as amended, otherwise known as the "National Electrification Administration Decree", holding the franchise to distribute electricity to thirteen (13) municipalities in Leyte, including Tolosa.
- g.) "End user" refers to any person or entity requiring the supply and delivery of electricity
- h.) "Hazardous activities" refer to planting of plants and trees, burning of waste and other materials, excavation, quarrying, construction, and other activities of the same nature and character and regardless of purpose intended, which are performed partially/wholly inside the powerline corridor which threaten or endanger the continuous and uninterrupted conveyance of electricity.
- i.) "Hazardous improvements" refer to plants, trees, structures, buildings and buildings of whatever kind, whether temporary or permanent in character, and regardless of purpose for which they are intended, which are located, partially or wholly inside the Power Line Corridor which threaten or endanger the continuous and uninterrupted conveyance of electricity.
- j.) "Owner or Operator of Power Lines" or "Power Line Owner/Operator" of "PLO" refers to DORELCO having the ownership and/or responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the distribution power lines.
- k.) "Power lines" refer to transmission lines, sub-transmission lines, distribution lines, and other connection assets including the poles and towers used to support the lines, and other related facilities constructed or erected used for the purpose of conveyance of
- 1.) "Power line obstruction" refers to any hazardous activity or hazardous improvement and other similar circumstances that threaten or endanger the continuous and uninterrupted conveyance of electricity.
- "Tall growing plants" refer to plants, vines and other plant species, which grow or have the potential to grow more than three (3) meters in height from the ground.
- n.) "Power Line Corridor (PLC)" refers to and is constituted as the land beneath, the air spaces surrounding, and the area traversed by power lines, which shall be kept clear and free from any power line obstructions, dangerous structures, hazardous activities and improvements and other similar circumstances in accordance with the provisions

Section 4. Prevention and Removal of Power Line Obstruction on Public Property. - In cases where the power line corridor is wholly or partially located within public property, DORELCO shall have the right to enter the said property to prevent and remove any power line obstruction, and perform the following acts:

(a) To conduct maintenance and inspection activities within the power line corridor.

- (b) To conduct repair or restoration activities within the power line corridor.
- (c) To conduct trimming, pruning, cutting, or clearing activities for tall growing plants within the power line corridor without the need of securing prior clearance or permit from the Local Government Unit of Tolosa.
- (d) To remove, dismantle, or demolish hazardous improvements in accordance with the National Building Code of the Philippines: Provided, that such acts may be carried out without prior clearances or permit from but with due notice to the Local Government Unit of Tolosa.
- (e) To stop, prevent, or prohibit the conduct of hazardous activities; and
- (f) Perform other analogous acts or activities, which will cause the prevention and removal of any power line obstruction.
- (g) Any damages that may be incurred during the cause of operation shall be the sole responsibility of DORELCO, which shall be liable for any and all resulting costs, repairs, or claims arising therefrom.

Section 5. Prevention and Removal of Power Line Obstruction on Private Property. — DORELCO shall have the primary duty and responsibility to remove power line obstructions. In cases where the power line corridor is wholly or partially located within a private property, the property owner shall coordinate and assist DORELCO by facilitating the necessary access in order to perform the acts enumerated in Section 4.

The property owner shall have the primary duty and responsibility to prevent power line obstructions and to inform DORELCO of their existence. In the performance of these acts, the acceptation, technical and manpower support from DORELCO.

In the event that the property owner fails to perform any duty and responsibility under the preceding paragraphs, the owner or operator of the power lines shall have the right to access the power line corridor in order to undertake the acts enumerated under Section 4: Provided, however, that the NOTICE TO THE PROPERTY OWNER shall no longer be required to avert an imminent danger posed by a power line obstruction.

Any damages that may be incurred during the cause of operation shall be the sole responsibility of DORELCO

Section 6. Assistance from the Barangay. — In the performance of this acts under Sections 4 and 5, DORELCO shall coordinate and be assisted by the Barangay concerned where the clearing or removal of line obstructions are being conducted.

The Barangay is mandated to provide assistance by way of providing manpower to augment the clearing crew/personnel of DORELCO.

The Barangay is mandated to keep its residents updated and notified of the clearing schedules as provided by DORELCO.

**Section 7. Disposal of Waste and Debris.** – Waste and debris which resulted from the removal of obstructions and other activities under this Ordinance shall be disposed of by the Barangay where the clearing or removal of line obstructions are conducted in accordance with the relevant barangay and municipal ordinances.

**Section 8. The DORELCO** shall assist in the disposal of debris beyond the Barangay's capacity, such as large branches and other oversized waste, in compliance with environmental laws and municipal regulations

**Section 9. Separability Clause.** – Any portion or provision of this Ordinance, which may be declared unconstitutional or invalid shall not have the effect of nullifying other portions or provisions hereof.

Section 10. Effectivity – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
