Subject: The Duplication Of Projects In San Isidro, Leyte

Date: April 2, 2025

Venue: SP Session Hall, 3rd Floor, Leyte Provincial Government Complex, Palo, Leyte

I. BACKGROUND

The Committee on Ways and Means convened a hearing to deliberate on the potential duplication of two infrastructure projects in San Isidro, Leyte, both involving the construction of an access road to Danao Elementary School, Brgy. Basud. The projects under review are:

1. DPWH GAA 2025 Project (to be funded in 2026) – “Construction of Road from Sitio Maasin to Sitio Danao Elementary School, Brgy. Basud, San Isidro, Leyte.”
2. Term Loan 11 under Municipal Ordinance No. 174, Series of 2025 – “Construction of Access Road along Danao Elementary School in Brgy. Basud.”

Concerns were raised regarding the redundancy of funding sources for what appeared to be the same infrastructure need.

III. DISCUSSION AND FINDINGS

1. Clarification of Project Timelines
 - DPWH representatives confirmed that the GAA 2025 project is programmed for implementation in 2026, meaning the construction will not commence this year. Engr. Cesar V. Makabenta manifested that the proposed “Construction of Road Sitio Maasin to Sitio Danao Elementary School, Brgy. Basud” is a multi-year project. This project has a total span of 2000 meters, starting from the junction of the National Road to Danao Elementary School, with a total proposed budget of Php 35,000,000.00. Of this multi-year project, Php 5,000,000.00 is already funded by the GAA 2025. The remaining Php 30,000,000 is to be included in the proposed National Expenditure Program for FY 2026.
 - The Municipal Government’s loan-funded project is ready for implementation within 2025, pending clearance on potential duplication concerns.
2. Urgency of the Project
 - Engr. Elrian D. Bactol, MPRM, Municipal Engineer of San Isidro, emphasized that the project is a priority request from Danao Elementary School due to the immediate need for an accessible road.
 - The existing road conditions pose difficulties for students, teachers, and residents, especially during inclement weather.
3. The Office of the Provincial Engineer did an actual site inspection and verification together with the Municipal Engineering Office.
 - The inspection team of the Office of the Provincial Engineer concurred with the findings of the Municipal Engineering Office that there is no overlapping or duplication. This conclusion is based on: 1) the GAA project has a different starting point than that of the LGU, and 2) the unpaved portion of the road is too long to be completed with the amounts budgeted in both the GAA for FY 2025 (Php 5,000,000) and Term Loan 11 of proposed Municipal Ordinance No. 174, s. 2025 (Php 10,000,000).
4. Committee Position on Funding and Implementation
 - Given the urgency of the project and considering that the DPWH-funded project will only commence in 2026, the Committee sees no issue in allowing the San Isidro LGU to proceed with its loan-funded road construction.
 - The Committee acknowledges the need to avoid duplication but also recognizes the importance of timely infrastructure development in response to the community's needs.

IV. COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

In light of the discussions, the Committee on Ways and Means recommends the following:

1. Allow the LGU of San Isidro to Proceed with its Loan-Funded Project
 - Since the DPWH project is set for 2026, the municipal government should be given clearance to implement the Term Loan 11 project in 2025 to

address the immediate concerns of Danao Elementary School and the local community.

2. **Reassess the Need for the DPWH Project in 2026**
 - Given that the LGU project will address the infrastructure gap ahead of schedule, the DPWH and San Isidro LGU should reassess the necessity of the DPWH-funded road project in 2026.
 - If the DPWH project is still deemed necessary, adjustments should be made to avoid redundancy and ensure efficient fund utilization.
3. **Improve Coordination Between National and Local Government Agencies**
 - The Committee urges the DPWH, Provincial Government, and LGUs to strengthen coordination efforts to prevent similar project duplication concerns in the future.
 - A unified project database should be established to monitor infrastructure plans and funding sources across government levels.

V. CONCLUSION

Since the National Expenditure Program for 2026 has yet to be ratified by Congress, this Committee finds that no duplicity or overlap exists between Project Term Loan 11, which is designated for the construction of an access road to Danao Elementary School, and the concurrent DPWH project funded in the GAA 2025.

The Committee on Ways and Means affirms its unwavering commitment to the principles of efficiency, transparency, and accountability in the execution of public infrastructure projects, thereby serving the best interests of the constituents of Leyte. Moreover, the Committee acknowledges the pressing necessity for infrastructure development and the prudent allocation of financial resources. In light of the findings presented, the Committee supports the immediate implementation of the LGU-funded access road project in San Isidro, taking into account the protracted timeline associated with the DPWH project and the urgent request from the educational institution.

Accordingly, this Committee formally recommends the approval of Ordinance No. 174 s. 2025 of San Isidro, Leyte.

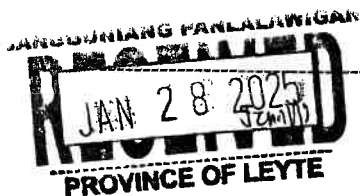

Issues/ concerns for review/ recommendation/legal opinion is/ are as follows:

- Municipal Ordinance No. 174 s. 2025 entitled: **“An Ordinance Authorizing the Proposed Borrowing of the Municipality of San Isidro, Leyte, in the Amount of Sixty Million Pesos (P60,000.00) to Fund the Local Priority Development Projects in the Municipality.”**

REVIEW/RECOMMENDATION/LEGAL OPINION:

This office is of the opinion that the subject Ordinance is generally in accordance with its power under Section 447(a)(2)(iii)¹ and Section 297² of the Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A. 7160). However, this Office notes that in the title of the Ordinance the numerical figure shown is “P60,000.00” which contradicts the number specified in words which is “Six Million Pesos”. Thus, the numerical figure needs to be revised to conform with the number specified in words. Considering the foregoing, further review of said Ordinance is recommended.

Please note that the opinion rendered by this Office are based on the facts available and may vary or change when additional facts and documents are presented or changed. This opinion is likewise without prejudice to the opinions rendered by higher and competent authorities and/or the courts.

¹ (iii) Subject to the provisions of Book II of this Code and upon the majority vote of all the members of the sangguniang bayan, authorize the municipal mayor to negotiate and contract loans and other forms of indebtedness;

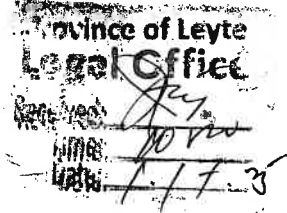
² **Section 297. Loans, Credits, and Other Forms of Indebtedness of Local Government Units. -**

(a) A local government unit may contract loans, credits, and other forms of indebtedness with any government or domestic private bank and other lending institutions to finance the construction, installation, improvement, expansion, operation, or maintenance of public facilities, infrastructure facilities, housing projects, the acquisition of real property, and the implementation of other capital investment projects, subject to such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon by the local government unit and the lender. The proceeds from such transactions shall accrue directly to the local government unit concerned.

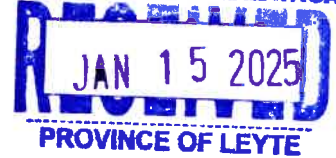

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PROPOSED BORROWING OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN ISIDRO, LEYTE IN THE AMOUNT OF SIXTY MILLION PESOS (P 60,000.00) TO FUND THE LOCAL PRIORITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS IN THE MUNICIPALITY.

BE IT ENACTED by the Sangguniang Bayan of San Isidro, Leyte in session assembled that:

Section 1. Title. — The Municipal Mayor, in representation of the Municipality of San Isidro herein after referred to as the “Municipality”, is hereby authorized to enter into Term Loan Facility (TL 10) amounting to Ten Million Pesos (P10,000,000.00), Term Loan Facility (TL 11) amounting to Ten Million Pesos (P10,000,000.00), and Term Loan Facility (TL 12) amounting to Forty Million Pesos (P 40,000,000.00) with the Land Bank of Philippines in accordance with Section 297 of Republic Act No. 7160 a.k.a. the Local Government Code of 1991, in the total amount of Sixty Million Pesos (P 60,000,000.00) under the terms and conditions herein set forth and such other terms and conditions as may be agreed upon with any person, corporation or entity for the purpose of funding priority projects, and subject to the requirements under Section 123 of Republic Act No. 7653 as implemented by the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas Circular No. 402. In this connection, the Municipal Mayor shall have full power and authority represent the Municipality of San Isidro, Leyte in negotiation the terms and conditions for the said borrowing and in signing, executing and delivering such agreements, contracts, deeds, papers, and documents as may be

necessary and proper for the full and total implementation of the authority herein granted.

SECTION 2. The said local priority development projects herein specified as the following: a.) Water Source Development of the Municipality; b.) Construction of Access Road along Danao Elementary School; and c.) Improvement of Municipal Park (Lagoon) are certified to be a local infrastructure and/or other socio-economic development projects in accordance with the approved local development plan and public investment program for the period 2024 and for the current year 2025 of the Municipality of San Isidro, Leyte and is supported by a final feasibility study prepared by the Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator which is also hereby approved by the Sangguniang Bayan Resolution No. 2024-218 dated December 16, 2024.

SECTION 3. Consistent with the covering borrowing/loan contract, deeds and assignment, mortgage contracts, and such other agreements as maybe entered into by the Municipality/ City / Province in connection with the borrowing, the features, terms and conditions shall be as follows and are hereby approved.

I. Term Loan 10

Name of Account: Municipal Government of San Isidro, Leyte
Project: To finance the Water Source Development of the municipality.
Principal: 10,000,000.00
Interest: At LANDBANK's prevailing rate at the time of availment, subject to quarterly repricing.
Term: Fifteen (15) years reckoned from the date of initial drawdown, inclusive of two (2) years grace period on principal repayment.
Mode of Payment: Principal shall be payable in fifty-two (52) equal quarterly amortizations to start at the end of the 9th quarter from date of initial loan release.
Interest shall be payable quarterly in arrears to start at the end of the first quarter from date of initial loan release.

II. Term Loan 11

Name of Account: Municipal Government of San Isidro, Leyte
Project: To finance the Construction of Access Road along Danao Elementary School.
Principal: 10,000,000.00
Interest: At LANDBANK's prevailing rate at the time of availment, subject to quarterly repricing.
Term: Fifteen (15) years reckoned from the date of initial drawdown, inclusive of two (2) years grace period on principal repayment.
Mode of Payment: Principal shall be payable in fifty-two (52) equal quarterly amortizations to start at the end of the 9th quarter from date of initial loan release.
Interest shall be payable quarterly in arrears to start at the end of the first quarter from date of initial loan release.

II. Term Loan 12

Name of Account: Municipal Government of San Isidro, Leyte
Project: To finance the Improvement of the Municipal Park(Lagoon)
Principal: 40,000,000.00
Interest: At LANDBANK's prevailing rate at the time of availment, subject to quarterly repricing.
Term: Fifteen (15) years reckoned from the date of initial drawdown, inclusive of two (2) years grace period on principal repayment.
Mode of Payment: Principal shall be payable in fifty-two (52) equal quarterly amortizations to start at the end of the 9th quarter from date of initial loan release.
Interest shall be payable quarterly in arrears to start at the end of the first quarter from date of initial loan release.


SECTION 4. The Municipality hereby appropriates the entire proceeds of the borrowing exclusively to finance LGU-Local Development Project: Water Source Development of the Municipality, Construction of Access Road along Danao Elementary School and Improvement of the Municipal Park (Lagoon).

SECTION 5. Any Ordinance or parts thereof, inconsistent with this enactment is hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its publication and compliance with all procedures required under Republic Act No. 7160 of an ordinance for its validity, including the affixation of signatures of the Sanggunian Bayan members, on all pages of this Ordinance.







We are pleased to inform you that Land Bank of the Philippines has approved your request for the establishments of Term Loan Facility (TL 10) amounting to PESOS: TEN MILLION ONLY (P10,000,000.00), Term Loan Facility (TL 11) amounting to PESOS: TEN MILLION ONLY (P10,000,000.00), and Term Loan Facility (TL 12) amounting to PESOS: FORTY MILLION ONLY (P40,000,000.00). The loan is subject to the Bank's standard terms and conditions and to the following specific terms and conditions:

Other Terms and Conditions:

1. Mode of Release

Loan releases for construction projects shall be on staggered basis, as follows:

First Release – 15% of the approved amount or contract price, whichever is lower.

Succeeding Releases – in tranches via progress billing duly supported by LGU's Accomplishment Report as approved by Local Chief Executive (LCE).

Final Release – minimum of 10% subject to submission of the following:

- a. Certificate of Acceptance by the LCE; and
- b. PVSD/FSSC Inspection/Appraisal Report showing 100% completion.

2. Handling and commitment fees shall be waived. Prepayment shall be allowed and the pre-payment penalty of two percent (2%) shall be waived unless taken-out by other financial institution/banks.

3. Penalty rate of twenty four percent (24%) per annum, in case of non-payment, shall be charged, to start on the day after due date of loan amortization/credit accommodation up to the date of settlement.

4. LANDBANK shall be authorized to debit from the LGUs deposit account with the Bank the amount of amortization due, insurance premium and other charges.

5. Cost overruns shall be for the account of the borrower.

6. The Bank reserves the right to withhold loan releases should there be:

- a. A case filed against the LGU or its officials involving the projects to be financed.
- b. Adverse findings on the project or object of financing, or
- c. Withdrawal of the Sanggunian on the authority of the Local Chief Executive (LCE) to contract this loan.

7. LANDBANK shall be the LGU's official depository bank of its NTA and major depository bank for its deposits, revenue and collections which designation shall not be revoked while the loan obligation remains outstanding and directing the LGU Secretary to provide a copy of the Resolution to DBM or other NTA administering office.

8. The Borrower shall give its consent to LANDBANK to disclose credit information about the Borrower to other Banks, Financial Institutions, the Banker's Association of Philippines-Credit Bureau and other Credit Bureaus or Institutions.

9. Post-release requirements: The LGU shall submit annually a certification that the proposed source of repayment are available and not restricted by law and its obligations and are appropriated in their respective budget.

10. The BORROWER hereby waives his/her/its rights under applicable laws on bank secrecy and information security existing or may hereafter be enacted, such as Republic Act (R.A.) No. 1405 (The Law on Secrecy of Bank Deposits), R.A. 6426 (Foreign Currency Deposit Act), R.A. 8791 (The General Banking Law), R.A. 10173 (Data Privacy Act), and authorizes the LENDER: (a) pursuant to BSP Circular No. 472 Series of 2005, as amended, and as implemented by BIR Revenue Regulation RR 4-2005, to verify with the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) (or such other taxing authority that may substitute it) in order to establish authenticity of the annual income tax returns and accompanying financial statements and documents or information submitted by the BORROWER, (b) to inquire into any of the deposit accounts or properties maintained by the BORROWER with the LENDER, its parent, subsidiaries or affiliates for the purpose of implementing the Automatic Debit Authorization or set-off provisions, and (c) obtain from or disclose to its parent, subsidiaries, affiliates, or credit bureau any information regarding the BORROWER, the Loan/Line or this Agreement, as the LENDER may deem necessary to exercise its rights under this Agreement or as may be allowed or required by applicable laws, rules and regulations. The BORROWER also hereby authorizes the LENDER to request information on the status of any court case to which he/she/it is a party. WHEREAS, the Honorable Marie Kathryn Veloso - Kabigting, suggested that the Sangguniang Bayan of San Isidro specify the recipient Barangays for the proposed projects for transparency, good debt management and credibility;

WHEREAS, the August Body, deemed it proper to return said Ordinance to the SB of origin for further review;

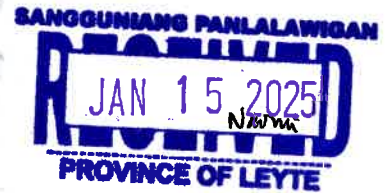

Section 1. Title. — The Municipal Mayor, in representation of the Municipality of San Isidro herein after referred to as the "Municipality", is hereby authorized to enter into Term Loan Facility (TL 10) amounting to Ten Million Pesos (P10,000,000.00), Term Loan Facility (TL 11) amounting to Ten Million Pesos (P10,000,000.00), and Term Loan Facility (TL 12) amounting to Forty Million Pesos (P 40,000,000.00) with the Land Bank of Philippines in accordance with Section 297 of Republic Act No. 7160 a.k.a. the Local Government Code of 1991, in the total amount of Sixty Million Pesos (P 60,000,000.00) under the terms and conditions herein set forth and such other terms and conditions as may be agreed upon with any person, corporation or entity for the purpose of funding priority projects, and subject to the requirements under Section 123 of Republic Act No. 7653 as implemented by the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas Circular No. 402. In this connection, the Municipal Mayor shall have full power and authority represent the Municipality of San Isidro, Leyte in negotiation the terms and conditions for the said borrowing and in signing, executing and delivering such agreements, contracts, deeds, papers, and documents as may be

necessary and proper for the full and total implementation of the authority herein granted.

SECTION 2. The said local priority development projects herein specified as the following: a.) Water Source Development of the Municipality; b.) SECTION 4. The Municipality hereby appropriates the entire proceeds of the borrowing exclusively to finance LGU-Local Development Project: Water Source Development of the Municipality, Construction of Access Road along Danao Elementary School and Improvement of the Municipal Park (Lagoon).



Fidel, Jr. under 2025 GAA worth P 5,000,000.00 from Sitio Maasin to Sitio Danao,

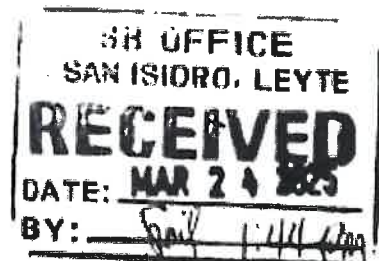

Warmest Greetings!

In response to Resolution No. 2025-132 regarding the alleged duplication of the Local Government Unit (LGU) project and the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) project, we would like to clarify that there is no overlap between the two projects.


The total road stretch from Sitio Danao to Sitio Maasin is approximately 1.8 kilometers. The LGU project covers only 529.9 meters of this stretch, with a budget of ₱10 million, while the DPWH project has a budget of ₱5 million, which we presume corresponds to a shorter length. Given this budget allocation, it is unlikely that the DPWH project will exceed the extent of the LGU project.

Furthermore, the DPWH project will commence from Sitio Maasin to Sitio Danao, while the LGU project starts from Sitio Danao to Sitio Maasin. This clear separation in direction further supports that both projects are distinct and do not duplicate each other.

We hope this clarification sufficiently addresses the concerns raised in the resolution. Should further details be required, we are open to discussions and documentation review.

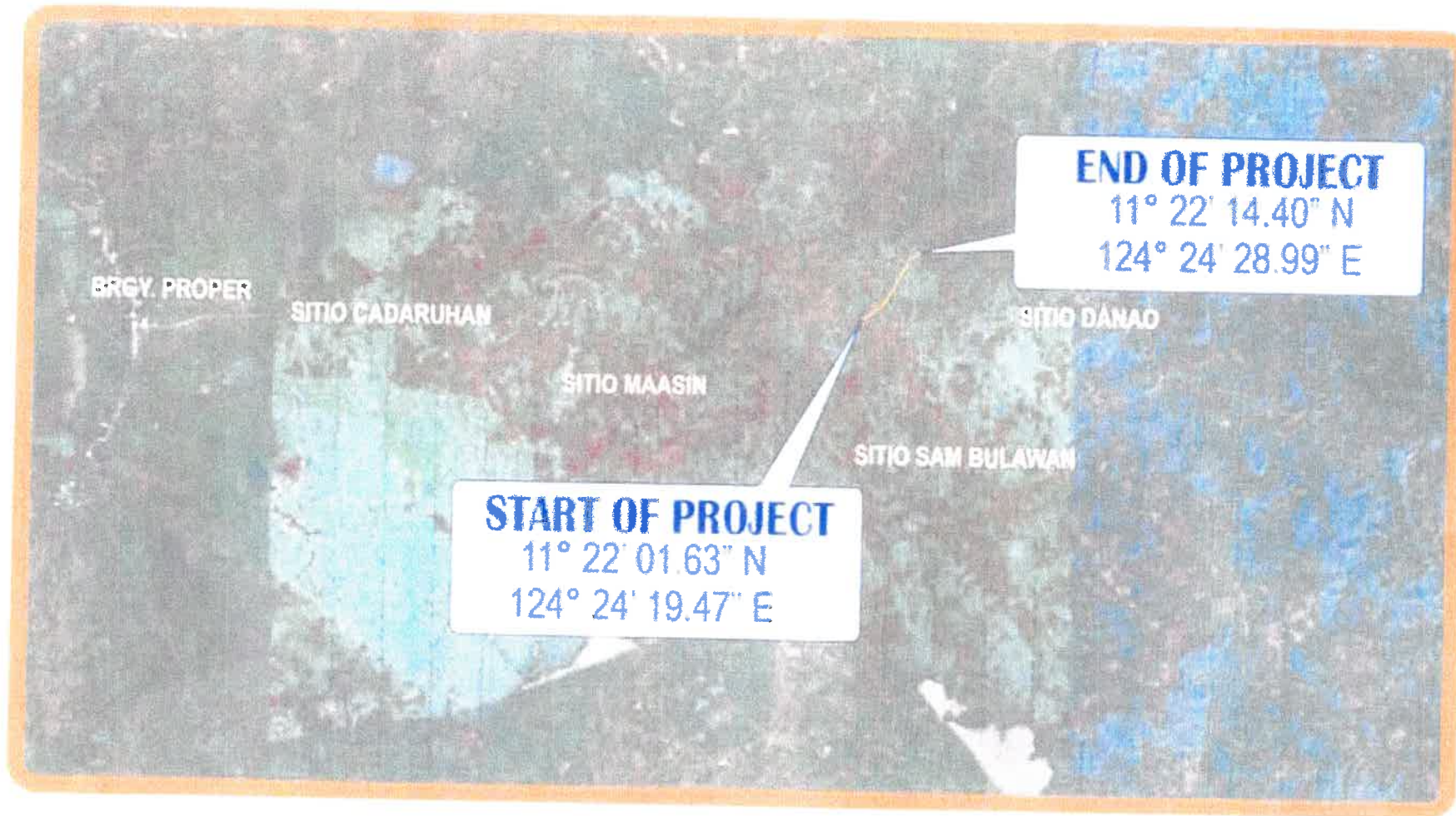

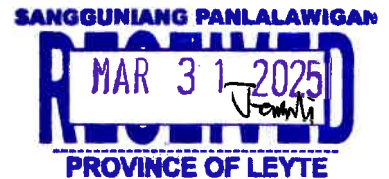
