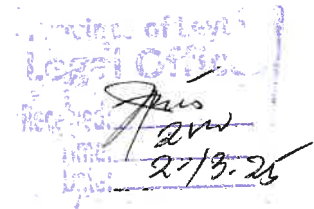

manage the unauthorized manufacture, sale, and distribution of PNP uniforms, insignias and other accoutrements.

WHEREAS, E.O. No. 297 impose as penalties the immediate closure of establishment; cancellation of business license or permit, condemnation, seizure and forfeiture of unauthorized items and imposition of reasonable fines for violators of the said order, all of which could be undertaken by the local government units concerned;

WHEREAS, the authorized manufactured, sale, use and distribution of PNP uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrements impose serious concerns since such symbolic PNP identifiers, instead of providing a comforting sense of security, could be used by lawless elements in the commission of crimes within the municipality;

WHEREAS, considering that the "PNP National Headquarters" sits within the territorial jurisdiction of Pastrana, Leyte and there are a number of business establishments that engage in the manufacture, sale and distribution of PNP uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrements there is a dire need enact a corresponding municipal uniforms and commission of illegal activities within Pastrana, Leyte;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Pastrana, Leyte in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. TITLE OF ORDINANCE- The Ordinance shall be known as: An Ordinance Mandating Business Operating within the Territorial Jurisdiction of Pastrana, Leyte to Secure a PNP Certificate of Conformity before Manufacturing, Selling, Using or Distributing PNP Uniforms, Insignia's, and Other Accoutrements and Prescribing Penalties for Violations Thereof.

SECTION 2. SCOPE AND APPLICATION- All businesses, whether in physical, online or in digital platforms, engaged in the manufacture, sale, use, and distribution of Philippines National Police uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrements. It includes enterprises dealing with raw materials for the production of aforementioned items.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS- For purposes of implementation of this Ordinance, the following definitions shall be binding and controlling:

- a) PNP uniforms, insignias and accoutrements- these are authorized clothing, garment, distinguishing mark emblem, merchandise, or decorations worn by bonafide members and officially acknowledged by the PNP.
- b) PNP Certificate of Conformity- a certification issued by the PNP through the Directorate for Research and Development (DRD) which signifies authority to manufacture, sell, or distribute PNP uniforms, insignias and accoutrements.
- c) Distributor- an authorized agent of a supplier or manufacturer to supply of deliver PNP uniforms insignias and accoutrements wherein the latter has a valid PNP Certificate of Conformity.

- d) Manufacture and sale- act of producing or trading of fit-to-use, ready-to-wear, or ready-to-use PNP uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrements.
- e) Certificate of Distributorship and certification issued by a holder of PNP Certificate of Conformity which warrants that the person/company is authorized to distribute, supply or sell specific PNP uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrements.

SECTION 4. REQUIREMENT FOR PNP CERTIFICATE OF CONFORMITY AND/OR CERTIFICATE OF DISTRIBUTORSHIP-

All businesses engaged and dealing with PNP uniforms, insignias, and accoutrements must secure a PNP Certificate of Conformity and/or a Certificate of Distributorship before applying for a corresponding business license or permit. All existing businesses must likewise secure the same certification prior to its application for business license/permit renewal.

SECTION 5. IMPLEMENTING OFFICES- The Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO) is the primary office mandated to make the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) and to execute the provisions of this Ordinance, with the assistance of the Department of Public Order and Safety (DPOS) and the Information and Technology Department and in coordination with the PNP through the DRD.

SECTION 6. COORDINATION WITH THE PNP- The BPLO will regularly coordinate with the PNP DRD for the manufacturers, suppliers, sellers, distributors, etc., with valid and existing PNP Certificate of Conformity and/or Certificate of Distributorship. The updated list will be the basis of verification by the Municipal Government of Pastrana, Leyte of the status of the applicant for business license/permit.

SECTION 7. AUTHORITY TO INSPECT ESTABLISHMENTS- The DPOS shall be authorized to conduct inspection of business establishments requiring the presentation of its respective PNP Certificates of Conformity and/or Certificate of Distributorship. Authorized distributors of PNP uniforms insignias and other accoutrements shall likewise present acceptable proof of authority to supply sell or base aforementioned items.

SECTION 8. PENALTIES- Failure to present or submit a PNP Certificate of Conformity and/or PNP Certificate of Distributorship is a ground for denial of application for issuance/renewal of business permit or license for the covered businesses.

For purposes of this Ordinance after thirty (30) days from the initial findings of noncompliance, continued and subsequent failure to comply with the provisions of this Ordinance shall constitute ground for suspension, revocation, or cancellation of establishments business permit.

In case of violations found during the aforementioned inspections for failure to present competent proof of authority to deal PNP uniforms, insignias and other accoutrements, the items found there shall be seized or confiscated subject to proper disposal, without prejudice to the cancellation or revocation of business license/permit and the filing of appropriate administrative civil or criminal case.

Any violator of the aforementioned provisions shall be imposed of a penalty of fine not exceeding 2,500.00 Pesos not less than 1,500.00 Pesos and/or imprisonment for 15 days.

SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE- If for any reason, any section of this Ordinance shall be hold unconstitutional or invalid other sections which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and affect.

SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE- All ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that the rights that are vested upon the effectivity of this Ordinance shall not be impaired.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE- This Ordinance shall take effect the (10) days after its publication in a newspaper of local circulation.

MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING ON THE MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE “AN ORDINANCE MANDATING BUSINESS OPERATING WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION PF PASTRANA, LEYTE TO SECURE A PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP) CERTIFICATE OF CONFORMITY AND/OR CERTIFICATE DISTRIBUTORSHIP BEFORE MANUFACTURING, SELLING, USING OR DISTRIBUTING PNP UNIFORMS, INSIGNIAS AND OTHER ACCOUTREMENTS AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF” HELD LAST JULY 25, 2024 AT THE MUNICIPAL AUDITORIUM, THIS MUNICIPALITY.

I. Preliminaries

- a. The Public Hearing was conducted by the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan of Pastrana, Province of Leyte, spearheaded by the SB Committee Vice Chairman on Peace and Order and Public Safety and was joined by the members of the committee mentioned above.
- b. It was well participated by the different Drivers Association, Barangay Chairpersons, Sangguniang Kabataan Chairpersons and all others interested to listen to this particular public hearing. (Attached is the Attendance sheet)
- c. The said public Hearing was Presided over by Honorable Gerardo S. Carian, SB Committee Vice Chairman on Peace and Order and Public Safety.
- d. The said Public Hearing started at exactly 1:30 in the afternoon, and Prayer and the singing of the Philippine National Anthem was conducted through an overture.

II. Parliamentary Proceedings

- a. The Draft Ordinance, “AN ORDINANCE MANDATING BUSINESS OPERATING WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION PF PASTRANA, LEYTE TO SECURE A PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP) CERTIFICATE OF CONFORMITY AND/OR CERTIFICATE DISTRIBUTORSHIP BEFORE MANUFACTURING, SELLING, USING OR DISTRIBUTING PNP UNIFORMS, INSIGNIAS AND OTHER ACCOUTREMENTS AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF”, was presented by Hon Gerardo S. Carian and was read by the SB Staff Mr. Emelito Salvador Silva, with a power point presentation. After which Hon. Carian proceeded to the different Sections of the proposed ordinance and asked the participants if they have corrections and suggestions. Then, Hon. Loida B. Villablanca solicited for suggestions and ideas from the participants and according to him everyone is encouraged to share their opinions as all of those will be discussed and so they should not hesitate to do so.
- b. The Presiding Officer expressed that they can go over with each Sections to check and verify if they have clarifications.
- c. Since the proposed ordinance was only for adoption and the main concern for presenting it to the public is the penalty.
- d. Further discussion was conducted as to the process of the apprehension of the traffic violators.

III. Finally, "AN ORDINANCE MANDATING BUSINESS OPERATING WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION PF PASTRANA, LEYTE TO SECURE A PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP) CERTIFICATE OF CONFORMITY AND/OR CERTIFICATE DISTRIBUTORSHIP BEFORE MANUFACTURING, SELLING, USING OR DISTRIBUTING PNP UNIFORMS, INSIGNIAS AND OTHER ACCOUTREMENTS AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF" presented was applauded by everyone present and thus, being moved by Hon. Allan Encina, Barangay Chairperson of Barangay Manaybanay for approval. And this was duly seconded by Hon. Armando Lagera Barangay Chairperson of Barangay Sapsap.

IV. Since all participants were happy on the result of the Public Hearing with the approval of the majority participants present, so be it.

V. Adjournment




