 Ordinance No. 2025-12 entitled: "An Ordinance amending Municipal Ordinance No. 2015-12 otherwise known as "An Ordinance creating the Local Youth Development Council of the Municipality of Tanauan, Leyte and for other purposes."

REVIEW/RECOMMENDATION/LEGAL OPINION:

This office is of the opinion that the subject Ordinance is generally in accordance with its power for it is within the powers of the Local Council to repeal/amend its prior acts either expressly or by the passage of an essentially inconsistent resolution 1, subject to the availability of funds and to normal and regular accounting and auditing procedures. It is likewise recommended to change the docket number of the amending Ordinance to avoid confusion, since it is the same as the Ordinance sought to be amended. Hence, we recommend for the declaration of its validity.

Please note that the opinion rendered by this Office are based on the facts available and may vary or change when additional facts and documents are presented or changed. This opinion is likewise without prejudice to the opinions rendered by higher and competent authorities and/or the courts.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF TANAUAN, LEYTE IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED THAT:

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 13 of the 1987 Constitution provides that "the State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being. It shall inculcate in the youth patriotism and nationalism and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs;

WHEREAS, the right of children and young people to participate in governance has been recognized as early as the 1970s by the Philippine Government through PD603 or the Child and Youth Welfare Code. It is further enshrined in the Local Government Code (LGC) of 1990. The spirit of the law is to encourage active participation of our children and young people in local

SECTION 1. Section 15 of Ordinance No. 2015-12 is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 15. The Sports Achiever Awardee shall be entitled to a cash incentive in accordance to the following schedule:

A.) Provincial Competition

•	Gold Medal	-	P3,000.00
•	Silver Medal	-	P2,000.00
•	Bronze Medal	_	P1,000.00

B.) Regional Competition

•	Gold Medal	-	P5,000.00
•	Silver Medal	-	P3,000.00

C.) National Competition

•	Gold Medal	-	P10,000.00
0	Silver Medal	-	P7,500.00
•	Bronze Medal	-	P5,000.00

D.) International Competition

•	Gold Medal	-	P20,000.00
•	Silver Medal	-	P15,000.00
•	Bronze Medal	-	P10,000.00

Provided that only winners of the sports competition sanctioned by the Philippine Sports Commission or the Department of Education particularly the Provincial Meet, Eastern Visayas Regional Athletic Association (EVRAA) and the Palarong Pambansa, shall qualify for the incentives provided herein.

Provided further, that a certification issued by the appropriate sanctioning body shall be presented, unless the competition is under the auspices of the Department of Education.

SECTION 2. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – All other policies or laws creating organizations, council, or boards in the municipality which exist having similar program with the Local Youth Development Council are hereby repealed.



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

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-12

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE LOCAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TANAUAN, LEYTE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

> Introduced by: Hon. Mark Giffren E. Merilo, author Hon, Atty. Asterio Mario A. Villero, co-author

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SANGGGUNIANG BAYAN OF TANAUAN, LEYTE IN SESSION ASSEMBLED THAT:

Chapter I

Section 1. Title. - This Ordinance shall be known as the "Local Youth Development Council Ordinance of the Municipality of Tanauan, Leyte."

Section 2. Declaration of Policy. - It is a declared policy of the Municipality to promote and protect the physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social well-being of the Filipino youth, inculcating in them patriotism and nationalism, and encourage their involvement in public and civil affairs.

Section 3. Definition of Terms. – As used in this ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

- (a) Youth refers to a person whose age ranges from fifteen (15) to thirty (30) years as provided for under Republic Act 8044.
- (b) In-School-Youth refers to a youth attending either formal school or nonschool-based educational programs under institutions recognized by the State.
- (c) Out-of-School-Youth refers to youth not enrolled in any formal or vocational school, not employed or self-employed, and who is not college or technical/vocational school graduate.
- (d) Working Youth refers to youth who is either employed, self-employed, underemployed or who belongs to specific employable job seeking youth groups (such as graduates of tertiary and vocational schools, or those who previously were employed and are actively looking for work) both in the formal and informal sectors of the society.
- (e) Youth with Special Needs refers to youth marginalized by existing societal forces, namely: youth in indigenous cultural communities, youth with disabilities, youth in situations of armed conflict, victims of natural disasters and calamities, youth offenders, delinquent youth, drug-dependent youth, street youth, abused/exploited youth, and abandoned/neglected youth.
- Section 4. Local Youth Development Council. There shall be created a Local Youth Development Council which shall be responsible for the formulation of policies and implementation of youth development programs, projects and activities in coordination with various government and non-government organizations.
- Section 5. Objectives. Local Youth Development Councils shall have the following objectives:
 - a.) General Objectives:
 - 1. to develop and harness the full potential of the youth as responsible partners in nation-building;
 - 2. to encourage intensive and active participation of youth in all government and nongovernment programs, projects, and activities affecting them;
 - 3. to harmonize all government and non-government initiatives for the development of the youth sector; and
 - to supplement government appropriations for youth promotion and develop with funds from other sources;

- b.) Specific Objectives:
- to broaden and strengthen the services provided by the national government agencies, local government units and private agencies to young people;
- to provide information mechanism on youth opportunities on the areas of education, employment, livelihood, physical and mental health, capability-building and networking;
- to increase the spirit of volunteerism among the youth of the municipality particularly in the maintenance of peace and order and preservation, conservation and protection of the environment and natural resources within their locality;
- 4. to provide monitoring and coordinating mechanisms for youth programs, projects and activities; and
- 5. to provide venue for the active participation of the youth in cultural and ecotourism awareness program.

Section 6. Composition of the Council. – The Council shall be composed of the following:

- (a) Municipal Mayor Chairperson
- (b) SB Chairman of the Committee on Youth and Sport Development- Co-Chair.
- (c) Municipal Planning and Development Officer Vice-Chair
- (d) Municipal Social Welfare and Development Officer Vice- Chair
- (e) Schools Division Superintendent or his/her duly designated representative in the locality Member
- (f) Two (2) Youth Serving Organization representatives
 - 1. Church-based- Member
 - 2. Community-based Member

Section 7. Function of the Local Youth Development Council. – The following shall be the functions of the Local Youth Development Council:

- to formulate policies and component programs in coordination with the various government agencies handling youth-related programs, projects and activities;
- to coordinate and harmonize activities of all agencies and organizations in the Municipality engaged in youth development programs;
- to develop and provide support for the development and coordination of youth projects and design strategies to gain support and participation of the youth;
- to accredit sports and recreational centers, training centers and other institutions providing services to the youth as identified in the ordinance;
- 5. to assist the national government and government agencies, in the promotion of programs, projects and activities in the local level;
- to assist various government and non-government agencies in the identification and nomination of qualified participants to different programs, projects and activities;
- 7. to conduct fund raising programs and solicitations. It shall likewise receive donations, bequests, and may enter into contracts with other government and nongovernment agencies necessary for the accomplishment of the objectives of this ordinance:
- 8. to recommend youth programs and project proposals to appropriate government agencies and non-government organizations;

- to recommend youth programs and project proposals to appropriate government agencies and non-government organizations necessary for the accomplishment of the objectives of this ordinance;
- to accredit training pools for the purpose of assisting line agencies in implementing training and capability – building programs;
- 11. to solicit books and receive donations from any individual, non-government agencies, both local and international;
- 12. to create a research team that will formulate a mechanism to create a mechanism to come up with a Local Youth Situationer;
- 13. to establish youth centers as deemed necessary;
- 14. to monitor implementation of programs and projects at the local level;
- 15. to nominate its delegate to the National Youth Parliament; and
- 16. to perform such other functions as may be provided by law.

Section 8. Local Youth Development Plan. — The council shall formulate and adopt a five year Municipal Youth Development Plan which shall be duly supported by an ordinance enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan. The said plan shall be the basis for the implementation of Local Youth Development programs and services in coordination with the concerned agencies. These shall include but not limited to Youth Development Programs and Youth Development Services.

Section 9. Youth Center. – The Council may establish a Youth Center which shall be located in the Municipal proper. The Youth Center shall operate as a multi-purpose center or a Onestop shop facility.

Section 10. Meetings of the Council. – The Council shall meet at least once every 3 months or as often as maybe deemed necessary. The Chairman or his duly designated convenor shall preside in all council meetings.

Section 11. Appropriations. — There is a hereby authorized appropriation for the establishment of the Local Youth Development Council subject to the availability of funds.

Chapter II

Sports Achiever Award

Section 12. There is hereby established in the municipality of Tanauan, Leyte the "Sports Achiever Award" to honor and provide incentives to the persons who excel in the field of sports.

Section 13. The Sports Achiever Award program shall be conferred only to person or team:

- a.) Who, or the total membership thereof, is a resident of Tanauan, Leyte;
- b.) Who acquired a new title or successfully defended his/their current title in professional sports competition, or has won gold, silver or bronze medal in any regional, national or international amateur sports competition; and
- c.) Who submit certificate of award as proof of winning the competition.

Section 14. The Local Chief Executive's Office may process cash incentive for the medalists immediately after presentation and submission of necessary documents thereto, while the giving of plaques and/or certificates shall be on the second week of December of such year.

Only winners of the competitions sanctioned by the Philippine Sports Commission involving Regional and National levels shall be given cash incentives.

Section 16. The Office of the Municipal Mayor, through the Youth Development Council, shall formulate the necessary rules and regulations in the effective implementation of the provisions of this Ordinance.

Chapter III

Awards for Youth Excellence Program

Section 17. There is hereby established in the Municipality of Tanauan, Leyte the "Awards for Youth Excellence Program" (AYEP) for the youth who excel in the fields of leadership, academics, literature, culture, and the arts.

Section 18. The Awards for Youth Excellence Program (AYEP) shall be available only to person:

- a.) who is fifteen (15) to thirty (30) years of age;
- b.) who is a resident of the Municipality of Tanauan; and
- c.) who won in any competition that has regional and/or national qualifying levels, or a recipient of prestigious award in the field of leadership, academics, literature, culture, or the arts, or topped the Bar or any licensure examination duly accredited by the Professional Regulatory Commission (PRC).

The program maybe conferred also to group of persons who compete in a contest requiring the participation of at least five (5) individuals per group.

Section 19. The search for the outstanding youth who may be conferred of AYEP on the second week of December of every year shall begin from January up to October of the same

Section 22. All other policies or laws creating organizations, councils or boards in the municipality which exist having similar program with the Local Youth Development Council are hereby repealed.
