AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE MANUFACTURE, SALE, DISTRIBUTION, AND USE OF PNP UNIFORMS, INSIGNIAS, AND OTHER ACCOUTREMENTS WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TABANGO, LEYTE.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code or Republic Act No. 7160. also known as the General Welfare Clause provides in part that every local government unit shall ensure and support the maintenance of peace and order within their respective territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 297 entitled Regulating the Manufacture, Sale, Distribution, and Use of PNP Uniforms, Insignias, and Other Accouterments was signed on October 4, 2000, to control and manage the unauthorized manufacture, sale, and distribution of PNP uniforms, insignias, and other accouterments;

WHEREAS, the unauthorized manufacture, insignia sale, use, and distribution of PNP uniforms, insignias, and other accouterments impose serious concerns since such symbolic PNP identifiers, instead of providing a comforting sense of security, could be used by lawless elements in the commission of crimes within the municipality;

WHEREAS, there is a need to enact a corresponding ordinance to mitigate, or even eradicate, the proliferation of the unauthorized use of PNP uniforms, and the commission of illegal activities within the municipality;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Tabango, Leyte in its session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the "PNP UNIFORMS, INSIGNIAS, AND OTHER ACCOUTREMENTS REGULATION ORDINANCE."

SECTION 2. SCOPE AND APPLICATION. All businesses operating within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Tabango whether physical, online, or in digital platforms, engaged in the manufacture, sale, and distribution of Philippine National Police uniforms. insignias, and other accouterments.

SECTION 3. PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to regulate the manufacture, sale, distribution, and use of PNP uniforms, insignias, and other accouterments to prevent unauthorized use and to maintain the integrity and dignity of the Philippine National Police.

SECTION 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS. For purposes of implementation, the following definitions shall be binding and controlling:

- PNP uniform refers to the authorized clothing or official attire worn by a bonafide member and officially acknowledged by the Philippine National Police.
- 2) Insignias refers to emblems or badges indicating rank, position, or affiliation with the PNP.
- 3) Accouterments refer to accessories or equipment worn by a PNP Officer, including but not limited to belts, holsters, and protective gear.
- 4) PNP Certificate of Conformity (COC) refers to a certification issued by the PNP through the Directorate for Research and Development (DRD) which signifies authority to manufacture, sell, or distribute PNP uniforms, insignias, and accounterments.
- 5) Distributor refers to an authorized agent of a supplier or manufacturer to supply or deliver PNP uniforms, insignias, and accounterments wherein the latter has a valid PNP Certificate of conformity.
- 6) Manufacturer refers to an act of producing or trading fit-to-use, ready-to-wear, or ready-to-use PNP uniforms, insignias, and other accounterments.

SON C VOSQTROS SECTION 5. REGULATION ON MANUFACTURE, SALE, AND DISTRIBUTION.

- No individual or business entity shall manufacture, sell, or distribute PNP uniforms, insignias, or other accouterments without a valid business permit issued by the local government unit (LGU) of Tabango.
- 2) All businesses engaged and dealing with PNP uniforms, insignias, and accouterments must secure a PNP Certificate of Conformity (COC), which shall be post-permit compliance to all businesses after the issuance of a business permit.

SECTION 6. REGULATION ON USE. Only members of the Philippine National Police (PNP) are authorized to wear official uniforms, insignias, and accounterments.

SECTION 7. AUTHORITY TO INSPECT ESTABLISHMENTS. The Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO) in coordination with the PNP, shall periodically conduct joint inspections of covered business establishments requiring the presentation of the PNP Certificate of Conformity.

SECTION 8. ENFORCEMENT. The Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO) is the primary office mandated to implement and execute the provisions of this Ordinance and in coordination with the Tabango Police Office.

SECTION 9. PENALTIES. Violations of this Ordinance shall be subject to the following penalties:

- 1) For unauthorized manufacture, sale, and distribution:
 - 1st Offense ₱1,000.00
 - 2nd Offense ₱2,000.00 and suspension of the business permit for seven (7) days
 - 3rd Offense ₱2,500.00 and revocation of the business permit.
- 2) For unauthorized use:
 - 1st Offense ₱500.00
 - 2nd Offense ₱1,500.00
 - 3rd and subsequent Offenses ₱2,500.00 or imprisonment not exceeding six
 (6) months, or both in the discretion of the court.

SECTION 10. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be found to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions thereof which are not affected thereby, shall continue to be in full force and effect.
