

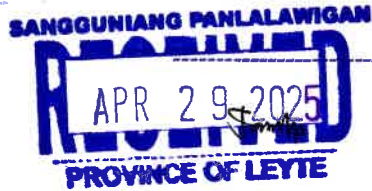

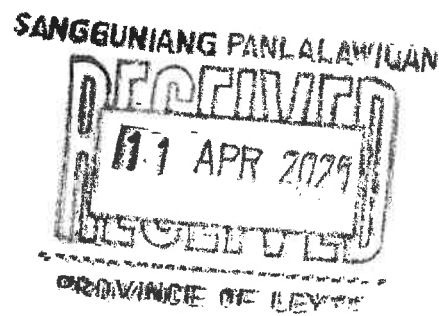

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE NEW VISION-MISSION GOAL (VMG) STATEMENTS OF ABUYOG COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

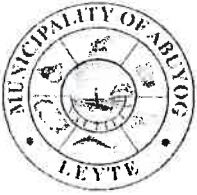




