This is to provide information and clarification regarding an ongoing activity involving the transfer and treatment of medical wastes originating from Mandaue City, Cebu, to the Province of Leyte.

The medical wastes, with an estimated volume of more than 300 drums consisting mainly of pathological and infectious wastes, are sourced from the Mandaue City Integrated Solid Waste Management Facility (ISWMF). The activity is coordinated through the Mandaue City Environment and Natural Resources Office (MCENRO).

The wastes will be transported to Cleanaway Philippines, Inc. (CPI) located at the Leyte Industrial Development Estate (LIDE) in Isabel, Leyte. CPI serves as a key regional hub for hazardous and medical waste management in Eastern Visayas, catering to waste generators across the Visayas and Mindanao regions.

Upon arrival at CPI, pathological and infectious wastes will undergo treatment using Autoclave technology (Hydroclave or Pyroclave systems). After treatment, the sterilized and inert residues will be disposed of at CPI's own sanitary landfill located within the same facility in Isabel, Leyte.

In terms of regulatory compliance, the following permits and registrations have been secured to legally facilitate the transport and treatment of these wastes:

The Mandaue City ISWMF holds a Hazardous Wastes Generator Registration Certificate (OL-G-R7-22-065869) issued by EMB Region 7 on 05 January 2025 and a Permit to Transport (OL-P-R8-37-146258) covering 21.28 Metric Tons of pathological and infectious wastes issued by EMB Region 8 on 07 July 2025.

Cleanaway Philippines, Inc. is duly registered as a Treatment, Storage, and Disposal (TSD) facility under TSD Registration Certificate (OL-TR-R8-37-000136) issued by the EMB Central Office on 27 September 2024, valid for one year and renewable.

CPI is also authorized to operate as a hazardous waste transporter under HW Transporter Registration Certificate (OL-TP-R8-37-000184), last amended on 21 April 2025.

This operation is aligned with environmental management protocols for the safe handling, treatment, and disposal of medical wastes and remains under the regulatory oversight of the Environmental Management Bureau (EMB).
