
**Issues/concerns for review/recommendation/legal opinion is/are as follows:**

- Ordinance No. 14 s. 2025 entitled: **“An Ordinance granting cash incentives to champion athletes of the Municipality of Villaba, representing in provincial regional, national, and international competition at all levels and appropriating funds therefor, etc.”**

**REVIEW/RECOMMENDATION/LEGAL OPINION:**

This office is of the opinion that the subject Ordinance is generally in accordance with its power under Section 447(a)(1)<sup>1</sup> of the Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A 7160). However, it is recommended that Section 8 of the subject Ordinance should specify from where and how the funds are to be sourced as not to run afoul Section 335<sup>2</sup> of the same Code. Hence, further review of the Ordinance is recommended.

We hope to have assisted you with this request. Please note that the opinion rendered by this Office are based on the facts available and may vary or change when additional facts and documents are presented or changed. This opinion is likewise without prejudice to the opinions rendered by higher and competent authorities and/or the courts.

<sup>1</sup> (a) *The sangguniang bayan, as the legislative body of the municipality, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the municipality as provided for under Section 22 of this Code, and shall:*  
*(1) Approve ordinances and pass resolutions necessary for an efficient and effective municipal government*



**MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 14, S. 2025**

**AN ORDINANCE GRANTING CASH INCENTIVES TO CHAMPION ATHLETES OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF VILLABA REPRESENTING IN PROVINCIAL, REGIONAL, NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION AT ALL LEVELS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR**

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The Philippine Government has adopted a policy of incentivizing athletes who are winners or medalists in legitimate international and local sports competitions pursuant to R.A. 9064 or the National Athletes, Coaches and Trainers Benefits and Incentives Act of 2001;






Article II, SECTION 17 of the Philippine Constitution provides that "The State shall give priority to education, science and technology, arts, culture, and sports to foster patriotism and nationalism, accelerate social progress, and promote total human liberation and development";

Article XIV, SECTION 19 (1) of the same fundamental law provides that "The State shall promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork, and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry";

Providing incentives to the winners of sports competitions is giving credence to their achievements worthy of emulation by the younger generation. These winners, through their sacrifices, enthusiasm, and motivation, serve as inspiration and good role models to our youth whom they look up to in life. In so doing, these winners do not just give hope, honor, glory and pride to themselves, their own families, and their locality but also to the Municipality of Villaba.

For bringing of honor and prestige to the name of the Municipality of Villaba, the Local Government of Villaba deems it right to provide due compensation in the form of cash incentives to these deserving athletes;

**Section 1. TITLE.** This Ordinance shall be known as "VILLABA ATHLETES SPORTS INCENTIVE PROGRAM".

**Section 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY.** It is a policy of the Municipality of Villaba, Leyte to promote the excellence of youth in various fields of sports competitions by extending financial incentives to these youth/athletes in duly recognition of the honor they brought to the Municipality by representing and winning in varying level of competitions.

**Section 3. SCOPE AND COVERAGE.** The athletes, who may be entitled to the incentives granted by this Ordinance shall be those who have landed as Champions in their respective levels of Sports Competitions.

**Section 4. DECLARATION OF PURPOSE.** It is hereby declared a policy of the Municipality of Villaba to extend financial incentives to deserving athletes for having given honor to the Municipality in various legitimate competitions in the fields of sports competitions.

**Section 5. DEFINITION OF WORDS AND PHRASES.** For the purpose of this ordinance, the terms hereunder mentioned shall be defined as follows:


1. **SPORTS COMPETITION-** refer to various sports competitions that are accredited or sanctioned by the following government agencies:
  - Department of Education (DepEd)
  - Philippine Olympic Committee (POC)
  - Philippine Sports Commission (PSC)
  - Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG)
  - Commission on Higher Education (CHED)
  - Higher Education Institution (HEI)
2. **ATHLETE-** bona-fide resident of the Municipality of Villaba and must have duly represented the Municipality of Villaba in the sports competitions she/he had participated involving physical strength, speed or endurance.
3. **COMPETITION-** refers to all forms of sports activities vied by athletes for excellence, except exhibition games.
4. **GRANTEE-** this refers to a Gold/ Champion title holder Filipino Citizen who is qualified to avail the privileges granted by this ordinance.

**Section 6. SPORTS COMPETITION CATEGORIES-**Sports competitions may be categorized as;



**Section 7. QUALIFICATION OF GRANTEES.** To qualify as a grantee, he/she must:

- Must be naturally born of the Municipality of Villaba and must have duly represented the Municipality of Villaba in the competitions and have successfully won GOLD/CHAMPION in the said competition she/he had participated;
- Have informed the Municipal Sports Incentive Committee through writing of his/her participation and that she/he is an official representative of the Municipality, Province, Region and/or the country in a particular competition before the actual competition for records purposes;
- Be able to submit the following requirements in original and/or certified true copy:
  - Certification and appropriate documentations that he/she participated and won first (1st) place or gold medal accordingly in a duly accredited sports competitions in the provincial, regional, national, international and worldwide levels.
  - Birth Certificate issued by the Philippine Statistics Authority.
  - Certification from School Head that the athlete duly enrolled in the said institution.

**International Level- 50,000.00**

**Section 9. MUNICIPAL SPORTS INCENTIVE COMMITTEE AND ITS ESTABLISHMENT.** The Municipal Sports Incentive Committee is hereby created, which primarily tasked is to judiciously screen applicants based on the qualifications set forth in this ordinance and its implementing rules and regulations. The Chairman is the Municipal Mayor and the members shall be appointed by the Local Chief Executive who shall serve a period of three (3) calendar years and upon the effectivity of the term of service of the appointing officer and subject to reappointment. The Municipal Sports Incentive Committee is composed of the following:

Chairman: Municipal Mayor

Vice Chairman: Municipal Vice Mayor

Members: Local Youth Development Officer

Municipal Social Welfare and Development Officer






**Section 12. MANDATORY FUNDING REQUIREMENT.** To carry out the provisions of this ordinance, the amount of THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P300, 000.00) shall be appropriated annually from the General Fund of the Municipality.

**Section 13. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

**Section 14. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All ordinances, as well as pertinent rules and regulations thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

**Section 15. EFFECTIVITY.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its completion of the publication requirements.

### MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING

The public hearing commenced at 1:30 in the afternoon and was attended by the Municipal Budget Officer, Mr. Manuel Rubillos, the Municipal Accountant, Mr. Antonio G. Calumba, the Local Youth Development Officer, Mr. Felix Albaño Jr, Mrs. Frances Ruth Rodriguez, representative from the Office of the Municipal Treasurer and the Rhodora Avon Ylaya, Sangguniang Bayan Staff. After the reading and presentation of the proposed ordinance, Mr. Albaño manifested that the amount as cash incentive for the individual and group sports category shall be increased. Mr. Rubillos explicated that this is to give justice to the effort and pride given by the athletes in representing the municipality and to motivate the athlete to compete for Gold/Champion Award, as this amount is also an expression of support of the Local Government Unit to our athletes. The members of the Local Finance Committee agreed to the allocate bigger funds for the purpose since this will be a great help to the athletes who will represent the municipality and the allocation shall be incorporated in the Sports Development Funds. The Local Youth Development Officer also manifested that in the meantime, since the budget for the calendar year 2025 is already approved and this incentives were not yet included, the allocated budget for the Sports Development Funds can be use for this calendar year.

The attendees also commented with regards to the requirements to be submitted by the grantees as indicated in the proposed ordinance, that an original copy of the Birth Certificate from the Philippine National Statistics Office must be submitted in lieu of the Barangay Certificate of Residency, considering that not all of the athletes are currently residing in the jurisdiction of the municipality due to training requirements and the lack of sports equipment here in our municipality, especially to those who will compete for the National and International Sports Competition. It was also a highlight in the said public hearing that all schools in the municipality shall be furnished with a copy of the ordinance to boost our learners' determination in the athletic field.

The public hearing ended at 2:30 in the afternoon.

- In the meantime, the budget allocations under the Sports Development Fund will be used for the implementation of the ordinance for this calendar year.






