**REVIEW/RECOMMENDATION/LEGAL OPINION:**

This office opines that the subject Ordinance is, in general, within the legislative authority of the Sangguniang Bayan under Section 447(a)(1)<sup>1</sup> of the Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A 7160) pursuant to RA 11361<sup>2</sup>. Hence, we recommend for the declaration of its validity.

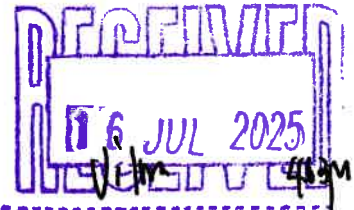

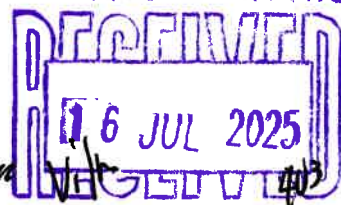

WHEREAS, the Philippine Congress on August 8, 2019 enacted Republic Act 11361 (R.A. 11361), "An Act Ensuring the Continuous and Uninterrupted Transmission and Distribution of Electricity and the Protection of the Integrity and Reliability of Power Lines, and Providing Penalties for Integrity and Reliability of Power Lines, and Providing Penalties for Violations Thereof", also referred to as the "Anti-Obstruction of Power Lines Act;


WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17 of Republic Act No. 11361," (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), the Department of Energy (DOE), in consultation with the appropriate government agencies such as the National Electrification Administration (NEA), the National Power Corporation (NPC), Board of Electrical Engineering (BEE), National

Transmission Corporation (TransCo), the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), the National Housing Authority (NHA), the Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD), the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), the Philippine Coconut Authority (PCA), the National Commission on the Indigenous Peoples (NCIP), the Philippine National Police (PNP), the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP), concerned electric power industry stakeholders, and private stakeholders, and the Joint Congressional Energy Commission (JCEC), has issued, adopted and promulgated the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) to implement the provisions of the Act;

WHEREAS, IRR of R.A. 11361 includes the general provisions to be followed in outlining the responsibilities of the owner or operator of power lines in the prevention and removal of power line obstructions located within any public or private property, with the ultimate objective of ensuring the continuous and uninterrupted conveyance of electricity;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of MacArthur, Leyte has compelling interest in ensuring that the power lines within the municipality located along the national highway and the interior barangays are free of obstructions to ensure the uninterrupted conveyance of electricity essential to sustain the municipality's economic development;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of MacArthur, Leyte acknowledges the crucial role of property owners in ensuring that power lines remain free of any dangerous and hazardous activities and improvements.

WHEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Victoriano T. Lazar duly seconded by en masse, be it

Ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of MacArthur, Leyte that:


**SECTION 1. Purpose.** To ensure the uninterrupted conveyance of electricity from DORELCO power substations to the end users—the member-consumer-owners, and protect the integrity and reliability of the Electric Cooperative's distribution system by keeping the land beneath, the air spaces surrounding and the area traversed by power lines clear of dangerous obstructions.

**SECTION 2. Coverage.** This Ordinance shall cover all power lines and other related facilities for the conveyance of electricity throughout the Municipality of MacArthur, Leyte.

**SECTION 3. Definition of Terms.** For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following terms are defined as follows:



b. "Associated facilities" refers to any or all of the equipment and other fixtures that are attached or connected with, and are integral to a power line, such as, but not limited to poles, guys, crossarms, insulators, and conductors;

c. "Conveyance of Electricity" refers to the delivery of electricity from the DORELCO Power Substation to the premises of the end user, through power lines;

d. "Distribution lines" refer to the portion of the distribution system pertaining to the lines or wires;

e. "Distribution system" refers to the system of wires and associated facilities belonging to DORELCO extending between the delivery points from the EC power substation and the connection to the premises of the end user;

f. "Electric Cooperative" or "EC" refers to DORELCO, a duly organized and registered Electric Cooperative pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 269, as amended, otherwise known as the "National Electrification Administration Decree", holding the franchise to distribute electricity to thirteen (13) municipalities in Leyte, including MacArthur, Leyte;

g. "End user" refers to any person or entity requiring the supply and delivery of electricity for its own use;

h. "Hazardous activities" refer to planting of plants and trees, burning of waste and other materials, excavation, quarrying, construction, and other activities of the same nature and character and regardless of purpose intended, which are performed partially/wholly inside the powerline corridor which threaten or endanger the continuous and uninterrupted conveyance of electricity;


i. "Hazardous improvements" refer to plants, trees, structures, buildings and buildings of whatever kind, whether temporary or permanent in character, and regardless of purpose for which they are intended, which are located, partially/wholly, inside the Power Line Corridor which threaten or endanger the continuous and uninterrupted conveyance of electricity;

j. "Owner or Operator of Power Lines" or "Power Line Owner/Operator" or "PLO" refers to DORELCO having the ownership and/or responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the distribution power lines;


k. "Power lines" refer to transmission lines, sub-transmission lines, distribution lines, and other connection assets including the poles and towers used to support the lines, and other related facilities constructed or erected used for the purpose of conveyance of electricity;


l. "Power line obstruction" refers to any hazardous activity or hazardous improvement and other similar circumstances that threaten or endanger the continuous and interrupted conveyance of electricity;







m. "Tall growing plants" refer to plants, vines and other plant species, which grow or have the potential to grow more than three (3) meters in height from the ground

n. "Power Line Corridor (PLC)" refers to and is constituted as the land beneath, the air space surrounding, and the area traversed by power lines, which shall be kept clear and free from any power line obstructions, dangerous structures, hazardous activities and improvements and other similar circumstances in accordance with the provisions of the Act.

SECTION 4. Prevention and Removal of Power Line Obstruction on Public Property. In cases where the power line corridor is wholly or partially located within the public property, DORELCO shall have the right to enter the said property to prevent and remove any power line obstruction, and in particular, perform the following acts;

- a. To conduct maintenance and inspection activities within the power line corridor;
- b. To conduct repair or restoration activities within the power line corridor;
- c. To conduct trimming, pruning, cutting, or clearing activities for all growing plants within the power line corridor without the need of securing prior clearance permit from the Local Government Unit of MacArthur, Leyte;
- d. To remove, dismantle, or demolish hazardous improvements in accordance with the National Building Code of the Philippines; Provided, that such acts may be carried out without prior clearances or permit from, but with due notice to the Local Government Unit of MacArthur, Leyte;
- e. To stop, prevent, or prohibit the conduct of hazardous activities; and
- f. Perform other analogous acts or activities, which will cause the prevention and removal of any power line obstruction.

SECTION 5. Prevention and Removal of Power Line Obstruction on Private Property. DORELCO shall have the primary duty and responsibility to remove power lines obstructions. In cases where the power line corridor is wholly or partially located within the private property, the property owner shall coordinate and assist DORELCO by facilitating the necessary access in order to perform the acts enumerated in Section 4.

The property owner shall have the primary duty and responsibility to prevent power line obstruction and to inform DORELCO of their existence. In the performance of these acts, the property owner shall be entitled to necessary assistance such as, but not limited to, education, and information, and technical and manpower support from DORELCO.


In the event that the property owner fails to perform any duty and responsibility under the preceding paragraphs, the owner or operator of





the power lines shall have the right to access the power line corridor in order to undertake the acts enumerated under Section 4: Provided, however, That the NOTICE TO THE PROPERTY OWNER shall no longer be required to avert an imminent danger posed by a power line obstruction.

SECTION 6. Assistance from the Barangay. In the performance of this acts under Section 4 and 5, DORELCO shall coordinate and be assisted by the Barangay concerned where the clearing or removal of the line obstacles are being conducted.

The Barangay is mandated to keep its residents updated and notified of the clearing schedules as provided by DORELCO.


SECTION 7. Disposal of Waste and Debris. Waste and debris which resulted from the removal of obstructions and other activities under this ordinance shall be disposed of by the DORELCO in accordance with the relevant barangay and municipal ordinances.

SECTION 8. Separability Clause. Any portion or provision of this Ordinance, which may be declared unconstitutional or invalid shall not have the effect of nullifying other portions or provisions hereof.

SECTION 9. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect upon due compliance with all the requirements as provided for under R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code 1991.

ENACTED by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled on June 16, 2025 at the Municipal Session Hall, Legislative Building, MacArthur, Leyte, Philippines.

Minutes of the Public Hearing held last April 4, 2025, at the Evacuation Center, Barangay Romualdez, MacArthur, Leyte

**AGENDA:**

Presentation and deliberation of the proposed legislative measures sponsored by Honorable Victoriano T. Lazar, to wit:

*Municipal Ordinance No. 04, Series of 2025, AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF DISTRIBUTION LINES OF VARIOUS UTILITIES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MACARTHUR, LEYTE*

*Municipal Ordinance No. 05, Series of 2025, AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING REPUBLIC ACT 11361 OR THE "ANTI-OBSTRUCTION OF POWER LINES ACT" AND FURTHER STRENGTHENING ITS IMPLEMENTATION IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MACARTHUR, LEYTE*

The Secretary to the Sanggunian was requested to act as a moderator of the said Public Hearing.

Honorable Lazar made further explanation on some terms under the Definition of Terms of Municipal Ordinance No. 04, Series of 2025, such as the Pole Location Plan, Rehabilitation Plan and Sag.

Honorable Lazar also made a query to the DORELCO personnel if there is a need to have a memorandum of agreement between private lot owners for the installation of poles. Engr. Salazar said that there should be road right of way. Honorable Guimalan shared that their procedure is to let the landowner sign for authority. With the road right of way, Engr. Salazar shared that they had encountered that the former punong barangay agreed to the installation of poles but then when the implementation was about to commence, the newly elected punong barangay decline and so they must seek again for a consent. He added that there should have a service pole every 40 to 50 meters.

Honorable Bede Mundala raised concerns about those households who are distant from the mainline who wished to have electrical lines. Engr. Joel answered that as long as there are more than 10 household in the area, they can provide a secondary line extension provided that there is a request such as barangay resolution.

Honorable Lazar declared to regulate the height of wires from the ground. Engr. Joel said that the standard vertical clearance is 18ft. During the application, there is a seminar that should be attended by the applicant. The applicants are being informed that in every 40-50 meters there should be a service pole that the consumer should provide since the DORELCO has limit of 100meters.

Then, Honorable Lazar asked what to do about the dangling service wires. Engr. Salazar answered that it should be reported to DORELCO for appropriate action. He added that the

consumers are obliged to install poles for new application but those who are currently using the bamboo as poles, they are given the time to change.

Honorable Milar asked if who is in charge of fixing those sagging wires, is it ok to tap those accredited electrician of DORELCO. Engr. Salazar answered that it should be the DORELCO sub-office who should take charge given that they have the tools and equipment to carry out the task the electricians.

Honorable Guimalan requested for a copy of the ordinance once approved.

Afterwards, Honorable Lazar proceeded to discussion of Municipal Ordinance No. 05, Series of 2025. He raised his concern about the clearing operation of debris. Engr. Joel said that their office has a huge area of responsibility, and thru the proposed ordinance, the barangay will be the one given the responsibility to clear the debris. He added that the vegetation around the poles can cause electrical outage/brownout. Honorable Guimalan declared that there should be a proper coordination with the barangay prior to any clearing operation. Engr. Joel said that it is their negotiation team who identify the area that needs to have vegetation clearing and they have to inform the barangay 3 days before the execution.

Honorable Lazar asked about the vegetation rooted from a private property and leaning toward poles. Engr. Salazar shared that once the vegetation have touched wire, eventually it will fall. There should be a request letter addressed to DORELCO for appropriate action since there should be a consent from the landowner. There should be a clearance of 3 meters to all sides of the poles.

Honorable Lazar raised about the dangling wires of streetlights. Honorable Remanes Jr raised the same concern and recommended to have 18ft height of poles. Honorable Milar complain about the installation of utility wires that are not installed properly and eventually becomes dangling wires. Honorable Remanes Jr., declared that it is the call of the barangay officials to monitor. Honorable Bede Mundala recommended that the barangay officials shall be given the authority. Honorable Lazar said that he will consider to include in the ordinance to have a permit/clearance from the barangay.

#### ADJOURNMENT

There being no more concerns raised the Public Hearing was adjourned at 12:10 high noon.
