This office opines that the subject Ordinance is, in general, within the legislative authority of the Sangguniang Bayan to repeal/amend its prior acts either expressly or by the passage of an essentially inconsistent resolution¹. Hence, we recommend for the declaration of its validity.



ORDINANCE NO. 12, S. 2025

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 06, SERIES OF 2016, KNOWN AS “THE BARUGO, LEYTE COCKFIGHTING ORDINANCE OF 2016”

WHEREAS, Section 5 (d) of P.D. 449, also known as the Cockfighting Law of 1974, as amended, provides as follows:

“Section 5. Cockpits and Cockfighting: In General:

xxx xxx xxx

(d) Holding of Cockfights. Except as provided in this Decree, cockfighting shall be allowed only in licensed cockpits during ***Sundays and legal holidays and during local fiestas*** for not more than three days. It may also be held during provincial, city or municipal, agricultural, commercial or industrial fair, carnival or exposition for a similar period of three days upon resolution of the province, city or municipality where such fair, carnival or exposition is to be held, subject to the approval of the Chief of Constabulary or his authorized representative: Provided, that, no cockfighting on the occasion of such fair, carnival or exposition shall be allowed within the month of a local fiesta or for more than two occasions a year in the same city or municipality: Provided, further, that no cockfighting shall be held on December 30 (Rizal Day), June 12 (Philippine Independence Day) November 30 (National Heroes Day), Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Election or Referendum Day and during Registration Days for such election or referendum.” (***bold italic supplied***)

WHEREAS, Section 8 of Municipal Ordinance No. 06, Series of 2016, provides:

“Section 8. – HOLDING OF COCKFIGHTING ACTIVITY. – Cockfighting shall only be allowed in a licensed cockpit during the following days, except as otherwise provided in this ordinance:

1. Sundays;
2. Legal holidays;
3. ***Market days;***
4. During local fiestas for not more than three days; and ...” (***bold italic supplied***)





RESOLUTION NO. 97, S. 2016

THE BARUGO, LEYTE COCKFIGHTING ORDINANCE OF 2016, AS AMENDED

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled, to enact the following Ordinance:

ORDINANCE NO. 06 s. 2016

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, THAT:

SECTION 1. TITLE. -This ordinance shall be known as "The Barugo, Leyte Cockfighting Ordinance of 2016, as amended."

SECTION 2. SCOPE. - This ordinance shall govern the establishment, operation, management, maintenance, promotion and regulation of cockpit(s) and cockfighting activities within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality of Barugo, the imposition of regulatory fees and charges therefore, and the penalties herein provided for violation thereof.

Any existing franchise shall adhere to the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS. - When used in this article,

BET CALLER (KRISTO) - a person undertaking the call or taking bets for others but independently becomes liable to the wager himself.

BET TAKER/MANAGER (Maciador) -refers to a person who calls for bets and takes the bets for the management subject to the instruction and supervision of the management/owner/promoter, who in turn are liable to the bettors.

BETTOR - a person who undertakes to bet money or things of value for and in consideration of the winning outcome of the cockfight.

COCKFIGHTING (BULANG) - shall mean the commonly known game or term "cockfighting", "derby", "pintakasi" "topada" "sabong" or its equivalent terms in different Philippine localities.

COCKPIT – includes any place, compound, building or portion thereof, where cockfights are held, whether or not money bets are made on the results of such cockfights.

DERBY, LOCAL – is an invitational cockfight participated in by game cockers or cockfighting "aficionados" of the Philippines with "pot money" awarded to the proclaimed winning entry.

PANTA DERBY – shall mean the proper matching of one's cock with another cock by way of determining the physical appearance of both cocks with pot money awarded to winning entry

DERBY, INTERNATIONAL – refers to an invitational cockfight participated in by local and foreign game cockers or cockfighting "aficionados" with pot money awarded to the proclaimed winning entry.

GAFFER (TAGA TARI) – refers to a person who attaches the gaff to the leg or both legs of the fighting cock.

LINCISED COCKFIGHTING OPERATOR – refers to any person, natural or juridical, who has been granted permit/franchise by the municipality of Barugo to operate cockfighting activity within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality after complying with all requirements for its issuance.

LICENSED COCKPIT AREA – pertains to a place duly authorized by the Municipality of Barugo for the conduct of cockfighting activity.

PIT MANAGER – refers to person who manages or takes charge of the pit or ring, who orders or signals to start actual cockfighting after bets are agreed on. He calls for the conduct of the cockfighting activity.

PROMOTER OR OWNER – refers to any person, natural or juridical, who initiates a cockfighting activity, orders the commencement of the cockfight and thereafter distributes won bets to the winners after deducting a certain commission.

REFEREE (SENTENTIADOR) – refers to a person who oversees the cockfighting activity inside the arena/ring/pit. He determines the proper gaffing of fighting cocks; determines the physical condition of game cocks while cockfighting is in progress, the injuries sustained by the cocks and their capability to continue fighting; and he decides and make known his final decision, either by word or gesture, the result of the cockfight by announcing the winner or deciding a tie or no contest, in accordance with the rules of the management.

REGULAR PERMIT HOLDERS - refers to those operator(s)/owner(s)/licensee(s) who are granted permit/license/franchise to regularly operate a cockpit within days as may be allowed by law or ordinance after complying with all the requirements and payments of corresponding fees appurtenant to the operation /management of the cockpit within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Barugo.

SPECIAL PERMIT HOLDER – refers to those operator(s)/promoter(s)/permittee(s) who are not Regular Permit Holders but are granted a special permit to promote/operate/conduct cockfighting activities in accordance with the provision of this ordinance.

Section 4. ADMINISTRATIVE POVISION

- (1) **OWNERSHIP, OPERATION AND MANAGEMENT OF COCKPIT** – Only Filipino persons natural or juridical, who are not otherwise prohibited by existing ordinances or laws, shall be allowed to own, manage and operate cockpits with in the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Barugo.
- (2) **ESTABLISHMENT OF COCKPIT** – The Sanggunian Bayan in accordance with law, shall determine the number of cockpits to be allowed to operate in this Municipality. Where population of the Municipality does not exceed One Hundred Thousand, no two (2) cockpits shall be allowed to operate.
- (3) **COCKPIT CONTRUCTION** – Cockpits shall be constructed and operated within the appropriate areas as prescribed in the Zoning Law or Ordinance of this Municipality. In the absence of such law or ordinance, the Municipality shall see to it that no cockpits are constructed within or near existing residential or commercial areas, hospitals, school buildings, churches or other public buildings, owners, lessees or operators of cockpits which are now existence and do not conform to this requirement are required to comply with these provisions within a period to be specified in the franchise/permit provided. Approval or issuance of building permits for the construction of cockpits shall be made by the Municipal Engineer in accordance with existing ordinances, laws and practices. Construction of cockpits shall be gender responsive and disaster risk free.

- (4) **PERMIT TO OPERATE** – No person, natural or juridical, shall be allowed to operate/conduct any cockfighting activity without securing the necessary franchise/license/mayor's permit and payment of the required fees/charges herein provided.
- (5) Only duly registered and licensed promoters and cockpit/cockfighting personnel shall take part in all kinds of cockfighting activity held in this Municipality. No operator or owner of a cockpit shall employ or allow to participate in a cockfight activity any said personnel unless he has registered them and paid the fees herein required.
- (6) There shall be no cockfighting activities conducted in any barangay of this municipality except during the occasion of the celebration of the barangay fiesta which is traditionally held once a year. Such cockfighting activity may be initiated by the local barangay unit or any person duly recommended by the concerned barangay, unless otherwise precluded by law or ordinance.
- (7) The barangay concerned shall only be allowed to hold cockfighting activities for three (3) days prior to the day of its declared fiesta day. The said barangay unit shall be responsible for the maintenance of peace and order and the safety of the public during the holding of cockfighting activities.
- (8) **FILING OR REQUEST** – Any request to hold cockfighting activities shall be filed with the Mayor's Office Secretary at least ten (10) days before the intended date of cockfighting activities. The number of days shall be reckoned from the time such request is stamped received by the Mayor's Office Secretary. Failure to comply with this provision shall result in the disapproval of such request.
- (9) All fees required under this ordinance shall be paid to the Municipal Treasurer.
- (10) **ALL REGULAR PERMITS/LICENSE** granted under this ordinance shall be valid for one (1) year, unless otherwise disqualified by law or ordinance and/or revoked for cause by the issuing authority.
- (11) **ALL SPECIAL PERMITS/LICENSE** granted under this ordinance shall be valid within the number of days provided in the special permit and shall automatically cease to be valid upon the expiration of the period unless earlier revoked/cancelled for cause by the issuing authority.
- (12) **PROHIBITION OF MINORS** – No minor children shall be allowed within the premises of the cock arena/area in whatever capacity.

Section 5. IMPOSITION OF FEES – There shall be collected an annual fee for the issuance of regular Mayor's Permit and/or one-time fee for special permits for operator(s)/owner(s)/licensee(s) and their personnel for the operation/conduct of cockfighting activity(ies) within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Barugo.

Section 6. TIME AND MANNER OF PAYMENTS.- The fees/charges herein imposed shall be payable to the Municipal Treasurer of this Municipality before any cockfighting can be lawfully held.

Section 7. SURCHARGE FOR LATE PAYMENT.- Failure to pay the fee prescribed in this Article within the time required shall be subject the taxpayer to a surcharge of Twenty-five percent (25%) of the original amount due. Such surcharge shall be paid at the same time and the same manner as the original fee due.

Section 8.- HOLDING OF COCKFIGHTING ACTIVITY.- Cockfighting shall only be allowed in a licensed cockpit during the following days, except as otherwise provided in this ordinance:

1. Sundays;
2. Legal holidays
3. Market Days
4. During local fiestas for not more than three (3) days; and
5. During Municipal Agriculture, Commercial, or Industrial fairs, carnivals, or exposition for a similar period of three (3) days upon resolution of the Sanggunian Bayan. No cockfighting on the occasion of such affair, carnival or exposition shall be allowed within the month of a local fiesta or for more than two (2) occasions a year.
6. Cockfighting for entertainment of tourists or for charitable purposes. Subject to the preceding subsection hereof, the holding of cockfights may be allowed for the entertainment of foreign dignitaries or for tourists, or for returning Filipinos, commonly known as "Balikbayans" or for the support of national-fund raising campaigns for charitable purposes as may be authorized upon resolution of the Sanggunian Bayan, in a licensed cockpit or in a playground or park. This privilege shall be extended for only one (1) time, for a period not exceeding three (3) days, within a year.

Section 9. SPECIAL PROHIBITION- No cockfighting shall be held on the following days:

1. December 30 (Rizal Day);
2. June 12 (Independence Day);
3. November 30 (National Heroes Day);
4. Holy Thursday & Good Friday
5. Election or Referendum Day; and
6. During Registration Days for such Election or referendum

Section 10. COCKFIGHTING ACTIVITIES SUBJECT TO A SPECIAL PERMIT— The following shall be subject to a special permit as provided in this ordinance and the corresponding requirements duly complied with by the applicant promoter/organizer:

1. The Barangay applicant shall declare through a Barangay Resolution the official date of the Barangay Fiesta that it celebrates, and SB Resolution adopting such Barangay Resolution. For purposes of this ordinance, no two (2) official dates shall be declared by any barangay local government unit as their official Feast Day.
2. During Municipal, Agricultural, or Industrial Fairs, carnival or exposition for a similar period of three (3) days upon resolution of the Sanggunian Bayan. No cockfighting on the occasion of such affair, carnival or exposition shall be allowed within the month of the local fiesta or for more than two (2) occasions a year.
3. Cockfighting for entertainment of tourists or for charitable purposes. Subject to the preceding subsection hereof, the holding of cockfights may also be allowed for the entertainment of foreign dignitaries or for tourists, or for returning Filipinos, commonly known as "Balikbayans," or for the support of national-fund raising campaigns for charitable purposes as may be authorized upon resolution of the Sanggunian Bayan, and shall be extended for only one (1) time, for a period not exceeding three (3) days, within a year.

Section 11. RULES GOVERNING COCKFIGHTING- (a) The promoter or owner of licensed cockpit or permit holder shall promulgate house rules on the conduct of cockfighting, which shall be clearly made known to all stakeholders in the conduct of cockfighting activities, i.e., announcing house rules in the cockpit area, posting of the house rules in the cockpit premises or other ways as the management may deem fit, in which case the cockpit "*affectionados*" shall follow and adhere. The said house rules shall be consistent with laws, public policy, public order, good customs and practices.

(b) Promoter(s)/Owner(s)/Licensee(s) shall ensure public order and safety in the conduct of any cockfighting activity.

Section 12. APPLICABILITY CLAUSE – The provisions of PD 449 and Republic Act 7160 shall apply to all matters regarding the establishment, operation and regulation of cockpits and the holding of cockfights in the Municipality of Barugo.

Section 13. PENALTIES.

- (1) FIRST OFFENSE – Fine of Php 1,000.00 plus confiscation of the fighting cocks and cockfighting paraphernalia.
- (2) SECOND OFFENSE and Onward – Fine Php 2,000.00 and the confiscation of fighting cocks and cockfighting paraphernalia or imprisonment of not more than (1) month or both fine and confiscation and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.
- (3) On top of the penalty herein imposed, the violator shall likewise be required to pay any unpaid fees and charges as required by this ordinance.
- (4) Any person violating any provision of this ordinance and who is found to be a public official or employee shall, in addition to the penalties herein imposed, likewise be charged administratively.

Section 14. REPEALING CLAUSE – This ordinance specifically amends and/or repeals:

- (a) Ordinance No. 01, Series of 2004;
- (b) Ordinance No. 01, Series of 2011, Chapter III:
Art. A, Section 3A.01 (4) x x x x Cockpit P 500.00;
Art. A, Section 3A.02;
Art. 3B, Section 3B.01, 3B.02, 3B.03, 3B.04, and 3B.05;
Art 3B-1, Section 3B-1.01, 3B-1.02, 3B-1.03, 3B- 1.04, 3B- 1.05 and 3B-1.06; and
- (c) All other provisions, ordinances, rules, regulations or parts thereof, inconsistent with or in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, shall be deemed repealed or amended accordingly.

Section 15. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – If any provision of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional, the remaining provision shall not be affected by such declaration.

Section 16. Effectivity- This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.




